Bioluminescence is sometimes caused by tiny algae or a kind of plankton in the water,

which, when agitated, can light up as a defense mechanism.

And beyond algae, certain fish, squid, and jellyfish are also bioluminescent,

107

so it can't rule that out as a possibility.

and when 9-11 happened, he worked in counter-terrorism in Afghanistan.

The next mission was to spearhead the top-secret investigation of UFOs from the Pentagon,

Camp Pendleton is where the United States Marine Corps does a lot of their training,

194

but you also have a defunct nuclear power plant.

The one thing that we have a pretty good grasp on within the government is that there seems to be some sort of nuclear connection with UFOs.

196

Let's not forget that you had the Nimitz carrier group right here in this area in 2004.

197

You had a nuclear-powered submarine.

198

That's a huge, huge footprint from a nuclear technology perspective.

So the question we were having in the Pentagon was,

UFO encounters near nuclear technology have been reported for decades.

203

Bill and I even investigated the possible connection between nuclear sites and UFOs back in New Mexico.

204

We saw a UFO, an unidentified flying object.

205

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:26,000

There have been 8,500 sightings near nuclear facilities in the U.S. alone,

206

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:32,000

but as far as we know, there are no sources of nuclear power beneath the waters around California.

207

00:11:32,000 --> 00:11:37,000

Why do you think there's been so many sightings in this area under the water?

208

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:41,000

Perhaps there is a hotspot based upon where we are.

209

00:11:41,000 --> 00:11:46,000

So what I have here is the magnetic survey superimposed on a map.

210

00:11:46,000 --> 00:11:52,000

You can see the coastline here and we are in Catalina Island in a field of nothing for thousands of miles.

211

All of a sudden you have this weird magnetic anomaly.

212

00:11:56,000 --> 00:11:58,000

There's a lot of energy there.

213

00:11:58,000 --> 00:12:02,000

A magnetic anomaly is a variation in strength of the Earth's magnetic field.

214

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:08,000

This can be caused by large concentration of rocks with high metal content or large metal structures.

215

00:12:08,000 --> 00:12:12,000

On Louise's map, the red areas represent a constant magnetic field

216

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:17,000

and the blue, just northwest of Catalina, is an area with a stronger magnetic pole.

217

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:21,000

Could that be the thing that's actually attracting you at both sides?

218

00:12:21,000 --> 00:12:28,000

We get multiple reports and a lot of data that indicates these things are somehow related to these magnetic anomalies.

219

00:12:28,000 --> 00:12:33,000

Right now we're hovering over the area which indicated a high level of magnetism on Louise's map

220

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:38,000

and has seen the highest concentration of USO reports.

221

00:12:38,000 --> 00:12:42,000

Could whatever's causing that energy be attracting you up?

222

00:12:42,000 --> 00:12:46,000

Could it be the same thing that's been happening in the past?

223

00:12:46,000 --> 00:12:50,000

Could it be the same thing that's been happening in the USO reports?

224

00:12:50,000 --> 00:12:56,000

Could whatever's causing that energy be attracting UFOs and explain so many USO sightings?

225

00:12:56,000 --> 00:13:01,000

It's the same area where Jess and I saw a mysterious light under the water last night.

226

00:13:01,000 --> 00:13:07,000

So are there other encounters that are as well documented as that Nimitz encounter that just aren't public yet?

227

I have to be careful when I say it.

228

00:13:09,000 --> 00:13:15,000

We'll tell you there are absolutely multiple, multiple other encounters that are very well documented

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00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:18,000

and there's a lot of fidelity to the data.

But I unfortunately can't discuss those.

I still have a security clearance.

I need to find any recent reports that describe a similar light below the surface to figure out what we and others are seeing around here.

236

Meanwhile, Phil and Louise head out to our research vessel to see if they can find what's responsible for the magnetic anomaly deep below the surface.

237

A lot of the locals here, they actually swear that there is some sort of underwater facility, a base, a location.

238

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:04,000

Do you think something like that is possible out here?

239

00:14:04,000 --> 00:14:10,000

Well, I think if you look back even just with our own technology, going back to World War II and whatnot,

240

00:14:10,000 --> 00:14:12,000

we've always had secret submarine bases.

241

00:14:12,000 --> 00:14:18,000

We've had all sorts of top secret locations to support our war machine.

242

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:21,000

But the question is, is it not man-made?

243

00:14:21,000 --> 00:14:26,000

The idea of underwater bases is not science fiction and definitely not new.

244

00:14:26,000 --> 00:14:32,000

We've had a naval testing facility 1100 feet below the surface of an Idaho lake since World War II.

245

And near the Bahamas, Autech, the Atlantic Undersea Test and Evaluation Center, located at depths of 6000 feet,

246

00:14:39,000 --> 00:14:44,000

was specifically built to test underwater vehicles, weapons, and systems.

247

00:14:44,000 --> 00:14:48,000

Interestingly, UFOs have also been reported around Autech.

248

00:14:48,000 --> 00:14:54,000

If there were some kind of base under the waters here, I feel like it would have to be in that deeper water.

249

00:14:54,000 --> 00:15:00,000

Certainly, if you want to keep something secret, probably the best way to do that would be out of the prying eyes of your enemy.

250

And in this case, the deeper the water, the better.

251

After scouring sources online and in Catalina, I've found an eyewitness who saw an unusual light underwater

252

00:15:11,000 --> 00:15:14,000

off the island's northern coast around the same time we did.

253

00:15:14,000 --> 00:15:20,000

Andrew Quintana is a longtime resident of Catalina, and he knows the coastline well.

254

00:15:20,000 --> 00:15:24,000

So if I've been talking to folks around the island, they said you were the guy to meet up with.

255

00:15:24,000 --> 00:15:29,000

I've lived here for about 15 years, and I've seen a lot of things that have happened out here on Catalina.

256

00:15:29,000 --> 00:15:37,000

Andrew runs an eco-tourism company in Catalina, and he has led guided tours of the island's

surrounding waters for years.

257

00:15:37,000 --> 00:15:41,000

I live right by the ocean. I know what dolphin pods look like. I know what bioluminescence looks like.

258

00:15:41,000 --> 00:15:44,000

I saw something that I couldn't really explain.

259

00:15:44,000 --> 00:15:46,000

Who? Were you nervous, scared?

260

00:15:46,000 --> 00:15:51,000

It was more of a, I need to assess what's going on right now before I start thinking I'm crazy.

261

00:15:52,000 --> 00:16:02,000

When you hear someone say that they saw UFO, and they're certain it's UFO, with your background, you know, how do you call out the BS, essentially?

262

00:16:02,000 --> 00:16:10,000

First of all, these things fall squarely within the five categories of observables that we in the

Pentagon were able to determine.

263

And the last observable is something that can defy the natural effects of Earth's gravity without any obvious signs of propulsion, any obvious signs of lift, any control surfaces.

So when we talk about those five observables, does the Nimitz encounter from 2004 hit all five?

272

Imagine now having a vehicle that can do all five of those observables. You're now talking a real serious national security threat.

Wow. When we're in the chop, we showed us a map of the magnetic activity. Like, is that the Earth's right now?

I'll tell you what, we have a sonar on board that I think we should put in action to see if we can pick up anything down below.

Now that we're in our target zone, we'll use two sonar scanners which will help locate anything unusual and identify its steps.

We're doing good.

The difference in colors that we're seeing here, can you describe what those actually mean?

So the dark red you're seeing there is the ball of fish.

So what should be the plan of action?

That is structure.

Look at the size of that thing.

319

You're saying there's a structure on the bottom of the ocean.

320

There is structure on the bottom.

321

I don't know what it is.

322

Well that's promising.

323

00:19:30,000 --> 00:19:31,000

What the hell is that?

324

That is not small.

325

Phil and Luis Elizondo, the former head of the Pentagon's UFO investigation program, are scanning

the waters off of Catalina Island.

326

And their research vessel Sonar has just detected an unknown structure on the sea floor.

327

Is there anything natural that would explain a structure like that, like coral reefs?

I feel like we have to check this thing out.

Andrew Quintana tells me the mysterious light he saw in the water wasn't bioluminescence.

334

We're out there, just me and three of my buddies.

335

I looked down over the boat and there was just something glowing down there.

336

00:20:19,000 --> 00:20:21,000

I could tell that it was coming from very deep.

337

It was looking down and that ball light got big, got small, and then it was gone.

338

Oh it was pulsing.

339

Yeah.

340

And then it just disappeared?

341

So you don't think it was military or anything like that?

343

You try to rationalize what you're seeing.

It's either the military with some fun toys they're not telling us about or something beyond that.

Have there been any other reports from locals of USOs underneath the water?

As someone who has witnessed bioluminescence in these waters many times, Andrew says the

And the fact he saw it around the same time Phil and I saw an unusual light,

354

I'm convinced we're dealing with a hell of a lot more than just some algae that glows in the dark.

355

Well thank you so much for all that information.

356

I'll let you know what we find.

357

Our sonar has detected an unidentified structure that could be creating a magnetic field below the surface

and potentially attracting UFOs to the area.

On this dive, I'm bringing a waterproof electromagnetic field reader or EMF reader

360

that will be able to detect and measure any magnetic fields below the surface.

361

Alright, I'm bringing down the EMF because as you said this is a very magnetically active area underneath this right now

362

and perhaps the structure we found could be given off some EMF as well.

363

And I'm going to bring a water test kit.

364

I want to look for things like heavy metal.

Are there any traces of any type of radioactive isotopes that maybe we can detect?

More data is good data.

Oh yeah.

Our air tanks are filled with nitrox, a mixture that contains higher amounts of oxygen than the air used in typical scuba tanks.

369

This prevents nitrogen buildup in our system.

370

Too much nitrogen in the bloodstream can inhibit motor function and lead to unconsciousness and even death.

371

Plus, the nitrox will double our time underwater so we can dive deeper.

372

With visibility like this, anything could be hiding down here.

373

No, what's your depth?

375

Alright, we landed south of the Sonar hit, let's try swimming north.

377

Good copy, I agree.

You see anything yet?

Nothing yet.

Most shipwrecks close to the shore of Catalina have been documented and mapped, but just a few miles out and in deeper water, it's a different story.

There could be hundreds of un-catalogged wrecks down here.

389

This massive ship is definitely one of those and could have been down here for decades, so who knows what else could be hidden here.

390

Look at this thing, this thing is massive.

391

00:23:42,000 --> 00:23:45,000

Let's try swimming around the perimeter and see how big it is.

392

00:23:46,000 --> 00:23:50,000

I think the size matches up. It is dense, it is old metal.

393

00:23:50,000 --> 00:23:56,000

It must be the object that showed up on Sonar, but so far, no unusual magnetism.

394

00:23:56,000 --> 00:23:59,000

Check the EMF reader, are you getting anything?

395

00:24:03,000 --> 00:24:05,000

No, nothing yet.

396

00:24:05,000 --> 00:24:10,000

Looks like we've solved the mystery of the unidentified structure that appeared on Sonar.

397

But as far as identifying the magnetic anomaly that's been detected in the area, I'm still not getting any readings.

398

This ship is definitely not the source of that energy.

399

So we venture beyond the wreck and keep searching.

The seafloor soon plummets down into a very deep underwater canyon with no bottom in sight.

Getting a huge spike. No idea why.

It seems to be coming from deep in the channel.

The seafloor beyond the shipwreck plummets into an abyss,

408

so whatever is setting off the EMF reader is a lot farther down than our current dive gear or physiology can handle.

409

Alright, you ready for the water sample?

410

Let's do it.

We collect a water sample so we can test for heavy metals, radioactive isotopes,

412

or anything else that could be rising from the seafloor hundreds of feet below

413

and provide a new insight into what's causing the magnetic energy in the area.

414

I think we gotta go up.

And ascend back to the surface.

The hit I got on the EMF reader from the deep water, something is down there.

This is the right area.

And that wreck, it goes to show just how easy it is to hide a giant object under the water.

The EMF readings didn't come from the shipwrecks, so that can't be the source of the magnetic energy in the area.

There must be something deeper in the channel generating magnetism.

425

What about something up?

450

If there's some kind of large magnetic structure down there,

creating the unusual magnetic signature in the area,

453

this high-powered marine magnetometer can pinpoint its exact location.

I'm ready to deploy, so if you can kick it up to five, six knots,

455

Let me know immediately what you see when you come up on it.

Bioluminescence is found in a large number of marine organisms,

565
