And he says, well, there's an artifact here.

And he put the x-ray up on the light box and he pointed it out to me.

9

Square a little structure in my knee, about the size of a fingernail with two wires attached

10

to it.

00:00:50,800 --> 00:00:53,160

And I said, that's inside my leg?

12

He said, yeah.

13

But you don't have a scar.

Just the visual of seeing the x-ray and finding out that it's under my skin without an explanation

15

just ramped up my anxiety.

And then I started having nightmares of something that actually happened to me decades ago.

While I was in the Air Force, I went camping with a friend.

And I'm just having fun.

Until I see these lights flashing at odd intervals.

And our UFO decides Walmart appears over us.

22

From dead center of this thing, there came a milky white light.

23

It took me inside the ship.

24

And I'm screaming as loud as I can.

25

And then I was out unconscious.

I woke up to the flashing yellow, orange and white lights outside the canvas of the tent.

And I'm thinking, what is this?

What is that?

Over the years, countless videos of strange lights and objects in the sky have been shared

and reshared on social media.

But in April of 2023, Pentagon officials surprised the public when they announced they were

Many of these reports, under official investigation, have been submitted by military personnel.

While the sightings seem to defy explanation, some say the government has known more about

During World War II, pilots began to see what they called the Foo Fighters, sometimes overseas

in the Pacific and European theater.

Foo Fighter was the name given to formations of orange lights, seen moving at high speeds.

40

Things really picked up in and around Los Alamos and New Mexico, scientists, security

41

personnel, civilians, military pilots.

42

00:03:22,560 --> 00:03:27,280

All kinds of people were seeing these unidentified flying objects.

43

So at that point, the Air Force began to study it.

44

There was ultimately Project Blue Book.

45

The project had two main goals, to analyze UFO data and determine if these unidentified

objects were threat to national security.

So with the public and civilians reporting these things, there was a tremendous amount

of activity.

I am here to discuss so-called flying saucers.

50

The Air Force's interest in this problem has been to identify anything in the air that

51

may have the possibility of threat or menace to the United States.

52

00:04:05,960 --> 00:04:13,080

They amassed over 12,000 sightings, were unable to explain over 700 of them.

53

00:04:13,080 --> 00:04:16,440

This was becoming almost national pandemonium.

54

00:04:16,440 --> 00:04:22,640

There were articles in block letters this big about UFOs over the capital.

55

00:04:22,640 --> 00:04:28,240

Hundreds of reports of strange objects in the sky have been filed with the Air Force.

56

00:04:28,240 --> 00:04:33,800

They ultimately were not able to resolve this and wanted to get this off their plate.

57

00:04:33,800 --> 00:04:39,680

So the Air Force commissioned a study which reached the conclusion they wanted it to,

58

that there's nothing of interest here for science or national security, even though the

59

data contradicted that conclusion.

And they walked away from it.

The Air Force has been accused in time of hiding information about UFO.

62

What do you have to say to that?

63

Whose charges are absolutely untrue?

64

To this day, people report a wide range of experiences, interactions.

There are people that have reported wounds and illnesses from being in close proximity,

66

which provides evidence that they were affected in some very real way as a result of some

67

In 1977, I was a non-commissioned officer.

69

I was a staff sergeant and stationed at Whiteman Air Force Base in Western Missouri.

I was trained as an EMT and I worked with my friend Toby.

71

00:05:36,360 --> 00:05:40,960

You know, we socialized together on the weekends and he says, hey, I got an idea.

72

00:05:40,960 --> 00:05:44,760

Let's go camping.

73

00:05:44,760 --> 00:05:52,360

June 11, 1977, we exited the base and drove south.

74

00:05:52,480 --> 00:05:55,560

Toby said, well, there's supposed to be this piece of high ground.

75

00:05:55,560 --> 00:05:58,480

I had never been down there and it was amazing.

76

00:05:58,480 --> 00:06:00,640

We found it right away.

77

00:06:00,640 --> 00:06:05,160

We set up the camp and we're chatting back and forth.

78

00:06:05,160 --> 00:06:12,040

And then not only did it get quiet, it got still.

79

00:06:12,040 --> 00:06:18,200

And Toby has his head turned to the left, which would have been toward the west.

80

00:06:18,200 --> 00:06:21,440

He says, hey, Terry, were those lights there before?

81

00:06:21,440 --> 00:06:22,800

And I'm like, what lights?

82

00:06:22,800 --> 00:06:24,000

You know, we're in the middle of nowhere.

83

00:06:24,000 --> 00:06:25,000

There should be no lights.

84

00:06:25,000 --> 00:06:33,720

So I take a step back and on the horizon, there was a triangle made of very bright stars.

85

00:06:33,720 --> 00:06:37,440

They were all the same luminosity.

86

00:06:37,440 --> 00:06:41,880

The three stars rotated clockwise about 120 degrees.

87

00:06:41,880 --> 00:06:49,000

I think that what we were looking at was the triangular shaped craft and it was clear that

88

it was coming in our direction.

89

00:06:51,360 --> 00:06:57,480

And this thing did a complete somersault and it did that twice.

90

The exterior of the thing was about the size of a Walmart, several stories in height and

there were windows and there was light pouring out of the windows.

From dead center of this thing, there came a light about the same diameter as a softball

93

and it was a milky white light and it landed square in the middle of our campfire.

I don't know, but Toby and I both were inside this triangle thing.

95

Now, I opened my eyes and I'm thinking, am I dreaming?

96

00:07:30,720 --> 00:07:31,720

What is this?

97

00:07:31,720 --> 00:07:32,720

What is this place?

98

00:07:32,720 --> 00:07:35,040

But it felt too real to be a dream.

99

00:07:35,040 --> 00:07:36,040

It wasn't a dream.

100

00:07:36,040 --> 00:07:37,520

I know it wasn't a dream.

101

I had heard Toby screaming.

102

00:07:39,120 --> 00:07:41,960

I recognized his voice.

103

00:07:41,960 --> 00:07:44,000

But I can't move.

104

00:07:44,000 --> 00:07:45,160

I can't turn my head.

105

00:07:45,160 --> 00:07:46,800

I can't lift a finger.

106

00:07:46,800 --> 00:07:49,760

The only thing I can move is my eyes.

107

00:07:49,760 --> 00:07:54,360

I saw a line of six or seven beings.

108

00:07:54,360 --> 00:07:59,800

They wore tan colored flight suits with an orange patch on their shoulder.

109

00:07:59,800 --> 00:08:05,880

The guy in front was doing something on the panel and it took me down a long corridor

110

00:08:05,880 --> 00:08:12,120

to a white loom with a dome ceiling and there was a pretty standard looking x-ray table.

111

There were two beings in the room and they were seven foot tall.

112

00:08:16,400 --> 00:08:20,000

I got this clinical, medical vibe from them.

113

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:22,440

I didn't think they were going to kill me.

114

00:08:22,440 --> 00:08:25,920

I thought they might hurt me and they did.

115

00:08:25,920 --> 00:08:34,200

And then I was out in a deep sleep and I woke up to these orange and white flashing lights

116

00:08:34,200 --> 00:08:37,040

outside the canvas of the tent.

117

00:08:37,040 --> 00:08:40,200

So I wake up and I kind of don't have my wits about me.

118

00:08:40,200 --> 00:08:43,280

I turn to my friend Toby and I'm like, Toby, what's out there, man?

119

00:08:43,280 --> 00:08:45,920

He didn't really give me a coherent answer.

120

00:08:45,920 --> 00:08:51,400

And I was just absolutely terrified.

121

00:08:51,400 --> 00:08:57,880

It was 45 minutes before dawn and we watched this thing take off.

122

00:08:57,880 --> 00:09:02,520

And then we're both sitting in this tent still scared to death and Toby's like, we've got

123

00:09:02,520 --> 00:09:03,520

to get out of here.

124

00:09:03,520 --> 00:09:05,680

Let's make a run for the car.

125

00:09:05,680 --> 00:09:13,040

On our drive back from Devil's Den, we were both hurting and we were both severely dehydrated.

126

00:09:13,040 --> 00:09:18,560

This was right at dawn and the light from the morning sunshine was just killing my eyes.

127

00:09:18,560 --> 00:09:21,160

I was just terribly photophobic.

128

00:09:21,160 --> 00:09:25,200

When I got home, I didn't even know what to tell my wife.

129

00:09:25,200 --> 00:09:28,400

I wasn't even sure what had happened.

130

00:09:28,400 --> 00:09:33,040

Both of our wives took us to Whiteman Air Force Base Hospital because my wife is like, what

131

00:09:33,040 --> 00:09:34,040

happened to you?

132

00:09:34,040 --> 00:09:36,280

I said, I don't know.

133

00:09:36,280 --> 00:09:38,440

I woke up like this.

134

00:09:38,440 --> 00:09:42,440

When the doctors asked me what happened, I had no idea what to tell them either.

135

00:09:42,440 --> 00:09:47,440

It was difficult to make sense of it back then.

136

00:09:47,440 --> 00:09:49,880

I found out that I had what they call flash burns.

137

00:09:49,880 --> 00:09:52,240

It's a sunburn to the cornea of your eye.

138

00:09:52,240 --> 00:09:56,160

It's the same injury an arc welder would get if they didn't wear that hood with the

139

00:09:56,160 --> 00:09:57,160

smoke glass.

140

00:09:57,160 --> 00:09:59,240

It was very painful.

141

00:09:59,240 --> 00:10:00,240

I was treated.

142

00:10:00,240 --> 00:10:02,320

I spent several nights in the hospital.

143

00:10:02,320 --> 00:10:07,320

The doctors kept the lights off in the room and they put the salve in my eyes and came

144

00:10:07,320 --> 00:10:11,200

in with an injection for me for pain and to help me sleep.

145

00:10:11,200 --> 00:10:17,920

On the third night, OSI agent from the Office of Special Investigations came in my room and

146

00:10:17,920 --> 00:10:23,760

he walked over to my bed and he put his hand against the door and he got down right in

147

00:10:23,760 --> 00:10:33,480

my face and he said, son, I know and you know, you two knuckleheads stumbled onto something

148

00:10:33,480 --> 00:10:36,560

out there and I think you know what I mean.

149

00:10:36,560 --> 00:10:38,760

And I didn't know how to answer.

150

00:10:38,760 --> 00:10:46,720

I had no clue what had happened but he knew I saw a spaceship.

151

00:10:46,720 --> 00:10:51,680

When Terry is released from the hospital, he is given orders by his commanding officer

152

00:10:51,680 --> 00:10:57,200

to never discuss what happened that night at Devil's Den with anyone and to cease all

153

00:10:57,200 --> 00:10:59,440

contact with Toby.

154

00:10:59,440 --> 00:11:05,960

They cut orders for Toby to go to Japan and they cut those orders at light speed.

155

00:11:05,960 --> 00:11:10,040

I mean he was gone in a matter of weeks and I was thinking that if I could say goodbye

156

00:11:10,040 --> 00:11:15,480

to this guy, that would kind of give me some element of closure to this.

157

00:11:15,480 --> 00:11:21,320

I decided to swing by Toby's house to say goodbye to him and he comes out of the bedroom

158

00:11:21,320 --> 00:11:25,680

and his hair is all wonky and he's got on a dirty t-shirt and he looked up at me in

159

00:11:25,680 --> 00:11:29,160

his eyes or bloodshot and I could smell liquor on his breath.

160

00:11:29,160 --> 00:11:33,120

He said, it happened, didn't it Terry?

161

00:11:33,120 --> 00:11:35,240

And I said, yes, my brother, it really happened.

162

00:11:35,240 --> 00:11:36,920

You're not losing your mind.

163

00:11:36,920 --> 00:11:38,520

And he said, yeah, but why us?

164

00:11:38,520 --> 00:11:42,640

And I said, man, I don't have an expletive clue.

165

00:11:42,640 --> 00:11:43,640

That was.

166

00:11:43,640 --> 00:11:52,200

The last time I saw Toby, years later I found out Toby had passed away.

167

00:11:52,200 --> 00:11:58,480

And Terry isn't the only service member to conceal the fallout of a strange encounter.

168

00:11:58,480 --> 00:12:03,600

I think probably most of the people that report this are probably having sleep paralysis

169

00:12:03,600 --> 00:12:05,400

and things like that.

170

00:12:05,400 --> 00:12:09,200

But there's some cases where there's enough evidence that you really do wonder.

171

00:12:09,200 --> 00:12:14,280

In one extraordinary case, an individual named John Burroughs, who was an Air Force Security

172

00:12:14,280 --> 00:12:23,320

Officer in England, got very close to a bizarre unidentified flying object that was in the

173

00:12:23,320 --> 00:12:27,760

woods adjacent to his base.

174

00:12:27,760 --> 00:12:32,960

I was stationed at Ariapat Waters Woodbridge.

175

00:12:32,960 --> 00:12:38,400

The Rundle-Schwem Forest event took place outside the East Gate at Ariapat Woodbridge

176

00:12:38,400 --> 00:12:43,240

on the 26th of December, 1980, at 0300.

177

00:12:43,240 --> 00:12:47,720

About three o'clock in the morning I was riding with my supervisor and he saw some strange

178

00:12:47,720 --> 00:12:52,320

lights in the sky coming down into the forest.

179

00:12:52,320 --> 00:12:56,800

So a decision was made at that point to go ahead and have us go out and investigate to

180

00:12:56,800 --> 00:13:00,280

see if something crashed into the forest.

181

00:13:00,280 --> 00:13:04,840

So we went ahead and departed the base, went down into the forest on a service road, went

182

00:13:04,840 --> 00:13:08,520

as far as we could before we were blocked by a fence.

183

00:13:08,520 --> 00:13:10,480

Nothing felt right.

184

00:13:10,480 --> 00:13:15,360

It was like the forest itself had like a white light in it.

185

00:13:15,360 --> 00:13:21,000

Within the white light there seemed to be an oval type red ball with blue lights and

186

00:13:21,000 --> 00:13:23,120

a white light below it.

187

00:13:23,120 --> 00:13:29,560

And eventually whatever it was rose up into the trees and then shot off towards the coast.

188

00:13:29,560 --> 00:13:32,320

Our higher-ups, they weren't sure what happened.

189

00:13:32,320 --> 00:13:37,040

They told us to go out to the site and daylight to take a look around, which we did.

190

00:13:37,040 --> 00:13:41,280

We found some indentations in the ground and then some damage to the canopy above us in

191

00:13:41,280 --> 00:13:44,280

the forest.

192

00:13:44,280 --> 00:13:47,680

I wasn't consumed by this encounter in the forest.

193

00:13:47,680 --> 00:13:52,680

I was just like, well, something happened and I can't explain it and I'm going on in

194

00:13:52,680 --> 00:13:53,680

my life.

195

00:13:53,680 --> 00:13:55,480

My life went back to normal.

196

00:13:55,480 --> 00:13:59,640

I did my two years and left Woodbridge Air Force with it.

197

00:13:59,640 --> 00:14:03,360

The Air Force actually classified as records.

198

00:14:03,360 --> 00:14:12,800

We have a very arcane secrecy system and different services and organizations can classify information

199

00:14:12,800 --> 00:14:17,680

at such a high level that even the chairman of the intelligence committee is not privy

200

00:14:17,680 --> 00:14:18,680

to it.

201

00:14:18,680 --> 00:14:24,640

Sort of smoke and mirrors, pallets of secrets that we have that's hard to negotiate and

202

00:14:24,640 --> 00:14:27,120

impedes the flow of information.

203

00:14:27,120 --> 00:14:33,160

They can classify stuff based off of whatever happened in a military operation.

204

00:14:33,160 --> 00:14:36,120

They can deny access to anybody.

205

00:14:36,120 --> 00:14:39,560

That's why I'll never understand how my name got leaked out.

206

00:14:39,560 --> 00:14:44,440

But somehow some of the people involved, their names were exposed.

207

00:14:44,440 --> 00:14:50,920

That's when these different people started trying to track us down, including CNN.

208

00:14:50,920 --> 00:14:54,240

CNN was doing an investigation.

209

00:14:54,240 --> 00:15:00,120

Four years after the event occurred at RAF Bentwater's Woodbridge, CNN airs their special

210

00:15:00,120 --> 00:15:01,960

investigation.

211

00:15:01,960 --> 00:15:09,000

This is Woodbridge Airfield, an American Air Force base in Eastern England.

212

00:15:09,000 --> 00:15:12,800

Woodbridge Field was the site of something that witnesses say seemed to be taken from

213

00:15:12,800 --> 00:15:13,800

science fiction.

214

00:15:13,800 --> 00:15:20,280

What I can tell you is at the time the incident became public, it was done through a memo

215

00:15:20,280 --> 00:15:22,560

for the Ministry of Defense.

216

00:15:23,040 --> 00:15:28,000

The leak out in the Air Force can no longer deny, neither could the M.O.D. deny that something

217

00:15:28,000 --> 00:15:29,000

took place.

218

00:15:29,000 --> 00:15:30,880

That was the big story.

219

00:15:30,880 --> 00:15:33,680

Aliens were involved at Bentwater's Air Force base.

220

00:15:33,680 --> 00:15:38,760

I was approached by CNN, but I refused to do an interview because I was asked to sign

221

00:15:38,760 --> 00:15:43,640

certain non-disclosure stuff, you know, prior to departing the RAF Bentwater's.

222

00:15:43,640 --> 00:15:49,240

While others shared their shocking accounts with CNN on the condition of anonymity.

223

00:15:49,240 --> 00:15:56,120

So I think I saw a UFO, some kind of a spaceship from someplace out of this earth.

224

00:15:56,120 --> 00:16:00,440

Anything that happens inside the military, if the press gets involved, you have to report

225

00:16:00,440 --> 00:16:04,880

it to your chain of command, and they have to determine what you can and can't say in

226

00:16:04,880 --> 00:16:05,880

how it's handled.

227

00:16:05,880 --> 00:16:09,040

They knew that the investigation was going to be made public.

228

00:16:09,040 --> 00:16:14,040

I don't know what the Air Force felt as far as to how far this would go, but it clearly

229

00:16:14,040 --> 00:16:17,520

had gotten more traction than they were comfortable with.

230

00:16:17,520 --> 00:16:23,400

The government uses the news media to deliver information to the public on a daily basis.

231

00:16:23,400 --> 00:16:28,720

But certain information is deliberately withheld from news sources through non-disclosure agreements

232

00:16:28,720 --> 00:16:31,960

and the classification of sensitive data.

233

00:16:31,960 --> 00:16:36,960

With only partial view of the facts, it would be impossible to see the full picture of what's

234

00:16:36,960 --> 00:16:38,200

really going on.

235

00:16:38,200 --> 00:16:48,600

It's hard for people in the government to talk about this.

236

00:16:48,600 --> 00:16:55,680

There absolutely were cases where NDAs were signed and personnel refused to share information

237

00:16:55,680 --> 00:17:00,280

even with other cleared military personnel.

238

00:17:00,280 --> 00:17:03,920

Could people be literary a little bit about talking about stuff?

239

00:17:03,920 --> 00:17:08,520

Sure, but in reality, you have to follow the order of the military law or you would

240

00:17:08,520 --> 00:17:13,560

be in trouble no matter what the incident is.

241

00:17:13,560 --> 00:17:18,800

For decades, service members like John and Terry have been forced to keep their strange

242

00:17:18,800 --> 00:17:23,600

encounters secret.

243

00:17:23,600 --> 00:17:30,000

Before I saw the X-rays, it was 2012 and the incident was 40 years in my past.

244

00:17:30,000 --> 00:17:34,360

And I felt like I was finally coming to grips with it and I knew that I would never tell

245

00:17:34,360 --> 00:17:36,000

a soul.

246

00:17:36,000 --> 00:17:42,840

But those X-rays, when I saw the thing, it validated for me that these things had put

247

00:17:42,840 --> 00:17:44,080

their hands on me.

248

00:17:44,080 --> 00:17:47,880

I decided to write this book, Incident at Devil's Den.

249

00:17:47,880 --> 00:17:50,760

I decided to speak publicly about it.

250

00:17:50,760 --> 00:17:56,480

I was thinking that if enough people talk about it, it will have some sway on the government

251

00:17:56,480 --> 00:17:59,200

to come clean.

252

00:17:59,200 --> 00:18:05,080

When I started writing my book in 2017, I wanted to get a copy of my medical records

253

00:18:05,080 --> 00:18:06,920

from 1977.

254

00:18:06,920 --> 00:18:13,760

I did a written request and I was there six years and the packet of stuff I got was no

255

00:18:13,760 --> 00:18:15,480

bigger than that.

256

00:18:15,480 --> 00:18:18,040

My medical record should have been fatter than that.

257

00:18:18,040 --> 00:18:21,800

I like to say there were holes in this you could drive a truck through.

258

00:18:21,800 --> 00:18:28,080

So when I realized that I really couldn't process this on my own, I researched alien

259

00:18:28,080 --> 00:18:31,840

implants and I came up with their all sense.

260

00:18:31,840 --> 00:18:34,760

I'm a private investigator in the state of Texas.

261

So what problems have you had getting X-rays, Terry?

Terry's a good example.

313

I don't know some of these other people personally, but I can tell you that it's a mess trying

to find medical records and the help from the VA.

315

The first issue that I had was when I got sick.

316

When I came in the Air Force, I had clean bill of health.

You couldn't have gotten in the Air Force with a heart murmur.

If your records are classified, they can't acknowledge other records that would have

supported my claim.

335

The Air Force decided to not acknowledge the fact that I was in from 79 to 82.

336

My name is Cheryl Bennett and I was a staff assistant for Senator John McCain.

337

I took care of constituents that were having problems with the VA.

338

00:22:44,080 --> 00:22:50,600

In August of 2013, I met John Burroughs from the U.S. Air Force.

339

00:22:50,600 --> 00:22:55,280

He came in to seek help for his DD 214s and his medical records.

340

00:22:55,280 --> 00:22:58,840

Everybody has one DD 214 when they get out.

341

00:22:58,840 --> 00:23:04,520

A DD 214 form is issued to service members who have been honorably discharged from active

342

00:23:04,520 --> 00:23:06,160

duty.

343

00:23:06,160 --> 00:23:10,920

They are used to verify military service to obtain benefits.

344

00:23:10,920 --> 00:23:12,920

John never got that when he left.

345

00:23:12,920 --> 00:23:16,960

And then when he finally decided he needed some medical attention, that's when this whole

346

00:23:16,960 --> 00:23:17,960

problem started.

347

00:23:17,960 --> 00:23:20,960

Oh no, you weren't in the military.

348

00:23:20,960 --> 00:23:24,600

I mean at an point he had to question himself, am I insane?

349

00:23:24,600 --> 00:23:25,600

Am I going crazy?

350

00:23:25,600 --> 00:23:28,160

You know, did this really happen or not happen?

351

00:23:28,160 --> 00:23:31,880

The Department of Justice got involved.

352

00:23:31,880 --> 00:23:35,840

Cheryl told me it brought in somebody with a high clearance to review my stuff who couldn't

353

00:23:35,840 --> 00:23:38,320

even get access to my records.

354

00:23:38,320 --> 00:23:44,840

And the fact is they couldn't verify anything other than I was in at the time I said it happened.

355

All my stuff was still classified.

356

I mean when your records are classified, you're pretty much SOL because they will not release

357

00:23:53,600 --> 00:23:54,600

them to you.

I mean I even had a letter sent back to me from one of the attendants from the Department

359

00:24:00,600 --> 00:24:07,120

of Justice saying that I don't care, you can't throw John McCain's name out there, it's not

360

00:24:07,120 --> 00:24:09,080

going to get you anywhere.

361

00:24:09,080 --> 00:24:11,080

That pissed me off.

362

00:24:11,080 --> 00:24:18,520

Congress, the CIA, the FBI, the Department of Justice, the Department of Defense, all

363

the higher liaisons that I was working with, they were covering up his records, all of

364

00:24:23,200 --> 00:24:24,840

them.

365

00:24:24,840 --> 00:24:31,040

But for some service members and officials, the central issue isn't government manipulation.

366

They believe the real problem is a lack of intelligence.

367

I went to school for mechanical and aerospace engineering.

368

00:24:47,040 --> 00:24:51,480

And shortly after that I joined the Navy, ended up flying the F-18 Super Hornet off the east

369

00:24:51,480 --> 00:24:54,400

coast of Virginia Beach for a number of years.

370

00:24:54,400 --> 00:24:59,360

So in 2014, as we were flying around, we would have these objects brought on our radar.

371

00:24:59,360 --> 00:25:01,560

We'd have all our other sensors on it.

372

00:25:01,560 --> 00:25:04,440

And all those sensors actually get plumbed into our helmet.

373

00:25:04,440 --> 00:25:09,920

So as we look out into the sky outside of our cockpit, it's like an augmented reality.

374

There's only supposed to be F-18s out there.

375

00:25:11,680 --> 00:25:15,120

So we'd go out there and see someone that didn't belong that immediately stuck out.

376

But okay, that could happen with the commercial air traffic.

377

00:25:17,880 --> 00:25:21,640

But what's unique about these objects is that they weren't behaving like aircraft.

378

They were stationary.

379

00:25:23,000 --> 00:25:25,800

They were at very high or very low speeds.

380

00:25:25,800 --> 00:25:27,680

And they were out there all day.

381

00:25:27,680 --> 00:25:30,000

So who were they?

382

In recent years, the term UFO, unidentified flying object, has been replaced with the

383

00:25:36,120 --> 00:25:41,120

term UAP, unidentified aerial phenomena.

384

00:25:41,120 --> 00:25:45,440

Our culture has had UFO on our minds for quite some time.

385

00:25:45,440 --> 00:25:50,520

As soon as you say UFO, people immediately think alien is coming from another place.

386

00:25:50,520 --> 00:25:53,320

So the term has a lot of baggage.

387

00:25:53,320 --> 00:25:58,600

And we needed to get away from that and find something that was more neutral, more objective.

388

00:25:58,600 --> 00:26:01,880

Unidentified aerial phenomena acknowledges they may not even be objects.

389

00:26:01,880 --> 00:26:02,880

It could be plasma.

390

00:26:02,880 --> 00:26:06,560

It could be an atmospheric phenomenon.

391

00:26:06,560 --> 00:26:10,280

Over the course of time, as we observed these objects, the only natural conclusion we'd

392

00:26:10,280 --> 00:26:14,760

come to was this was some super top secret program that we were just not aware of.

393

00:26:14,760 --> 00:26:16,360

Is this a foreign adversary?

394

00:26:16,360 --> 00:26:18,280

Is this Russia or China?

395

00:26:18,280 --> 00:26:24,320

Have they developed a breakthrough that allows them to operate with impunity in restricted

396

00:26:24,320 --> 00:26:25,720

military airspace?

397

00:26:25,720 --> 00:26:30,600

If these looked like a Russian aircraft or Chinese aircraft, there would be much to do

398

00:26:30,600 --> 00:26:31,600

about this.

399

00:26:31,600 --> 00:26:33,000

The Air National Guard would probably be brought in.

400

00:26:33,000 --> 00:26:35,080

It would be a major issue.

401

00:26:35,080 --> 00:26:41,840

And Ryan would soon witness the most widely discussed UAP in recent history.

402

00:26:41,840 --> 00:26:45,840

In January of 2015, my squadron and I were operating off of Jacksonville, Florida, when

403

we captured the gimbal video.

404

00:26:51,320 --> 00:26:56,840

So we see here, the aircraft taking this is at 25,000 feet above the ocean.

405

00:26:56,840 --> 00:26:59,820

And this object is basically at the same altitude.

This looks pretty refined as far as the image goes.

407

00:27:03,520 --> 00:27:06,480

And then we see the rotation of the object.

408

00:27:06,480 --> 00:27:09,480

You see it just rotates like a gimbal.

409

00:27:09,480 --> 00:27:14,080

A gimbal is a mechanism that allows a device to rotate on an axis.

410

00:27:14,640 --> 00:27:19,320

In 2017, I saw the New York Times article that came out with the gimbal video.

411

00:27:19,320 --> 00:27:21,800

I was like, I was there on that film was taken.

412

00:27:21,800 --> 00:27:23,920

I recognized the voices of my buddies.

413

00:27:23,920 --> 00:27:25,920

But there's a new thing.

414

00:27:25,920 --> 00:27:27,960

It's rotated.

415

00:27:27,960 --> 00:27:35,320

On social media platforms, the gimbal video reinvigorates the debate surrounding UAP.

416

00:27:35,320 --> 00:27:41,520

After I had left the Pentagon formally, I became aware that we were having violations of restricted

417

00:27:41,520 --> 00:27:47,840

military airspace on an ongoing basis and had been already for a couple of years.

418

00:27:47,840 --> 00:27:50,640

And nobody was doing anything about it.

419

00:27:50,640 --> 00:27:54,680

Look at the pride.

420

00:27:54,680 --> 00:27:59,360

The objects that we were seeing didn't look or didn't behave like our threat nations or

421

00:27:59,360 --> 00:28:00,860

our adversaries.

422

00:28:00,860 --> 00:28:05,400

And so it seemed to get ignored in a way that otherwise wouldn't have been ignored.

423

00:28:05,400 --> 00:28:10,400

So is there an unofficial don't ask, don't tell policy when it comes to UAP?

424

00:28:10,400 --> 00:28:13,000

Or simply a lack of protocol?

425

00:28:13,000 --> 00:28:18,160

There were all kinds of organizations in the national security community that were touching

426

00:28:18,160 --> 00:28:20,480

parts of this problem.

427

00:28:20,480 --> 00:28:24,200

And none of them had a place to report this.

428

00:28:24,200 --> 00:28:31,880

And it was at that point that I really got involved, ultimately in a very public way.

429

00:28:31,880 --> 00:28:39,120

The appropriations committee was still of the mindset that this is wacky stuff, UFOs.

430

00:28:39,120 --> 00:28:43,560

They were not interested in supporting anything in this area, and they didn't have the information

431

00:28:43,560 --> 00:28:44,560

yet.

432

00:28:44,560 --> 00:28:50,040

So my suggestion was, ask for a report, a public report from the intelligence community on

433

00:28:50,040 --> 00:28:51,040

this issue.

434

00:28:51,040 --> 00:28:56,360

So that report came out in June of 2021.

435

00:28:56,360 --> 00:29:03,400

The preliminary report says accounts of UAP generally fall into five main categories.

436

Foreign air clutter, natural atmospheric, foreign adversary systems, classified developmental

437

00:29:10,000 --> 00:29:16,200

programs, and other, the events without explanation.

438

00:29:16,200 --> 00:29:19,920

When the preliminary report went to Congress, it was very unique because it was the first

439

00:29:19,920 --> 00:29:24,200

time that we've ever really publicly acknowledged as a military that there is this uncertainty

440

00:29:24,200 --> 00:29:25,800

there.

441

00:29:25,800 --> 00:29:30,480

Someone like Ryan Graves is also an aerospace engineer in addition to being a pilot.

442

00:29:30,480 --> 00:29:35,360

So when somebody like that tells you that he's seeing one of these things out there

443

00:29:35,360 --> 00:29:40,880

and seeing them on a regular basis, you can take that to the bank.

444

00:29:40,880 --> 00:29:46,080

Unidentified aerial phenomena are a potential national security threat.

445

00:29:46,080 --> 00:29:50,600

For too long, the stigma associated with UAPs has gotten in the way of good intelligence

446

00:29:50,600 --> 00:29:52,400

analysis.

447

00:29:52,400 --> 00:29:55,520

Pilots avoided reporting or laughed at when they did.

448

00:29:55,520 --> 00:30:00,120

What it's done is validated the statements of the operators that were at the very low

449

00:30:00,120 --> 00:30:01,120

level.

450

00:30:01,120 --> 00:30:04,400

And it just goes to show the amount of stigmatism that had to be overcome, right?

451

00:30:04,400 --> 00:30:07,960

We had to go through such extreme lengths to get that information from the operators

452

00:30:07,960 --> 00:30:09,360

to the decision makers.

453

00:30:09,360 --> 00:30:12,240

And these reports are part of that process.

454

00:30:12,240 --> 00:30:16,560

That's why there is an all-domain anomaly resolution office within the Department of

455

00:30:16,560 --> 00:30:18,120

Defense now.

456

00:30:18,120 --> 00:30:23,120

That office is now charged with receiving all information from all government organizations,

457

00:30:23,120 --> 00:30:28,520

analyzing it, reviewing all intelligence records back to World War II, creating a whistleblower

458

00:30:28,520 --> 00:30:34,480

process where people can come in regardless of any NDA they sign and talk openly about

459

00:30:34,480 --> 00:30:36,880

what they saw and what they knew.

460

00:30:36,880 --> 00:30:40,720

We didn't win the Cold War because we were better at protecting secrets.

461

00:30:40,720 --> 00:30:45,680

We won the Cold War because we were better at moving and sharing information.

462

00:30:45,680 --> 00:30:52,480

But I think they've been trying to avoid anything that would set the press off and anything

463

00:30:52,480 --> 00:30:58,520

that could be construed as proof or evidence that there are craft out there that might

464

00:30:58,520 --> 00:31:00,080

be ill in it.

465

00:31:00,080 --> 00:31:05,880

Though any effort to downplay the strange events happening in U.S. airspace became impossible

466

00:31:05,880 --> 00:31:09,120

in February of 2023.

467

00:31:09,120 --> 00:31:14,160

February of 2023, the United States shot down a number of objects, four total objects, over

468

00:31:14,160 --> 00:31:16,120

in the continental United States.

469

00:31:16,120 --> 00:31:21,280

There was coverage in any leading news organization in the United States.

470

00:31:21,280 --> 00:31:25,720

The Pentagon briefing reporters just before we came on the air saying they are now tracking

471

00:31:25,720 --> 00:31:29,200

a suspected Chinese spy balloon hovering over the northern U.S.

472

00:31:29,200 --> 00:31:33,960

For the third day in a row and the fourth time in just nine days, the United States

473

00:31:33,960 --> 00:31:37,720

has shot down an unidentified high-flying object.

474

00:31:37,720 --> 00:31:42,000

They were over Alaska, Canada's Yukon Territory, and Lake Huron.

475

00:31:42,000 --> 00:31:46,800

This after a Chinese spy balloon was shot down more than a week ago off the coast of

476

00:31:46,800 --> 00:31:47,800

South Carolina.

477

00:31:47,840 --> 00:31:51,400

Tonight the U.S. is still not able to call the three objects shot down by the United

478

00:31:51,400 --> 00:31:54,920

States over the course of three days, anything but objects.

479

00:31:54,920 --> 00:31:57,720

This is completely unprecedented for a number of reasons.

480

00:31:57,720 --> 00:32:01,720

We were told very clearly that there was a Chinese spy balloon that was offering her

481

00:32:01,720 --> 00:32:07,480

vicinity and then in the very same note, the next three objects we shot down remain unidentified

482

00:32:07,480 --> 00:32:10,000

and unattributed as well.

483

00:32:10,000 --> 00:32:14,800

Given the unanswered questions surrounding these events and the experiences of military

484

00:32:14,800 --> 00:32:21,400

members like Terry, John, and Ryan, do we even have the capabilities to know what's

485

00:32:21,400 --> 00:32:23,400

really in the skies?

486

00:32:33,000 --> 00:32:34,400

We just simply don't have enough data.

487

And at the end of the day, the only way we're going to be able to figure it out is if we

488

put energy and put attention into it.

489

This recognizes the subject of UAPs as multifaceted and requires a careful data-driven approach.

490

Today we are not just debating the existence of UAPs, we are deliberating on the principles

491

that define our republic, which is a commitment to transparency and accountability.

492

We can see that conversation moving into the public sector.

493

I think that's going to be key to moving the conversation forward in an open manner.

The American public has a right to learn about technologies of unknown origins, non-human

495

intelligence, and unexplainable phenomena.

Now the sheer number of reports, whistleblowers, and stories of unidentified anomalous phenomena

497

should raise real questions.

If you believe we have crashed craft, stated earlier, do we have the bodies of the pilots

499

who piloted this craft?

As I've stated publicly already in my news nation interview, biologics came with some

of these recoveries.

And then the government just pulls out aliens like surprise.

509

I would like to be the first to ask the aliens to abduct me.

510

But there are objects flying around here that they have no clue what's going on.

511

We can't afford to not know who's overflying our country.

512

It's much, much better, but there's still more progress that needs to be made.

513

What do you know now you didn't know before?

514

Nothing.

515

00:34:20,400 --> 00:34:22,640

What are you going to know next month?

516

00:34:22,640 --> 00:34:23,640

Nothing.

517

00:34:23,640 --> 00:34:25,760

What are you going to know six months from then?

518

00:34:25,760 --> 00:34:26,760

Nothing.

519

00:34:26,760 --> 00:34:29,640

Oh, there'll be a little leak here and a little leak there.

520

00:34:29,640 --> 00:34:32,120

If that's good enough for you, that's all you're going to get.

521

Bring a congressional investigation and guess what you're going to get?

522

That's a big cover story.

523

They've acknowledged that there's stuff they can't explain totally and they're investigating
