And if you could imagine her eyes closed, that would have been her.

The woman that Deborah Hoyt saw could not have been Christine Scoobish

The coroner's report indicated that death was immediate and that she died on impact.

She was lying dead in that car for five days before Deborah Hoyt ever saw anybody on the side of the road.
