And crucially, they're quick to pick up new tricks.

But the question is, are our canine companions learning days behind them when they reach

What's that you say?

Excellent question.

I think it's pretty straightforward.

I think we bring in a couple of dogs and we see if we can teach them some tricks.

Well, they got to be old dogs because after all, that's what this is about.

57

Maybe we can each take one and we'll train them separately.

58

They should be also as close in age as possible.

59

I mean, preferably they're from the same litter, couple of brothers, brother and sister,

something like that.

And we can do some kind of like a dog show.

62

What do you think?

A Mythbusters dog show at the end.

That's perfect.

And just as perfect are these beautiful old dogs, Bobo and Cece.

They're headstrong.

So, you know, if we can train these old dogs, this being the worst-case scenario,

we should be able to train any old dogs.

Mush!

Adam and Jamie have just one week to get these homeless furballs pulling in the right direction.

75

So they're going to need some expert help.

Adam and Cece have enlisted dog trainer Beverly Ulbrich.

77

So what we've got is somewhat of a contest between Jamie and I.

And what I need your help with is to get Cece here to learn how to heal, sit, stay, down,

79

and shake hands all in the next week.

80

Can we do that?

81

I sure hope so.

82

Let's give it a shot.

83

Bling, bling, bling here.

84

With her shiny new training collar, Cece is ready for lesson number one, healing.

85

So the idea with the walk is you want the dog paying attention to you, not everything else around you.

86

If you think about, like, how a pack travels, there's one pack leader,

87

00:04:14,680 --> 00:04:17,680

and the rest of the dogs are behind it just following naturally and easily.

88

00:04:17,680 --> 00:04:20,680

And obviously right now she's trying to be that pack leader.

89

00:04:20,680 --> 00:04:24,680

Beverly's theory about dog training is to let them know you're the pack leader.

90

00:04:24,680 --> 00:04:31,680

So it's all about conditioning the dog both positively and negatively in ways that the pack leader would do.

91

00:04:31,680 --> 00:04:34,680

You give them affection when they do right, you give them a scruff on the neck,

92

00:04:34,680 --> 00:04:36,680

just like the pack leader would do when they do wrong.

93

00:04:36,680 --> 00:04:41,680

And as long as you repeatedly do that, and you do that exactly when they're doing stuff right,

94

00:04:41,680 --> 00:04:45,680

and exactly when they're doing stuff wrong, they become much more manageable,

95

00:04:45,680 --> 00:04:47,680

because they all want to be part of a team.

96

That's the theory.

97

And for all dog Cece, it seems to be working.

98

Already she's surprisingly well healed, which begs the question,

99

How old is old when it comes to dogs?

100

Well, how old is old when it comes to people?

101

It's pretty subjective.

102

However, the best estimates that the vet has is that Bobo and Cece were born about seven years ago,

103

which in human terms for their size makes them approximately 50 years old.

That didn't be about in the butters on for our test.

105

Indeed.

Outside and school starting for old dogs Jamie and Bobo.

107

And headteach Jean Donaldson from the SPCA confirms we're starting from scratch.

Bobo, can you sit?

109

He probably has never been taught.

He's looking at it, he may as well be saying it in Swahili as no clue.

Undaunted, Jamie and Jean get classes started.

112

And at this dog school, the curriculum is slightly different.

113

Jean's technique is influenced by Pavlov, Skinner, even Darwin.

114

We could talk about it in terms of operant conditioning and other things,

115

but it boils down to that if the dog's behavior is good, you reward it.

116

If it's bad, you ignore it.

117

00:06:04,680 --> 00:06:10,680

So I've got leverage in my hand, and at the moment, he's not going to give me a full down,

118

00:06:10,680 --> 00:06:12,680

but I've got to pay some things.

119

It's called shaping by successive approximations.

120

I'm waiting for that right front leg as soon as he crosses it, I'm going to pay him.

Waiting for the leg, there's the leg.

122

With Bobo getting down and Cece also responding well to the first day's lessons,

123

doesn't that mean this myth is already busted?

124

I think the myth is looking pretty bad at this point.

125

The real test will come, I think, with the handshake.

126

I think all the other stuff, heal, sit, stay, those are your pack commands.

127

You know, just getting the dog to understand your words for what it naturally wants to do.

128

But shaking hands, that doesn't happen in the wild.

129

I think that's really going to be where the rubber meets the road

130

00:06:55,680 --> 00:06:58,680

and whether or not these dogs can learn a real trick.

Our next myth could get you ripped limb from limb.

132

Cool! What is it?

We're going to the dogs!

It's time to test mythical ways to get past the guard dog.

When it comes to breaking and entering, the mythbusters are unsurprisingly experts.

Their criminal record includes safe cracking, climbing air ducts, and beating laser beam alarms.

Alright, let's get out of here before the cops come.

But today they're filling the gap in their criminal CV by testing mythical methods to bypass a guard dog.

I think the first step is obvious. We need to get ourselves a dog.

145

And I don't want to use just vicious pets.

I want to go find a guard dog training school and get a real guard dog.

147

This is going to be fun.

148

Oh yeah, as long as you don't get bitten.

149

Yeah.

150

00:08:09,680 --> 00:08:13,680

The researchers have found just the place to get this myth off the ground.

151

Whitmer Tyson Kennels, where police and guard dogs go to school.

152

00:08:18,680 --> 00:08:22,680

And in case you're wondering who let the dog out, Mike the Handler did.

153

This is Ewan. He's a five-year-old German Shepherd.

154

00:08:26,680 --> 00:08:29,680

And what we can do is we can give you a demonstration on how he stops people.

155

00:08:29,680 --> 00:08:32,680

One of our main trainers here is Jim.

156

00:08:32,680 --> 00:08:35,680

He's going to play the bad guy and he's going to try and escape.

157

00:08:35,680 --> 00:08:37,680

Cool!

158

00:08:38,680 --> 00:08:44,680

Jim manages just a few cases before Ewan is on him in a flash of fur and teeth.

159

00:08:44,680 --> 00:08:50,680

And it's only that specially designed protective suit that prevents him from being the dog's dinner.

160

So, who's going to be deserved?

161

00:08:58,680 --> 00:08:59,680

Anybody want to try it?

162

Yeah, Tory volunteers.

163

Grant works on the principle that although there's no I in team, there is a me.

164

Dang! This is getting scary.

165

And Tory is once again in the firing line.

166

Oh! Good boy! Good boy!

167

Whoa! This dog's got some bite!

168

Oh yeah, I can feel the pressure on my arm.

169

00:09:28,680 --> 00:09:30,680

Oh!

170

00:09:30,680 --> 00:09:33,680

Yeah, you got the big suit on, it's going to protect you.

171

00:09:33,680 --> 00:09:39,680

But man, you see that dog barreling down on you with his teeth exposed and it's growling and then it takes a bite on you.

172

It's pretty scary.

173

00:09:40,680 --> 00:09:46,680

And then there's a couple of points where he got his teeth around my arm and I could feel the pressure bite down on my arm.

174

It wasn't the teeth that weren't piercing into my skin or anything, but you could definitely feel the pressure.

175

So that's Ewan the guard dog.

176

Fast, focused and furious.

177

And the team now know what the myth is up against.

178

Oh, that pinched the skin!

179

00:10:01,680 --> 00:10:05,680

Looks like we got ourselves a good guard dog, Ewan. He's vicious.

180

00:10:05,680 --> 00:10:09,680

Yeah, that dog was biting with over 550 pounds of pressure.

181

00:10:09,680 --> 00:10:11,680

Yeah, I wouldn't want that biting on my leg.

182

00:10:11,680 --> 00:10:14,680

So what kind of mythical techniques do we have to get past him?

183

00:10:14,680 --> 00:10:16,680

We have distracting them with a big juicy steak.

184

00:10:16,680 --> 00:10:20,680

We have acting aggressive, acting submissive.

185

00:10:20,680 --> 00:10:22,680

We also have wolf urine.

186

00:10:22,680 --> 00:10:25,680

We have scent of a lactating bitch.

187

00:10:25,680 --> 00:10:26,680

What?

188

00:10:26,680 --> 00:10:28,680

It's supposed to calm them down.

189

00:10:28,680 --> 00:10:33,680

We also have urine from a bitch in heat, which is obviously supposed to distract them.

190

00:10:33,680 --> 00:10:35,680

Well, he is a male dog.

191

00:10:35,680 --> 00:10:40,680

Well, we can't forget the enclosure that we're supposed to build to do our experiments.

192

00:10:40,680 --> 00:10:41,680

Well, let's keep that simple.

193

00:10:41,680 --> 00:10:43,680

We'll close off an area with the chain link fence.

194

00:10:43,680 --> 00:10:51,680

We'll put a safe in the middle, put treasure in it, and then we'll try our different techniques to

see if we can get to the safe, get the treasure, and get out safely.

195

Coming right up, it's the moment of truth for our old dogs.

196

00:10:54,680 --> 00:10:55,680

Sit.

197

00:10:55,680 --> 00:10:56,680

Good girl.

198

00:10:56,680 --> 00:11:00,680

And then Adam turns Convict to beat the bloodhound.

199

00:11:00,680 --> 00:11:02,680

It's a dog eat Convict world out there.

200

00:11:12,680 --> 00:11:18,680

Carrie, Grant and Tori are attempting to beat E1, the well-trained guard dog.

201

00:11:18,680 --> 00:11:28,680

They're going to test several techniques to sneak past the four-legged guardian, get into the safe in the center of the compound, and then escape safely with the loot.

202

00:11:28,680 --> 00:11:32,680

The first tactic I'm going to utilize is diversion.

203

00:11:32,680 --> 00:11:33,680

I've got some stakes.

204

00:11:33,680 --> 00:11:37,680

I'm going to chuck it in one set of the yard, and then I'm going to try to make a run for it.

205

00:11:37,680 --> 00:11:41,680

I see, and that's supposed to draw the dog's attention away from you.

206

00:11:41,680 --> 00:11:43,680

It always works in the cartoons.

207

00:11:43,680 --> 00:11:44,680

Good luck with that.

208

00:11:45,680 --> 00:11:50,680

Carrie gets into the dog-proof safety suit and then gives it a test run.

209

00:11:55,680 --> 00:12:01,680

With Carrie about as mobile as a dog's chew toy, she adapts her heist plan.

210

00:12:01,680 --> 00:12:03,680

I'm not going to be able to throw anything with this.

211

00:12:03,680 --> 00:12:05,680

I'm going to get one of the boys to go over the corner and throw it.

212

00:12:05,680 --> 00:12:06,680

That's not cheating.

213

00:12:06,680 --> 00:12:08,680

Everybody's got a partner in crime.

214

00:12:09,680 --> 00:12:14,680

Tori gets the plan underway by interesting E1 in his meaty treat.

215

00:12:14,680 --> 00:12:16,680

Oh, look, he likes.

216

00:12:16,680 --> 00:12:17,680

Oh, you're looking at him.

217

00:12:17,680 --> 00:12:18,680

He likes, oh, you like these.

218

00:12:18,680 --> 00:12:20,680

You like the meat.

219

00:12:21,680 --> 00:12:23,680

I think you guys should probably go for it now, no?

220

00:12:27,680 --> 00:12:33,680

Tori's tasty T-bone taunting has bought Carrie enough time to get to the safe.

221

00:12:38,680 --> 00:12:44,680

But then Carrie's accomplice turns nasty as Tori throws the steak into the compound.

222

00:12:44,680 --> 00:12:46,680

Not at me! Not at me!

223

00:12:46,680 --> 00:12:52,680

It's a poor throw, but E1 stays focused on the meat and starts to chow down as Carrie

224

00:12:52,680 --> 00:12:56,680

heads for an unofficial exit on the far side of the compound.

225

00:12:56,680 --> 00:12:57,680

But it's locked.

226

00:12:57,680 --> 00:12:59,680

Hurry, he's eating the meat.

227

00:12:59,680 --> 00:13:04,680

Meanwhile, E1 has finished the first course and goes back to Tori for more.

228

00:13:04,680 --> 00:13:09,680

But when Tori doesn't have another steak ready, E1 goes to work.

229

00:13:22,680 --> 00:13:23,680

Well, kinda.

230

00:13:23,680 --> 00:13:29,680

The delicious diversion did distract E1 long enough to get to the safe and secure the loot.

231

00:13:29,680 --> 00:13:33,680

But poor planning meant that Carrie ended up as the main course.

232

00:13:33,680 --> 00:13:35,680

But the necklace is somewhere inside the suit.

233

00:13:35,680 --> 00:13:38,680

I swear it's in here. I grabbed it.

234

00:13:38,680 --> 00:13:42,680

So it's plausible to distract a guard dog with tasty treats.

235

But without that suit, Carrie would have been breakfast.

236

Well done.

237

00:13:47,680 --> 00:13:54,680

Next up, Grant and Tori are tackling two myths which an animal behaviorist and fan of the show suggested.

238

And they're both based on the concept that by using body language, you can persuade the dog to leave you alone.

239

00:14:04,680 --> 00:14:12,680

First into the ring is Grant, and the theory is E1 will take Grant's submissive posture as proof he's not a threat.

240

00:14:12,680 --> 00:14:15,680

Oh my god, this is not working, this is not working, this is not working!

241

00:14:15,680 --> 00:14:18,680

I don't think it's working.

242

00:14:18,680 --> 00:14:20,680

But it doesn't work.

243

00:14:20,680 --> 00:14:25,680

Next, Tori attempts to take Alpha Dog status by getting aggressive.

244

00:14:27,680 --> 00:14:32,680

But his top dog impression simply results in him being the dog's lunch.

245

00:14:32,680 --> 00:14:38,680

With the score Mythbusters 1, Guard Dog 2, it's back to Adam and Jamie.

246

00:14:41,680 --> 00:14:44,680

So how old is the phrase you can't teach an old dog new tricks?

247

00:14:44,680 --> 00:14:53,680

Well, it's pretty old. It originated from some guy named Fitz Herbert who wrote a paper on animal husbandry in 1523.

248

That's it?

249

00:14:54,680 --> 00:14:55,680

Yeah.

250

00:14:55,680 --> 00:15:05,680

Alright, the dogger must learn it when he is a well-be, or else it will not be, for it is hard to make an old dog to stoop.

251

00:15:05,680 --> 00:15:08,680

Like I said, you can't teach an old dog new tricks.

252

00:15:09,680 --> 00:15:14,680

It's an age-old adage and the Mythbusters can't resist putting it to the test.

253

On day one, the training went so well, the myth looked busted.

254

Sit.

255

00:15:19,680 --> 00:15:21,680

Good girl.

256

00:15:21,680 --> 00:15:26,680

But in today's session, without pack leaders Beverly and Jean to show them who's boss,

257

00:15:26,680 --> 00:15:28,680

Cici, sit.

258

00:15:30,680 --> 00:15:34,680

Well, the dog's personalities are proving obstructive.

259

00:15:34,680 --> 00:15:36,680

We're a little too excited this morning.

260

00:15:37,680 --> 00:15:38,680

Bubbles of brat.

261

00:15:38,680 --> 00:15:40,680

First of all, I don't think he's as smart as Cici.

262

00:15:40,680 --> 00:15:41,680

I can see it in his eyes.

263

00:15:41,680 --> 00:15:47,680

And Carrie ups the stakes with a urine soaked rag and a little trail of scent along the fence line.

472

Tari tippy toes inside and incredibly the plan appears to be working.

473

Ewan oblivious to the intruder is simply thinking hot lady dog thoughts.

474

Look at the drool coming off of that dog. Those chops are soaked.

475

I can't believe it.

476

00:28:06,680 --> 00:28:08,680

We just did bitch in heat and it worked.

477

The dog was totally distracted. He had his face down in the urine the whole time.

478

Every once in a while he would look up, check me out, see what I was doing, but then he would go back to the urine.

479

I just slowly walked over to the safe, got the jewels and slowly walked out.

480

I mean, he didn't even act like he was going to try to attack me.

481

497

Water's no guarantee that the scent's going to go away.

As long as the water is slow moving or still, it has the potential to retain the trail better than dry land.
