phantom cats and stuff like that.

353

I mean, you name it, we were trying to catch everything, but we also wanted to try and find real reasons for it.

354

As soon as we were downstairs, as soon as you said you felt creepy in the washroom for no real reason,

355

you had a red flag for us.

356

That means that chances are there's something down there emitting a high electromagnetic field,

357

371

If it happens again, run down, look at the pipes as soon as you can and see if they're going all over the place.

Or bracket them, and if the problem continues, then we know there's another problem.

373

I'll have my husband run down because I'll be too scared.

374

And one other thing we did find was on the basement door, how it just opened up by itself at times,

What could they be? What could cause them?

It smelled like the furnace was running really rich.

So, I did end up tightening up the clamp and it stopped banging.

810

It was made for a waterway system.

So, very possibly the shakes that you guys have experienced,

814

it could be the rush of water coming through and just vibrating through the ground and so forth.

Now, have you guys ever experienced anything from the attic area?

The faucet just turned on in here.

Okay, what happened there is while Jay was asking hello, hello, hello,

828

I'm standing at the bottom and the far faucet in the bathroom turned on.

829

00:38:26,000 --> 00:38:29,000

The only type of faucets that really do that are the ones that turn.

830

00:38:29,000 --> 00:38:32,000

If the stop gets broken, it can turn on.

831

00:38:32,000 --> 00:38:35,000

The pressure can move it and turn it on.

832

00:38:35,000 --> 00:38:38,000

But here you've got a single lever one that just, that doesn't happen.

833

And it was moved up.

834

I had to pull it down and turn it on.

835

There's nothing we caught seeing like it had any malicious intent.

862

00:39:55,000 --> 00:39:59,000

So yeah, there does seem to be some sort of paranormal activity going on.

863

00:39:59,000 --> 00:40:06,000

Now, I've been in this field for a long time and, you know, I've never heard of anybody being seriously injured by haunting.

864

00:40:06,000 --> 00:40:11,000

So you are saying that you believe that there is some paranormal activity?

865

00:40:11,000 --> 00:40:14,000

You know, I can't sit here and say that I believe you have a ghost.

866

00:40:14,000 --> 00:40:18,000

I can just say that you seem to have some sort of paranormal activity going on.

867

00:40:18,000 --> 00:40:25,000

And I think it's going to take further investigation to find out, number one, if there is an entity itself here and what it needs.

868

And just think of that entity as a person that needs some help.

869

And, you know, maybe the thing that happened in your leg wasn't an act of malicious intent.

870
