version had been released which was about nine\h
pages which really didn't say very much at all\h\h

but what john greenwald did with great
effect was obtain a slightly longer report

which was the uh redacted uh as released
classified version of the uap report and

huge amount but interesting nonetheless you know

for me is i'm looking over this thing saying

it went to the senators and the congress people

enhanced version why was it open to a foia release

stuff is behind black boxes so look one of the

80

the debate this week is is uh what's behind the

81

redactions and one of the most interesting things
was that there was a section in the report that

82

described the shapes of the uaps that have been
seen mainly by navy pilots and commercial pilots

83

and that was redacted that was classified which
kind of begged the question why would you have to

84

classify something that was merely describing
the shapes of the objects that have been seen

85

there's a couple of takeaways from the report that
i thought were significant that if you interpret

86

the report clearly it means that about 80 out
of 144 cases that were included in the report

87

were corroborated by several systems at once which
is very significant they were corroborated either

88

by radar visual by pilots or visual by either
ultraviolet or infrared sensors or perhaps also by

89

satellites and that's very significant because it
explains why it's being taken so seriously there's

90

multiple corroboration of what these pilots were
seeing it wasn't just their eyeballs it wasn't

91

just their gun cameras it was other data sources
that corroborated and underlined what these people

92

were seeing um i i think that's really important
but the it was very frustrating because in the

93

end a lot of the debate about the significance
of the report descended into an argument about

94

whether or not it was 17 pages or the 70 pages
that have been suggested by some people including

95

lou elizondo and frankly to me it's a kind of a
silly argument i'm not really fussed about that

96

the fact is uh they've been able to get this
report released and information's been provided

and as we know from last year i don't disagree

do we know factually whether it was 17 pages or 70

offered to me is that the uh report the classified\h
report that went to congress had appendices that\h\h

weren't included in the redacted version that\h
was provided to john greenwald frankly we just\h\h

don't know but what disturbs me and this takes\h
us on to another issue that i think we should\h\h

address this week what disturbs me is that it's\h
been used yet again to attack the credibility of\h\h

uh people like louis lozando who who\h
did suggest that the report was long\h\h

in ufology that essentially it's the duty of\h\h

who ran the program that the government set up for

resigns and now he's sort of it's almost like

now he's out there telling the truth as he knows

it but he's being somewhat coy by saying he's got
an nda but at the same time he's laying out more

provocative things and i think the question has
come up over and over is like will the real lou

quite sure what they should make of him now

of the biggest secrets inside the us government

air base raft bent waters in the united kingdom

which allegedly was nuclear-armed it was one
of the main nuclear bases in the united kingdom

and in december 1980 when airman john burrows and
his colleague sergeant jim peniston went into the

rendelsham forest to investigate an object which
was seen descending into the forest burroughs

said he only saw strange flashing red green and blue lights and a clearing that threw off the

image of something that looked like a craft but he never saw anything metallic or hard peniston

has described in great detail actually physically touching a craft which he had almost said almost

254

but the takeaway from that case that has often been overlooked is that john burroughs suffered

256

the intervention of the good senator john mccain airman first class john burroughs was acknowledged

this incident i think that's very significant

strongly suspect cash landrum was some kind of u.s

of 29th december 1980 which as you say is very

very close to the ref bentwaters case across on\h
the united kingdom betty cash vicki landrum and\h\h

colby landrum who were seven years old at the time\h
were driving home to their home in dayton texas\h\h

and all of a sudden they came across a huge\h
diamond-shaped object hovering over the road\h\h

and it appeared to be in trouble it was\h
emitting flame and emitting significant heat\h\h

so much heat that allegedly somebody's\h
hand on the dashboard actually sank into\h\h

the vinyl on the dashboard and\h

very serious radiation injuries that were measured\h
and assessed as real by doctors and because they\h\h

of helicopters pursuing this object that appeared\h
to be united states military helicopters they sued\h\h

they lost the case because they couldn't prove\h\h

that the the object that was seen was in fact
a u.s government object even though they were

burns that essentially have got infected and

quite harrowing it's i've seen those photos

317

uh they are troubling they're disturbing and yes
we will put them up on the uh the video version

of this because damien has told us it's okay to do
that he's he's interested in in seeking the truth

of an iceberg of people who are people involved in proximity to uaps who have suffered injuries

as a result of exposure to those uaps professor nolan who's an extremely reputable scientist

based at stanford university has described anomalous mris he's actually described how

331

very similar to somebody with multiple sclerosis\h\h

it looks like white matter disease this scarring\h
and this apparently is what damian's been told\h\h

he's got on mris that he's sent to doctors at\h

if you actually read what gary nolan said to vice\h

who've been exposed to these objects actually have\h

of their exposure to these uaps he's not saying\h

what that means but basically when you have brain\h

as they explained to their pilots uh there was a
