The special relationship between pet and master may be based upon an unexpected link.

It is August in Walcott, Indiana, and Bobby is lost.

He became separated from his family five hours ago as they were moving from their old home to a new home more than 2,000 miles away.

They searched for him, but not finding him sadly had to continue on.

Now abandoned, he struggles through a long journey.

They would expect him to turn back along the route they have traveled to return to his old home,

but Bobby pushes forward, searching for a place he's never known.

No matter how great the obstacles, Bobby travels on as though drawn by some unseen beacon.

Researchers call this scy-trailing from the word psychic.

It's often confused with homing, but it's quite another phenomenon.

Homing occurs when an animal is taken away from a familiar place and finds its way back following

normal sensory cues.

A dog may follow a trail or remember familiar landmarks, but in verified cases of scy-trailing, there is no explanation other than ESP.

Six months later, Bobby arrives in Portland, Oregon.

Finally, he's reunited with those he loves.

Was Bobby guided by emotional signals from his family?

Could it be that extrasensory perception was the magnet that pulled the animal and his masters together?

The possibilities of animal ESP could have a profound effect on all of us.

Some forms of communication could be drastically altered, maybe even become obsolete.

Stories such as Bobby's have intrigued scientists for years.

His case is among hundreds examined by Dr. J.B. Rine, America's Dean of Parapsychology.

For Dr. Rine, such examinations are a labor of love.

There's a gradient of evidence that there is an extrasensory exchange between animals and men.

We'd like to have more evidence, we'd like to keep the quest open rather than making it a decisive conclusion at this time.

But there's a great deal of evidence on it.

Oh man, come on!

Anecdotes of scy-trailing are not conclusive proof of animal ESP,

but they do suggest that the bond between some masters and pets may be so deep that even distance cannot separate them.

While a director at the Rockland Research Institute in New York,

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00:03:14,101 --> 00:03:23,103

Dr. Hans Essar searched for laboratory evidence of this unspoken link between masters and their dogs.

Each dog in the study was placed in an isolated soundproof chamber.

There his physical activity and heart rate were recorded.

Dr. Essar selected dogs with a close relationship with their masters,

feeling these teams would most likely demonstrate an ESP link.

The master was then isolated in a separate soundproof room.

We will try in this experiment to replicate the bond established between you and your dog and in general between master and dog.

Try to experience it as fully as possible so that the emotion you feel and you generate can be picked up by your dog.

The only possible connection between master and dog would be ESP.

Okay, the dog is lying down now, we can begin.

You mark, start.

You have the first event now.

The master was shown a series of slides.

Some were pleasant subjects, evoking a positive reaction, others were disturbing.

Would the dog perceive a change in his master's mood?

The dog is perceiving probably emotional reaction from the master.

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00:04:36,120 --> 00:04:41,121

This, in our thinking, takes place through the oldest part of our brain.

This brain is non-verbal, it does not talk, but it does form the seed of our emotion.

Although this experiment is a preliminary investigation, a pilot study,

Dr. Essar did record a correlation in a few instances.

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00:04:57,125 --> 00:05:00,126

He continued with phase two.

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00:05:00,126 --> 00:05:08,128

Gary, I do want you now to imagine exactly the episode of pleasure that you had this morning with Solomon

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00:05:08,128 --> 00:05:13,129

and in your mind recollect the whole event in the park.

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00:05:13,129 --> 00:05:20,131

Finding laboratory proof of animal ESP is most difficult.

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00:05:20,131 --> 00:05:26,132

This study is among the first to begin the search and raise an even greater question.

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00:05:26,132 --> 00:05:31,133

What I am investigating is actually the so-called web of life.

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00:05:31,133 --> 00:05:37,135

The relationships between every single living being in the large society of this earth.

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00:05:37,135 --> 00:05:45,137

It is nowadays an ecological concept. How do we all hang together?

While the study did not provide proof, it had set the theme for our search

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00:05:50,138 --> 00:05:55,139

and would lead us to further fascinating evidence.

Beyond emotions, might our animals also perceive when we are having an extra sensory or psychic experience?

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00:06:04,141 --> 00:06:10,142

During times of great stress, people have reported having out-of-body experiences,

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00:06:10,142 --> 00:06:17,144

feeling literally that they can leave their own form, hover above it, or travel to other places.

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00:06:17,144 --> 00:06:23,146

Such reports are not uncommon, but some people, like Sherry Green,

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00:06:23,146 --> 00:06:26,146

feel they can actually control the phenomenon.

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00:06:26,146 --> 00:06:31,147

Sherry says she is able to have an out-of-body experience at will.

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00:06:31,147 --> 00:06:34,148

Could her pet kitten respond to her experience?

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00:06:34,148 --> 00:06:38,149

And if so, would this indicate animal ESP?

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00:06:38,149 --> 00:06:44,151

A classic experiment tested this question in search of reunited key investigators

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00:06:44,151 --> 00:06:50,152

from the Psychical Research Foundation of Durham, North Carolina.

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00:06:50,152 --> 00:06:55,153

Researchers take Sherry and her kitten to an observation room half a mile away.

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00:06:55,153 --> 00:06:58,154

The kitten will remain here for the experiment.

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00:06:58,154 --> 00:07:00,154

This is where Jill's going to be.

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00:07:00,154 --> 00:07:05,155

And Johnny's going to be charting Jill's movements and also the number of times that she may have.

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00:07:05,155 --> 00:07:09,156

And this is where we want you to focus your experience.

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00:07:09,156 --> 00:07:13,157

Sherry returns to the lab to have her out-of-body experience.

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00:07:13,157 --> 00:07:17,158

The experiment is supervised by Dr. John Hartwell.

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00:07:17,158 --> 00:07:20,159

We're plugging in the last of these wires here now

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00:07:20,159 --> 00:07:25,160

so that we can learn something about the physiology of this experience.

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00:07:25,160 --> 00:07:27,161

In addition to how the animal responds,

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00:07:27,161 --> 00:07:30,161

we want to know something about how it is that your body responds.

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00:07:30,161 --> 00:07:37,163

We began to pursue these studies because the subjective nature of the out-of-body experience

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00:07:37,163 --> 00:07:40,164

begs for that kind of research.

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00:07:40,164 --> 00:07:43,164

For in this experience, a person feels like he is out of his body.

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00:07:43,164 --> 00:07:49,166

He feels like he is out there and perceives the world from a different point of view.

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00:07:49,166 --> 00:07:52,167

And perhaps he affects the world.

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00:07:52,167 --> 00:07:55,167

In the critical moments before the experiment,

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00:07:55,167 --> 00:08:00,168

Sherry's brain waves and pulse are closely monitored.

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00:08:00,168 --> 00:08:05,170

She meditates and prepares for her experience.

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00:08:05,170 --> 00:08:11,171

A half a mile away, the kitten is placed on the observation grid.

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00:08:11,171 --> 00:08:17,172

She paces restlessly in the alien, unfamiliar surroundings.

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00:08:17,172 --> 00:08:25,174

The experimenters wonder if a kitten's behavior will change during Sherry's experience.

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00:08:25,174 --> 00:08:36,177

As Sherry meditates, she signals her experience is about to begin.

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00:08:37,177 --> 00:08:42,178

Sherry now feels she is leaving her body to visit her kitten.

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00:08:42,178 --> 00:08:45,179

She attempts to calm and reassure it with her presence

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00:08:45,179 --> 00:08:49,180

to make it feel more secure in a strange place.

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00:08:49,180 --> 00:08:52,181

Each trial lasted several minutes.

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00:08:52,181 --> 00:08:57,182

Over 33 trials, the researchers found a striking correlation.

Whenever the subject reported an out-of-body experience,

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00:09:01,183 --> 00:09:06,184

the kitten became measurably quieter and calmer.

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00:09:06,184 --> 00:09:09,185

Its behavior had changed dramatically.

Whether the kitten actually saw or felt a presence, no one can say.

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00:09:14,186 --> 00:09:20,187

But during these out-of-body experiences, something was happening.

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00:09:20,187 --> 00:09:27,189

We tried people, animals, physical sensors, various electromagnetic detectors.

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00:09:27,189 --> 00:09:33,190

The only consistent evidence that we found was the behavior of this one kitten.

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00:09:33,190 --> 00:09:39,192

The fact that the kitten gave the only consistent results there is intriguing.

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00:09:39,192 --> 00:09:43,193

We don't know what that means, but it does seem to us that it is very important.

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00:09:43,193 --> 00:09:47,194

We would like to try to go further and see if we can come to interpret that.

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00:09:49,194 --> 00:09:53,195

If further study reveals that animals have psychic abilities,

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00:09:53,195 --> 00:09:57,196

might some species be able to use them to alter their world?

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00:09:57,196 --> 00:10:02,197

And might we someday learn to communicate with our pets through ESP?

The in-search of cameras turned to these questions next.

The possibility that animals can perceive their world through extrasensory means

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00:10:14,200 --> 00:10:16,201

leads to further questions.

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00:10:16,201 --> 00:10:20,202

Can they influence their world through psychokinesis?

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00:10:20,202 --> 00:10:21,202

Mind over matter?

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00:10:21,202 --> 00:10:25,203

Could an animal with primitive mental ability, such as a fish,

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00:10:25,203 --> 00:10:28,203

exert an influence on its environment?

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00:10:28,203 --> 00:10:31,204

Current research suggests this may be so.

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00:10:31,204 --> 00:10:36,205

At the Mind Science Foundation in San Antonio, Texas,

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00:10:36,205 --> 00:10:41,207

Dr. William Broad conducts an experiment to determine if a Siamese fighting fish

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00:10:41,207 --> 00:10:44,207

can alter the conditions in its tank.

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00:10:44,207 --> 00:10:48,208

The male Siamese fighting fish is extremely aggressive.

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00:10:48,208 --> 00:10:51,209

It displays hostile behavior to other males,

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00:10:51,209 --> 00:10:54,210

and even to its own reflection in a mirror.

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00:10:54,210 --> 00:10:58,211

Given the choice, it will seek out a male to challenge.

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00:10:58,211 --> 00:11:01,211

To study the effects of this aggressive desire,

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00:11:01,211 --> 00:11:04,212

Dr. Broad has designed a special aquarium.

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00:11:04,212 --> 00:11:09,213

Along one side is a mirror that is only visible to the fish at irregular intervals,

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00:11:09,213 --> 00:11:12,214

selected at random by a special generator.

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00:11:12,214 --> 00:11:15,215

To determine when the mirror will be visible,

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00:11:15,215 --> 00:11:19,216

the generator uses the same random principle as flipping a coin.

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00:11:19,216 --> 00:11:25,217

Through many trials, the mirror should appear exactly half the time.

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00:11:25,217 --> 00:11:29,218

Yet, when the fighting fish is placed in the special tank,

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00:11:29,218 --> 00:11:33,219

a consistent and startling change takes place.

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00:11:33,219 --> 00:11:37,220

The mirror begins to appear more than half the time.

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00:11:37,220 --> 00:11:44,221

Could the fish and its desire to fight cause a change in the random operation of the generator?

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00:11:44,221 --> 00:11:48,222

The fish seemed to influence the random generator.

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00:11:48,222 --> 00:11:54,224

After about 3400 trials, the machine started generating more mirror trials

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00:11:54,224 --> 00:11:56,224

than you would expect by chance.

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00:11:56,224 --> 00:11:59,225

But if you take the fish out, that effect goes away.

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00:11:59,225 --> 00:12:05,226

The most simple explanation of that is that the fish is somehow influencing that generator,

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00:12:05,226 --> 00:12:08,227

although there's no physical connection between the two.

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00:12:08,227 --> 00:12:12,228

That is, some kind of psychokinetic influence is being displayed here.

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00:12:12,228 --> 00:12:16,229

In human beings, for example, there's considerable research that indicates

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00:12:16,229 --> 00:12:22,230

that persons can mentally influence a variety of systems, living systems, inanimate systems,

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00:12:22,230 --> 00:12:29,232

small ones, large ones, simply by imagining or intending for certain outcomes to occur.

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00:12:29,232 --> 00:12:35,233

And apparently the same thing is occurring in the Siamese fighting fish in this experiment.

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00:12:36,234 --> 00:12:43,235

Dr. Broad is also searching to discover what extrasensory link there may be between animal and man.

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00:12:43,235 --> 00:12:51,237

His subjects have had success influencing the behavior of a mouse-like gerbil without even being in the same room.

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00:12:51,237 --> 00:12:55,238

A lot of us feel a special closeness with animals, a kind of connectedness

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00:12:55,238 --> 00:13:00,239

that goes beyond the usual kinds of relationships with animals.

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00:13:00,239 --> 00:13:06,241

And what the data of parapsychology is suggesting is that this feeling of connectedness,

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00:13:06,241 --> 00:13:09,242

or this fact of connectedness, may be much more general,

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00:13:09,242 --> 00:13:17,243

that we are, in fact, intimately connected with other human beings, with animals, with all aspects of nature.

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00:13:17,243 --> 00:13:21,244

Parapsychologists aren't certain what this intimate connection may be.

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00:13:21,244 --> 00:13:29,246

There is a theory that the unintentional psychic abilities of the researchers affect the outcome of every experiment.

So it's not yet possible to isolate and prove animal ESP.

In Cincinnati, a veterinarian finds the concept vitally important in his practice.

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00:13:41,249 --> 00:13:45,250

Veterinary science is one of the most difficult fields of medicine,

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00:13:45,250 --> 00:13:49,251

for the doctor cannot communicate with the patient.

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00:13:49,251 --> 00:13:50,251

What happened to this little fellow?

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00:13:50,251 --> 00:13:57,253

Dr. Marvin Kane is a former veterinarian of the Cincinnati Zoo and has practiced for 23 years.

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00:13:57,253 --> 00:14:00,254

He welcomes the most difficult cases.

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00:14:00,254 --> 00:14:05,255

Five days ago you presented your dog completely paralyzed, no feeling.

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00:14:05,255 --> 00:14:13,257

We've treated him, we've taken x-rays, myelograms, and there's no definite disturbance of the vertebrae.

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00:14:13,257 --> 00:14:20,258

He has responded to points, but yet there is no realization of where his legs and feet are.

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00:14:20,258 --> 00:14:25,259

Having studied in China, Dr. Kane now teaches acupuncture to other vets

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00:14:25,259 --> 00:14:30,261

and continues his search for new ways to relieve animal suffering.

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00:14:30,261 --> 00:14:37,262

One of his greatest allies is a consultant whom he feels has the gift of communicating with animals through ESP.

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00:14:37,262 --> 00:14:40,263

She's Beatrice Leidecker of Los Angeles.

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00:14:40,263 --> 00:14:45,264

I like to think of myself as a diagnostic tool to a veterinarian,

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00:14:45,264 --> 00:14:49,265

because an animal can't say where it hurts, but he hurts.

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00:14:49,265 --> 00:14:54,266

And the vets many times say, I know the animal's sick, but I can't pinpoint it.

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00:14:54,266 --> 00:15:02,268

When I first met Dr. Kane, he was skeptical. He wanted some proof, which I couldn't blame.

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00:15:02,268 --> 00:15:12,271

Now after having been stimulated by the possibility that someone could indeed look into and perceive an animal's body and mind,

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00:15:12,271 --> 00:15:16,272

this opened up a new possibility of diagnosis for me.

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00:15:16,272 --> 00:15:23,273

I decided to test Ms. Leidecker and take x-rays of a known diagnostic patient

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00:15:23,273 --> 00:15:27,274

and see whether or not she would come up with the same solution than I did.

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00:15:27,274 --> 00:15:31,275

Dr. Kane prepared his test with a thoroughbred jumping horse,

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00:15:31,275 --> 00:15:36,276

whose tiny yet painful leg fractures he had already diagnosed.

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00:15:36,276 --> 00:15:42,278

Could Beatrice discover the problem through mental communication with the horse itself?

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00:15:42,278 --> 00:15:46,279

He had one horse there that was a jumper and he was having difficulty with him.

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00:15:46,279 --> 00:15:50,280

And he asked me, can you tell me what's wrong with him?

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00:15:50,280 --> 00:15:54,281

When I asked the horse, how do you feel physically when you're jumping?

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00:15:54,281 --> 00:15:58,281

He showed me a picture in my mind of him going over the jump,

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00:15:58,281 --> 00:16:03,283

and when he landed on his front feet, I felt sharp pain going down my arms.

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00:16:03,283 --> 00:16:08,284

The pain going down the back of my arms, which would be equal to his splint bone.

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00:16:08,284 --> 00:16:14,285

Stoundingly, Beatrice had described exactly the fractures in each foreleg.

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00:16:14,285 --> 00:16:20,287

I was very conscious of the fact that she did not even look at the parts of the horse

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00:16:20,287 --> 00:16:23,287

as we would go about examining them.

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00:16:23,287 --> 00:16:28,289

She stood there and she just communicated, seemingly communicated with the horse.

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00:16:31,289 --> 00:16:35,290

After five years from that first initial experience,

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00:16:35,290 --> 00:16:41,292

I still am amazed and I'm still, well, now I'm very respectful

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00:16:41,292 --> 00:16:49,294

of Beatrice's ability to look into and communicate with an animal,

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00:16:49,294 --> 00:16:51,294

with an animal's consciousness.

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00:16:51,294 --> 00:16:58,296

I feel that possibly we all might have that ability and we all should try to exercise it.

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00:16:59,296 --> 00:17:04,297

For ten years, Beatrice has traveled the country, helping animals and their owners through ESP.

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00:17:04,297 --> 00:17:09,298

In her books, she reveals that the process is still a mystery.

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00:17:09,298 --> 00:17:14,299

I cannot explain to you what the mode of transmitting the mental pictures and things are.

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00:17:14,299 --> 00:17:17,300

It's nothing that I can say that I can feel.

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00:17:17,300 --> 00:17:22,301

I don't even know that it could be measured on an instrument, but it's there.

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00:17:22,301 --> 00:17:27,303

We're all born with it as children, and you can put children and animals together

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00:17:27,303 --> 00:17:30,303

and they can talk to each other with no problem at all.

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00:17:31,303 --> 00:17:35,304

Beatrice finds we can recapture this extrasensory ability

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00:17:35,304 --> 00:17:39,305

and report success teaching owners to communicate with their pets.

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00:17:39,305 --> 00:17:45,307

Now tonight I'm going to be teaching you a new language transmitted by mental pictures.

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00:17:45,307 --> 00:17:49,308

Now to the degree that you believe in what you're doing,

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00:17:49,308 --> 00:17:54,309

to that degree you will have success, no more and no less.

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00:17:54,309 --> 00:18:00,310

The important thing is that at first you cannot tell if it's something the animal is communicating to you

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00:18:00,310 --> 00:18:02,311

or if it's your imagination.

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00:18:02,311 --> 00:18:09,312

So no matter what you get, no matter what the feeling is, the picture, the hunch, whatever you call it,

act on it because as you use it, as you practice it,

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00:18:13,313 --> 00:18:17,314

you will begin to tell later on whether it really is your imagination

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00:18:17,314 --> 00:18:20,315

or whether it's something the animal is really telling you.

The people that make the best students are the ones that can forget themselves long enough

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00:18:25,316 --> 00:18:31,318

to get inside of something else, to see life from that animal's point of view

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00:18:31,318 --> 00:18:34,318

and say, hey, maybe their motivation is different.

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00:18:34,318 --> 00:18:39,320

People write to me all the time and say, wow, my life is so different, you know.

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00:18:39,320 --> 00:18:45,321

It has just totally changed my attitudes with my animals and we now have a different relationship.

Professional animal keepers like those at Kings Island Park in Ohio

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00:18:51,322 --> 00:18:55,323

ask Beatrice to visit their animals and communicate with them.

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00:18:55,323 --> 00:18:58,324

The results are often striking.

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00:18:58,324 --> 00:19:03,325

She has helped solve the most difficult behavioral and medical problems.

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00:19:03,325 --> 00:19:10,327

What I hope people will come to understand about themselves, about the animals and about ESP between us

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00:19:10,327 --> 00:19:13,328

is that here's a new exciting dimension.

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00:19:13,328 --> 00:19:18,329

We have a lot to learn and I hope that people will really find a dimension of excitement

that I'm just beginning to scratch the surface on.

It isn't just in our pets, but it's in the whole animal kingdom

From the romping days of childhood to the quieter hours of later years

Many of us feel that this relationship is not hampered by the lack of a common language

237

because the relationship goes beyond words

238

into the realm of feeling.

Just as human beings share ESP experiences with one another

240

it may be that the bond between humans and animals is but another link on that same chain.

241

The more animal ESP is investigated

the more we may learn that a bond between us and animals is real

and that we are all in fact the same.

And that we are all in fact connected in a web of life.

Perhaps someday we will communicate clearly and directly with animals
