One incredible story from Stringfield's files comes from a first-hand witness who inventoried

Wright Patterson Air Force Base, Foreign Material Division, 1955.

During the 1940s and 50s, a woman named Norma Gardner works in the Foreign Materials Division

at Wright Patterson.

65

She's a very high-security clearance, and in 1955, she is tasked with cataloging all

66

of the incoming UFO material.

Over the course of a year, Norma Gardner catalogs approximately 1,000 different items from UFO

68

crashes.

Now, she photographs and tags each one.

One day, while on duty, she witnesses a cart being moved from one room to another.

And on that cart are dead alien bodies.

She notes that the aliens are suspended in some sort of chemicals to keep them preserved.

their heads are large compared to a human, and their eyes are narrow and slanted.

Although sworn to secrecy, Norma Gardner eventually breaks her silence.

In 1959, she retires from her job at Wright Pat for health reasons.

77

She learns that she has cancer and that it's terminal.

78

00:07:02,605 --> 00:07:05,445

It's on her deathbed that she confesses her story.

79

00:07:05,445 --> 00:07:10,206

She claims Uncle Sam can't do anything to me once I'm in my grave.

80

00:07:10,206 --> 00:07:15,527

About six months later, she passed away.

81

00:07:15,527 --> 00:07:21,289

Is Wright Patterson Air Force Base the final resting place for aliens recovered from crash

82

00:07:21,289 --> 00:07:22,489

sites?

83

00:07:22,489 --> 00:07:27,010

Or is it merely a receiving station?

84

Rumors suggest the answers reside in a special section of the base.

J.K. is a computer missile specialist with top security clearance.

In 1966, he's working with the Nike Missile Program and stationed out of Wilmington, Ohio,

120

a 45-minute drive from Wright Patterson Air Force Base.

J.K. finds himself on many occasions at Wright Pat.

122

00:11:09,340 --> 00:11:13,541

One of these times, he's escorted to an underground facility on the base that is inaccessible

123

without top-level security.

00:11:17,382 --> 00:11:20,422

Inside this facility, he sees nine glass cases.

125

The glass appears to be about an inch thick, and each case is illuminated.

And he can see that inside the cases are nine bodies.

in communication with some humans.

You have to ask, who is communicating with these aliens and what have we learned?

Individuals who have these profound experiences, these telepathic contact with aliens, quite

literally, you know, there's this idea that they're chosen.

A man who claims to be one of the chosen, saying he has intimate knowledge of extraterrestrials,

I know for a fact that the United States government knows much more than what it's telling the

Lo and behold, at my knee steps is Air Force Captain.

Something fascinating about Clifford is that he was never supposed to be in the military.

They were doctors and they couldn't talk to them.

If they had to ask a question, then they had to have me or whoever the interfacer was

235

there to talk to them.

236

00:20:35,986 --> 00:20:40,788

This information was compiled into a special handbook.

237

They had a book of 57 different species that we had thus far identified as visiting planet

238

Earth.

239

It was titled Long the Lines of Guidelines on Interaction with Our Visitors.

Has the military actually come into contact with and documented 57 different species of

241

aliens?

242

They had pictures so they at least had some contact with each and every one of those species

243

that was there.

244

00:21:12,115 --> 00:21:19,236

It went into some of their cultural backgrounds and some of the first aid treatments that

245

we could render if they had certain injuries.

The idea that there's more than one kind of alien, that's just another one of those

247

There were certain anatomical differences that made it very clear that they were not

human.

These bodies are sent to multiple locations for security reasons.

341

One of these locations being Wright-Patterson Air Force Base.

342

At Wright-Patterson, one body is believed to have been selected for autopsy by two leading

343

scientists.

According to an IPU report, Dr. Dietrich Brank has been asked to assist in the autopsy

345

00:30:00,553 --> 00:30:05,794

of one well-preserved cadaver to be done by Charles Ethan Ray.

346

Charles Ray is an interesting character.

347

He was a surgeon and an MD.

He was personally recruited by the head of the Air Force Special Weapons Project.

This autopsy has two original purposes.

367

As humans, we want to understand what we're dealing with so we take it apart.

370

In this particular case, the secondary purpose was to discover what could have caused the

371

deaths of the on-site technicians and could whatever it was be used against our enemies.

372

Unfortunately, the report from the Interplanetary Phenomenon Unit does not contain the autopsy's

373

findings.

But another document reveals some startling insights.

First of all, it implies that whatever caused the deaths of the on-site technicians might

have come from the alien bodies.

But more than that, it suggests that the government may have started using research on alien bodies

to create biological weapons.

Almost immediately, old threats return.

Not long after she began speaking with Mufon investigators, Beanie got a call from someone

She had heard that she was speaking with Mufon and wanted to remind her that the government

404

00:34:37,175 --> 00:34:41,936

had a long on.

This same pattern of intimidation is seen throughout the Leonard Stringfield files.

406

Many of Stringfield's informants came forward only with the assurance of total anonymity.

407

Or sometimes, like in Norma Gardner's case, when they had nothing left to lose.

408

Because Len was so loyal to his sources, people felt safe coming to him with their stories.

409

00:35:11,582 --> 00:35:16,023

Even now, Mufon allows very limited access to the Stringfield files.

410

00:35:16,023 --> 00:35:20,504

It was Len's wish that the identities of his sources remain protected even after his

411

00:35:20,504 --> 00:35:22,425

death.

412

00:35:22,425 --> 00:35:26,186

The military's point of view is we've got to make this go away.

413

I wouldn't be surprised if factions of the government were involved with disinformation.

414

I mean, this is true, this is not made up.

Power and money.

The government will do whatever it takes to make sure that the balance is in their favor.
