But we're down quite a bit now.

9

And where was the first one found?

10

It was right just east of that, east of where I came out of that house there, just in that

11

00:02:11,880 --> 00:02:14,040

patch right there.

12

00:02:14,040 --> 00:02:17,720

And that was the very first one that I noticed.

13

I really looked at it good because it was right close to the house.

14

And that's when it had, well, the eyes were missing, laser cuts on the body.

15

How long was it until the second one was found?

16

I've been having them for every year.

17

Every year?

18

00:02:37,320 --> 00:02:38,320

Yeah.

How long you guys been out here?

20

They just started in 1996.

21

So far I've had 16 of them that I've counted, cows and calves that were mutilated.

22

And pretty much one a year for the most part.

23

Yeah, pretty more or less.

24

And sometimes it'd go a little longer.

But then we had another one out here in this pasture out here.

26

And it was just out in the prairie.

27

And there was brush around there and everything.

28

And its ribs were broke.

29

It didn't just fall over and die because its ribs wouldn't have been broke.

And so it had to be dropped for quite a ways.

One time I had two of them, two cows at the same time.

Right next to each other, essentially?

Right next to each other.

And what happened, when I had those two and they were down there in that aroria down there,

one of them was completely mutilated and the other one was laying right beside it with

a back broke.

And it wasn't mutilated.

38

Somehow they were able to draw them up to their UFO or whatever.

And then they do what they do and then they drop them back down.

These two cows were right together.

And so when they started picking them up and then as they go up a little higher, it narrows

down and the one dropped off.

Colorado.

Visions of the Old West come to mind.

45

Ghost towns and pasture land alongside rugged mountains and endless skies.

Oh yeah.

47

And mines.

And so I was able to get to the rest of those in this state.

I'm Shannon Legreau and my search for stories has brought me to the Centennial State.

50

I've been curious about the cattle mutilation phenomenon and its connection to the UFO mystery

51

for a long time.

00:06:08,360 --> 00:06:14,320

And along with the small town monsters crew and documentarian Seth Breedlove, I've already

53

begun to uncover stories that connect strange lights in the sky to mutilated animals on

54

00:06:19,760 --> 00:06:20,760

here.

00:06:20,760 --> 00:06:26,920

To this valley in the heart of Colorado, which also happens to be positioned neatly as the

56

00:06:26,920 --> 00:06:33,600

heart of the animal mutilation subject, the place where it all began, the San Luis Valley.

57

So we just got here.

58

00:06:35,680 --> 00:06:36,680

Yeah.

59

00:06:36,680 --> 00:06:41,920

Like honestly, I'm pretty astounded at the varying topography of Colorado.

60

I've briefly at one point driven through part of it and it was very mountainous.

61

00:06:46,080 --> 00:06:54,280

I wasn't expecting all the open valleys and almost a high desert feel similar to Nevada.

62

So it reminds me a lot of Utah, which happens to house Skinwalker Ranch.

63

Right.

64

00:07:00,680 --> 00:07:05,440

And a lot of the ranches here also have a lot of the same activity, including cattle

65

00:07:05,440 --> 00:07:07,320

mutilations and horse mutilations.

66

00:07:07,320 --> 00:07:12,120

I guess what surprised me about the area is I've always been aware of the rich history

67

00:07:12,120 --> 00:07:15,720

of like UFO sightings and cattle mutilations.

68

00:07:15,720 --> 00:07:22,720

I didn't realize there's such a wide range of activity in the area and reported activity.

69

00:07:22,720 --> 00:07:28,400

And it really reminds me of places we've looked into like the Chestnut Ridge or Skinwalker

70

00:07:28,400 --> 00:07:30,120

Ranch, like you mentioned.

71

00:07:30,120 --> 00:07:38,160

I'm excited to see if we can make some connections between all these various phenomena and come

72

00:07:38,160 --> 00:07:43,840

up with something that correlates the high strangeness in the state.

73

00:07:43,840 --> 00:07:48,120

When you were mentioning on some of the readings that we were doing before we got here of people

74

00:07:48,120 --> 00:07:51,680

that think some of the mountains are actually hollow, hollowed out by the government for

75

00:07:51,680 --> 00:07:53,480

whatever reason.

76

00:07:53,480 --> 00:07:56,120

At one time, mining was what Colorado was known for.

77

00:07:56,120 --> 00:08:01,600

I think I looked online and did some research before we came and you're talking like 18,000

78

00:08:01,600 --> 00:08:03,880

mines around the state at one time.

79

00:08:03,880 --> 00:08:09,240

So that's an interesting correlation to what we looked into in West Virginia.

80

00:08:09,240 --> 00:08:13,080

And there is this activity too that seems to emanate from the Earth itself.

81

I'm curious to see how many of the people that we're going to interview think it's military

82

00:08:19,120 --> 00:08:21,320

related or truly off-planet.

83

00:08:21,320 --> 00:08:22,320

Desire.

84

00:08:22,320 --> 00:08:30,760

Like, yeah, like some kind of a true ET experience or things coming from another dimension or

85

00:08:30,760 --> 00:08:32,160

universe planet, whatever.

86

My name is Katie Goroski.

87

I am the state director for Colorado Mufon and I'm also the administrator for Mufon's

88

00:08:46,240 --> 00:08:47,240

Mars project.

89

00:08:47,240 --> 00:08:48,240

USA wide.

90

00:08:48,240 --> 00:08:52,000

How many UFO reports are there on file?

91

00:08:52,000 --> 00:08:59,080

Well Colorado averages about 12 a month, so 250 a year-ish.

92

00:08:59,080 --> 00:09:05,240

So populated states obviously have more reports than less populated states like for example

93

00:09:05,240 --> 00:09:08,360

Wyoming compared to California, big difference.

94

00:09:08,360 --> 00:09:13,160

So 10,000 reports, I mean, it just varies year to year.

95

Richard, thanks for being here.

96

First of all, how long have you been in Colorado and how long have you been looking into specifically

97

00:09:20,520 --> 00:09:21,520

the UFO?

98

00:09:21,520 --> 00:09:27,240

Well I've been in Colorado for 22 years, paranormal investigator for 25, 26.

99

00:09:27,720 --> 00:09:31,960

Investigating the UFO phenomenon since my publisher has asked me to write a book on it

100

00:09:31,960 --> 00:09:33,800

five years ago.

101

00:09:33,800 --> 00:09:38,320

Colorado is a state that is defined by its valleys, its mountains, its prairies and there

102

00:09:38,320 --> 00:09:45,360

are many instances of craft that have been seen or at least reported emerging from mountains,

103

00:09:45,360 --> 00:09:49,440

whether they're in some cave system, we don't know, some subterranean hiding place.

104

00:09:49,440 --> 00:09:52,200

Also rising from bodies of water such as lakes.

105

00:09:52,200 --> 00:09:55,360

Colorado also has a rich history of mining and indeed we have the School of Mines here

106

00:09:55,400 --> 00:10:00,200

which is very prestigious and is known for its geology, digging into the earth.

107

00:10:00,200 --> 00:10:04,840

So you personally, when you get a report into MUFON, into your office, how often do you

108

00:10:04,840 --> 00:10:09,000

actually physically are able to go out and go to location where the sighting happened

109

00:10:09,000 --> 00:10:10,000

from?

110

00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:14,360

Interestingly enough that happens less than you might believe it happens.

111

00:10:14,360 --> 00:10:19,600

A lot of the work MUFON does and our investigators do are on the computer.

112

00:10:19,600 --> 00:10:24,360

But if a case is good enough and it's active, actively happening, because most times you'll

113

00:10:24,360 --> 00:10:29,440

just see lights in the sky and by the time you get out there the phenomenon's gone.

114

00:10:29,440 --> 00:10:34,920

Now we will go on location if it's a repeated event or if they have evidence on the ground

115

00:10:34,920 --> 00:10:39,160

or if it was a more close encounter we'll go out there and try and do testing and interviews

116

00:10:39,160 --> 00:10:40,560

face to face.

117

00:10:40,560 --> 00:10:43,920

So the crafts that appear, they vary throughout.

118

00:10:43,920 --> 00:10:50,480

A lot of this is strange lights in the sky, the classic, you know, unidentified flying

119

00:10:50,480 --> 00:10:51,480

light.

120

00:10:51,480 --> 00:10:55,480

Of course we live in the age of the drone, but then there are these lights that plainly

121

00:10:55,480 --> 00:11:01,520

are not drones, that behave in ways which you could not control a drone so sensitively,

122

00:11:01,520 --> 00:11:05,920

that don't seem to obey the laws of physics as we understand them, that will stop dead

123

00:11:05,920 --> 00:11:12,160

and gain altitude extremely quickly or decelerate and then change course far more quickly than

124

00:11:12,160 --> 00:11:14,060

a piloted object could.

125

00:11:14,060 --> 00:11:19,180

Over 80% of my cases are what we call IFOs or identified flying objects, but then we

126

00:11:19,180 --> 00:11:25,420

have that 15 to 20% that we have no idea what they are and those go in as unknown so

127

00:11:25,420 --> 00:11:29,660

they can be unknown UAPs, unknown other.

128

00:11:29,660 --> 00:11:35,060

Generally speaking here in Colorado it's lights rather than craft as such and of course we've

129

00:11:35,060 --> 00:11:42,300

had a few cases in which genuine man-made objects were mistaken for UFOs.

130

00:11:42,300 --> 00:11:47,540

Do you get cattle mutilation reports at Moonfong?

131

00:11:47,540 --> 00:11:49,900

No, I wish we got more than we did.

132

00:11:49,900 --> 00:11:54,980

We will from time to time, but we don't get them as often and I really believe after the

133

00:11:54,980 --> 00:12:00,740

interviews I've done out in these small communities and with ranchers, this is a phenomenon that

134

00:12:00,740 --> 00:12:05,700

has been happening now for decades and a lot of these ranchers they don't want the publicity,

135

00:12:05,700 --> 00:12:10,060

the stigma and more importantly I think they know that nothing will come of it.

136

00:12:10,060 --> 00:12:14,900

Like we have been trying to get to the bottom of what's been happening, not only with cattle

137

00:12:14,900 --> 00:12:21,260

but horse, sheep, other animals, there's even been dogs.

138

00:12:21,260 --> 00:12:26,420

Right now when we look at the global understanding of the public perception of UFOs, it's become

139

00:12:26,420 --> 00:12:32,300

a part of the whole zeitgeist, hasn't it, this idea that cows, horses, sheep, cattle

140

00:12:32,300 --> 00:12:40,660

are kind of either taken up, moved, mutilated by some unseen force.

141

00:12:40,660 --> 00:12:46,300

One of the stranger things by far and this is a phenomenon that happened throughout the

142

00:12:46,300 --> 00:12:54,380

60s, 70s, 80s, 90s was very common amongst ranchers throughout the Midwest and still happens

143

00:12:54,380 --> 00:13:02,300

to this day with no credible explanation.

144

00:13:02,300 --> 00:13:07,100

And I just want to say I'm not the cattle mutilation expert, I mean that's really Christopher

145

00:13:07,100 --> 00:13:13,460

O'Brien, that's been their wheelhouse for decades.

146

00:13:13,460 --> 00:13:19,060

My name is Christopher O'Brien, I've been involved researching and investigating cattle

147

00:13:19,060 --> 00:13:28,460

mutilation phenomenon for almost 30 years.

148

00:13:28,460 --> 00:13:32,380

So are there historical texts that you can look at?

149

00:13:32,380 --> 00:13:33,380

Yeah.

150

00:13:33,380 --> 00:13:43,100

I found the first outbreak that's documented but I found in 1605 right after James I got

151

00:13:43,100 --> 00:13:51,540

in as king and in the court records there's a very interesting quote in there and it's

152

00:13:51,540 --> 00:14:00,980

Lately here about strange deaths, 101 cases, less than others, strange sheep were found

153

00:14:00,980 --> 00:14:08,820

missing parts, the tallow and wool left behind.

154

00:14:08,820 --> 00:14:16,100

So the first indication that we have of waves of mutilation is the earliest that I can find

155

00:14:16,100 --> 00:14:18,660

is 1605 in England.

156

00:14:18,660 --> 00:14:23,460

This became such a widespread thing, you have researchers like Linda Moulton-Howe whose

157

00:14:23,460 --> 00:14:28,460

project is Strange Harvest I believe it was looked at this in depth but this is something

158

00:14:28,460 --> 00:14:31,900

that's now been with us for decades.

159

00:14:31,900 --> 00:14:36,460

Ranchers still experience this to this day, usually in isolated places that are in the

160

00:14:36,460 --> 00:14:37,540

middle of nowhere.

161

00:14:37,540 --> 00:14:41,540

So it's not something you're going to see in downtown Denver but if you live way out

162

00:14:41,540 --> 00:15:08,140

in the middle of the boonies it's certainly a concern and it certainly happens.

163

00:15:08,140 --> 00:15:15,260

Colorado is a mysterious place especially once you travel out of the hub that is Denver.

164

00:15:15,260 --> 00:15:20,700

There exists a stark division between the cities and the wilderness here yet both boast

165

00:15:20,700 --> 00:15:25,020

their own unique history of unexplained occurrences.

166

00:15:25,020 --> 00:15:30,380

The pasture lands of the eastern section of the state give way to arid desert to the south

167

00:15:30,380 --> 00:15:33,380

and rugged mountains to the west.

168

00:15:33,380 --> 00:15:37,540

No single place looks the same as any other.

169

00:15:38,060 --> 00:15:43,700

In the backwoods, grassy prairies and rugged wilds encounters with lights in the sky are

170

00:15:43,700 --> 00:15:45,780

commonplace.

171

00:15:45,780 --> 00:15:50,380

Crafters seen as frequently as the planes that fly into and out of Denver International

172

00:15:50,380 --> 00:15:56,300

Airport and nearly everyone has their own story about a brush with the bazaar.

173

00:15:56,300 --> 00:16:01,700

Colorado is home to numerous military bases and this fact has helped propel the strange

174

00:16:01,700 --> 00:16:02,700

sightings.

175

00:16:03,500 --> 00:16:08,660

To be certain, a fair number of the objects or lights seen overhead here probably have

176

00:16:08,660 --> 00:16:15,060

mundane explanations but that hasn't stopped stories from spreading of military installations

177

00:16:15,060 --> 00:16:19,540

which possess a far darker modus operandi.

178

00:16:19,540 --> 00:16:25,340

Out here everyone encounters something, even law enforcement.

179

00:16:25,340 --> 00:16:27,300

So I spent eight years in the United States Army.

180

00:16:27,340 --> 00:16:32,660

I served in Afghanistan almost a decade ago and then after that I went into law enforcement

181

00:16:32,660 --> 00:16:33,940

here in the Denver metro area.

182

00:16:33,940 --> 00:16:39,020

So I've worked for two different agencies, one up in the northern part of the metro area

183

00:16:39,020 --> 00:16:42,460

that was sort of along the foothills and then I worked for another agency that was south

184

00:16:42,460 --> 00:16:47,660

of Denver and that sort of boarded the prairie, the plains, east of the I-25 corridor.

185

00:16:47,660 --> 00:16:51,860

So during that time I was a field training officer, I trained new officers straight out

186

00:16:51,860 --> 00:16:56,780

of the academy and I was also a trained FBI certified crime scene investigator.

187

00:16:58,300 --> 00:17:03,020

Colorado is a, it's very saturated as you guys have seen with military, with government.

188

00:17:03,020 --> 00:17:07,140

The Fed Center out in Lakewood is actually the largest concentration of government employees

189

00:17:07,140 --> 00:17:08,900

west of the Mississippi.

190

00:17:08,900 --> 00:17:12,100

We've got Buckley Space Force Base, we've got Norah down to the south.

191

00:17:27,300 --> 00:17:36,580

Colorado also has no shortage of course of military installations.

192

00:17:36,580 --> 00:17:41,940

Cheyenne Mountain out of which NORAD was run for the longest time is one of the most secure

193

00:17:41,940 --> 00:17:47,500

facilities in the world designed famously to withstand a hit from a thermonuclear weapon.

194

00:17:47,500 --> 00:17:51,180

We also have Buckley Air Force Base which again is very close to where we film now in

195

00:17:51,180 --> 00:17:53,020

the city of Aurora.

196

00:17:53,020 --> 00:17:56,820

Buckley Air Force Base is where Space Command operated from.

197

00:17:56,820 --> 00:18:02,260

The Space Command was responsible for tracking objects in orbit and the US military's eyes

198

00:18:02,260 --> 00:18:05,180

in the sky above the atmosphere.

199

00:18:05,180 --> 00:18:09,740

And if you study the UFO phenomenon globally throughout the world, whether we're looking

200

00:18:09,740 --> 00:18:16,020

at the Soviet Union, China, Europe, the UK, there are countless instances of UFOs being

201

00:18:16,020 --> 00:18:18,380

drawn to military facilities.

202

00:18:18,380 --> 00:18:24,020

And generally speaking, the more top secret the facility is, the more attention they tend

203

00:18:24,020 --> 00:18:25,460

to attract from UFOs.

204

00:18:26,820 --> 00:18:34,900

So there's always weird stuff, you always hear weird things and so I experienced a couple

205

00:18:34,900 --> 00:18:36,620

of those when I was in law enforcement.

206

00:18:36,620 --> 00:18:41,500

I had a few calls in my career both on the north side of the metro area and then down

207

00:18:41,500 --> 00:18:43,660

south more closer to the plains of the prairie.

208

00:18:43,660 --> 00:18:47,700

This probably happened about three or four times in my six years on the road where we'd

209

00:18:47,700 --> 00:18:51,900

get a call from somebody saying, hey, I'm in my backyard, I see some lights moving in

210

00:18:51,900 --> 00:18:56,700

the sky, they're moving really weird, they look like discs, now they look like a rectangle

211

00:18:57,460 --> 00:19:00,860

they're kind of zipping around, it doesn't make sense can somebody come by.

212

00:19:00,860 --> 00:19:04,460

You sort of take those things with a grain of salt, but the fact that they kept happening

213

00:19:04,460 --> 00:19:07,460

three or four times and it was always very similar descriptions.

214

00:19:07,460 --> 00:19:14,820

It was always these lights are a disc, now there's three of them and now they're a rectangle.

215

00:19:14,820 --> 00:19:18,820

That was always kind of the pattern that I'd heard and it was weird that it happened both

216

00:19:18,820 --> 00:19:22,060

when I worked up north and then a few years later when I was down south.

217

00:19:22,140 --> 00:19:27,420

So the incident that really caught my attention when I was down south was I was driving on

218

00:19:27,420 --> 00:19:31,860

the highway one night on I-25 taking somebody down to jail and I'm coming back and it's

219

00:19:31,860 --> 00:19:35,900

about three or four in the morning and so nothing's going on and it's pitch black dark

220

00:19:35,900 --> 00:19:37,380

in this corridor of the highway.

221

00:19:37,380 --> 00:19:41,260

And again, I got another call saying, hey, this call is coming in, we're getting weird

222

00:19:41,260 --> 00:19:43,780

reports of lights out east of the highway.

223

00:19:43,780 --> 00:19:48,020

In this particular area out east, there's really nothing, but it was just really strange

224

00:19:48,020 --> 00:19:52,500

to get those light reports again and I was kind of at a spot on the highway where it

225

00:19:52,500 --> 00:19:56,100

kind of descends down a hill so I kind of have a view of the area.

226

00:19:56,100 --> 00:20:00,780

I can kind of see like what they're talking about and I keep hearing the radio chatter

227

00:20:00,780 --> 00:20:05,540

from one of our sister agencies, hey, I'm in the area, we're checking it and dispatch has

228

00:20:05,540 --> 00:20:10,620

given us notes saying, hey, the RP, the reporting person is saying that they still see it, it's

229

00:20:10,620 --> 00:20:12,340

right above their yard.

230

00:20:12,340 --> 00:20:15,500

I'm on the highway with a vantage point of this area.

231

00:20:15,500 --> 00:20:20,540

One of my buddies from another agency from our county sheriff's, he's in the neighborhood,

232

00:20:20,540 --> 00:20:24,700

but the reporting party is giving this description that I had now heard two, three, four times

233

00:20:24,700 --> 00:20:29,380

in my law enforcement career, working two different parts of the Denver Metro agency,

234

00:20:29,380 --> 00:20:34,620

two completely different agencies, two completely different dispatch areas, one along the

foothills,

235

00:20:34,620 --> 00:20:39,220

one out closer to the prairie and it just, the fact that they synced up like that just

236

00:20:39,220 --> 00:20:43,740

kind of stuck with me like that's weird.

237

00:20:44,100 --> 00:20:47,180

Weird things happen in the Colorado mountains, especially in the foothills of the Denver

238

00:20:47,180 --> 00:20:52,580

Metro area, anywhere between Denver and maybe the first half hour to an hour into the Rockies

239

00:20:52,580 --> 00:20:56,060

where you have a high saturation of the population.

240

00:20:56,060 --> 00:21:03,020

There's just weird stuff that comes out of there all the time.

241

00:21:03,020 --> 00:21:09,100

Encounters with the unusual in this state run the gamut from simple observations of strange

242

00:21:09,180 --> 00:21:11,820

lights to full on craft sightings.

243

00:21:11,820 --> 00:21:16,180

But while the abduction phenomenon might have come into its own on the east coast with the

244

00:21:16,180 --> 00:21:21,140

Betty and Barney Hill incident, Colorado's history of missing time reports and abduction

245

00:21:21,140 --> 00:21:24,180

cases is as old as New Hampshire's.

246

00:21:24,180 --> 00:21:28,180

This is where the UFO game takes a nasty turn.

247

00:21:28,180 --> 00:21:32,180

Abductions and cattle mutilations throw a wrench into the works for those of us who want to

248

00:21:32,180 --> 00:21:36,420

see the subject return to its once hopeful roots.

249

00:21:36,500 --> 00:21:40,780

To ignore the nastier side of the topic is to ignore the truth.

of Denver and the surrounding suburbs, and into the prairies that sit in the shadows

Here, in the forested hills and valleys at the base of one of the most well-known mountain

chains in the United States, sit ranches and ranch land that seem to act as a magnet for

the bazaar.

It's here where we got our first hint as to just how unusual the activity in this part

So it was like you'd hear the adults talking about police being called and cattle being

killed and, you know, UFOs being sighted and lights in the sky and Sasquatch creatures

and banging on the house and paranormal activity, all of these crazy things.

They had rewards out trying to figure out who's mutilating these cattle.

You didn't go up to anybody's door at night without letting them know you're coming because

they were actively looking for who was doing this.

One of the experiences was it was a Colorado day and anybody who lives in Colorado knows

418

In the springtime, you still get snow.

419

The snow gets really wet and heavy, you know, but the sun's still shining and it's nice.

420

00:34:06,820 --> 00:34:11,060

So my sister and I were out there on the ranch just tossing the Frisbee back and forth.

421

And we looked down and we noticed that we're standing in this dry dirt where nothing grew.

422

And we're like, well, that's really weird because over here it's like wet, heavy snow.

423

But here's dry.

00:34:23,100 --> 00:34:24,340

It wasn't even wet dirt.

It was dry.

And then to get the briefing document all the years later and to see that they are talking

about that in these reports at the time.

It was 35 feet in diameter around.

So all the adults are in this little room, not about the size of this room, playing games.

Just the three boys, my sister and I, just being teenagers and kids.

And I was the youngest of them.

And all of a sudden the humming noise starts up.

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00:35:11,340 --> 00:35:14,740

And sometimes that humming sound would get so loud you couldn't even hear yourselves talk

over it.

And like, okay, and everybody's like, what the heck?

Oh, I need to talk to him.

482

Another time I was with the younger boys in the back of the pickup truck with their dog.

483

There's ponderosa pines behind the ranch house.

484

00:37:10,220 --> 00:37:13,500

And we were just driving around the back of the ranch property.

485

We stopped at this little outbuilding.

486

We get out of the truck.

487

I don't know what the adults were doing, but I just remember this humming noise starting

up, you know, this low humming noise.

And all of a sudden I hear the box, the box, the box.

The ranch where Katie experienced years of bizarre activity might just be a microcosm

508

00:38:23,740 --> 00:38:28,780

for the entirety of one of the weirdest places in the state of Colorado.

509

The San Luis Valley of southern Colorado is a stark contrast.

510

00:38:33,580 --> 00:38:40,460

The valley is ringed by the San Juan Mountains and runs nearly 122 miles down into the state

It's about 10,000 square miles.

It's about 140 miles long.

The San Luis Valley portion is the part in Colorado, but the tip of the valley is in

New Mexico and goes down to Taos.

It's a spooky place.

The variety and intensity of unusual phenomena there and the reports is unrivaled anywhere

in the country.

Everything from big, huge, giant thunderbirds, big foot elementals.

And there's a lot of occult practices going on too in the area.

Lots of coup d'endera, healers, lots of brujos and brujas.

It's a pretty interesting place with its own unique set of folklore and legends.

The San Luis Valley down south where you get a host of UFO activity.

We have the original horse mutilation story, livestock mutilation in the form of Snippy

541

We have the UFO watchtower, of course, which is pretty unique.

I just give them and say we need a UFO watchtower because of the stories.

Native Americans considered the valley floor sacred.

589

They wouldn't fight on the valley floor.

590

They'd have their peace talks on the valley floor.

591

00:44:07,780 --> 00:44:09,540

Others say it's the vastness.

592

It's so large and not highly populated.

593

Some say that there's an extraterrestrial base in Mount Blanca over here.

594

Could be lots of activity over there.

595

Would you mind starting from the beginning?

Sure.

Cattle mutilations have been part of the public consciousness and tied so tightly to the UFO

631

In the 1970s and 80s, authors like Linda Moulton-Howe and journalists like George Knapp

633

popularized the subject through their books and various television and radio appearances,

634

00:47:13,460 --> 00:47:18,980

but even before then, ranchers were discovering mutilated animals on their farms and ranches

635

00:47:18,980 --> 00:47:21,180

across the United States.

636

00:47:21,180 --> 00:47:27,100

Fittingly, the first known cattle mutilation case originates right here in the San Luis

637

00:47:27,100 --> 00:47:31,020

Valley and it wasn't a bovine at all.

638

00:47:31,020 --> 00:47:33,380

It was a horse named Lady.

639

00:47:33,380 --> 00:47:39,220

The first place that happened was in Southern Colorado and it was a horse named Lady who

640

00:47:39,220 --> 00:47:44,420

came to be known as Snippy, was missing for about a day and was found in a very unusual

641

00:47:44,420 --> 00:47:46,180

situation.

642

00:47:46,180 --> 00:47:51,660

There were a series of round indentations in the ground near the horse's body.

643

00:47:51,660 --> 00:47:58,620

There was a very strange viscous substance on one of the bushes near the remains and perhaps

644

00:47:58,620 --> 00:48:04,660

most interesting of all, the state of this poor animal, much of the tissue from her skull

645

00:48:04,660 --> 00:48:07,780

and neck had been excised was gone.

646

00:48:07,780 --> 00:48:15,020

When I was 10 years old, I was with my mom shopping at a safeway and I saw the inquire

647

00:48:15,020 --> 00:48:20,100

and it had this flying saucer that killed my horse and it was a headline and there was

648

00:48:20,100 --> 00:48:24,420

a picture of this horse that had all the flesh and tissue and muscle and hide and everything

649

00:48:24,420 --> 00:48:29,620

just vacuum cleaner withers from the neck to the tip of its nose.

650

00:48:29,620 --> 00:48:36,940

The first documented livestock mutilation was Snippy the horse and I have her here

651

00:48:36,940 --> 00:48:41,620

and I will take you over and let you see her and it's quite the story.

652

00:48:41,620 --> 00:48:44,260

It still hasn't been solved.

653

00:48:44,260 --> 00:48:47,620

The ground where she was was radioactive.

654

00:48:47,620 --> 00:48:50,060

There was some slimy stuff on the bush.

655

00:48:50,060 --> 00:48:53,060

Their hands would burn.

656

00:48:53,060 --> 00:49:00,380

The L said that his hand itched so bad he had to go wash his hands to get whatever it was off.

657

00:49:00,380 --> 00:49:08,100

It happened on the King Ranch over here and they attributed it to alien UFOs.

658

00:49:08,100 --> 00:49:15,460

I had one of the relatives from the King family call me two weeks ago and she said,

659

00:49:15,460 --> 00:49:20,900

I heard that you've got Snippy and I said, yes, I have Snippy.

660

00:49:20,900 --> 00:49:26,020

And she said, well, you realize Judy, it was UFO related.

661

00:49:26,020 --> 00:49:31,020

It was a UFO that did that.

662

00:49:31,020 --> 00:49:35,500

So Judy, can you describe when they first found Snippy since we're standing here with

663

00:49:35,500 --> 00:49:36,500

him?

664

00:49:36,500 --> 00:49:39,180

Yeah, all the hide, meat, everything.

665

00:49:39,180 --> 00:49:42,260

The only thing that was exposed was the bones.

666

00:49:42,260 --> 00:49:46,180

It was all bare from here to the tip of her nose.

667

00:49:46,180 --> 00:49:54,980

I had a young man in and when he was a teenager, he was there when they took the hide off this area.

668

00:49:54,980 --> 00:49:59,660

And he said, taking the hide off, he said nothing was there.

669

00:49:59,660 --> 00:50:07,900

All of the internal organs were gone and they cut into the skull up there to get the brain

670

00:50:07,900 --> 00:50:10,500

and no brain.

671

00:50:10,660 --> 00:50:17,780

So from what I understand, the area where she was was radioactive.

672

00:50:17,780 --> 00:50:18,980

What about Snippy herself?

673

00:50:18,980 --> 00:50:21,340

Was she also very radioactive?

674

00:50:21,340 --> 00:50:24,580

Yeah, all around where she was.

675

00:50:24,580 --> 00:50:30,580

And then they said that there were some about 100 yards or 100 feet from where they found

676

00:50:30,580 --> 00:50:33,940

her, there were holes in the ground.

677

00:50:33,940 --> 00:50:37,780

They think that that's where a spaceship had landed.

678

00:50:37,780 --> 00:50:44,420

But they said that the bones looked like they had been laying out in the elements for 20

679

00:50:44,420 --> 00:50:45,420

years.

680

00:50:45,420 --> 00:50:48,100

They were just that white.

681

00:50:48,100 --> 00:50:52,300

Do you know what the time frame was from when they last saw Snippy alive and breathing

682

00:50:52,300 --> 00:50:53,700

to when they found her land?

683

00:50:53,700 --> 00:50:55,900

Yeah, it was two days.

684

00:50:55,900 --> 00:51:01,820

Well, she didn't come in for her feed or her water and that's when they decided they better

685

00:51:01,820 --> 00:51:02,820

go look.

686

00:51:02,820 --> 00:51:05,500

The other horses came in but she didn't.

687

00:51:05,540 --> 00:51:07,860

At that time, how much property did they have?

688

00:51:07,860 --> 00:51:11,300

Gosh, the King Ranch, they were big.

689

00:51:11,300 --> 00:51:14,180

What else was going on around the area in 1960?

690

00:51:14,180 --> 00:51:15,180

Anything weird in the area?

691

00:51:15,180 --> 00:51:18,300

They saw strange lights.

692

00:51:18,300 --> 00:51:20,020

That's what the family reported.

693

00:51:20,020 --> 00:51:21,860

They saw strange lights.

694

00:51:21,860 --> 00:51:26,940

And the lady who owned her, her name was Nellie Lewis.

695

00:51:26,940 --> 00:51:32,500

And she swears to God that she saw spaceships over there.

696

00:51:32,500 --> 00:51:36,700

And after this happened, then she passed away.

697

00:51:36,700 --> 00:51:39,100

I think she committed suicide.

698

00:51:39,100 --> 00:51:45,380

But anyway, it was sad, you know?

699

00:51:45,380 --> 00:51:52,700

It was just sad.

700

00:51:52,700 --> 00:51:59,500

The things that are taken are the pituitary gland, thyroid gland, the tongue and part

701

00:51:59,500 --> 00:52:01,500

of the brain.

702

00:52:01,500 --> 00:52:10,500

Sometimes the innards, the organs inside are taken, like the uterus and the ovaries.

703

00:52:10,500 --> 00:52:14,180

It's just strange, just strange.

704

00:52:14,180 --> 00:52:17,300

Cattle are the closest to match genetically to humans.

705

00:52:17,300 --> 00:52:25,380

If you're an AB positive, blood type, you can actually receive a transfusion of Cattle

706

00:52:25,380 --> 00:52:28,700

Hemoglobin and it won't kill you.

707

00:52:28,700 --> 00:52:33,060

Another interesting fact too, when you think about it, is the parts that are taken, generally

708

00:52:33,060 --> 00:52:39,740

the reproductive organs, the tongue, these are areas in the human body that tend to develop

709

00:52:39,740 --> 00:52:40,740

cancer.

710

00:52:40,740 --> 00:52:43,820

There seems to be a correlation there.

711

00:52:43,820 --> 00:52:48,060

And skeptics say, well, you know, insects get into the body of a dead animal, get into

712

00:52:48,060 --> 00:52:50,420

the carcass, they will eat it away.

713

00:52:50,420 --> 00:52:54,380

They'll eat the brains and the soft organs, tissues, things of that nature.

714

00:52:54,380 --> 00:52:58,580

But generally that doesn't happen in such a short space of time that usually takes a

715

00:52:58,580 --> 00:52:59,580

while.

716

00:52:59,580 --> 00:53:06,420

That's the first thing I look for is cut hair follicles because scavengers, birds, insects,

717

00:53:06,420 --> 00:53:09,900

the flesh just tears between the hair follicles.

718

00:53:09,900 --> 00:53:16,740

Over the years I've come to find out that a lot of these popular notions about mutilations,

719

00:53:16,740 --> 00:53:20,460

like they're always drained of blood, animals will never go near them.

720

00:53:20,460 --> 00:53:21,860

It's not necessarily so.

721

00:53:21,860 --> 00:53:24,860

I did not have very many cases that were drained of blood.

722

00:53:24,860 --> 00:53:29,020

I've had a couple cases though where we cut into it and the meat was pale.

723

00:53:29,020 --> 00:53:34,900

The meat wasn't red and it appeared to have been drained down to the capillary level.

724

00:53:34,900 --> 00:53:39,020

When I investigated the ranch in Elbert County, you can't investigate that location and the

725

00:53:39,020 --> 00:53:42,500

things that happened to me when I was a young girl and my sister as well and everybody on

726

00:53:42,500 --> 00:53:46,860

the property without looking at the catalyzed relations because it was almost occurring

727

00:53:46,860 --> 00:53:47,860

daily out there.

728

00:53:47,860 --> 00:53:52,780

I went out and interviewed another witness who, if you visit the Elbert County Museum,

729

00:53:52,780 --> 00:53:55,620

her family kind of pioneered the location.

730

00:53:55,620 --> 00:54:01,940

So they have a long time in this small town and I went to Wyoming.

731

00:54:01,940 --> 00:54:06,900

She lives in Wyoming now and interviewed her and she had a really fascinating encounter

732

00:54:06,900 --> 00:54:13,340

right out of high school and her husband was out on horseback checking the cows for calves.

733

00:54:13,340 --> 00:54:16,380

He came across a calf and the calf was dead.

734

00:54:16,380 --> 00:54:19,860

The calf had four cuts in a perfect square.

735

00:54:19,860 --> 00:54:22,020

So incision, incision, incision, incision.

736

00:54:22,020 --> 00:54:26,660

The top of the fur was removed but the skin was still there but the calf was dead.

737

00:54:26,660 --> 00:54:29,300

And so he gets on the horse, he goes back and gets my witness.

738

00:54:29,300 --> 00:54:34,300

They come back and maybe took 20 to 30 minutes to get back in the truck.

739

00:54:34,300 --> 00:54:37,380

By the time they got back, the calf was mutilated.

740

00:54:37,380 --> 00:54:43,140

Perfectly clean incisions, organs removed, blood drained, which coyotes will jump up

741

00:54:43,140 --> 00:54:45,620

on the back and just kind of tear at it.

742

00:54:45,620 --> 00:54:50,260

This was clean cut incision, no tracks, no sounds.

743

00:54:50,260 --> 00:54:54,060

I mean, they're out in the middle of nowhere, miles from a road.

744

00:54:54,060 --> 00:54:59,380

Nobody just came up and pulled off the side of the road and did this.

745

00:54:59,380 --> 00:55:05,060

So the interesting thing about it to me, because this is a memory I have from when I was young,

746

00:55:05,060 --> 00:55:07,660

is they had a sense of being watched.

747

00:55:07,660 --> 00:55:11,100

They felt it was really eerie, they felt it was evil.

748

00:55:11,100 --> 00:55:13,300

And again, no helicopter sounds.

749

00:55:13,300 --> 00:55:17,460

No car marks or truck marks, only the horse.

750

00:55:17,460 --> 00:55:21,860

And so, really fascinating case.

751

00:55:21,860 --> 00:55:26,460

Some of these cases can be written off of course as when the carcass blows, it fills

752

00:55:26,460 --> 00:55:31,940

with gas, the skin will tear along very neat, clean lines.

753

00:55:31,940 --> 00:55:37,660

But when you see a true mutilation, what you're looking at is almost a surgical excision of

754

00:55:37,660 --> 00:55:39,980

parts of the carcass.

755

00:55:39,980 --> 00:55:44,660

As if it's done with a scalpel, an extremely sharp scalpel, or something even finer than

756

00:55:44,660 --> 00:55:45,660

that.

757

00:55:45,660 --> 00:55:49,220

This one case I had, probably the spookiest one.

758

00:55:49,220 --> 00:55:54,260

The animal had been found in a pristine, fresh five inch snow, not one drop of blood.

759

00:55:54,260 --> 00:55:56,340

Its right front leg was gone.

760

00:55:56,340 --> 00:56:04,140

And when the rancher found the animal, the heart and the liver had been expertly taken

761

00:56:04,140 --> 00:56:08,020

out and then laid side by side in the body cavity.

762

00:56:08,020 --> 00:56:14,940

The spine was gone from the base of the skull to the hips and had been taken out in an upwards

763

00:56:14,940 --> 00:56:18,740

fashion which was impossible because the skin was there.

764

00:56:18,740 --> 00:56:24,300

There was no brain in the brain case which hadn't been broken into.

765

00:56:24,300 --> 00:56:31,060

It had a subtle smell of some sort of disinfectant.

766

00:56:31,060 --> 00:56:32,460

The thing wouldn't rot.

767

00:56:32,460 --> 00:56:38,100

I went back four days later and the thing was in the exact same condition that I had

768

00:56:38,100 --> 00:56:41,380

seen it in four days before.

769

00:56:41,380 --> 00:56:48,780

That particular case was one of the only cases that was signed off on by Dr. John King who

770

00:56:48,780 --> 00:56:56,940

was the head of the New York State Veterinary College at Cornell.

771

00:56:56,940 --> 00:57:02,260

Tom Miller's ranch is the knot at the end of many strings that form Colorado's rich

772

00:57:02,260 --> 00:57:04,340

eufological history.

773

00:57:04,340 --> 00:57:09,300

A second generation rancher, Tom had been noticing strange cattle deaths on his ranch

774

00:57:09,300 --> 00:57:15,140

for over two decades before he finally started viewing them in a different light.

775

00:57:15,140 --> 00:57:19,900

Field dressed and surgically removed organs along with eyes and ears is what caught his

778

And the activity on his land has become more and more disturbing and bizarre.

The land where Tom's ranch sits has an interesting past that might help to shine a light on

780

00:57:35,540 --> 00:57:38,300

just what is going on here.

781

00:57:38,300 --> 00:57:43,260

At one time these lands were inhabited by the Yut Indians who have their own beliefs and

782

00:57:43,260 --> 00:57:47,420

traditions regarding skinwalkers and strange lights.

783

00:57:47,420 --> 00:57:52,700

The Purgatory River cuts through their property and at one time the Purgatory was referred

784

00:57:52,700 --> 00:57:58,700

to as the River of Lost Souls due to a regiment of Spanish soldiers who went missing after

785

00:57:58,700 --> 00:58:02,220

setting off to follow the river south.

786

00:58:02,220 --> 00:58:08,020

Trinidad, the closest town to the ranch, has its own sordid past, comprised of death and

787

00:58:08,020 --> 00:58:09,020

debauchery.

788

00:58:09,020 --> 00:58:13,300

You know, the usual old west stuff.

789

00:58:13,300 --> 00:58:18,520

But today it's the mutilations that bring us here to the banks of the Purgatory River

790

00:58:18,520 --> 00:58:23,880

in the heart of former native lands where a door we might not want open has been kicked

791

00:58:23,880 --> 00:58:25,920

right off its hinges.

792

00:58:25,920 --> 00:58:29,000

So 16 calves or and or calves.

793

00:58:29,000 --> 00:58:34,160

To you what is the strangest thing that you've seen out here or aspect of the whole thing?

794

00:58:34,160 --> 00:58:40,240

The calves are the some of the way the calves have been left are pretty hideous.

795

00:58:40,240 --> 00:58:44,440

I think that little calf that they got it cleared down to the spinal cord was one of

796

00:58:44,440 --> 00:58:45,440

the worst.

797

00:58:45,440 --> 00:58:46,880

All the organs missing?

798

00:58:46,880 --> 00:58:52,040

Everything was missing except the spinal cord and it was fine a few hours before.

799

00:58:52,040 --> 00:58:57,080

And then the second one would have been the back strap off of the cow on the last one.

800

00:58:57,080 --> 00:59:01,720

Usually they they leave that but this was a perfect horseshoe shaped piece.

801

00:59:01,720 --> 00:59:02,720

Oh, yeah.

802

00:59:02,720 --> 00:59:03,720

Down to the hips.

803

00:59:03,720 --> 00:59:04,720

That was pretty much.

804

00:59:04,720 --> 00:59:10,680

A lot of times in the cattle mutilations you read about blood being just magically drained

805

00:59:10,680 --> 00:59:13,320

and gone and no trace of it anywhere.

806

00:59:13,320 --> 00:59:15,120

Is that the same with some of these?

807

00:59:15,120 --> 00:59:19,280

I don't know if it's magically drained but a cow has what seven and a half gallons of

808

00:59:19,280 --> 00:59:23,040

blood and there's never a drop anywhere.

809

00:59:23,040 --> 00:59:24,640

It's gone.

810

00:59:24,640 --> 00:59:30,840

There are no blood leakages around the calf or cow.

811

00:59:30,840 --> 00:59:35,640

Whatever is used it's probably intubated and taken out in that manner because there's

812

00:59:35,640 --> 00:59:36,640

nothing around.

813

00:59:36,640 --> 00:59:37,640

There's nothing left.

814

00:59:37,640 --> 00:59:41,800

In fact the animals won't even go near it for a while.

815

00:59:41,800 --> 00:59:45,240

They will stay away from the carcass completely.

816

00:59:45,240 --> 00:59:47,920

And then over a period of time it just deteriorates on its own.

817

00:59:47,920 --> 00:59:48,920

We had one cow.

818

00:59:48,920 --> 00:59:50,920

That was pretty strange too.

819

00:59:50,920 --> 00:59:56,680

We had one that was near the house and Tom took it across the road.

820

00:59:56,680 --> 01:00:01,600

We went out the next morning to look at it and it had turned into a pile of ash overnight.

821

01:00:01,600 --> 01:00:10,080

Yeah, well that was a calf but it was still, there was nothing, it was just ashes there

822

01:00:10,200 --> 01:00:14,040

like it and we never could figure out what happened there.

823

01:00:14,040 --> 01:00:16,040

That was the only time that happened?

824

01:00:16,040 --> 01:00:24,400

So they're different, you know, I mean whatever is or whoever is or whatever is has its own

825

01:00:24,400 --> 01:00:26,400

agenda.

826

01:00:26,400 --> 01:00:31,200

Typically they have the same trademark cuts.

827

01:00:31,200 --> 01:00:35,960

Probably everybody across the country on the 37th parallel has that.

828

01:00:35,960 --> 01:00:38,320

We just had a feel that it had been really different.

829

01:00:38,320 --> 01:00:45,200

In the 1970s reports of mysterious unmarked helicopters erupted around the United States.

830

01:00:45,200 --> 01:00:50,520

Many of these reports were in conjunction with either UFO reports or that of mutilated

831

01:00:50,520 --> 01:00:51,520

livestock.

832

01:00:51,520 --> 01:00:56,640

Theories abound as to what the purpose of the helicopters might be as well as who might

833

01:00:56,640 --> 01:00:58,760

actually be piloting them.

834

01:00:58,760 --> 01:01:04,520

Here in Colorado it's easy to speculate that their origin might simply be the US military.

835

01:01:04,520 --> 01:01:08,640

After all this is a state with a strong military presence.

836

01:01:08,640 --> 01:01:14,120

But the helicopters are so often seen in places of high strangeness that it's easy to wonder

837

01:01:14,120 --> 01:01:18,160

if they aren't tied directly to the UFOs themselves.

838

01:01:18,160 --> 01:01:24,480

Even the Miller Ranch has had their own brushes with mysterious aerial phenomena, both man-made

839

01:01:24,480 --> 01:01:27,320

and otherworldly.

840

01:01:27,320 --> 01:01:29,200

But I had lots of helicopters.

841

01:01:30,200 --> 01:01:32,360

Lots of helicopter sightings.

842

01:01:32,360 --> 01:01:35,560

As many as seven in one case.

843

01:01:35,560 --> 01:01:37,080

That was back in the 70s.

844

01:01:37,080 --> 01:01:41,320

The Kings still believe that it was UFOs.

845

01:01:41,320 --> 01:01:43,800

Was there a military presence after that happened?

846

01:01:43,800 --> 01:01:49,560

You know, anytime there is a cattle mutilation there's always military activity.

847

01:01:49,560 --> 01:01:56,800

The ranchers describe seeing black helicopters, jets, everything flying around their ranch.

848

01:01:56,800 --> 01:02:04,520

Especially when they see helicopters around their place, or after a mutilation case.

849

01:02:04,520 --> 01:02:08,480

If they're ex-military then they tend to report it because they think they're being

850

01:02:08,480 --> 01:02:10,560

victimized by the government.

851

01:02:10,560 --> 01:02:17,080

And so that would be one of the motivating factors to actually report a case.

852

I had a post-master helicopter maintenance guy in his house with his wife at night and

853

01:02:23,800 --> 01:02:26,960

about ready to go to bed.

854

01:02:26,960 --> 01:02:29,720

He heard like it sounded like a tornado outside.

855

01:02:29,720 --> 01:02:31,480

The trees were whipping around.

856

01:02:31,480 --> 01:02:35,400

And so he went out and looked up and there's huge helicopters there.

857

01:02:35,400 --> 01:02:45,560

But it didn't make a single noise except the noise of the prop and the trees swirling around.

858

01:02:45,560 --> 01:02:46,560

It was dark color.

859

01:02:46,560 --> 01:02:49,760

You couldn't tell if it was black or dark purple or dark blue.

860

01:02:49,760 --> 01:02:51,680

It was all dark, uniform dark.

861

01:02:51,680 --> 01:02:53,280

There was no markings.

862

01:02:53,280 --> 01:02:54,280

It was a military helicopter.

863

01:02:54,280 --> 01:02:59,400

He said it was a big one like a sea stallion or one of the bigger choppers.

864

01:02:59,400 --> 01:03:06,920

I mean he used to work on helicopters and he knows the sound of their engines and that

865

01:03:06,920 --> 01:03:08,800

they have to make a sound, right?

866

01:03:08,800 --> 01:03:13,000

He said this thing was completely silent and so it took off.

867

It goes out the next morning and three of his animals are mutilated.

868

There's quite a number of cases with weird lights are seen, usually orange.

869

There are cases that obviously indicate that the animal was taken somewhere and then dropped

870

01:03:34,400 --> 01:03:36,160

back.

871

01:03:36,160 --> 01:03:41,240

Animals have been found five fence lines away from where they're supposed to be.

872

01:03:41,240 --> 01:03:42,760

Animals have been found.

873

01:03:42,760 --> 01:03:48,520

Quite a number have been found with broken legs, horns driven into the ground, snapped

874

01:03:48,520 --> 01:03:57,760

off, all the ribs on the one side broken like the animal had been dropped from a height.

875

01:03:57,760 --> 01:04:03,040

Suppose you never find footprints or tire tracks or anything, any sort of crime scene

876

01:04:03,040 --> 01:04:04,040

evidence.

877

01:04:04,040 --> 01:04:08,640

I had a case where it looked like a crop circle in the grass.

878

01:04:08,640 --> 01:04:14,920

It had swirled down and there was an emulated cow right in the middle and the hair on the

879

01:04:14,920 --> 01:04:28,400

tail had been taken out and then spinkled around.

880

01:04:28,400 --> 01:04:31,000

You seen any of the craft that may be due to this?

881

01:04:31,000 --> 01:04:32,320

Never seen the craft.

882

01:04:32,320 --> 01:04:33,320

We have seen lights.

883

01:04:33,320 --> 01:04:37,240

We have seen the lights but again we don't know where they originate from.

884

01:04:37,240 --> 01:04:38,640

They've come out of the river.

885

01:04:38,640 --> 01:04:40,640

They have flown over.

886

01:04:40,640 --> 01:04:42,140

They've been at the windows.

887

01:04:42,140 --> 01:04:43,560

They've been at the windows.

888

01:04:43,560 --> 01:04:45,520

What was Tom's experience?

889

He had red orbs looking in the windows.

890

Yeah, actually I was sleeping and turned over and there were two, there were about like

He couldn't walk, had taken the doctors.

What did they say?

902

01:05:48,280 --> 01:05:50,200

They didn't have an explanation.

903

01:05:50,200 --> 01:05:53,200

He told them what had happened and they're like, mm-hmm.

904

01:05:53,200 --> 01:05:56,440

That's what most everybody says.

905

01:05:56,440 --> 01:06:01,280

It's all about where the orbs will follow vehicles in or out.

906

01:06:01,280 --> 01:06:04,400

We have lights that have followed us.

907

01:06:04,400 --> 01:06:09,360

We have had other people that have been on their way out to the ranch to do things.

908

01:06:09,360 --> 01:06:11,760

In fact, our insurance agent was called.

909

01:06:11,760 --> 01:06:15,120

He called from about a 10 minute drive up the road and he said, I'll be there in 10

910

01:06:15,120 --> 01:06:16,120

minutes.

911

01:06:16,120 --> 01:06:17,120

I said, okay.

912

01:06:17,120 --> 01:06:21,360

An hour and a half passed and he never showed up and I thought, oh God, a car wrecked something.

913

01:06:21,360 --> 01:06:23,240

He finally got here and he was all shaking.

914

01:06:23,240 --> 01:06:30,000

He said when he crossed over that bridge lights lifted out and he ended up almost to 165 miles

915

01:06:30,000 --> 01:06:31,120

away.

916

01:06:31,120 --> 01:06:33,280

We have hunters down here.

917

01:06:33,280 --> 01:06:38,480

They hunt deer and stuff.

918

01:06:38,480 --> 01:06:42,640

They have tree sands down there.

919

01:06:42,640 --> 01:06:47,960

These hunters go out there in the middle of the night and sit up in the trees and wait.

920

01:06:47,960 --> 01:06:55,160

One of them came the next morning and he showed me a picture on his cell phone.

921

01:06:55,160 --> 01:06:58,600

It looked like a little marble.

922

01:06:58,600 --> 01:07:04,520

He said that thing was just out there in the sky.

923

He said it was there and it was there.

924

It was there.

Just moved just that fast.

926

He said I couldn't tell how far out it was.

927

In the cell phone it looked like a little marble, but it could have been a mile away.

928

It could have been 10 miles away.

929

You don't know.

930

01:07:27,560 --> 01:07:33,800

He couldn't figure that out, but he watched it for quite a while.

931

You ever see anything, the cliché black helicopters or anything like that?

932

Yeah, we have those around here.

933

01:07:40,480 --> 01:07:47,080

We don't think militaries at all involve because we've got a huge Fort Carson base right here

934

01:07:47,080 --> 01:07:49,280

and they run hundreds of head of cattle.

935

01:07:49,280 --> 01:07:53,520

They're not going to come and take a few of our little cows and create a stir in the

936

01:07:53,520 --> 01:07:57,440

community.

937

01:07:57,440 --> 01:08:01,680

As far as the ranch goes, we know there are these menacing helicopters.

938

01:08:01,680 --> 01:08:06,520

We know that they were out there investigating and maybe doing some of the mutilations out

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01:08:06,520 --> 01:08:07,520

there.

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01:08:07,520 --> 01:08:08,520

There's no question about that.

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01:08:08,520 --> 01:08:13,440

My question was always, were they out there causing the phenomenon, trying to scare the

942

01:08:13,440 --> 01:08:15,120

family off the property?

943

01:08:15,120 --> 01:08:19,680

Or were they out there investigating the unknown phenomenon that they were aware of that was

944

01:08:19,680 --> 01:08:20,680

happening?

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01:08:20,680 --> 01:08:25,240

I am finally, after all these years, coming to the conclusion that it was both.

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01:08:25,240 --> 01:08:29,640

I really think that they were made aware of that some strange things were happening

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01:08:29,640 --> 01:08:35,160

and then they were out there trying to investigate as well and maybe do some of their own research.

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01:08:35,160 --> 01:08:39,520

There's a lot of debate about what the source of this phenomenon is.

949

Since its inception, people have just jumped to, hey, the UFO phenomenon equals aliens.

950

The extraterrestrial hypothesis is interesting because when you look at the history of this

951

phenomenon, the first sightings, the first landings and contacts allegedly between humans

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01:08:54,480 --> 01:09:01,120

and extraterrestrials, they said that the UFOs were coming from Venus, that they were

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01:09:02,120 --> 01:09:05,960

Well, we sent probes to Mars and Venus and rather inconveniently, we found there was

nobody or nothing there and the conditions were nothing like the contactees were telling

So, the story began to change.

Rather than traveling these vast interstellar distances, these craft or travelers call them

966

what you will, may be coming in from another plane of reality from another dimension.

967

01:09:46,020 --> 01:09:49,540

We can say for sure that something is invading our airspace.

968

01:09:49,540 --> 01:09:51,100

We don't know what it is.

969

01:09:51,100 --> 01:09:56,540

We're not able to stop it and it seems to defy our current understanding of physics.

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01:09:56,540 --> 01:10:01,580

The word consciousness comes in play a lot with some of this stuff.

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01:10:01,580 --> 01:10:03,980

What are your opinions on that?

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01:10:03,980 --> 01:10:04,980

Probably.

973

Probably right.

I think that they are in a different dimension than we are.

975

To get that thing and to cut it up with such precision and not spill any blood, be able

to leave a pristine crime scene, these are really slick operators that are doing this.

But I think there's multiple groups of humans for various reasons are perpetrating these

983

01:11:00,820 --> 01:11:05,380

cases and they're piggybacking on other cases.

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01:11:05,380 --> 01:11:09,100

It's almost like there's an action reaction.

985

It seems like the government is involved on several levels but one level is monitoring

986

01:11:17,780 --> 01:11:23,580

the other groups and that's where the helicopters come in.

987

There is at the core of the phenomenon about 2%.

988

I'd say maybe three.

989

There is a high strange perpetrator that are doing the ones you just can't explain.

But that's one or two cases out of 100.

You'll have that really mind-numbing case that just, even me, as hard-boiled as I am

992

about it, I've had a couple cases that kept me up at night.

993

Just like any of the phenomenon, a lot of it you can, even with orbs and things like

994

01:11:59,460 --> 01:12:04,340

that, it's dust, it's bugs, you can explain away some of it but you still are left with

995

01:12:04,340 --> 01:12:09,500

these really high, strange cases that just don't make any sense.

996

Just enough to keep you going, okay, what is this?

997

And especially when you're getting into these noises, the disappearing boxes and it's almost

as if that high magnetism open, it either allows us to be able to experience the phenomenon

or it's allowing some sort of open doorway or something where these things are coming

1000

When I first found it, it was real smooth, just all the way around, clear up to there.

And it looked kind of like those other cuts and it was just...

When we started on this journey, Colorado seemed to be something far different to me.

1004

01:13:07,180 --> 01:13:13,020

The reality is though, I found a place where UFO sightings are abundant and seemingly take

1007

01:13:13,020 --> 01:13:17,620

on a more sinister undercurrent due to the cattle mutilation phenomena.

1008

01:13:17,620 --> 01:13:23,100

It's a place where encounters are had with strange lights, craft, bizarre boxes, voices

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01:13:23,100 --> 01:13:27,900

from beyond and probably countless things we've yet to even hear about.

Sometimes, this array of paranormal entities intersect in strange ways, ways that begin

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01:13:33,820 --> 01:13:40,060

to push the boundaries of thinking of the UFOs as simply visitors from outer space.

But if not that, then what are they and why are they present in the places they're found?

Some say, well, they're using that DNA to create a superior race or to help a race or

a planetary people survive if their planets have been destroyed, et cetera.

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01:14:18,140 --> 01:14:21,220

I mean, they're all kinds of speculative reasons why.

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01:14:21,220 --> 01:14:25,380

They do know that the DNA is very closely related to human DNA.

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01:14:25,380 --> 01:14:29,740

We've had every researcher around has been here.

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01:14:29,740 --> 01:14:34,380

We've had the doctor that is the head of the veterinary school at Fort Collins, CU.

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01:14:34,380 --> 01:14:37,340

He's been here, he's analyzed everything.

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01:14:37,340 --> 01:14:41,340

So he would go up to each carcass as he came over and there would be radiation.

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01:14:41,340 --> 01:14:42,860

They would bring quick-mush with him.

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01:14:42,860 --> 01:14:44,500

They would bring Geiger counters.

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01:14:44,500 --> 01:14:46,700

They would bring different kind of computers monitoring.

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01:14:46,700 --> 01:14:49,860

Do they, I mean, what did they find in the soil?

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01:14:49,860 --> 01:14:50,860

Anything they could identify?

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01:14:50,860 --> 01:14:53,460

There was some kind of a meteoric.

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01:14:53,460 --> 01:14:57,300

It was radioactive number one, but then there were some minerals that generally come off

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01:14:57,300 --> 01:14:59,540

of meteorites that was within the soil.

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01:14:59,540 --> 01:15:01,260

Yeah, that's what he said.

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01:15:01,260 --> 01:15:07,260

It was when a meteorite falls, there's a certain amount of radiation from it and these cows

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01:15:07,260 --> 01:15:12,860

have the same type of radiation or something like that.

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01:15:12,860 --> 01:15:15,540

Yeah, I don't remember what he said was in the soil.

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01:15:15,540 --> 01:15:20,140

That's been quite a while back.

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01:15:20,140 --> 01:15:27,820

We've tell us that the electromagnetic field across the world is like .09.

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01:15:27,820 --> 01:15:31,860

So as they were going around checking for all kinds of weirdness in the ground, when
