The public was told a mistake had been made and the crashed object was nothing more than

an ordinary weather balloon.

Despite testimonies of scores of reliable witnesses who have since come forward, the

official stand today, nearly 50 years later, is still that it was just a military weather

balloon.

A new Air Force investigation announced its findings just weeks before this broadcast.

It wasn't a UFO.

This is what the Air Force is saying after an eight-month investigation of a crash near

Roswell, New Mexico.

A crash that occurred 47 years ago.

For years there have been stories passed along by the residents that what the Air Force

called a weather balloon was really a UFO and that there were extra terrestrials on board.

The Air Force tracked down people, combed archives, and even sent some old news photos

to the CIA for analysis.

It concluded what other government agencies had concluded for many years.

There was no conspiracy to hide the truth.

The amount of dissenting opinion is almost overwhelming among those who have investigated

Don Schmidt, author of UFO Crash at Roswell, has painstakingly researched every angle of

a UFO.

The first press release that it was a flying saucer and six hours later, we're sorry ladies

and gentlemen, there is no threat.

There's nothing to be up in arms about.

It's just a radar reflector device constructed of foil, balsa wood, and bailing twine.

As an Army pilot stationed at Roswell, he got a close look at some of the recovered material

He remembers the report that it was a flying saucer.

The very next day there was a recant from 8th Air Force saying that it was a weather balloon

that was found and not an unknown object.

All I can say to that is that we had weather balloons in base operations because the weather

station was there also and I would see them carry a balloon out and blow it up and send

it on its way with a radio sign and so forth.

What was brought through the building and loaded on the airplane was not the same material.

It was not a weather balloon.

One important figure to express skepticism over the continuing balloon story is Congressman

Stephen Schiff of New Mexico.

His office has initiated its own investigation into the case.

He believes official records pertaining to Roswell exist and that these should be made

available to the public.

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00:05:14,000 --> 00:05:19,880

Can you imagine probably the best bomber group in the Army Air Corps saying that a weather

balloon was a flying saucer?

That would have been quite an embarrassment and there should be some documentation of

How could we make such fools out of ourselves if that is in fact what occurred?

Walter Hort was the Public Information Officer at Roswell, whose job it was to issue the

Hort's Army experience with public information and UFOs has been called upon more recently.

to satisfy a growing curiosity on the subject.

Radar and visual presentation from all 50 states.

Several months ago, the Showtime cable network aired a special two-hour movie about Jesse

It was less than two years after the end of World War II, the troops had come home.

And the Cold War was heating up.

In late June and early July, there were a series of strange reports from all over the

world.

People were seeing unrecognizable objects flying around with inexplicable trajectories.

Some appeared to be round discs, others cigar shaped.

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00:09:24,800 --> 00:09:27,960

And the stories were not just from ordinary citizens.

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00:09:27,960 --> 00:09:34,040

Many reports came from highly trained pilots, both civilian and military.

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00:09:34,040 --> 00:09:40,600

New Mexico at the time was home to a number of highly classified military projects.

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00:09:40,600 --> 00:09:45,640

On the night of July the 4th, the central part of the state was hit by some of the most

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00:09:45,640 --> 00:09:48,280

violent thunderstorms in memory.

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00:09:48,280 --> 00:09:54,600

A rancher named Mack Brazell was one of a number of people who heard a loud explosion

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00:09:54,600 --> 00:09:56,600

amidst the thunder.

Investigators have established a sequence of events which then followed.

July the 5th, Brazell discovers a huge field of very strange, lightweight metallic debris

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00:10:08,680 --> 00:10:13,600

on his ranch and the next day he brings it to the sheriff in Roswell.

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00:10:13,600 --> 00:10:17,360

They then report the find to the Army Air Base.

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00:10:17,360 --> 00:10:24,640

On July 7th, Brazell takes Major Jesse Marcell and another officer out to the debris field

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00:10:24,640 --> 00:10:29,240

where they load up some of the material and bring it back to the base.

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00:10:29,240 --> 00:10:34,400

The next morning, troops are sent out to guard the debris field as well as an actual crash

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00:10:34,400 --> 00:10:37,160

site 40 miles away.

After Brazell talks to some local radio stations, Colonel Blanchard, the commander of the base

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00:10:42,800 --> 00:10:48,920

at Roswell, dictates a press release saying the Army has captured a flying disk.

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00:10:48,920 --> 00:10:55,320

That afternoon the story hits the wires and phone lines in Roswell are jammed.

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00:10:55,320 --> 00:11:00,840

But within hours Major Marcell is sent to Fort Worth with some of the debris and there

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00:11:00,840 --> 00:11:06,880

General George Ramey gives Marcell some remnants of a weather balloon.

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00:11:06,880 --> 00:11:12,160

At a hastily arranged press conference, Ramey says his officers had made a mistake and the

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00:11:12,160 --> 00:11:19,680

crashed object was in fact nothing more than a weather balloon with an attached radar reflector.

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00:11:19,680 --> 00:11:22,600

And so the case was closed.

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00:11:22,600 --> 00:11:25,040

Everyone moved on to other things.

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00:11:25,040 --> 00:11:30,040

Just two months later the attention of the nation was riveted on Chuck Yeager as the

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00:11:30,040 --> 00:11:36,080

man with the right stuff broke the sound barrier and our own space program was officially

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00:11:36,080 --> 00:11:37,640

underway.

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00:11:37,640 --> 00:11:46,640

Whatever happened at Roswell was quickly forgotten by all, except those who were actually there.

One of the most perplexing features of the incident is that the Army at first appeared

to acknowledge the existence of an extraterrestrial craft, then completely denied it.

Why didn't anyone question the about face?

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00:12:00,560 --> 00:12:03,880

Those who were there have their own theories.

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00:12:03,880 --> 00:12:06,120

This was right after the war.

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00:12:06,120 --> 00:12:12,200

I say right after, it was a year and a half, but even so everyone who had been in the service

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00:12:12,200 --> 00:12:18,840

during the actual war period had been always told, don't talk to anybody, don't tell them

what you're doing, etc., etc.

I think you've got to take a couple things into consideration.

The 509th was a very highly classified organization.

They were the only ones in the world capable of handling and delivering an atomic weapon.

If you didn't have a need to know, you didn't ask.

00:12:44,160 --> 00:12:49,360

I was a bombardier amongst other duties.

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00:12:49,360 --> 00:12:58,040

I never was permitted to go near an airplane that had the bomb racks capable of handling

an atomic weapon.

172

00:12:59,440 --> 00:13:01,400

I never asked to.

173

00:13:01,400 --> 00:13:04,840

I knew that I wasn't supposed to, so that was the end of it.

174

00:13:04,840 --> 00:13:14,600

You've got a different frame of mind back in 1947 than you have in 1994.

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00:13:14,600 --> 00:13:21,840

Frank Joyce was a radio personality in Roswell at the time and spoke with Rancho MacBrasel.

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00:13:21,840 --> 00:13:26,280

He believed national security may have motivated the cover up.

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00:13:26,280 --> 00:13:28,280

That was a different era than now.

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00:13:28,280 --> 00:13:32,240

You didn't have the complex society that we have now.

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00:13:32,240 --> 00:13:40,040

You did not have TVs, camera men as we have scheduled here, a news reporter like yourself

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00:13:40,040 --> 00:13:45,080

with a backing of all sorts of people and all the best equipment in the world to report

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00:13:45,080 --> 00:13:47,760

everything that happened.

When a statement came out on the news wire that simply said, it's a weather balloon,

people were inclined to believe it.

This was before the era of Vietnam.

It wasn't yet common practice to question everything the government did.

It wasn't until 1978 that the file on Roswell was reopened.

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00:14:37,760 --> 00:14:43,560

Stanton Friedman, a nuclear physicist, author and popular lecturer, was the person who stumbled

upon this extraordinary story.

In the course of my lecturing, of course, because I take such a strong stand, the lecturers,

I'm not an apologist, you're a phologist.

A lot of people tell me lots of things.

Once when I was in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at a television station waiting for a third

interview where the station managers give me coffee because the girl was late, out of

Oh, well, he handled pieces of one of these saucers when he was in the military.

I got my attention as you could imagine.

As well as he alive, do you know him?

207

Oh, yeah, he lives over in Homa.

I had the faintest idea where Homa, Louisiana was then.

I've been there since, of course.

We're old ham radio buddies.

Great guy.

Friedman began to look into the case and his findings led to a book, Crash at Corona.

Others followed his lead and one by one, witnesses who had kept silent for over 30 years began

Most people connected with Roswell took their cue from the army and quietly accepted the

They staged a launch of a radar reflector from a weather balloon and loudly proclaimed

All these pictures deal with this silly little radar reflector on a weather balloon.

General Ramey gives the explanation.

Next day they staged the launch.

The media are there.

It was out on the wire and that was the end of the flying saucer craziness.

Those who ask questions were told quite directly, don't.

The first release, all that material was taken out.

00:16:29,160 --> 00:16:33,720

Some of it, I understand, got into papers in other parts of the country off the original

release.

But I spent about 15 or 20 years not knowing whether that was true or not because this

story was really hushed up.

I mean it was shut up entirely.

Jud Roberts managed the radio station in Roswell where Frank Joyce worked.

He recalls that dropping the entire story wasn't a request.

It was an order.

00:16:58,280 --> 00:17:07,680

I had a call from Washington the next day right after the news deal had come out and

saying that if we put anything on the air at all, that they were monitoring us and if

236

00:17:14,920 --> 00:17:21,760

there was anything on the air at all, frankly, they'd pull our license.

237

00:17:21,760 --> 00:17:24,280

He wasn't talking about a hearing or anything.

238

00:17:24,280 --> 00:17:28,680

He said it'll be cancelled not later than tomorrow morning.

239

00:17:28,680 --> 00:17:33,520

There are many reports of witnesses being threatened or bullied or in the case of military

240

00:17:33,520 --> 00:17:38,000

personnel being shipped off to remote locations.

241

00:17:38,000 --> 00:17:41,760

All to keep the lid on this story.

242

00:17:41,760 --> 00:17:46,240

Nobody knew about this site except some of the civilians involved and they were actually

243

00:17:46,240 --> 00:17:48,840

threatened into submission.

244

00:17:48,840 --> 00:17:57,720

The military went to their homes, they sequestered them at the base and reinforced their oaths

245

00:17:57,720 --> 00:17:59,840

of secrecy with physical threats.

246

00:17:59,840 --> 00:18:05,240

In other words, you will come to bodily harm if you ever say a word about this.

247

00:18:05,240 --> 00:18:10,240

When people like Stanton Friedman, Don Smit and others went to federal agencies and began

248

00:18:10,240 --> 00:18:15,640

probing, one thing they found was that the US government was anything but cooperative

249

00:18:15,640 --> 00:18:17,120

with information.

250

00:18:17,120 --> 00:18:21,360

Back in the late 70s went after the CIA, everybody's favorite target.

251

00:18:21,360 --> 00:18:24,800

We want all your UFO information, we don't have any UFO information, you do too, we do

252

00:18:24,800 --> 00:18:27,400

not, we appeal, they deny, we go to court.

253

00:18:27,440 --> 00:18:31,720

The judge says, do a search of your files, gentlemen, at the CIA.

254

00:18:31,720 --> 00:18:35,760

They come back, oh, we found 900 pages of UFO information.

255

00:18:35,760 --> 00:18:37,600

After saying they had none, you'll understand.

256

00:18:37,600 --> 00:18:40,560

I naturally filed with the CIA for their 23 UFO documents.

257

00:18:40,560 --> 00:18:43,440

They were supposed to respond in 10 working days.

258

00:18:43,440 --> 00:18:46,440

That's pretty quick and you know what's going on.

259

00:18:46,440 --> 00:18:49,800

35 months later they responded.

260

00:18:49,800 --> 00:18:51,520

They agreed to release the first nine.

261

00:18:51,520 --> 00:18:53,440

I was ecstatic until I looked at them.

262

00:18:53,440 --> 00:18:56,280

We're talking 23 documents, nine's pretty good.

263

00:18:56,280 --> 00:19:01,120

They were press abstracts of Eastern European newspaper articles about flying saucers, which

264

00:19:01,120 --> 00:19:03,200

the Russians had the day they were published.

265

00:19:03,200 --> 00:19:06,040

Their own 14 documents, they withheld.

266
