And beyond algae, certain fish, squid, and jellyfish are also bioluminescent,

And when 9-11 happened, he worked in counter-terrorism in Afghanistan.

So what is special about where we are?

The first thing you have Los Angeles over here, when you look south a little bit here on the coastline, you come to Camp Pendleton.

Camp Pendleton is where the United States Marine Corps does a lot of their training, but you also have a defunct nuclear power plant.

171

The one thing that we have a pretty good grasp on within the government is that there seems to be some sort of nuclear connection with UFOs.

172

Let's not forget that you had the Nimitz carrier group right here in this area in 2004.

173

You had a nuclear-powered submarine.

174

You also had nuclear-capable vessels that are escorting the fleet.

175

That's a huge, huge footprint from a nuclear technology perspective.

So the question we were having in the Pentagon was, is it possible that the quote-unquote TICTAC event was really an attempt to surveil our capabilities?

Phil and I even investigated the possible connection between nuclear sites and UFOs back in New Mexico.

There have been 8,500 sightings near nuclear facilities in the U.S. alone.

But as far as we know, there are no sources of nuclear power beneath the waters around Catalina Island, attracting UFOs under the surface.

Why do you think there's been so many sightings in this area under the water?

Perhaps there is a hot spot based upon where we are.

184

So what I have here is the magnetic survey superimposed on a map.

You can see the coastline here and we are in Catalina Island.

In a field of nothing for thousands of miles, all of a sudden you have this weird magnetic anomaly.

187

There's a lot of energy there.

188

A magnetic anomaly is a variation in strength of the Earth's magnetic field.

189

00:12:07,000 --> 00:12:13,000

This can be caused by large concentration of rocks with high metal content or large metal structures.

190

00:12:13,000 --> 00:12:23,000

On Louise's map, the red areas represent a constant magnetic field and the blue, just northwest of Catalina, is an area with a stronger magnetic pole.

191

00:12:23,000 --> 00:12:27,000

Could that be the thing that's actually attracting UFOs to this area?

192

00:12:27,000 --> 00:12:36,000

We get multiple reports and a lot of data that indicates these things are somehow related to these magnetic anomalies.

193

Right now we're hovering over the area which indicated a high level of magnetism on Louise's map and has seen the highest concentration of USO reports.

194

Could whatever is causing that energy be attracting UFOs and explain so many USO sightings?

It's the same area where Jess and I saw a mysterious light under the water last night.

196

So are there other encounters that are as well documented as the Nimitz encounter that just aren't public yet?

197

I have to be careful when I say it. We'll tell you there are absolutely multiple, multiple other encounters that are very well documented with a tremendous amount of fidelity to the data.

But I unfortunately can't discuss those. I still have a security clearance. I don't know what I'm prepared to say right now.

After we touch down, I'm splintering off to try to make sense of the mysterious light we saw in the water the other night.

Phil thinks it was bioluminescence created by algae, but I'm not so convinced.

I need to find any recent reports that describe a similar light below the surface to figure out what we and others are seeing around here.

Meanwhile, Phil and Louise head out to our research vessel to see if they can find what's responsible for the magnetic anomaly deep below the surface.

A lot of the locals here, they actually swear that there is some sort of underwater facility, a base, a location.

Do you think something like that is possible out here?

205

Well, I think if you look back even just with our own technology, going back to World War II and whatnot, we've always had secret submarine bases.

We've had all sorts of top secret locations to support our war machine.

207

But the question is, is it not man-made?

208

The idea of underwater bases is not science fiction and definitely not new.

209

We've had a naval testing facility 1100 feet below the surface of an Idaho lake since World War II.

210

And near the Bahamas, Autech, the Atlantic Undersea Test and Evaluation Center, located at depths of 6000 feet, was specifically built to test underwater vehicles, weapons, and systems.

211

Interestingly, UFOs have also been reported around Autech.

212

If there were some kind of base under the waters here, I feel like it would have to be in that deeper water.

213

Certainly, if you want to keep something secret, probably the best way to do that would be out of the prying eyes of your enemy.

214

And in this case, the deeper the water, the better.

215

After scouring sources online and in Catalina, I've found an eyewitness who saw an unusual light underwater off the island's northern coast around the same time we did.

216

Andrew Quintana is a longtime resident of Catalina, and he knows the coastline well.

217

00:15:20,000 --> 00:15:24,000

So if I've been talking to folks around the island, they said you were the guy to meet up with.

218

I've lived here for about 15 years, and I've seen a lot of things that have happened out here on Catalina.

219

00:15:29,000 --> 00:15:37,000

Andrew runs an eco-tourism company in Catalina, and he has led guided tours of the island's surrounding waters for years.

220

00:15:37,000 --> 00:15:41,000

I live right by the ocean. I know what dolphin pods look like. I know what bioluminescence look like.

221

I saw something that I couldn't really explain.

222

00:15:44,000 --> 00:15:46,000

Andrew, were you nervous, scared?

223

00:15:46,000 --> 00:15:51,000

It was more of a, I need to assess what's going on right now before I start thinking I'm crazy.

224

When you hear someone say that they saw UFO, and they're certain it's UFO, with your background, you know, how do you call out the BS, essentially?

225

First of all, these things fall squarely within the five categories of observables that we in the Pentagon were able to determine.

226

Are they U.S. technology, or are they something completely different?

227

So there's five observables.

The first one is instantaneous acceleration.

229

The second one is hypersonic velocity.

230

The third one is low observability.

The fourth observable is trans-medium travel.

232

The ability to travel not just in our atmosphere, but in space and possibly underwater.

233

And the last observable is something that can defy the natural effects of Earth's gravity without any obvious signs of propulsion, any obvious signs of lift, any control surfaces.

234

Nothing that we would normally associate as being an aircraft or a rocket.

235

So when we talk about those five observables, does the Nimitz encounter from 2004 hit all five?

236

Absolutely. Every single one.

237

Imagine now having a vehicle that can do all five of those observables. You're now talking a real serious national security threat.

238

Wow. When we're in the chop, we showed us a map of the magnetic activity. Like, is that the Earth's right now?

239

Yeah, it's actually right here.

240

Right off your starboard side.

241

00:17:15,000 --> 00:17:22,000

I'll tell you what, we have a sonar on board that I think we should put in action to see if we can pick up anything down below.

242

Let's do it.

243

Now that we're in our target zone, we'll use two sonar scanners which will help locate anything unusual and identify its depth.

244

Hey there, Captain.

How are we doing?

246

So the dark red you're seeing there is the ball of fish.

Nothing yet that screams underwater UFO base.

I'm up for that.

So what should be the plan of action? If we want to cover a lot of ground here, should we just kind of go back and forth on the boat?

258

We're going to make numerous passes in the general area.

259

See if we can pick it up here on the sonar and then we'll narrow in and get the depth meter directly over what we're looking for.

You seen that?

So the dark red you're seeing there is the sea floor and then the shadowing coming off the sea floor there is fish.

A lot of fish out here.

So we're seeing more fish.

Hold up.

270

So now we're starting to get a big target.

So what we're seeing right here, that's going to show up on this pretty soon?

272

Correct. As we move across it, we'll pick it up directly underneath us.

That is not a ball of fish. That is structure.

279

Look at the size of that thing.

280

You're saying there's a structure on the bottom of the ocean.

281

There is a structure on the bottom. I don't know what it is.

282

Well that's promising.

What the hell is that?

284

That is not small.

285

Phil and Luis Elizondo, the former head of the Pentagon's UFO investigation program, are scanning the waters off of Catalina Island.

286

And their research vessel Sonar has just detected an unknown structure on the sea floor.

287

Is there anything natural that would explain a structure like that, like coral reefs?

I feel like we have to check this thing out.

Yeah man, let's go. Let's go wet.

Captain, we're good to anchor here and go for a dive?

292

Absolutely.

Andrew Quintana tells me the mysterious light he saw in the water wasn't bioluminescence.

294

We're out there, just me and three of my buddies.

295

I looked down over the boat and there was just something glowing down there.

296

00:20:18,000 --> 00:20:20,000

I could tell that it was coming from very deep.

297

00:20:20,000 --> 00:20:24,000

It was looking down and that ball light got big, got small, and then it was gone.

298

00:20:24,000 --> 00:20:25,000

Oh, it was pulsing.

299

00:20:25,000 --> 00:20:26,000

Yeah.

300

00:20:26,000 --> 00:20:28,000

And then it just disappeared?

301

00:20:28,000 --> 00:20:30,000

It was like someone turned off the light.

302

So you don't think it was military or anything like that?

303

You try to rationalize what you're seeing.

304

It's either the military with some fun toys they're not telling us about or something beyond that.

Have there been any other reports from locals of USOs underneath the water?

I'd say about 60% of the people in town have a story.

As someone who has witnessed bioluminescence in these waters many times,

312

Andrew says the unusual light he saw underwater wasn't naturally occurring phenomenon.

313

And the fact he saw it around the same time Phil and I saw an unusual light,

314

I'm convinced we're dealing with a hell of a lot more than just some algae that glows in the dark.

315

Well, thank you so much for all that information.

316

I'll let you know what we find.

Our sonar has detected an unidentified structure that could be creating a magnetic field below the

surface

and potentially attracting UFOs to the area.

On this dive, I'm bringing a waterproof electromagnetic field reader, or EMF reader,

320

that will be able to detect and measure any magnetic fields below the surface.

321

Alright, I'm bringing down the EMF because as you said this is a very magnetically active area underneath this right now

322

and perhaps the structure we found could be given off some EMF as well.

323

And I'm going to bring a water test kit. I want to look for things like heavy metal.

324

Are there any traces of any type of radioactive isotopes that maybe we can detect?

325

More data is good data.

326

00:21:52,000 --> 00:21:53,000

Oh yeah.

327

Ready to descend? Let's do it.

328

Our air tanks are filled with nitrox,

329

00:22:05,000 --> 00:22:10,000

a mixture that contains higher amounts of oxygen than the air used in typical scuba tanks.

330

This prevents nitrogen buildup in our system.

331

00:22:13,000 --> 00:22:19,000

Too much nitrogen in the bloodstream can inhibit motor function and lead to unconsciousness and even death.

332

Down to 50 feet now.

333

00:22:23,000 --> 00:22:27,000

Plus the nitrox will double our time underwater so we can dive deeper.

334

00:22:27,000 --> 00:22:32,000

With visibility like this, anything could be hiding down here.

335

00:22:32,000 --> 00:22:34,000

I've seen anything right here.

336

00:22:34,000 --> 00:22:35,000

No, what's your depth?

337

00:22:35,000 --> 00:22:37,000

96.

338

00:22:37,000 --> 00:22:40,000

Alright, we landed south of the Sonar Headlet. Let's trust we've been north.

339

00:22:40,000 --> 00:22:42,000

Good copy, I agree.

340

00:22:47,000 --> 00:22:50,000

You see anything yet? Nothing yet.

341

00:22:55,000 --> 00:22:57,000

You see anything yet?

342

00:22:58,000 --> 00:23:00,000

I don't know what the hell it is.

343

What are we looking at right here?

344

I have no idea.

Oh my god, it's shipwreck.

346

It is shipwreck.

347

Look at the size of this thing.

348

Most shipwrecks close to the shore of Catalina have been documented and mapped,

349

00:23:24,000 --> 00:23:28,000

but just a few miles out and in deeper water, it's a different story.

350

There could be hundreds of uncatalogued wrecks down here.

351

00:23:31,000 --> 00:23:36,000

This massive ship is definitely one of those and could have been down here for decades,

352

00:23:36,000 --> 00:23:38,000

so who knows what else could be hidden here.

353

00:23:38,000 --> 00:23:41,000

God, look at this thing. This thing is massive.

354

00:23:42,000 --> 00:23:45,000

Let's try swimming around the perimeter and see how big it is.

355

I think the size matches up. It is dense. It is old metal.

356

00:23:50,000 --> 00:23:56,000

It must be the object that showed up on Sonar, but so far, no unusual magnetism.

357

Check the EMF reader. Are you getting anything?

358

No, nothing yet.

359

00:24:05,000 --> 00:24:10,000

Looks like we've solved the mystery of the unidentified structure that appeared on Sonar,

360

but as far as identifying the magnetic anomaly that's been detected in the area,

361

I'm still not getting any readings.

362

00:24:16,000 --> 00:24:19,000

This ship is definitely not the source of that energy.

363

Let's keep pushing a little further.

364

So we venture beyond the wreck and keep searching.

365

Oh wow. Look how deep it is out there.

366

The seafloor soon plummets down into a very deep underwater canyon with no bottom in sight.

367

Getting a huge spike. No idea why.

369

It seems to be coming from deep in the channel.

370

Wow, that's strange.

371

The seafloor beyond the shipwreck plummets into an abyss,

372

00:25:04,000 --> 00:25:11,000

so whatever is setting off the EMF reader is a lot farther down than our current dive gear or physiology can handle.

373

Alright, you ready for the water sample? Let's do it.

374

00:25:17,000 --> 00:25:22,000

We collect a water sample so we can test for heavy metals, radioactive isotopes,

375

00:25:22,000 --> 00:25:26,000

or anything else that could be rising from the seafloor hundreds of feet below

376

00:25:26,000 --> 00:25:31,000

and provide a new insight into what's causing the magnetic energy in the area.

377

And ascend back to the surface.

378

Woo, that was incredible.

379

The hit I got on the EMF reader from the deep water, something is down there.

380

This is the right area.

381

And that wreck, it goes to show just how easy it is to hide a giant object under the water.

382

The EMF readings didn't come from the shipwrecks, so that can't be the source of the magnetic energy in the area.

383

There must be something deeper in the channel generating magnetism.

384

Well, I'm going to be curious what those water samples show.

385

00:26:08,000 --> 00:26:12,000

Yeah, you too. This is exactly where we think we would see something.

I'll send the water samples we collected back to the mainland for testing.

387

Louise has to leave, but the captain and I are getting our hands on some heavier tech

388

to investigate what could be at the bottom of that deep trench.

389

But before we head out, Jess and I need to compare notes.

390

Andrew told me that a lot of the locals have eyewitnessed craft from the shore overlooking the channel where you were with Louise.

391

So I'm going to head up there and I'll keep an eye on the sky watching for any UFOs flying around or into the water.

Why don't you take the boat?

What is it?

It's a magnetometer.

It kind of looks like a missile that you drag in the water behind the boat,

397

but it also can detect something metal underwater at much greater depths,

398

00:26:57,000 --> 00:26:59,000

and it's more accurate than my EMF reader.

399

00:26:59,000 --> 00:27:04,000

So really you're going to take out a gigantic EMF metal detector to try to find USOs underwater?

400

00:27:04,000 --> 00:27:06,000

Sure. What about something up?

401

00:27:06,000 --> 00:27:08,000

I'm into it. Cheers.

402

00:27:08,000 --> 00:27:09,000

Cheers.

403

00:27:11,000 --> 00:27:16,000

Jess positions herself overlooking the waters between Catalina and the mainland,

404

00:27:16,000 --> 00:27:25,000

and I head out into the deeper waters of the channel just past our previous dive location to look for whatever caused my EMF reader to spike.

405

00:27:25,000 --> 00:27:31,000

If there's some kind of large magnetic structure down there, or as Jess would put it, a secret underwater base,

406

00:27:31,000 --> 00:27:40,000

creating the unusual magnetic signature in the area, this high-powered marine magnetometer can pinpoint its exact location.

407

00:27:41,000 --> 00:27:47,000

I'm ready to deploy, so if you can kick it up to five, six knots, I'll be able to drop it in nice and slow.

408

00:27:47,000 --> 00:27:51,000

Okay, I'm in troll gear. Go ahead.

409

00:27:51,000 --> 00:27:53,000

All right, going in.

410

00:27:57,000 --> 00:28:01,000

There she goes. All right. Great. It's in.

411

So why don't we do a little bit of back and forth pattern around this area,

412

try to cover as much ground as possible and see what we get?

We're going to make a series of passes across our search area, towing the magnetometer behind the boat.

415

I'll monitor the data feed in real time on my laptop, looking for any magnetic signature underwater, which will appear red on the screen.

416

Okay, Phil, do you copy? I'm in my spot, and I think I see the boat.

417

Copy, out we're in position.

418

Good luck up there.

You too.

All right, so right now I've got the DAP cam set up so that it's pointed straight up into the sky above the boat.

421

I also have the low light camera pointed at the horizon line so that we're getting a little bit of the sky as well as a little bit of the water,

422

00:28:52,000 --> 00:28:58,000

not to mention the fact that Phil is on the boat with the magnetometer capturing things from his end.

423

So anything that's moving around in the sky or underwater, we should be able to catch it.

424

Jess, we've got the magnetometer in the water, so I guess we'll see what happens.

425

Absolutely, I think we have this pretty well covered.

426

All right, let's see if we can get anything.

427

We're good to turn.

428

Nothing yet.

429

Nothing around here either.

430

Several passes through our search zone and all is quiet under the water.

431

What's that?

432

00:29:52,000 --> 00:29:54,000

Oh, it's plane.

433

00:29:56,000 --> 00:29:58,000

Plane.

434

00:29:59,000 --> 00:30:01,000

Plane.

435

00:30:03,000 --> 00:30:07,000

Phil and I have been scanning the skies in the water for nearly five hours,

436

00:30:07,000 --> 00:30:10,000

but haven't seen anything out of the ordinary.

437

00:30:20,000 --> 00:30:22,000

Hang on.

438

00:30:22,000 --> 00:30:25,000

Holy s\*\*\*, I'm getting a monster hit right here.

439

Captain, can we stop the boat?

440

Okay.

441

00:30:29,000 --> 00:30:31,000

Do you mind marking these coordinates?

442

00:30:31,000 --> 00:30:33,000

Yeah, I'll mark a waypoint.

443

Okay, I'm not sure if this is some kind of underwater pit or some big chunk of iron rock or an object,

444

00:30:42,000 --> 00:30:44,000

but we got something down there.

445

Jess, you there?

446

Copy, I'm here.

447

We got something on the magnetometer.

448

No, you do not.

Yeah, I can't quite tell what it is, but it's definitely big and it's definitely metallic.

450

See anything glowing in that area at all?

451

Not seeing anything in the water, but the shape of what we're seeing on the magnetometer

452

00:31:05,000 --> 00:31:08,000

makes me think it may not be natural.

453

No way.

454

That's awesome.

455

00:31:12,000 --> 00:31:13,000

I know.

So I'm going to pull on the magnetometer and then I'm going to put the underwater ROV into the water

457

and see if I can get eyes on this thing.

458

Okay, absolutely.

459

00:31:21,000 --> 00:31:25,000

Let me know immediately what you see when you come up on it.

460

You got it.

461

The depth of the magnetometer hit is past 1,000 feet, far too dangerous to dive on with the equipment we have.

462

00:31:34,000 --> 00:31:39,000

So I'll be sending down a deep water remote operated vehicle or ROV.

463

00:31:39,000 --> 00:31:46,000

It's capable of operating at depths of nearly 1,000 feet and equipped with powerful lights and a high definition camera.

464

So whatever's down there, hopefully we'll get a good look at it.

465

All right, we've got the ROV in the water.

466

00:31:55,000 --> 00:31:57,000

Let's see what we can find.

467

Wow.

468

00:31:59,000 --> 00:32:01,000

Look at that.

Pitching down, going deeper.

470

Right now we're at about 75 feet and so far I'm seeing about a million jellyfish.

471

No aliens yet, though they look alien.

472

00:32:18,000 --> 00:32:22,000

Getting to deeper and deeper water.

473

00:32:22,000 --> 00:32:24,000

Oh, check this out.

474

00:32:24,000 --> 00:32:30,000

I'm actually getting flashes of blue, even the bright green, which is bioluminescence,

475

00:32:30,000 --> 00:32:35,000

meaning there are things down there making lights right now.

476

00:32:35,000 --> 00:32:38,000

That's good evidence.

477

00:32:38,000 --> 00:32:44,000

Bioluminescence is found in a large number of marine organisms including bacteria, algae and jellyfish,

478

00:32:44,000 --> 00:32:47,000

but it isn't just found in small swimmers.

479

00:32:47,000 --> 00:32:51,000

A new study in New Zealand has found that three species of deep sea shark,

480

00:32:51,000 --> 00:32:55,000

including the six foot long kite fin shark, are bioluminescent.

481

00:32:55,000 --> 00:33:00,000

The jellyfish caught on the ROV confirms bioluminescent organisms are in this water

482

00:33:00,000 --> 00:33:04,000

and could explain some of the sightings of underwater lights reported here,

483

00:33:04,000 --> 00:33:09,000

but it definitely doesn't explain the massive hit I got on the magnetometer.

484

00:33:09,000 --> 00:33:13,000

Okay, around 850 feet down.

485

00:33:14,000 --> 00:33:23,000

Whoa.

486

00:33:23,000 --> 00:33:27,000

What the hell was that?

487

00:33:27,000 --> 00:33:36,000

Just got a flash on the screen and it froze.

488

00:33:36,000 --> 00:33:39,000

Getting no more signal on the video.

489

00:33:39,000 --> 00:33:42,000

My ROV hit a depth of about 1,000 feet.

490

00:33:42,000 --> 00:33:46,000

There's a bright flash in the water and the ROV cuts out and dies.

491

00:33:46,000 --> 00:33:52,000

One thing that can disable electronic devices is an EMP or electromagnetic pulse.

492

00:33:52,000 --> 00:33:59,000

So if whatever that flash was sent a burst of electromagnetic energy, that could have disabled the ROV.

493

00:33:59,000 --> 00:34:00,000

Jesse there?

494

00:34:00,000 --> 00:34:01,000

Yeah, I'm here.

495

00:34:01,000 --> 00:34:04,000

We just got a big flash on the ROV screen.

496

00:34:04,000 --> 00:34:05,000

Really?

00:34:05,000 --> 00:34:10,000

We got a big light coming across the screen and then it froze.

498

00:34:10,000 --> 00:34:13,000

Like whatever the flash was messing things up.

499

00:34:13,000 --> 00:34:15,000

The ROV completely tanked.

500

00:34:15,000 --> 00:34:20,000

It's still out there, but the video feed that we had is just frozen.

501

No way.

502

00:34:22,000 --> 00:34:25,000

That's...

503

00:34:27,000 --> 00:34:30,000

Phil, are you seeing what I'm seeing?

504

00:34:32,000 --> 00:34:39,000

As Jess and Phil continue to investigate unidentified flying and submerged objects off the coast of California,

505

00:34:39,000 --> 00:34:46,000

you might be surprised to learn that this isn't the only place where these, whatever they are, have been caught on camera.

506
