

possibility of extra terrestriality and i think

the 17th of may the first congressional hearing

airborne clutter natural atmospheric phenomena

surprise and potential scientific discovery

the possibility that what we're talking about here

call it a catch-all other ben which I just found  
to be one of the greatest lines in UFO history

and so krishnamurthy to his credit asks how about\h\h

wreckage have we come across any wreckage of any\h

and scott bray from the navy says\h  
the uap task force doesn't have any\h\h

wreckage that isn't explainable that isn't\h  
consistent with being of terrestrial origin\h\h

so it does seem like the representative kind of missed an opportunity to say well thank you very

much for that answer but let me go a little bit further on this that and that was my issue my

allied or partner systems and other natural\h

concession that overtly states okay we're looking\h

now that to me is why i think this is a walk back\h  
because avril haynes stipulated that one possible\h\h

plausible explanation that required examination\h  
was the ridiculously stated extraterrestriality\h\h

she was referring to extraterrestrial life you\h  
know i'll give you a more plain spoken word that\h\h

they did seem to be using to to walk things back\h  
and it wasn't extraterrestriality or anything\h\h

else unpronounceable it was drone all right\h  
what i found that they did over and over and\h\h

i believe you feel the same way if they tried\h  
to make it sound like well you know this really\h\h

could just be drones well i don't think drones\h  
work quite the same way that a lot of these\h\h

sighting reports lay it out but i know that's\h

and scott bray another top intelligence official\h  
they both started using the word drone didn't\h\h

they rise to describe the phenomena that are now\h  
being seen in the sky well and it feels a little\h\h

dishonest doesn't it because i mean i don't think\h  
anybody uh in this business i'm certainly not\h\h

you're not drones are a big deal i mean there\h  
are drones out there there's lots of drones\h\h

um do we fly our own drones uh harassing our own\h  
ships hundreds of miles at sea probably not so\h\h

well where this came in where this came\h  
in was when the chairman of the committee\h\h

mr schiff he basically put the hypothesis  
to mr bray that these are commercial drones

162

and it was because mr bray had shown a video of  
a very underwhelming blurry object zooming past

163

a jet cockpit and then there was another video  
of a pyramid triangular pyramid-shaped object

that was shot on night vision above a navy ship an  
unnamed navy ship and these two videos were shown

165

to the committee and frankly i don't know about  
you bryce but i got the distinct impression that

these were designed to completely underwhelm  
anybody who viewed them because they were

167

i suggest possibly the least interesting videos  
one could possibly choose from the cupboard

168

that i have no doubt the defense department  
have full of interesting uap videos well we that

169

was the essence of uh our conversation with lou  
elizondo on our last episode where it it's clear

170

he has seen things that vastly exceed what uh was  
being shown to the committee and and many other

171

people claim the same christopher mellon and so\h  
many others have obviously seen incredible things\h\h

172

so you know had either of those two witnesses uh\h  
been free and clear to bring in the best stuff\h\h

they they would have done it and they would have\h  
blown some minds so you do have to wonder what\h\h

their motivation was for sure right so scott bray\h  
who's the deputy director of naval intelligence\h\h

he presented this video the night vision of a\h

unnamed u.s navy vessel he then asserted they were\h

were unmanned aerial systems in the area and\h  
essentially he told mr schiff the chairman\h\h

some type of drone some type of unmanned aerial\h  
system and he suggested essentially that what they\h\h

were looking at was essentially a bouquet effect\h  
that the night vision goggles had distorted the\h\h

180

slr camera lens to create a pyramid triangular\h  
shape now the bokeh effect may indeed be a\h\h

plausible explanation for that particular imagery\h  
but i just think at this point in the hearing\h\h

the public we're being led astray because\h

explained before the committee there and\h\h

failing to do their job because essentially\h\h

claim as you've already flagged\h\h
