I'm on a mission to find out if Bigfoot really exists.

I explore the world that exists between reality and speculation, the known and the unknown.

What we've been taught by mainstream scholars is not the whole picture.

In 1958, a bulldozer operator in Bluff Creek, California discovered 16-inch human-like footprints

19

near his equipment.

When he told his story to a local newspaper, he said that the footprints must have been

made by an animal with a really big foot.

And the legend of Bigfoot was born.

But tales of mysterious hairy beasts can be found in cultures throughout the world, dating

In the Himalayas, they have stories of the Yeti or the abominable snowman.

In Australia, they talk of a giant ape man known as Yawi.

In Mongolia, they have the Yarin.

And although the stories come from different parts of the world, the accounts are surprisingly

similar.

They describe a tall, massive creature walking on two legs and looking very much like some

sort of a giant ape.

But nowhere are the stories more prolific than in America's Pacific Northwest, where

We're about to see the people of the Olympic project.

35

They are Bigfoot researchers, and apparently they have all sorts of scientific equipment,

36

and they have dedicated their lives to investigating the mystery of Bigfoot, Sasquatch, the big

37

hairy monster.

38

This is in the middle of nowhere, and it is God's country.

39

It is absolutely gorgeous.

40

By the way, I have no idea what to expect.

All right.

This has to be the place.

The Olympic project's about six years old, and it's pretty much started out as a comprehensive

57

camera trap program, or we would camera trap predatory travel routes.

We're basically taking this core area right here.

59

00:04:06,360 --> 00:04:11,400

We're documenting every single thing that happens in hopes of getting pictures of Sasquatch.

60

The team of two dozen researchers includes experts in everything from wildlife habitats

61

to high-tech audio and video recording.

62

To date, the group has spent thousands of hours monitoring the Olympic forest, looking

63

for evidence of Bigfoot.

Meeting the team is longtime Bigfoot researcher Derek Randalls.

65

He has invited both myself and Dr. Jeff Meldrum, a professor of anatomy and anthropology at

66

Idaho State University, to join the team on an overnight expedition on the Olympic peninsula.

67

I explore the ancient mysteries of the world, and so the whole idea of Bigfoot to me is

68

interesting because all throughout history there are bizarre stories of these half-man,

69

half-beast creatures that are found not just in this part of the world, but all around

70

00:05:06,440 --> 00:05:07,440

the globe.

Given my background, I'm always a little more reticent.

72

I'm a little more critical initially, so I'm down here, and then as I investigate things

73

and ask for the questions and look for correlations and corroborations, then that level of acceptance

74

may increase.

What can you tell me about the area, and are there any local legends that talk about this

76

amazing creature here?

77

The Olympic mountain range has been for many years a serious hotspot in Bigfoot activity.

78

00:05:40,360 --> 00:05:47,360

Curiously, the Olympic mountain range is also a hotspot for UFO activity.

79

00:05:47,360 --> 00:05:52,960

Over the years, there have been hundreds of reported sightings of strange objects appearing

80

00:05:53,040 --> 00:05:57,480

and then quickly disappearing in the sky.

81

00:05:57,480 --> 00:06:03,800

In June 2011, two people even claimed they witnessed a cigar-shaped object hovering

82

00:06:03,800 --> 00:06:09,080

in the sky for nearly 15 minutes.

83

There have also been reports of people who saw strange lights following a Bigfoot encounter,

84

and there are even some reports of Bigfoot being seen coming out of a disc-shaped craft.

I started actually investigating the Olympic mountain range in 1985 when I had my own encounter,

86

and it forever changed my life.

You had your own encounter, so you've seen Bigfoot.

88

Back in the early 80s, I would get together with a couple of hiking partners of mine,

and we would go up on the trail system.

There's a very elaborate trail system throughout the Olympic National Park.

91

So at that time, we started to take our backpacks off and pull our tents out and ready to get

92

situated for the evening.

And we heard a very loud crash, and here comes a rock in its parking, and it comes down and lands

94

And we didn't even say anything, we didn't even move, we just stood there.

What we're looking at is a spectrogram of an audio file.

110

What I like to do is set up a recorder in an area that has promise, and record all night long.

111

And then review the audio file to see if I can find anything of interest.

112

00:08:19,960 --> 00:08:20,960

Okay.

113

00:08:20,960 --> 00:08:29,960

What I've got here is an isolated signature within a loop of five different vocalizations that are suspicious.

114

00:08:29,960 --> 00:08:31,960

Those lines are those the vocalizations?

115

00:08:31,960 --> 00:08:32,960

They are.

116

00:08:32,960 --> 00:08:33,960

Okay.

117

00:08:33,960 --> 00:08:36,960

So now this is just a loop of this specific vocal.

118

It's like a guy yodeling.

119

00:08:39,160 --> 00:08:41,160

It's very interesting.

120

00:08:41,160 --> 00:08:48,160

Yes. We can't say specifically that it's a Saswatch, but that's what interests people that are analyzing the audio.

121

What do you say to someone that might suggest, well, what we just heard is nothing else but a wolf howling?

122

00:08:55,160 --> 00:09:02,160

It's possible, but since we're looking at it in a spectrogram, we can compare it to a wolf howling.

123

00:09:02,360 --> 00:09:08,360

David Ellis has collected dozens of animal sounds recorded in the Olympic forest.

124

00:09:08,360 --> 00:09:16,360

And each new sound collected is compared to documented animal sounds by using spectrogram analysis.

125

With it, he can eliminate sounds that match with known animals.

126

00:09:21,360 --> 00:09:24,360

For example, a wolf howl.

127

According to Ellis, the sound we are listening to now does not match up with anything else on record.

128

That was very interesting.

129

The team arms themselves for the hunt with an arsenal of super sophisticated equipment.

They're so close to the sound.

The team arms themselves for the hunt with an arsenal of super sophisticated equipment.

Their so-called secret weapon is the FLIR camera, which stands for Forward-Looking Infrared.

135

Often used by law enforcement and the military, FLIR is the top of the line in thermal heat-sensing technology.

136

They also bring along an audio dish for amplifying sounds coming out of the forest

137

00:10:12,960 --> 00:10:21,960

and motion detector still cameras all in an effort to find concrete evidence of the legendary creature known as Bigfoot.

All of this is great, but as you all know, the real research takes place out in the field.

139

So I would love to take all these gadgets and all out here out in the open and let's see what happens.

140

Alright.

Why do you think Bigfoot is so illusive?

So Derek, where are we headed right now?

150

We're actually going up on this bench up here on the side of Mueller.

151

The team often conducts their Bigfoot expeditions at Mount Mueller, where numerous sightings have been reported.

152

So we're doing this on foot, not with a helicopter.

153

00:11:26,160 --> 00:11:27,160

On our foot.

154

00:11:27,160 --> 00:11:29,160

Alright, let's do it.

155

Is this beautiful through here?

156

00:11:37,160 --> 00:11:40,160

The scenery is absolutely beyond anything I've ever seen.

157

This area, there are apparently over 200 reports of sightings by different people.

158

And whenever I hear stuff like that, I'm interested because, you know, you can't suggest that all these 200 reports are from crazy people.

So what if something really is going on here?

And so I'm very excited to be out here and maybe we'll get some clues to explore this mystery.

On every expedition he goes on, Dr. Meldrum carries footprint-cast samples with him for comparison.

165

In the event they find a fresh one.

And many have recently been discovered in this particular forest.

167

So Dr. Meldrum, you know, you have to tell me, to you what is the most compelling reasons that you think that bigfoot might be real?

168

Well, from my point of view, it's the footprint evidence.

169

00:12:46,560 --> 00:12:53,560

I mean, clearly that's my area of expertise and so it has the greatest significance to me.

170

Let me show you a couple of examples here.

Oh wow, you brought a cast.

I did.

You'll hold that one for a second.

175

Oh wow, these are amazing.

176

Now, these are some good examples of some very classic Sasquatch tracks.

177

This is probably a large male.

178

00:13:14,760 --> 00:13:17,760

It measures between 16, 17 inches in length.

179

00:13:17,760 --> 00:13:18,760

It's quite broad.

180

00:13:18,760 --> 00:13:21,760

Nearly 7 inches across the forefoot here.

181

00:13:21,760 --> 00:13:26,760

And in contrast, the female, this is one of which measures between about 14 and 15 inches,

182

00:13:26,760 --> 00:13:29,760

maybe 5 inches across the forefoot here.

183

00:13:29,960 --> 00:13:37,960

And so, I mean, clearly these are not just simply someone with a big foot walking around barefoot.

184

Check this out.

185

Wow.

186

00:13:41,960 --> 00:13:53,960

Dr. Meldrum has over 200 examples of footprint casts that indicate that the anatomy of the creature

could be similar to that of a large bipedal ape.

187

With a foot measuring some 16 inches in length, it would stand somewhere between 8 and 10 feet tall and would weigh in excess of a thousand pounds.

188

00:14:07,160 --> 00:14:16,160

But rather than an arched foot, as in the case of humans, the creature's footprints indicate that its weight is distributed much more evenly,

189

00:14:16,160 --> 00:14:20,160

giving it flat but still very flexible feet.

190

So Dr. Meldrum, you're of the conviction that these prints are real.

191

00:14:28,360 --> 00:14:29,360

I am.

192

00:14:29,360 --> 00:14:30,360

I am.

193

Some unknown creature has been leaving these footprints.

194

00:14:33,360 --> 00:14:38,360

After hiking for several hours, the team sets up camp.

195

00:14:38,360 --> 00:14:43,360

Everyone works together to get organized quickly before the light fades.

196

00:14:43,360 --> 00:14:49,360

Then we head out into the woods with thermal cameras and audio equipment to search for bigfoot.

197

00:14:50,360 --> 00:14:53,360

So this is what we're going to be using.

198

00:14:53,360 --> 00:14:55,360

How long do you leave a camera out like this?

199

00:14:55,360 --> 00:15:00,360

Batteries usually last for three to six months depending on how many pictures they're taking.

200

00:15:00,360 --> 00:15:02,360

And it only picks up when there's movement.

201

00:15:02,360 --> 00:15:03,360

Movement, for sure.

202

00:15:03,360 --> 00:15:04,360

Okay, okay.

203

00:15:04,360 --> 00:15:06,360

So now we've set up the infrared camera.

204

00:15:06,360 --> 00:15:07,360

Looks good.

205

00:15:07,360 --> 00:15:08,360

Let's go back.

206

00:15:08,360 --> 00:15:19,360

In addition to the motion control cameras, David Ellis places audio recording equipment near game trails to capture any unusual vocalization.

207

00:15:19,560 --> 00:15:28,560

This is a parabolic dish and it is designed to amplify sound from a specific direction.

208

00:15:28,560 --> 00:15:33,560

And usually I'll have somebody off in the distance and we'll do sound checks.

209

00:15:33,560 --> 00:15:36,560

So I get an idea of how close something is to the dish.

210

00:15:36,560 --> 00:15:40,560

So would you be so kind as to do a sound check for me?

211

00:15:40,560 --> 00:15:42,560

Are you saying you want me to be bigfoot?

212

00:15:42,560 --> 00:15:43,560

Is that what you're saying?

213

00:15:43,560 --> 00:15:44,560

Fine.

214

00:15:44,560 --> 00:15:45,560

I'll do it.

215

00:15:45,560 --> 00:15:46,560

Okay.

216

00:15:46,560 --> 00:15:47,560

So just into the distance right here.

217

All right.

218

00:15:48,760 --> 00:15:56,760

That's probably far enough.

219

00:15:56,760 --> 00:15:57,760

All right.

220

00:15:57,760 --> 00:15:59,760

Now give me a whisper.

221

Can you hear me?

222

00:16:01,760 --> 00:16:02,760

Perfect.

223

00:16:02,760 --> 00:16:03,760

So you could hear me whisper.

224

00:16:03,760 --> 00:16:04,760

I can't.

225

00:16:04,760 --> 00:16:05,760

75 feet away.

226

00:16:05,760 --> 00:16:07,760

I mean, it clears a bell, right?

227

00:16:07,760 --> 00:16:08,760

Yes.

228

00:16:08,760 --> 00:16:09,760

So I'm good.

229

00:16:09,760 --> 00:16:10,760

All right.

230

00:16:10,760 --> 00:16:14,760

In the end, all of this is about the unknown.

231

Derek Randall is one of the founders of the Olympic project.

232

I wanted to spend some time with him and tap into his expertise about what he thinks this

233

00:16:24,960 --> 00:16:27,960

creature is and is not.

234

00:16:27,960 --> 00:16:32,960

So in your opinion, why do you think bigfoot is so illusive?

235

I think that there's very few.

236

00:16:34,960 --> 00:16:35,960

They're very few.

237

00:16:35,960 --> 00:16:36,960

They're very smart.

238

00:16:36,960 --> 00:16:38,960

They are expert woodsmen.

239

00:16:38,960 --> 00:16:42,960

To just go out and find a sasquatch, you're going to win the lottery first.

240

00:16:43,160 --> 00:16:47,160

They are far and away, our superior out here in the woods.

241

I find it interesting that every member of the Olympic project talks about bigfoot as

242

00:16:52,160 --> 00:16:56,160

being this very large, but also intelligent creature.

243

When I hear this, I'm reminded of the story of the Watchers from the Book of Enoch.

244

This apocryphal text, which was edited out of the traditional Christian Bible, tells

245

of a group of angels called the Watchers who descended to Earth from heaven shortly

246

00:17:15,360 --> 00:17:18,360

after the time of creation.

247

00:17:18,360 --> 00:17:24,360

According to the Book of Enoch, the Watchers mated with early humans and bred a race of

248

00:17:24,360 --> 00:17:28,360

giants called the Nephilim.

249

00:17:28,360 --> 00:17:35,360

Might other worldly visitors have come here and engaged in some sort of genetic manipulation?

250

00:17:35,560 --> 00:17:42,560

And could one of these genetic experiments still be living among us right here on Earth?

251

I want to talk to you about sound.

252

00:17:45,560 --> 00:17:49,360

I mean, I've also been told that people clap in order to make their presence known, and

253

00:17:49,360 --> 00:17:52,360

then there is a return clap or something like this.

254

What's that all about?

255

00:17:53,360 --> 00:17:54,360

You're probably referring to wood knocks.

256

Okay.

Many Native American cultures share traditional ancient legends

349

which refer to large, hair-covered man beasts

whom they believe inhabit the deep woods of the Pacific Northwest.

Even today, the Quinault Indians of the Olympic Peninsula report sightings of a huge ape-like hominid they call Tsiadko.

352

In fact, the existence of these tall shaggy creatures, also known as Sasquatch,

353

00:26:04,360 --> 00:26:09,360

is simply taken for granted by many Native American tribes.

354

I was driving down the road and it was about seven or eight in the evening, but it was still plenty light.

355

And I was coming around this corner and the beach was off to my left.

356

And just this dark figure that was really tall and big

357

Everything was really quiet and it was kind of drizzly. It was just an eerie day.

Although legends concerning large hairy creatures have been told and retold for centuries,

what turned Bigfoot into a household name was the notorious Patterson Gimbalan film.

Even though some have judged the footage as a hoax, there are many who believe

384

that it offers convincing evidence that Bigfoot really does exist.

385

So what do you think that creature actually is?

386

In the beginning when I got into it, I kind of looked at it as it must be a relic common to some type,

387

you know, North American ape and that certainly is a possibility.

388

But when you look at the Native American history, that's much more supernatural even to some aspects

389

00:28:53,360 --> 00:28:56,360

of a shapeshifter, interdimensional type being.

390

A shapeshifter, an interdimensional being?

391

00:29:00,360 --> 00:29:08,360

Now when I hear things like that, my mind goes to stories of shapeshifting beings that appear in many ancient cultures,

392

00:29:08,360 --> 00:29:15,360

including the Greek tale of Zeus who transformed King Lykeon into a wolf.

393

00:29:15,360 --> 00:29:20,360

Many Native American myths include legends of creatures known as skinwalkers,

394

00:29:20,360 --> 00:29:28,360

humans who can change their shape at will and often take the form of large hairy beasts.

395

00:29:28,360 --> 00:29:32,360

I'm not saying that I necessarily believe along those lines.

396

00:29:32,360 --> 00:29:34,360

But those stories exist.

397

00:29:34,360 --> 00:29:36,360

They do exist and there must be a reason for it.

398

00:29:36,360 --> 00:29:39,360

That's a verbal history of those people.

399

00:29:39,360 --> 00:29:44,360

And all tribes tend to have the same type of stories about these beings.

400

Well Rich, thank you very much for allowing me to come out here and to hear your stories.

401

The second encounter, the way you describe that, that will haunt me for the rest of my life.

402

After hearing Rich Jermot's incredible first-hand account,

403

I've decided to reach out to my good friend, Dr. Jonathan Young,

404

405

So thanks very much for seeing me on such short notice.

406

But I recently met this former detective, Rich Jermot,

407

00:30:25,360 --> 00:30:33,360

and he thinks that Bigfoot, or whatever it is he saw, was some sort of a shapeshifter or a skinwalker.

408

And so I know that that is right up your alley.

409

00:30:36,360 --> 00:30:38,360

Whatever's happening, it's significant.

410

00:30:38,360 --> 00:30:41,360

So we have Yeti in the Himalaya areas.

411

We have giants in Africa.

412

00:30:43,360 --> 00:30:46,360

We have all the reports in the Pacific Northwest which have been the Bigfoot sightings.

413

The fact that they keep happening suggests that there's something to it.

414

I want to show you some things.

415

Come with me.

416

All right.

So Tori, in your opinion, do you think it is at all feasible or possible

418

that a sub-species, for example, Bigfoot could exist under the radar?

419

I was thinking, George, Joe, about this wild man image, how it shows up in some really popular forms.

420

A very familiar form from Western culture is Merlin.

421

Merlin, he's a shamanistic magician.

422

00:31:26,360 --> 00:31:28,360

He lives in a cave.

423

So you've got the cave diver tradition there.

424

There's the troglodytes all the way back to the Greek historians.

425

Now, this is a truly fascinating connection to me because many historians believe

426

00:31:41,360 --> 00:31:48,360

that the wizard Merlin is actually based on a legendary Welsh figure named Merlin Wilt,

427

00:31:48,360 --> 00:31:54,360

who is described as a hairy madman who wandered in the company of beasts.

428

00:31:54,360 --> 00:32:01,360

Now, in the ancient Greek myths, the troglodytes are these large, hairy, beastly-looking creatures

429

00:32:01,360 --> 00:32:06,360

that lived underground and could be extremely terrifying.

430

00:32:06,360 --> 00:32:13,360

But they were also depicted as being very wise, and according to the ancient legends,

431

00:32:13,360 --> 00:32:18,360

the troglodytes descended from the sky and were hiding out in caves and tunnels

432

00:32:18,360 --> 00:32:22,360

because they wanted to keep their presence a secret.

433

00:32:23,360 --> 00:32:28,360

There have been stories about magical animals and humans turning into animals,

434

00:32:28,360 --> 00:32:33,360

turning into humans from, well, pretty much as long as we've had recorded history.

435

So take the werewolf.

436

Those characters transcend our moral code.

437

They do what they want. They are like beasts in that regard, and then they become people again.

Is the Bigfoot a shapeshifter? Is it something else?

439

Part of the time, is that why we don't see it all the time?

440

Man, the idea that Bigfoot could be some sort of a shapeshifter like a werewolf

441

00:32:56,360 --> 00:33:03,360

is incredible because if true, it could explain why Bigfoot has been so elusive.

442

It is able to hide among us in human form.

443

00:33:08,360 --> 00:33:14,360

I've always been fascinated by the idea of the hybrids, these half-man, half-animal creatures

444

00:33:14,360 --> 00:33:17,360

that permeate all of history.

445

In your opinion, what are we looking at there?

446

00:33:20,360 --> 00:33:24,360

Yeah, it's just very, very interesting the way they show up.

447

There are so many variations. We've got an image here of a half-horse, half-man.

448

00:33:29,360 --> 00:33:32,360

This is very close to the image of Pam.

449

00:33:32,360 --> 00:33:38,360

And it is very powerful crossing between the known and the unknown.

450

00:33:39,360 --> 00:33:46,360

All around the world, we can find carvings or statues of what are called hybrid beings.

451

00:33:46,360 --> 00:33:51,360

In India, we have the naga, which is a half-man, half-snake.

452

00:33:51,360 --> 00:33:55,360

In Greece, there is the medusa who has snakes for hair.

453

00:33:55,360 --> 00:34:02,360

In Egypt, there is an entire god Pantheon of half-man, half-animal deities.

454

00:34:02,360 --> 00:34:09,360

Like Anubis, a creature that has the head of a jackal and the body of a human being.

455

00:34:09,360 --> 00:34:15,360

Various hybrid images that show up from time to time all through history,

456

00:34:15,360 --> 00:34:19,360

and a recent present-day manifestation is Bigfoot.

457

00:34:19,360 --> 00:34:24,360

Yeti, do they have the kind of impact that these hybrid gods had?

458

00:34:24,360 --> 00:34:29,360

Are they showing us the way to something metaphysical, something transcendent?

459

00:34:29,360 --> 00:34:32,360

That's what gets me excited about these sightings.

460

00:34:32,360 --> 00:34:36,360

Life is strange, and there's a lot to know that we do not know.

461

And it's important to study the margins, to study the things that we don't understand yet.

462

Bigfoot and I will cross paths.

463

Jonathan, this was great. Thank you very much for your time. I've learned a lot.

464

Now we know that scientists are always discovering new organisms all the time.

465

00:34:55,360 --> 00:35:00,360

So it isn't so hard for me to believe or speculate that there really could be a creature,

466

00:35:00,360 --> 00:35:07,360

even one as large as Bigfoot, that has so far evaded detection or even capture.

467

00:35:07,360 --> 00:35:12,360

But the big difference between believing something and knowing it

468

00:35:12,360 --> 00:35:16,360

is the difference between faith and science.

469

And because scientists are the hardest people to convince,

470

I've made a trip to the Museum of Man in San Diego

471

00:35:24,360 --> 00:35:28,360

to ask biological anthropologist Dr. Tori Randall

472

00:35:28,360 --> 00:35:34,360

if she thinks that a creature like Bigfoot could actually be real.

473

00:35:35,360 --> 00:35:39,360

One of the main attractions here is a model of Lucy,

474

00:35:39,360 --> 00:35:44,360

a hominid whose skeleton was discovered in Ethiopia in 1974.

475

00:35:44,360 --> 00:35:49,360

It is considered by scientists to be what many have claimed Bigfoot could be,

476

00:35:49,360 --> 00:35:53,360

a missing link between apes and humans.

477

00:35:54,360 --> 00:35:57,360

All right. There she is.

478

00:35:57,360 --> 00:36:00,360

This is Lucy. She's an *Australopithecus* *afarensis*,

479

00:36:00,360 --> 00:36:04,360

an early hominin that lived about two to four million years ago.

480

00:36:04,360 --> 00:36:07,360

She stood about three and a half feet tall,

481

00:36:07,360 --> 00:36:11,360

and she has some ape-like and some more human-like traits.

482

00:36:11,360 --> 00:36:15,360

She's bipedal, which is one of the things that we attribute to humans.

483

00:36:15,360 --> 00:36:16,360

Right.

484

00:36:17,360 --> 00:36:23,360

Although Lucy is far too small to suggest that she may have a direct connection to Bigfoot,

485

00:36:23,360 --> 00:36:27,360

there were in fact a number of very large primates

486

00:36:27,360 --> 00:36:32,360

that walked the Earth as far back as a hundred thousand years ago.

487

00:36:32,360 --> 00:36:36,360

One of these, known as Jagantopithecus,

488

00:36:36,360 --> 00:36:40,360

stood an incredible ten to twelve feet tall.

489

00:36:41,360 --> 00:36:44,360

And if Bigfoot really exists,

490

00:36:44,360 --> 00:36:50,360

could it be a direct descendant of this giant prehistoric creature?

491

00:36:56,360 --> 00:36:58,360

Who are these two friends right here?

492

00:36:58,360 --> 00:37:02,360

So, we have a couple of reconstructions of different hominids here.

493

This one is an Australopithecusine,

494

which is an earlier form of hominin,

495

00:37:08,360 --> 00:37:11,360

probably about two to four million years ago.

496

This one is a Homo habilis,

497

00:37:14,360 --> 00:37:17,360

which is the first member of the Homo genus,

498

00:37:17,360 --> 00:37:19,360

which is what we are, Homo sapiens.

499

00:37:19,360 --> 00:37:23,360

So, a little bit more modern if you're comparing these two.

500

So, Tori, in your opinion, do you think it is at all possible

501

00:37:27,360 --> 00:37:33,360

that a subspecies, for example, Bigfoot,

502

00:37:33,360 --> 00:37:35,360

could exist under the radar,

503
