Since Qigong is no longer found only in China you can get the necessary herbs in America's Chinatowns.

Depending on the properties and curative effects different herbs and plants are used.

Qigong is a traditional Chinese medicine that is used to cure the body's disease.

He envelops the students with his qi to support theirs and keeps both the strong and weak qi from mixing.

The students are completely relaxed and feel a warm tingling sensation throughout their limbs and torso.

Their breathing is shallow, their heart beats strong and some even see colours while their eyes are closed.

They're dying here just like sleeping but he's different from sleep.

Well to explain the myth and explore the mystery we came here to where it all began in America in the 17th century.

Salem, Massachusetts.

172

In the 17th century the definition of witchcraft or being a witch meant that you had made a pact with the devil.

173

They very much believed in the existence of the devil in the 17th century.

174

The pact would have meant that you would give the devil your soul and in exchange you would get magic, evil powers with which you could torment other people.

175

That's the 17th century definition.

176

Then of course there's the popular witch image which we see a lot of at Halloween.

177

That comes down through probably European culture.

You think of Hansel and Gretel and the witch, the wicked witch out in the forest.

179

All that imagery.

182

Then there's the third meaning and this one is of course a very different kind of one.

183

There are people who practice witchcraft today and they date their religion back to ancient times.

It is a very different kind of belief than the 17th century definition.

Witchcraft is a religion that is earth based which means that it's a religion that works in harmony with the natural forces.

189

The fundamental belief is in the duality of the godhead.

191

That we believe in a god and goddess.

192

Within that form it is the feminine and masculine principle within ourselves.

193

The church during the early years, 11th through 17th centuries especially,

there was really a lot of propaganda confusing what is the god in nature and in witchcraft.

195

The pagan god who is another name for him is Pan.

196

The guy with the plain the flute and dancing around and they made him into the Christian idea of the devil

197

so that god could have an adversary.

There is no devil in witchcraft and there never has been.

199

One of our creeds or credos is do what that will not let it harm none and also beware of the three fold law.

201

It will come back in a return as well as positive things.

So that is a good check and balance I believe.

The word wicca or witchcraft comes from wicker.

204

It means to bend or to shape and it's about bending and shaping the realities that we can change.

The negative propaganda against wiccans has really translated into our fear of wearing our sacred symbols.

206

Especially the pentacle, the five pointed star with the circle around it,

207

which embodies earth, water, fire, air and spirit, which is the microcosm of the universe.

208

It is also a symbol of protection and reminds us of the web of life, the way everything is interconnected.

209

Witchcraft will practice two ways, actually three ways.

210

With robes, without robes or in street clothes.

211

00:18:04,000 --> 00:18:11,000

To make the sanctity of the ritual that much more important, we reserve the robe for the magical rite.

212

We celebrate in circles as opposed to in rows of people sitting and watching someone perform a ceremony.

213

It's very participatory, it's very personal and everyone who is a part of ceremony contributes to ceremony.

214

Well, we worship in small groups as opposed to occasionally there's larger celebrations,

215

00:18:33,000 --> 00:18:38,000

but usually it's a smaller group and the traditional Coven number is 13.

216

And it's a small group so you can really get to know people and really work together

217

00:18:43,000 --> 00:18:48,000

out of really getting to know each other over time.

218

And it's celebrations about the calendar of life, which is the agricultural calendar.

The solstices, the equinoxes, the cross quarter days.

220

You have several celebrations in a year, right?

221

Oh yes, we have eight. We have eight altogether.

The one coming up is the Folly Quinox and right after that will be Sawan or Halloween.

223

It's the more popular name for it.

224

And these are agricultural holidays.

225

These are the holidays of the farmer's year.

226

And we also have lunar celebrations, full moon, dark moon, new moon celebrations.

227

In addition to personal ceremony for rites of passage, for passages like birth and menopause and menstruation and death.

228

I feel like I have special powers that I have nurtured.

229

I think a general feeling with which is in general is that everyone has these so-called special powers that they are natural to every person.

230

It's a question of developing them and acknowledging them and learning how to use them for the benefit of yourself and others.

Healing abilities, ability.

232

A lot of it is a development of empathy and compassion, which are an intuition, which certainly traits that everyone has available to them.

In many cultures, the evil eye is thought to bring misfortune and even death to those in its path.

Evil sorcerers can cast the penetrating gaze, but others may have the invulnerability to use it and not even realize it.
