192

Ronald DeFeo

195

had murdered his father, mother, two brothers,

196

and two sisters. Sentenced to life in Clinton State Prison

in New York, DeFeo has claimed that demonic voices

198

goaded him into committing the gruesome killings.

Neighbors and acquaintances of DeFeo were

200

astonished at how George and DeFeo looked alike,

201

how they both presented the same appearance.

George feared that his recent personality changes

203

were further indications that he might become more and more like DeFeo,

This disturbing revelation prompted the Lutz's to seek out psychic investigators

Ed and Lorraine Warren. The Warren's have investigated

was the fact that there were six people

who were murdered in that house. The inhuman, the diabolical,

are attracted to where tragedies occur,

just like a moth would be attracted to a light.

And when the Lutz family moved in 13 months after these murders,

Perhaps these tortured souls caused negative forces

to inhabit the Amityville ground.

This seemingly far-fetched explanation helped confirm something the Lutz

229

came to bother us after we moved in. Let's put it that way.

All those involved with the Amityville

Why then was it never exercised?

237

I'm a Roman Catholic priest and the Roman Catholic Church teaches that

238

people can become possessed but not objects.

The Lutz's were not possessed, so therefore I don't believe they should have been exercised.

240

And I don't believe a house was possessed. There was something there.

To this day, no one knows what actually was in the Lutz home.

But whatever the explanation, in the case of the Amityville
