177

the aftermath of a heavy heavy rainstorm

flowing much more copiously than normal

180

the the the the ceiling here the angled

226

ceiling is probably pink Granite like

227

00:10:27,889 --> 00:10:25,560

they did in the king's chamber right the

228

00:10:29,930 --> 00:10:27,899

relieving Chambers above that uh the

229

00:10:33,350 --> 00:10:29,940

rest of this is probably Limestone but

230

00:10:34,850 --> 00:10:33,360

anyway this is 30 feet long seven feet

231

00:10:38,690 --> 00:10:34,860

wide

232

somewhere between seven and ten feet

233

Persians you know uh blasted that away

246

exposed that section that's where this

248

00:11:23,569 --> 00:11:21,600

sits and then points in

249

um what do you what do you make of this
