There's no doubt that our surroundings can have an impact on how we feel.

155

There's an ancient belief that a simple thing as the placement of your furniture can increase your energy.

It's called Feng Shui, the Chinese art of placement.

157

In ancient China, emperors and people with power controlled the Feng Shui masters.

158

00:14:40,160 --> 00:14:45,160

The Feng Shui art was considered so valuable and so important for the success of the emperor

159

00:14:45,160 --> 00:14:51,160

that all of the Feng Shui masters were kept in the Forbidden Cities, or areas controlled by men of power.

160

Both major branches of Feng Shui, traditional and transcendental, are based on the Yi Qing, or the Book of Changes.

161

In the Transcendental or Black Hat Sect of Tibetan Tandra Buddhism,

162

cures for problems with Qi, call for objects like the Bagua, Crystal Ball or Mira to enhance the circulation of Qi.

David Twicken, a specialist in both traditional and transcendental Feng Shui, came to analyze our offices.

When we evaluate Feng Shui, one of the most important areas in a building is the entryway, the front door entry to a building.

We say that's the mouse of Qi, that the universe will bring the Qi into the business or person's home life through the front door.

So we want everything in the way, direct pathway of the front door to be open and allow the Qi to flow smoothly.

167

So if we look at this situation here, we see the front door to the building, but we see a building right opposite, within probably 50 feet.

168

This is creating a blockage from the energy on the other side and around us to be able to come in and nourish this building properly.

The way we would correct it, one way would be to put a crystal ball up here, and if we hang the crystal ball and we do what is called the mudra in the mantra,

to call upon the universe to come and to bring energy and move energy through this building properly so it can be circulated and nourished people would be the proper correction.

171

Or you could put a mirror, which is curved inward, to attract the universal energy to come in here properly and be nourished.

One key aspect to analyzing Feng Shui is the environment.

So we would look at the buildings and trees and everything around the building we live in or the office we live in.

So if we look at this building here, this big building, and it's sort of much taller than our building, and it kind of like puts down a pressure on our building,

and it blocks the Qi flow from the whole environment from nourishing and nurturing our building properly.

But how important is the solar system or the alignment of the planets?

177

The solar system and the alignment of the planets is a very, very important aspect of Feng Shui.

178

It's an area that very, very few teachers know about, very few people know about, even in China.

179

And it's the deepest portion of Feng Shui.

180

It's sort of like getting to the DNA, the genetic makeup of the energy or magnetic field in Feng Shui system.

181

And the way we do that is we utilize an ancient geomancy compass called the Lopan.

182

And once we determine the inner structure of a building, we align this Lohan up in a certain configuration to tell us the energy field configuration.

183

So the combination of the alignment of the planets and the solar system at the time the building was constructed with the Lohan reading determines the magnetic field,

184

00:18:05,160 --> 00:18:11,160

the deepest and probably the most important aspect of Feng Shui, traditional Feng Shui.

After the exterior analysis, we went inside the offices to see how everyone was doing.

186

Then once you make it through the outside of the building and the front door, how important is the interior design?

187

The interior design and the structure and the layout is vital in the health and the success of the workers in an office environment.

188

Some general rules are, number one, never have your back to the front door or the entryway.

189

So we can see here, if somebody is sitting here, their back is to the front door.

190

So every time somebody walks by or someone comes in, they have to turn around.

191

So the whole central nervous system is out of whack. They don't know what's going on. They're constantly hearing things.

192

So they'll be very irritable, very on the edge, not knowing what's going on.

193

00:19:06,160 --> 00:19:15,160

But most importantly, neither of these desks are in what we call structured to be in a power position in the room, in the office.

194

Because most of what's going on, they're not aware, but if they were to flip this desk around and the person was sitting something like this with the desk out here,

195

00:19:25,160 --> 00:19:30,160

then they see everything that's going on and they're in a position of power and they know what's going on.

196

00:19:30,160 --> 00:19:38,160

It's very, very important for their psyche, for their emotions, for their whole psychology. It changes all the way you are.

197

One of the basic rules in Feng Shui is never to be in a direct line of an open door, especially at the end of a hallway, because the momentum builds.

198

00:19:48,160 --> 00:19:54,160

So as we see this gentleman in his desk is in the direct pathway, and we call it a dagger or a shah.

199

00:19:54,160 --> 00:19:59,160

We say it's a shah, a negative energy is going to bombard this gentleman.

200

00:19:59,160 --> 00:20:07,160

And things like irritability, anxiousness, edginess, his whole central nervous system will be out of balance and out of whack.

201

After Howard's evaluation, I was a little nervous about my office. We checked it out though. Everything was okay.

202

The Universal Life Force is the energy within every person, animal and thing throughout the universe.

The existence of this energy has been a part of human culture since ancient times.

204

It is known to the Hindus as Prana, to the Polynesians as Manna, and the Chinese call it Qi.

The Chinese concept includes the idea of Yin and Yang, light and dark, active and passive.

Balancing the Yin and Yang is important for good health.
