She thinks that the legs are too long and slender to be a boar.

And she was thinking maybe a pony, except for the fact

that this tail does not look like a pony.

Look at this.

As this animal is bounding along,

115

you can almost see kind of like the tuft at the end of it.

It's bulky and massive up front,

117

and then kind of slender to me, this looks like a black lion.

With the green screen, we can superimpose the animals

375

and see if we can replicate the exact same video we have.

377

We're going to start with the dog.

378

You put your hand through his chain there.

379

I'm going to go over there, get him revved up a bit.

When you feel he's pulling to get to me, just let him go.

Okay.

Hey, Austin, Sonya.

The cameras are up and running. We're ready to go.

I just don't think a dog can replicate that.

We devunked two popular theories of what the Dartmoor beast is.

So we're going to head out to the moors and we've enlisted the help of a local tracker.

447

His name is Danny Bamping.

He's going to help us track some wild boar to see if that is our beast.

449

Are you?

464

So you're really looking at a fox or a dog or even a big cat.

493
