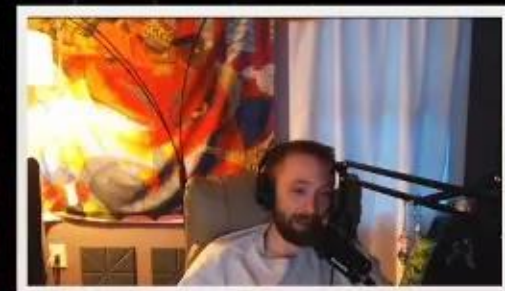
This pandemic has brought on a lot of shortages that I've been able to live with.
