Who was Ava Braun?

There seems little out of the ordinary about Ava Braun, born of respectable middle-class parents in Munich in 1912.

She grew up to be an attractive young girl. She was the second of Frau Braun's three daughters.

An indifferent student, she had two interests, dancing and photography.

Most of what we know about Ava comes from her snapshot albums and home movies found in a trunk in Munich at the end of the war.

She seems to have had a natural love of animals and children.

Ava Braun was the archetypal ordinary woman.

Hitler gets up on April the 3rd, 1945, and he knows it's going to be the last day of his life.

He's still alive in Cologne and who personally told me the whole story

and you're responsible for making sure that nothing was ever survived, just ashes.

I don't want the Russians getting hold of our bodies and setting them up in some kind of Russian waxworks,

a panopticum in Moscow.

At 3.30 on the afternoon of April 30th, Hitler and Ava retired to his sitting room.

I was in British intelligence at the end of the war and after the fall of Berlin, Hitler was

And he was missing for five months or so and nobody knew what had happened to him.

And the Russians accused the British of concealing him in their zone of Germany for use against them.

And the British authorities appointed me to find out what had happened to Marshal Zhukov, the Russian commander-in-chief.

First, he stated to Allied officers that Hitler had married Ava Braun, which had not been known before,

and that they had committed suicide and no sooner had this been released to the world than Zhukov changed his view and said he had no reason to believe that Hitler was dead.

He thought he was probably alive and after that he felt totally silent.

Marshal Zhukov said it. Marshal Zhukov told Eisenhower, he told Churchill, he told Truman. He said, we found no trace of Hitler.

There were several Americans who visited Stalin in Moscow at this time and to them, Stalin was saying that Hitler was alive.

161

So the Zhukov's true deduction from the inquiries which he had made in Berlin were put into reverse and the official line became that Hitler was alive and that was maintained for the rest of Stalin's life.

Thus the Russians set in motion in some way the legend that Adolf Hitler had escaped by submarine to a South America that he was still alive in Germany.

He was waiting to return. Evert Braun, of course, part of that legend.

No stories seemed too outlandish to print. Reports from people who claimed to have seen Hitler or Ava continued to come in from all over the world.

One woman who prefers to remain anonymous claims to have seen Ava in a village in Tibet.

My husband and I were traveling in the Himalayas when we came across a woman we were convinced was either Braun. I have seen her pictures and I would know her anywhere.

When later reports of escaping Nazis were found to be true, the stories did not sound so strange. Many of the leading Nazis were brought to trial at Nuremberg.

However, there were some who escaped and remained hidden for years in South America. It was easy for them to become lost in remote areas or in the cities among the large German population of Argentina.

It was here that Eichmann was finally captured, kidnapped by Israelis and brought to trial.

It has been more than 36 years since the fall of Berlin, but an air of mystery still surrounds those last days in the bunker.

Identification of bodies through their dental characteristics is now an exact science.

172

Recent information concerning Ava Braun has been published by international forensic expert Professor Radar Songness, founder of the School of Dentistry at UCLA.

173

Based on actual x-rays taken of Hitler's skull at the time of the bomb attempt on his life, Professor Songness in his UCLA lab built an exact replica of Hitler's dental structure.

He then made comparisons with the post-mortem reports.

175

00:17:41,659 --> 00:17:54,656

In fingerprints we require 12 concordant points. In the case of Adolf Hitler's condition, with so many very characteristic dental crowns and britches and root fillings and so forth,

evidence is now that we have 26 concordant points between antemortem and post-mortem information.

177

And as a result of this, we can now say with absolute certainty that the remains of Adolf Hitler have absolutely, definitely been identified.

Ava Braun's case is an entirely different matter. In that case we do not have a number of concordant points.

The Russians have indicated that the only conclusive proof that they may have Ava Braun is a britch in the lower right jaw of Ava Braun.

I have interviewed the dental assistant who was present when things were placed in the mouth of the patients.

181

And she has indicated to me that this britch was made but the time ran out and there was no time to put it in.

She told Dr. Songness of a visit by Soviet investigators a few days after the fall of Berlin.

183

The Russians demanded all dental information concerning Hitler and Ava. It was a tense period and she was terrified.

184

00:19:02,638 --> 00:19:08,636

Indeed, she was later sentenced to many years in Russian prisons, probably to ensure her silence.

185

00:19:08,636 --> 00:19:14,635

She remembered that a dental bridge had been made for Ava but never delivered.

186

The Russians took the bridge and later claimed they had found it as part of Ava's charge remains.

187

Here I have prepared a model showing the space that was supposed to have been filled by this britch.

188

And I've also made a model of the britch and here I will now insert it where it should have been inserted in Ava Braun's mouth.

189

And the mystery of the bridge is that with a fire that burned up half of her head and part of her jawbone,

190

these plastic teeth in front should in this case have been almost evaporated.

191

But according to the pictures the Russians have shown, it looked essentially intact.

192

Based on the fact that the bridge work is the only evidence that the Russians really are claiming for her identification,

193

I find that I am not able to make a post-mortem identification of Ava Braun.

194

Eva Braun died with Hitler in the bunker. Of that I have no doubt there's plenty of evidence and I'm sure of it.

195

While I am not suggesting that Ava Braun has escaped and is alive, while I believe that she probably is dead,

00:20:33,614 --> 00:20:42,611

I must from a scientific point of view indicate that we do not have any evidence from the information now available

that in fact she has been identified.

Today what remains of the entrance to the bunker lies just inside East Berlin.

It is necessary to get permission from the communists to get even close to it.

To the remains of Ava Braun or the answer to what became of her lie buried beneath this pile of rubble.

What became of those Nazis who were present in the last days in the bunker?

Joseph Goebbels and his wife committed suicide the next day after they had poisoned their five children.
