myself I think that there is and I asked him isn't that potentially dangerous though for

so that's not bad um and the question was

of non-human intelligence leading to disclosure

of Crash wreckage intact craft and reverse  
engineering efforts and we gave people four

125

options one was leaked documents one was a  
mass siding the other was whistleblower testimony

126

and the final one was some kind of high-res  
video image and here's how it came down Mass

127

siding walked away with it 43 followed by  
those high-res video images which got 23 percent

128

whistleblower testimony 21 and literally at  
the bottom of the barrel with 13 was leaked

129

documents so I guess people don't have a lot  
of confidence in that and yet I'd have to

130

say I have probably less confidence in the  
video and photo parts since you can fake anything

131

these days what's your take I would say seeing  
is believing personally I think that if you're

132

seeing it and you're having and this could

133

be potentially everywhere around the world  
too right it could be in multiple cities so

134

a mass sighting Lake documents can always

135

be forged misinformation campaigns and disinformation  
campaigns are always happening within the

American government so something could technically  
be leaked to be disinformation against China

137

and Russia let's say but it ends up getting  
leaked into our system and then we end up

138

taking it as fact when it real and becomes  
misinformation and fake news when it legitly

139

was done for a disinformation campaign to  
another country and ends affecting people

140

so that's why leak documents not so much for  
myself um and then looking at I think like

141

high-res photos not so much but I think people seeing it seeing it believing and having multiple

142

cities a one major city and people having their own footage and it going viral on social

143

00:12:41,440 --> 00:12:46,970

media that's that's where I would go you know hard as it is to believe I mean it just blows

144

00:12:46,970 --> 00:12:53,570

my mind but the Phoenix Lights Mass sighting was over 25 years ago I think it's 26 years

145

now so I think a lot about that because people go well if it was such a big important Mass

146

siding Why didn't it change everything I guess my question is in the 25 years since the Phoenix

147

sighting we've certainly changed how we look at this we have people investigating it we

148

have all the social media Etc if there was a mass siding of the style of what happened

149

in Phoenix back in 97 do you think it would be treated differently today and if so do

150

00:13:22,230 --> 00:13:30,000

you think that different treatment would lead to a a greater acceptance that these are possibly

151

00:13:30,000 --> 00:13:36,350

non-human intelligence a hundred percent it  
would be so different because of social media

152

we have we have a place where like we look  
at Tick Tock we have apps where we can zoom

153

00:13:40,850 --> 00:13:46,680

in exactly in the point in time in moment  
that things are happening so like I can go

154

00:13:46,680 --> 00:13:51,060

to Iran and I can look at what's going on  
I can go to Afghanistan and I can look at

155

00:13:51,060 --> 00:13:55,399

people's posts because it's open to the public  
so I can look at their photos so I can look

156

00:13:55,399 --> 00:14:00,510

at their videos so a hundred percent yes it  
would change the way we look at a mass sighting

157

like the Phoenix Lights would be documented  
in different ways we look at those the women

158

00:14:04,699 --> 00:14:09,880

and I believe it was a daughter and a mom  
that had the closest sighting when they drove

159

underneath it and they could explain what  
it looked like I believe they even talked

160

00:14:13,570 --> 00:14:19,510

about like the metal like color it looked  
like and shape and like legitly drove under

161

00:14:19,510 --> 00:14:24,410

the thing so you can imagine if you had a  
Snapchat or if you had any form of a real

162

00:14:24,410 --> 00:14:29,860

or going live that you'd be able to get hundreds  
of thousands potentially millions of people

163

on that live feed so yeah I think it would  
change everything and news media would pick

164

it up instantly as well but I think we just  
have challenges though that we haven't we

165

in again I bring into this I keep talking

166

people can obviously manipulate things and

167

it would have to take a large amount of people

168

in a mass sighting for people to really yeah  
jump jump on and be like okay this is actually

169

happening and sharing it with each other but  
it's very different from 97 in the Phoenix

170

Lights yeah absolutely well you know um Chrissy  
one of the things that we we do here on need

171

in the news on this UFO UAP reality issue

for the U.S government and he said at a 80

salt eye connections conference and the title

177

intelligence and crashed UFOs and in any case

uh paraphrasing uh Dr Nolan he said that not  
only did he think extraterrestrials had visited

uh the moderator uh at what percent you know  
uh how would he how confident he was of that

Twitter and frankly the entire world going

it's just recent that he's been saying that

190

bunch of people it's very bold move to do

191

I don't think it's when you say a hundred percent yeah and it's like a definite then

192

it's like what do you know then and why aren't you telling us more well when I hear somebody

193

say a hundred percent don't you kind of go to okay if you're talking about the UFO issue

and you're at I am not at 100 because they I've not seen a UFO up close and personal

a hard cut is where it happens overnight and

within that or questions or things that are
