Booth got on his horse.

He rode out 30 miles to Mudd's house.

He had a broken leg from the fall from the stage.

17

And when he jumped down, he got up.

18

Mudd set his leg.

19

He hosted him for a night, and the next morning Booth left.

20

But there's a huge debate over whether or not Mudd was involved in the whole thing.

Mudd said that he had no idea what Booth had done.

He gave him a bed for a night, and the next morning he was on his way.

But he still found guilty of conspiracy, and they actually gave him life in prison.
