The experiment is straightforward.

for a trip inside a clean room.

115

Any particles that we bring in from the outside

116

can contaminate the samples,

117

so we wipe down the equipment and wrap ourselves

118

in sterile gowns and gloves.

I'm a lunch lady.

120

Wow, look at this.

121

This is clean. This is the clean room, yeah.

122

Once we're allowed to set foot in the lab,

123

we sit down in front of Professor Wainwright's

scanning electron microscope,

125

which can image objects smaller than 1-1-hundredth

126

the diameter of a human hair.

127

All right, these are the stubs that we exposed

128

00:05:22,120 --> 00:05:24,120

in the stratosphere.

129

The microscope takes a few minutes to work.

130

Based on how we're dressed, I feel like we're waiting for a baby.

131

That's right.

132

There's a real waiting room vibe here at the hospital.

133

Professor Wainwright has only conducted a handful of tests like this

134

and has received promising results on each occasion.

135

We're hoping to get a significant result today,

136

since this is the first time this experiment

137

is being documented on camera.

138

It's a bit like waiting for images from the moon.

139

Exactly.

140

The team moves the camera on the electron microscope

141

00:05:58,120 --> 00:06:01,120

around the edge of the sample tray we sent to space,

142

looking for any particles that might have become attached.

143

Finally, the microscope gets a hit.

144

Oh, what's that? You see that?

145

A little guy?

146

Definitely an instance.

147

Yeah, OK, we've hit something.

148

What is it?

149

We don't know what it is until we get closer and closer.

150

It's getting a kind of a biological shape about it.

151

Look at that.

165

That certainly looks biological, I think.

166

It's about 20 microns in size.

167

Is that small enough that it could have been set up from the planet's surface?

168

No, this is four or five times too big.

169

This did not come from Earth.

170

00:07:14,120 --> 00:07:17,120

If it's biological and it's not from the planet's surface,

171

00:07:17,120 --> 00:07:19,120

then that's extraterrestrial?

172

00:07:19,120 --> 00:07:21,120

Well, what else can it be?

173

00:07:21,120 --> 00:07:23,120

Wait, do we just find it extraterrestrial?

174

00:07:23,120 --> 00:07:25,120

Is that what you're saying?

175

00:07:25,120 --> 00:07:28,120

Well, if it isn't, I don't know the answer to what it is.

176

I might be looking at extraterrestrial life here.

177

That's crazy.

178

That's completely insane.

179

Dr. Wainwright's tests are making headlines around the world.

188

Skeptics are convinced that the particles,

189

like the one we found, must be from Earth.

190

Others are applauding his work and rushing to repeat and verify the results.

191

Time will tell, but Professor Wainwright seems certain

192

that the particle we're staring at is from a galaxy far, far away.

193

While the scientific community continues to study Dr. Wainwright's findings,

194

I'm not going to stop investigating.

195

196

200

207

Josh?

Hey, I'm in Oklahoma.

216

00:09:37,120 --> 00:09:38,120

Come on over.

217

00:09:38,120 --> 00:09:40,120

Chase is the director of the special assignment team

218

00:09:40,120 --> 00:09:43,120

for the oldest and largest UFO case in the world.

219

00:09:43,120 --> 00:09:45,120

First of all, what does MOFON stand for?

220

00:09:45,120 --> 00:09:47,120

MOFON stands for the Mutual UFO Network.

221

00:09:47,120 --> 00:09:50,120

And what separates MOFON from other reporting centers

222

00:09:50,120 --> 00:09:52,120

is that we have investigators.

223

00:09:52,120 --> 00:09:55,120

We have over 4,000 members and investigators all over the world

224

00:09:55,120 --> 00:09:57,120

ready to put boots on the ground.

225

00:09:57,120 --> 00:09:58,120

And what's your specific background?

226

00:09:58,120 --> 00:10:01,120

I'm a biomechanics engineer for the Department of Defense.

227

I'm actually a master trainer, master instructor.

228

Wow.

229

00:10:05,120 --> 00:10:07,120

So you have a really legit background in the end of this.

230

231

What's brought you and me now to the Oklahoma-Arkansas border?

235

A really great case has just come in.

It's a couple that had a very strange event happen on their property.

237

It's not far from here.

239

We're going to be the first.

240

241

I'm ready.

Come on, I have to you.

We leave Oklahoma and climb back into the Jeep in Arkansas.

244

Josh, before we leave, we have to get you an official MOFON uniform.

245

Yes.

246

00:10:41,120 --> 00:10:42,120

I'm Aldrin Scully.

247

00:10:42,120 --> 00:10:43,120

Let's go.

248

00:10:43,120 --> 00:10:48,120

The truth is out there.

249

00:10:48,120 --> 00:10:52,120

Here we go.

250

00:10:52,120 --> 00:10:57,120

Our destination is two hours into the mountains where a family claims to have seen dramatic

251

00:10:57,120 --> 00:11:02,120

lights hovering in the sky.

252

00:11:02,120 --> 00:11:06,120

We finally arrive at the Board Camp Crystal Mine to meet the Murphy family.

253

00:11:06,120 --> 00:11:07,120

How are you doing?

254

00:11:07,120 --> 00:11:08,120

Oh, Josh.

255

00:11:08,120 --> 00:11:14,120

This is Cheryl and their son Josh, who walk us down to the location of their sighting.

256

This is it.

257

00:11:15,120 --> 00:11:16,120

This is it.

258

00:11:16,120 --> 00:11:21,120

We were standing right here.

259

00:11:21,120 --> 00:11:27,120

We were watching out this area here and we were seeing little glows of light.

260

Then the top of the hill just glowed.

261

I mean the brightest glow you've ever seen.

262

Okay.

We would love answers.

272

Yes.

273

00:12:12,120 --> 00:12:19,120

The lights have been seen on several different occasions all around the same time of night.

274

00:12:19,120 --> 00:12:29,120

So when the sun sets, Chase and I hike to the scene to try to see the evidence ourselves.

275

Okay, so the site's back this way.

276

00:12:31,120 --> 00:12:34,120

We have a totally unobstructed view.

277

00:12:34,120 --> 00:12:39,120

By the way, it's about the same time as it was when they had their experience.

278

About that time?

279

It's about that time.

280

Okay, let's go dark here.

281

Okay, and see what we see.

And what they're describing is significantly bigger,

We leave the fireflies alone and decide to survey the edges of the area where the sighting occurred.

General Ramey is the senior military officer

513

involved with this.

514

The document that he's holding almost certainly pertains

515

to the Roswell incident itself.

516

Now, that photo is the only evidence of this document.

517

These very famous Ramey memo photos are here.

564

Yes, they're here in the cold bomb.

565

I'm excited to see the original.

566

Let's do it.

of debate.

And that is the original negative.

Mike, let's talk about what happens from here.

This negative would need to be scanned into a digital format,

put on a computer with the appropriate software,

ready to take a look at it.

Got it.

589

Mike scans the negative and begins the laborious process

590

00:27:35,120 --> 00:27:38,120

of forensically analyzing the photo.

591

Every pixel is scrutinized.

592

00:27:40,120 --> 00:27:44,120

This is the first time an impartial, court-certified expert

593

00:27:44,120 --> 00:27:47,120

has done this kind of examination on the Ramey memo.

594

And after hours of work, he's ready to show the results.

595

Using forensic enhancement techniques,

596

here we've got multiple coloring filters.

able to determine is actually something at ground level,

Clear lines.

This is actually several layers of video

729

stacked on top of each other.

730

They were probably filming with a cell phone camera

731

and they were filming vertical, which is a pet peeve of mine.

732

I don't know why people do that.
