For me personally, Mothman is the holy grail of the paranormal.

The first sighting of Mothman was in November 1966 in Point Pleasant, West Virginia.

Two newlywed couples were driving through Route 62 when they saw red eyes and something

37

fly away.

00:02:03,120 --> 00:02:05,080

Dozens were reported soon after.

39

A year later, a major disaster hit the town of Point Pleasant.

40

And the Mothman has been sighted just before other major world tragedies.

41

Chernobyl.

42

00:02:14,520 --> 00:02:15,720

The tsunami in India.

43

September 11th.

44

Are these sightings merely coincidental or is it something else?

45

Ever since I was little, I've been interested in the Mothman stories.

46

And I've always wanted to go to Point Pleasant, West Virginia, where the whole Mothman legend

47

began.

And we'll go and research the history of the Mothman Museum.

But beside just a field trip, I do want to actually find out what's going on.

I had grown up beside two of the people that were in the car that first night.

These are the original police reports about the Mothman.

68

This would be Linda and her husband and the other couple.

69

They sit down, wrote these out for the Sheriff's Department describing exactly what happened.

70

Each one of their stories are the same.

71

Director's log, Jeff Womsley at the Mothman Museum has given us several leads of eyewitnesses

72

we should talk to.

73

00:03:33,600 --> 00:03:35,400

So we're heading out to do that now.

74

How many times did you see the Mothman?

75

Hundreds.

76

Hundreds?

77

The first night we saw it, we were just driving around by the powerhouse and it was standing

78

there.

The wings caught in these cables and couldn't get loose.

80

And when it finally got loose, it took off and run into the powerhouse.

We took off down the road down Route 62 and it was waiting on us in a curve.

82

My brother thought it was a hoax and a joke and he was going to go out there and prove

83

All I could remember is turning off the main road and it was running beside the car.

85

You know, looking in the my side of the car window and all I caught was those red eyes.

The wings went out and it went straight up.

87

It all just cleared down in through town.

88

Keeping right up with us, we were going pretty fast.

89

We came right to the courthouse down here.

90

This police officer come out and he said, well, I reckon we're going to have to check

91

into this because too many people are saying they saw this thing.

You know, we all wrote the same thing.

93

I think that's what made him believe us because all of our stories were the same.

94

There was just too many people at the same time that didn't know each other and described

95

the same thing, the same mannerisms.

96

I don't think it could have been that organized of a scam or a hoax.

97

When the Silver Bridge collapsed, it took a lot of the attention and the focus off of

98

the Mothman sightings.

99

00:04:54,420 --> 00:04:58,240

This section right here on the Silver Bridge, my father compiled all this stuff when it

100

happened in some rare eight millimeter footage right after the bridge collapsed.

Where were you when the Silver Bridge collapsed?

102

00:05:05,200 --> 00:05:06,200

All the time.

103

00:05:06,200 --> 00:05:07,440

It's when I was pregnant.

104

00:05:07,440 --> 00:05:08,440

I heard it.

105

00:05:08,440 --> 00:05:10,520

It just sounded like a huge boom in the whole house.

106

00:05:10,520 --> 00:05:14,680

They sit down, turned on TV, and there it was, the bridge you fell.

107

00:05:14,680 --> 00:05:18,280

Do you remember the bridge falling?

108

00:05:18,280 --> 00:05:19,280

Oh yeah.

109

00:05:19,280 --> 00:05:20,880

Did you know anybody that was involved?

110

00:05:20,880 --> 00:05:23,040

Yeah, the girl in my class was.

111

They never did find her body.

112

What do you remember about the Silver Bridge collapse?

113

I can remember it very well, but that's something I don't really discuss.

114

My first husband and my son was on the bridge.

115

00:05:37,440 --> 00:05:39,040

This is such a small town.

116

00:05:39,040 --> 00:05:41,440

I think 46 people died.

117

00:05:41,440 --> 00:05:44,080

I must have just torn this whole town apart.

118

00:05:44,080 --> 00:05:45,080

They did.

119

00:05:45,080 --> 00:05:48,280

Yeah, they sure did.

120

00:05:48,280 --> 00:05:52,440

They said that the Mothman had seen it over the Silver Bridge and not collapsed.

121

00:05:52,440 --> 00:05:55,160

We didn't see it anymore after that.

122

00:05:55,160 --> 00:05:56,640

Do you think that it might come back?

123

00:05:56,640 --> 00:06:00,120

Do you mean I think it will?

124

00:06:00,120 --> 00:06:03,000

Would you feel better if you knew what happened, at least?

125

We'd like to know.

126

00:06:04,000 --> 00:06:05,000

I'm sure.

127

I can speak for myself.

128

I'd like to know what it is.

129

This made world news, didn't it?

130

The bridge?

131

Yeah.

132

It was like the disaster of its day.

133

There's 67 people on the bridge at the time.

134

00:06:18,040 --> 00:06:19,040

Total.

135

00:06:19,040 --> 00:06:20,040

Total.

136

00:06:20,040 --> 00:06:22,520

And then nine injured, 46 death.

137

00:06:22,520 --> 00:06:27,840

Witnesses that came to the shores described the people in the water as sounding like cows,

138

00:06:27,840 --> 00:06:32,080

because they were so cold that they couldn't really make out distinct voices.

139

00:06:32,080 --> 00:06:34,080

That'd be like ice water.

140

00:06:34,080 --> 00:06:35,080

Yeah.

141

00:06:35,080 --> 00:06:39,080

It was 40 degrees, they said.

142

00:06:39,080 --> 00:06:44,920

Tonight I've decided we should do dead time at the site of the tragic Silver Bridge collapse.

143

00:06:44,920 --> 00:06:49,600

I've invited Chip Coffey, a medium and frequent PRS consultant to join us there.

144

00:06:49,600 --> 00:06:54,040

If we're to find out more about the Mothman's role in the tragedy, we may need him to communicate

145

00:06:54,040 --> 00:06:55,440

for us.

146

00:06:55,440 --> 00:07:00,760

Alpha, you said that it was this way?

147

00:07:00,760 --> 00:07:01,760

Yep.

148

00:07:01,760 --> 00:07:02,760

There's the gate.

149

00:07:02,760 --> 00:07:03,760

Where?

150

00:07:03,760 --> 00:07:04,760

There.

151

00:07:04,760 --> 00:07:05,760

Wow.

152

00:07:05,760 --> 00:07:12,280

So I think it was over here somewhere.

153

Yeah, the bridge was.

154

Oh, wow.

You can imagine right here, 40 years ago.

156

Holy cow.

157

Getting chills.

158

What do you feel?

159

All the people knew they were going to die.

160

As soon as it happened, there was something that a lot of the people knew they were going

161

00:07:33,080 --> 00:07:34,080

to die.

162

00:07:34,080 --> 00:07:39,080

You can absolutely feel the fear that they felt and the cold that they felt.

163

00:07:39,080 --> 00:07:43,480

Lots of sadness, lots of fear.

164

00:07:43,480 --> 00:07:52,040

Really an overwhelming sense of a lot of different, very intense emotions.

165

00:07:52,040 --> 00:07:54,960

And it's almost like a resignation to what's going on.

166

00:07:54,960 --> 00:07:55,960

There's a release.

167

00:07:55,960 --> 00:07:58,560

That's the only word I can use.

168

00:07:58,560 --> 00:08:00,400

Just a release.

169

00:08:00,400 --> 00:08:03,120

And maybe that's the soul leaving the body.

170

00:08:03,120 --> 00:08:04,120

Maybe that's what it is.

171

00:08:04,120 --> 00:08:06,360

It's almost like this is okay.

172

00:08:06,360 --> 00:08:11,200

And letting go and not, it doesn't matter.

173

And the funny thing about it is it feels very quick.

174

So maybe that's a real blessing for the people whose families died right here in this river

175

00:08:18,280 --> 00:08:20,160

is the fact that it was quick.

176

The whole process was fast.

177

I understand what's going on.

178

00:08:23,560 --> 00:08:24,560

It's fearful.

179

00:08:24,560 --> 00:08:25,560

I'm scared.

180

00:08:25,560 --> 00:08:26,560

Oh my God.

181

00:08:26,560 --> 00:08:32,360

It's over.

182

00:08:32,360 --> 00:08:34,560

If I die, I hope it's that way.

183

00:08:34,560 --> 00:08:38,960

Chopra, you feeling anything?

184

00:08:38,960 --> 00:08:44,360

I just, I'm real drawn to that area down there.

185

00:08:44,360 --> 00:08:46,360

You mean down there by the water?

186

Yes.

187

Getting really hit very badly right in the solar plexus with a lot of energy just right

188

here in this area.

189

So he must be really close to the, how much the exact spot worth was.

190

A lot of confusion and a lot of fear and a lot of anxiety of what's going on.

191

What was that?

I just talked to Dysol Red Elite.

So did I.

Anybody else notice?

You did.

Interesting.

200

I don't know why, but I'm just getting something about Native American.

201

Something very interesting about the whole Native American tied to the thing, some sort

202

00:09:34,880 --> 00:09:39,560

of a ritualistic Native American something.

203

Director's log.

204

00:09:44,080 --> 00:09:48,240

Last night's dead time at the Silver Bridge really made an impact on us emotionally.

205

00:09:48,240 --> 00:09:52,080

Some people fear that the Mothman may have had something to do with the bridge's collapse,

206

00:09:52,080 --> 00:09:55,000

which makes this legend even more important for the town's history.

207

00:09:55,000 --> 00:09:58,240

I've decided to look at this case like any other investigation.

208

00:09:58,240 --> 00:10:01,760

Maybe we're on to something that no one else has seen or thought of.

209

00:10:01,760 --> 00:10:05,960

Ship gave us a couple of things that I think we should research.

210

00:10:05,960 --> 00:10:09,280

The Native American mythology and lore.

211

00:10:09,280 --> 00:10:13,840

I think this would be a great opportunity for us to look at it in a whole new light.

212

00:10:13,840 --> 00:10:15,880

Yeah, we are investigating the Mothman.

213

00:10:15,880 --> 00:10:26,200

There's all kinds of pieces to it.

214

00:10:26,200 --> 00:10:30,440

We studied things about Chief Cornstock all through school and we have his monument behind

215

00:10:30,440 --> 00:10:33,520

the flood wall and he's buried right down the end of the street.

216

00:10:33,520 --> 00:10:36,120

What do you know about the Cornstock curse?

217

00:10:36,120 --> 00:10:37,120

I don't know.

218

00:10:37,120 --> 00:10:38,120

I don't believe in curses.

219

00:10:38,120 --> 00:10:39,120

You don't think the town is cursed?

220

00:10:39,120 --> 00:10:40,120

No, I don't.

221

00:10:40,120 --> 00:10:42,120

Well, I firmly believe in that.

222

00:10:42,120 --> 00:10:45,120

Yeah, October the 10th, 1777.

223

00:10:45,120 --> 00:10:50,200

Cornstock, his oldest son, Lipso and Red Hawk was locked in the stock cage supposedly

224

00:10:50,200 --> 00:10:54,040

some of Lewis' men had started the stock cage killing all three of them.

225

00:10:54,040 --> 00:10:58,760

History has it that while Cornstock was dying, he placed a 200 year curse upon the area.

226

00:10:58,760 --> 00:11:01,480

He said that this town would never prosper.

227

00:11:01,480 --> 00:11:03,320

Three well true, there's nothing here.

228

00:11:03,320 --> 00:11:05,560

Stories are all closed down.

229

00:11:05,560 --> 00:11:08,720

This little town's had a lot of stuff happened to it.

230

00:11:08,720 --> 00:11:12,800

After that bridge fell, it's kind of left this little town lying, nothing big going

231

00:11:12,800 --> 00:11:15,200

on anymore.

232

00:11:15,200 --> 00:11:17,960

Everybody in the town that I interviewed knew about the Cornstock curse.

233

00:11:17,960 --> 00:11:23,040

From what I was told, Chief Cornstock was someone that the new United States government

234

00:11:23,040 --> 00:11:24,040

wanted dead.

235

00:11:24,040 --> 00:11:25,040

Really?

236

00:11:25,040 --> 00:11:27,480

And someone killed him.

237

00:11:27,480 --> 00:11:34,120

Pretty much upset a lot of tribes because they were original plans to try to make peace.

238

00:11:34,120 --> 00:11:36,200

No area was full of Indians.

239

00:11:36,200 --> 00:11:40,760

Anywhere where two rivers meet, the Shawnee Indians believed that was sacred territory.

240

00:11:40,760 --> 00:11:43,160

That's why they fought so much to keep everybody out of this area.

241

00:11:43,160 --> 00:11:45,280

The barrigrants were in this area too.

242

00:11:45,280 --> 00:11:47,920

The graves, you shouldn't disturb them.

243

00:11:47,920 --> 00:11:52,680

That area was to my understanding and doing some research, that area was originally three

244

00:11:52,680 --> 00:11:56,720

Indian burial grounds prior to them ever putting the TNT plan out there.

245

00:11:56,720 --> 00:12:00,640

This was a government facility that made high supplies right before World War II.

246

00:12:00,640 --> 00:12:03,840

It was a secret facility.

247

00:12:03,840 --> 00:12:06,920

And you've heard of the igloos, some of the igloos that are out there.

248

00:12:06,920 --> 00:12:09,480

So what does this have to do with Mothman though?

249

00:12:09,480 --> 00:12:12,360

This area right here that the Mothman was spotted.

250

00:12:12,360 --> 00:12:17,200

The TNT area today is still exactly the same as it was 40 years ago.

251

00:12:17,200 --> 00:12:19,960

That's almost like the crash site that Roswell would be.

252

00:12:19,960 --> 00:12:22,080

That right there is the Mothman story.

253

00:12:22,080 --> 00:12:27,520

The hot spot there, it would just put the hairs on your neck standing straight up.

254

00:12:27,520 --> 00:12:31,480

Directors log, we've learned that a Native American chief named Cornstock was killed

255

00:12:31,480 --> 00:12:36,840

by early settlers, causing him to put a 200 year curse on the town of Point Pleasant.

256

00:12:36,840 --> 00:12:41,320

To add insult to injury, the US government demolished his tribal burial grounds a century

257

00:12:41,320 --> 00:12:44,800

later to make way for a top secret weapons facility.

258

00:12:44,800 --> 00:12:50,600

This it turns out is the exact same location as the original sighting of the Mothman.

259

00:12:50,600 --> 00:12:55,400

So now, I'm taking my team out to the sermon potentially dangerous area to look for clues

260

00:12:55,400 --> 00:12:56,400

first hand.

261

00:12:56,400 --> 00:12:59,920

I have to admit, I'm a bit nervous.

262

00:12:59,920 --> 00:13:03,680

Not only are we entering a site where powerful explosives were built and tested, but we're

263

00:13:03,680 --> 00:13:08,280

also treading upon a fascinating American burial site, which could be the home to thousands

264

00:13:08,280 --> 00:13:11,280

of angry spirits.

265

00:13:11,280 --> 00:13:18,840

We're heading to the site where Linda Scarberry and other friends were riding.

266

00:13:18,840 --> 00:13:24,480

They're coming up the road towards us when they saw Mothman in this area.

267

00:13:24,480 --> 00:13:25,680

What's down that way?

268

00:13:26,640 --> 00:13:31,040

Down that way about maybe half a mile is where some of the igloos are, but it's really dense

269

00:13:31,040 --> 00:13:33,360

to get to some of those igloos.

270

00:13:33,360 --> 00:13:34,840

I'm real drawn to that area down there.

271

00:13:34,840 --> 00:13:35,840

You want to go down there?

272

00:13:35,840 --> 00:13:36,840

Yes.

273

00:13:39,840 --> 00:13:41,840

The adventure begins.

274

00:13:48,840 --> 00:13:49,840

What do you feel?

275

00:13:49,840 --> 00:13:51,320

I can't even explain it.

276

00:13:51,320 --> 00:13:53,840

It's like something knows we're here.

277

00:13:54,000 --> 00:13:57,000

Look at those bird feathers.

278

00:13:59,000 --> 00:14:00,000

What are they?

279

00:14:00,000 --> 00:14:01,000

What kind of feathers?

280

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:03,000

Feathers, an old bird.

281

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:06,000

And there's like long pieces out of here.

282

00:14:06,000 --> 00:14:07,000

Where are all you on?

283

00:14:07,000 --> 00:14:08,000

Sarge!

284

00:14:08,000 --> 00:14:09,000

Get over here.

285
