If somebody tells you that they've been abducted by aliens, there's not much middle ground.

219

We're investigating the case of West Yorkshire police officer Alan Godfrey,

220

who claims to have encountered the UFO on the Burnley Road in the Pennines on the 28th of November 1980.

221

Oh man, that is phenomenal, look how it pulses though. That is freaky man.

And it has prompted calls for reinvestigation of some of the most convincing accounts of sightings in recent years, including that of Alan Godfrey.

His vivid and terrifying experience is one of the most startling and compelling close encounters in UK UFO history.

I feel much more invigorated about this story now.

A touch of excitement in fact, Alan Godfrey in Todd Morden said he saw a big diamond-shaped spaceship,

but he wasn't the only one who saw it and the MOD got involved and interviewed him with his sergeant present,

which proves that they took it seriously as well.

And it's certainly exciting that we've got a mounting amount of evidence towards these claims.

Where do we go from here?

Well, interestingly, this isn't the only such claim.

There's been other people making similar claims to Alan.

And if we can understand why they happened, it could help us with this case.

I actually caught up with Nick Pope, who's a former MOD investigator and a UFO expert who told me about another case.

So the idea of people alleging to be abducted by aliens, this is nothing new.

No, these reports go back decades and I think it's one thing to say that you have seen a UFO

So actually seeing or claiming to see an alien life ball, there have been some quite famous cases, haven't they?

There was Pascua Gola in 1973.

Well, this was a really bizarre case.

This is the state of Mississippi.

Two guys out fishing, Calvin Parker and Charles Hexen.

They see a UFO, but then they describe almost being in a state of waking unconsciousness.

261

Ooh, it's like that. That's all.

262

And you know, you think you're dreaming about something like that, you know?

263

And they then describe these bizarre entities with like, strange appendages and slits

and they talk about being taken on the ship and having these procedures.

But just because something sounds bizarre, who's to say that it isn't true?

I think it is interesting that recently some new witnesses have emerged.

Yes, I think the police witness is absolutely something that adds credibility.

And there's a couple of other witnesses I'm aware of too.

There's somebody who was operating a crane who said that he saw a UFO.

And then there's another witness who claims that she saw a strange looking humanoid figure actually in the water.

So what are we saying then that this has been happening for decades and people have just not been believed?

304

They absolutely could. There's so many possibilities.

We know that people who were scared to come forward are now talking again.

This case here with Alan Godfrey is 40 years old, over 40 years old, yet it's still unsolved,

313

Coming up, what I'm really interested in is that missing 25 minutes.

Okay, sir, we've got Alan Godfrey, an on-duty police officer in West Yorkshire.

He sees a diamond-shaped spaceship in front of him.

332

What it was, he doesn't know, but all he knows is that he saw something which didn't belong there.

333

Now, we've got multiple witnesses, the caretaker, the bus driver, people have saw it zigzagging across a field.

There was also another witness who also contacted the police station the following morning

It's been 40 years since this case happened and could it have just been a folk story, something which has been embellished over time?

I've got someone who might be able to help with this.

340

This is really our last chance to find out exactly what happened to Alan Godfrey

and the person we're going to speak to is one of the UK's most renowned UFO experts.

342

His name is Philip Mantle and he joins us now.

343

Hi, Philip.

344

00:31:31,000 --> 00:31:32,000

Good afternoon, Greg.

345

Philip Mantle is a well-renowned UFO expert, author and researcher.

346

00:31:37,000 --> 00:31:45,000

Having dedicated 40 years of study to the case of Alan Godfrey, he has forensic knowledge of Alan's hypnotic regression.

347

00:31:45,000 --> 00:31:50,000

Can you talk us through what exactly happened in the regression with Alan Godfrey?

348

00:31:50,000 --> 00:31:57,000

So when he describes driving up the road, something grabs his attention and he goes to take a closer look at it.

349

00:31:57,000 --> 00:32:02,000

And at first, under hypnosis, Alan thinks it's a bus.

350

But as he gets closer, you can hear the quizzical tone in his voice.

351

It's a bus.

Yes.

It's not a bus.

It's not a bus.

So the hypnotherapist asked him, well, what is it?

356

It looks like a flying saucer.

357

It's spinning.

358

00:32:23,000 --> 00:32:25,000

There's a light on top.

359

00:32:25,000 --> 00:32:26,000

It's a dome.

I'm not going in an era.

361

So he gets back in his patrol car, starts to draw this, then he remembers being further down the road.

362

And then all of a sudden, out of nowhere, Alan throws his hands in a cross shape across his face and he recoils backwards.

And he literally shouts, there's a light, there's a light, there's a light.

There's a blinding light in his eyes.

365

And slowly, maturely, he regains his composure and he starts to describe the scene inside.

366

I'm in a room now.

There's a table.

368

There's him.

369

00:33:01,000 --> 00:33:06,000

Alan hears this man speak, but his mouth doesn't move.

370

00:33:06,000 --> 00:33:10,000

Alan can hear what he's saying inside his head.

371

00:33:10,000 --> 00:33:13,000

I can understand him, but I can't.

372

00:33:13,000 --> 00:33:15,000

He's not moving his mouth.

373

00:33:15,000 --> 00:33:19,000

So he asks Alan to get on this, we'll call it a bed.

374

00:33:19,000 --> 00:33:29,000

And as well as on this bed, he sort of looks to one side and again he recoils and he goes, ugh, ugh.

375

And he's talking about these smaller creatures.

376

To him looked like children, but he said they had heads that looked like the old fashioned light bulbs.

377

Oh, them are horrible.

Who's they?

379

00:33:43,000 --> 00:33:46,000

I don't want to talk about them.

380

00:33:46,000 --> 00:33:47,000

They're small.

381

00:33:47,000 --> 00:33:50,000

About the size of a little five-year-old that.

382

They're touching me.

383

00:33:51,000 --> 00:33:57,000

And in the end, you know, he's brought out of the hypnosis, having recounted these details.

384

And it's very strange.

385

Alan has no idea how he got on board this thing.

386

But there are similarities with other cases as well where regression has taken place.

It's got a nickname.

It's called doorway amnesia.

389

And what we call the alien abduction club.

390

It's a club that no one wants to join.

391

Philip, how many people are in the alien abduction club?

392

You'd be surprised.

393

00:34:21,000 --> 00:34:28,000

It's growing exponentially, but most of the people that are in that club don't seek publicity,

394

00:34:28,000 --> 00:34:30,000

don't want to go on the record.

395

00:34:30,000 --> 00:34:33,000

Very famous incident involved Travis Walton.

396

00:34:34,000 --> 00:34:44,000

U.S. forestry worker Travis Walton was lumberjacking in the Apache Slickreaves National Forest in Arizona in November 1975,

397

00:34:44,000 --> 00:34:50,000

when he had the most terrifying encounter of his life.

398

00:34:50,000 --> 00:34:55,000

I just felt this numbing shock go through my body.

399

00:34:55,000 --> 00:34:59,000

He went missing for five days before reappearing on the side of a road,

400

00:34:59,000 --> 00:35:03,000

with apparently no memory of how he got there.

401

00:35:03,000 --> 00:35:08,000

But I can still see this shiny hole there, hovering above the highway.

402

00:35:08,000 --> 00:35:12,000

Before it went up.

403

00:35:12,000 --> 00:35:17,000

His claim of alien abduction is one of the most infamous in the world.

404

Just like Alan Godfrey, Travis Walton couldn't recall boarding the alien craft,

405

00:35:22,000 --> 00:35:30,000

but claims to have woken up to find himself in a sterile room, being examined by strange entities.

406

00:35:30,000 --> 00:35:35,000

When I could finally focus my eyes, I could see it was these creatures.

407

00:35:35,000 --> 00:35:38,000

And I just flipped out.

408

00:35:38,000 --> 00:35:40,000

Just started screaming.

409

00:35:40,000 --> 00:35:51,000

They were hairless, small, huge eyes, and they just kept staring at me.

410

00:35:51,000 --> 00:35:58,000

Travis Walton saw a very human looking like beings, but then some other different types of creatures.

411

00:35:58,000 --> 00:36:01,000

So there are similarities with other accounts.

412

00:36:01,000 --> 00:36:08,000

Let's put the hypnotic regression aside and let's just purely focus on the sighting of the UFO.

413

Why did he not sort of seek to find some physical evidence of this?

414

00:36:12,000 --> 00:36:18,000

Alan thought the best thing to do is report this to my superior officers, which he did.

415

00:36:18,000 --> 00:36:24,000

They asked him to make a full report, which he did, which incidentally was sent to the Ministry of Defence,

416

00:36:24,000 --> 00:36:27,000

but you can't find it anywhere in their files that have been released.

417

00:36:27,000 --> 00:36:31,000

Do you not think there's a more likely down-to-earth explanation for this?

418

00:36:31,000 --> 00:36:34,000

Alan doesn't say he was abducted by aliens.

419

00:36:34,000 --> 00:36:40,000

What he does say is the thing is so on the road that morning, just coming off his night shift,

420

00:36:40,000 --> 00:36:45,000

he said if he had a brick, he could have thrown it at it and it would have gone clank.

421

00:36:45,000 --> 00:36:49,000

I did see a UFO that night. That object was real.

422

00:36:49,000 --> 00:36:52,000

If I had got out the car and thrown a brick at it, it would have gone bang.

423

00:36:52,000 --> 00:36:56,000

He drew it on his notepad while he was sighting the police car.

424

00:36:56,000 --> 00:37:01,000

Couldn't get through on the radio, which was not unusual for the area, I might add.

425

00:37:01,000 --> 00:37:08,000

The incident on the road that morning, he's 100% certain that this was something quite extraordinary.

426

00:37:08,000 --> 00:37:11,000

What do you think it was?

427

00:37:11,000 --> 00:37:16,000

Good question. I really couldn't put my finger on what it may or may not be.

428

00:37:16,000 --> 00:37:25,000

We have to remember Alan had more to lose than they had to gain by admitting to such a story and going public with it.

429

00:37:25,000 --> 00:37:35,000

What I would say is that Alan's story, going back from 1980, has never really changed, which I think speaks volumes for him.

430

I've just noticed something interesting.

431

Philip mentioned in his interview with us that the radio doesn't often work where Alan Godfrey was,

432

00:37:49,000 --> 00:37:53,000

but Alan Godfrey in his interview claimed that something stopped the radio working,

433

00:37:53,000 --> 00:37:59,000

and that kind of leads me to think that some of this other evidence might not be as credible as we first thought.

434

00:37:59,000 --> 00:38:04,000

But the hypnotic regression, some of that stuff there is next level, isn't it?

435

00:38:04,000 --> 00:38:08,000

What we've actually got from that is a transcript which came from the regression.

436

00:38:08,000 --> 00:38:15,000

Look, them are horrible. Who's horrible? They are. Who's they? I don't want to talk about them.

437

00:38:15,000 --> 00:38:20,000

Why not? Because they're horrible. What do they look like? They're small. How small is small?

438

Three foot, four foot? About the size of a little five year old lad? And how many? About eight.

439

Wow, eight of them. What's happening now? They're just touching me. Wow.

440

Chilling stuff, isn't it?

441

00:38:33,000 --> 00:38:36,000

Under hypnosis. That is frightening.

442

The Alan Godfrey case is one of the most disturbing and perplexing to hit our desk.

443

It's time to review the evidence we've uncovered and see if we can reach a conclusion.

444

Well, let's look at what we've got. Unfortunately, most of the evidence is purely anecdotal.

445

We've got no hard physical evidence. We've got a bus driver and a caretaker who said they thought they saw something odd.

446

00:39:00,000 --> 00:39:06,000

We've got Alan Godfrey's sketch of what he thought he saw that night. The MOD, they were involved.

447

00:39:06,000 --> 00:39:12,000

That's interesting to me. But those files went missing. When they released the files, they went in there.

448

00:39:12,000 --> 00:39:18,000

They weren't missing. They just didn't release into the public. There's probably thousands of MOD files that haven't been released.

449

00:39:18,000 --> 00:39:19,000

Why hasn't it been released?

450

00:39:19,000 --> 00:39:23,000

That we don't know, but we can't say that's conclusive evidence. It's a mystery still.

451

00:39:23,000 --> 00:39:30,000

And we've got the transcript from Alan's hypnosis, in which his suppressed memories of the missing 25 minutes were revealed.

452

00:39:30,000 --> 00:39:34,000

But that's all the evidence we've really got.

453

Do we have enough to determine what really happened to Alan Godfrey on that dark night in Yorkshire in November 1980?

454

Well, I thought we'd split these into two, the UFO sighting and the alien abduction, and decide on them individually.

455

I agree.

456

00:39:56,000 --> 00:40:03,000

OK, but before we reach a conclusion, I think Alan's been kind of lost in this a little bit, so let's look at his open statement once again.

457
