Research is extremely important to TABs,

135

Now, some of the claims, some of the stories that we have heard,

The name Julia Lowell does appear in history,

143

but I haven't been able to trace any ties to the Copper

144

Queen.

145

Another one of our stories that we've heard

146

was a story of a little boy chased down

147

00:05:19,160 --> 00:05:21,800

by his mother in the hotel and murdered.

148

00:05:21,840 --> 00:05:24,480

Supposedly this little boy's apparition

149

is seen on the second floor.

150

00:05:26,320 --> 00:05:30,400

The only news report that talked about a ghost

151

was actually involving a small boy.

152

00:05:32,680 --> 00:05:37,480

The hotel was a commercial hotel until the mining shutdown

153

00:05:37,480 --> 00:05:39,120

here in 1975.

154

00:05:39,120 --> 00:05:42,080

Several of us who have done some historical research

155

00:05:42,080 --> 00:05:46,720

here at Bisbee have tried to trace down someone or some event

156

00:05:46,720 --> 00:05:48,800

that could be the cause of this.

157

00:05:48,800 --> 00:05:50,600

And to the best of my knowledge, no one

158

00:05:50,600 --> 00:05:51,960

has been successful.

159

00:05:51,960 --> 00:05:54,920

OK, Gary, I really appreciate you sitting down with me today.

160

OK.

161

00:05:55,420 --> 00:05:56,640

Thank you so much, Gary.

162

I really appreciate your help.

163

165

168

For instance, the Julia Lowell story,

170

The Lady of the Night, he hasn't heard of her.

171

Same thing went for the man with the top hat,

172

00:06:18,080 --> 00:06:20,760

who leaves cigarette smoke smells around the place.

173

I mean, it could have been a million guys with top hats

174

00:06:23,240 --> 00:06:25,440

walking around this place in the day and age.

175

00:06:25,440 --> 00:06:28,440

And the third item was the story about the little boy

176

who died by the hands of his mother here in the hotel.

177

The story goes is that the boy was chased by his mother

178

down the hall.

179

She grabbed him and put him in a tub of cold water

180

00:06:38,280 --> 00:06:41,000

and persistently kept putting his head under the cold water.

181

Wait a minute.

182

00:06:41,400 --> 00:06:42,640

I thought he drowned in the river.

183

Yeah, that's what I heard.

184

After speaking with Gary, he was telling me

185

there was another boy around the same time period who

186

did drown in the river.

187

00:06:50,160 --> 00:06:50,680

OK.

188

00:06:50,680 --> 00:06:52,320

Gary was my best bet.

189

00:06:52,320 --> 00:06:56,240

And he couldn't confirm or deny any of the stories.

190

You know how we go about it.

191

We try not to add names to the so-called spirits,

192

00:07:00,720 --> 00:07:02,240

unless we're 100% sure.

193

But over generations and so forth, years have passed here.

194

So you've got to kind of go on with the local say to a point.
