Then I want a wireless run down there to listen to Grant listen to me with the cameras.

254

Oh, dude, I already know that.

255

I want a wireless run in that corner, shooting off, covering the kitchen over near the tent.

256

00:08:01,360 --> 00:08:04,360

No, I can put a wireless right here and I'll shoot into the...

257

00:08:04,360 --> 00:08:05,360

I'll put one right there.

258

00:08:05,360 --> 00:08:06,360

That's fine.

259

00:08:06,360 --> 00:08:08,360

If you cover that living room, I want the whole living room covered.

260

00:08:08,360 --> 00:08:11,360

I want the whole kitchen area where he's experienced that covered.

261

00:08:11,360 --> 00:08:12,360

I want these bedrooms covered.

262

00:08:12,360 --> 00:08:14,360

The other areas you can use hard lines on.

263

00:08:14,360 --> 00:08:17,360

Get it set up where we're not leaving any space unturned.

264

00:08:17,360 --> 00:08:18,360

You got it.

265

00:08:18,360 --> 00:08:20,360

Is what I want to see.

266

00:08:21,360 --> 00:08:24,360

As soon as they get the equipment up, we can kill the lights.

267

Yeah.

268

We can kill everything and just run.

269

That's it.

270

And then we can send Brian, Steve and Andy in at some point.

271

As long as we know when they're in.

272

As long as they stay out of the view of the cameras.

273

Yeah, I just think we can fit in that human investigation element tonight too.

274

If you want a trash...

275

No, I definitely agree.

276

No, I'm not saying trash.

277

00:08:44,360 --> 00:08:47,360

I'm saying I don't want people in front of the cameras.

278

00:08:47,360 --> 00:08:51,360

I want to make sure I want to keep the tax members down to a minimum walking in front of the cameras.

279

00:08:51,360 --> 00:08:53,360

We're not here to lounge on a couch in the living room.

280

00:08:53,360 --> 00:08:56,360

But if they're going to do an EMF sweep or something like that, you know...

281

00:08:56,360 --> 00:08:58,360

I don't think EMFs are going to work in this house.

282

00:08:58,360 --> 00:09:00,360

There's a lot of Romex cable.

283

00:09:03,360 --> 00:09:06,360

When Jay and I started talking, he made it like...

284

00:09:06,360 --> 00:09:08,360

Instead of the equipment and then leave the place empty.

285

00:09:08,360 --> 00:09:11,360

And I always think it's good to have at least someone, you know...

286

00:09:11,360 --> 00:09:15,360

Doing some kind of run through inside to have a human experience in there.

287

00:09:22,360 --> 00:09:23,360

Alright guys, listen up.

288

00:09:23,360 --> 00:09:26,360

What I was thinking would do like a criss-cross with the cameras.

289

00:09:26,360 --> 00:09:28,360

You only have four DVR cameras.

290

00:09:28,360 --> 00:09:31,360

Right. What I'm saying, we still can cover those angles down there.

291

00:09:31,360 --> 00:09:35,360

Let's see that's the whole thing. I don't want to move them up there because when you're going out,

292

00:09:35,360 --> 00:09:37,360

you've got to think the DVR camera is not going to shine down.

293

00:09:37,360 --> 00:09:38,360

So shine out.

294

No, I'm just thinking because I thought from the standpoint of...

295

We're going to put one up there.

296

They don't pivot down enough, is that what you're saying?

297

Because they're on a hard stand.

298

That makes sense.

299

That goes down to his corner.

300

Next to the fish tank.

301

What?

302

For more seconds.

303

Is it just that he's too...

304

Yeah.

305

00:10:02,360 --> 00:10:03,360

I like Andy.

306

00:10:03,360 --> 00:10:05,360

And I'm not going to say anything bad about him.

307

You know, he's a little hyper and stuff, but he's not a bad person.

308

I like investigating stuff with him.

309

That's probably one of my only problems right now is him.

310

Do me a favor. When you get everything in,

311

do a walk-through with the EMF meter and just see what's going on,

312

00:10:22,360 --> 00:10:24,360

see if you're going to be able to use it or not.

313

Alright.

314

Because after we get the cameras set up,

315

I don't want people walking in front of the camera.

316

If they've got to put a voice recorder down or something, that's fine.

317
