Digging book by book, row by row, in the entire economic section of the Library of Congress, I found this little magazine with the Jekyll Island story in it.

When I took that to Ezra Pound, he was so thrilled it was the biggest discovery of his life.

In fact, Ezra Pound called the Jekyll Island story the biggest detective story of the 20th century. But why?

Andrew Gray, grand-nephew of one of the six men who met to plot the creation of the Federal Reserve system, scoffs at talk of secret cabals.

Well, I've asked whether the Jekyll Island meeting can be automatically classed as a conspiracy.

And the answer, first of all, is that the need for secrecy does not necessarily imply conspiracy.

Very important legislation of any kind cannot be drafted in public forum.

Back in 1910, they called themselves the Jekyll Island Club. Collectively, members represented more than one sixth the wealth of the entire world.

So anxious were they to keep any knowledge of their meetings secure, they used code names even when talking to friends.

We're going to Jamaica, they would say, and those in the know would understand they were traveling to Jekyll Island.

The immediate excuse was the money panic of 1907, which was engineered by Jacob Schiff and the Rockefellers to gain control of some corporations they were after.

And so then they said, look, we've got another nationwide panic, we've got a banking reform.

81

The birth of the Federal Reserve system we know was at Jekyll Island, Georgia, in a secret meeting that took place that was attended by Senator Aldrich,

who was the chairman of the banking committee and whose son I knew incidentally, Winthrop Aldrich, when he was chairman of the Chase Bank.

The Aldrich bill, as it was initially called, received such violent opposition from Democrats and reformers like William Jennings Bryan

84

that despite avid lobbying by the monopoly men, the bill quickly went down to defeat.

Once the Aldrich bill flopped, the bankers immediately moved to plan B. It didn't work from trying to push it through with Republicans, so they tried to push it through with Democrats.

We had in 1912 a very popular president, a Republican named William Howard Taft.

87

The bankers needed Woodrow Wilson to sign this act into law. He did not have much charisma, he had not a chance against William Howard Taft.

Teddy Roosevelt, he was an explosion upon the political scene, dynamic, outspoken, warm, colorful, exciting, inspiring.

89

And under the surface was a man of ideals.

90

You could say that J.P. Morgan really owned Theodore Roosevelt. You see his right hand man, vice president of his bank in New York, George Perkins, lived at the White House.

91

He was the least on man with the president. And so a drug Theodore Roosevelt out of obscure retirement, Roosevelt formed the bold news party and split to Republican Party and elected Woodrow

Wilson.

92

That's the only way they could do it.

Woodrow Wilson immediately after his inauguration called a special session of the Congress to do away with the protective tariff, which had been the thing that had built this country.

The second thing that happened was that the income tax came in and the final thing was the creation of the Federal Reserve, which took place in December, around the Christmas holidays in 1913, that put the cap on this whole revolution.

Most of the senators had gone home for the Christmas holidays. We call that legislative circles having the skids greased.

96

And the skids were greased and they just slid it right on through.

Without much fanfare, the president signed it and it became law of the land.

One of the major opponents during the Federal Reserve Act battle was Representative Charles Lindberg from Minnesota, who interestingly enough was the father of aviator Lucky Lindberg, the first guy to cross the Atlantic Ocean solo.

99

Lindberg fought them tooth and nail and were referred to the Federal Reserve Act as the worst legislative crime ever perpetrated in the history of the United States.

And that may indeed well be true.

By 1916, even President Wilson was worried.

Near the end of his life, Wilson said that he had been deceived into signing the Fed into law, reportedly murmuring, just before he died, I have unwittingly ruined my government.

In law, when any people meet together to plot to rob somebody, that becomes a criminal operation. It can never be anything else.

105

Throughout its subsequent history, it can never overcome that initial criminal beginning.

And that's where we are today, a criminal syndicate. That's all it is. That's all there has been.

Did the creation of the Federal Reserve represent a takeover of the United States by shadowy international financiers?

Certainly, the Fed was designed to serve somebody's interest, but whose?

Not the American banking community. It was the international banking community.

And one of their agents drafted the script for the Federal Reserve.

The Rothschild family is one of the wealthiest families the world has ever known.

By the early 1800s, they established themselves as the most important bankers in all Europe.

115

By the end of the 19th century, they are said to control half the wealth of the world.

116

As Rothschild biographer Derek Wilson explains, Rothschild critics have justification for their anxiety.

117

The House of Rothschild is immensely more powerful than any financial empire that has ever preceded it.

118

And it's able to control governments behind the scenes, secretly.

119

Economic power, political power go hand in hand and it's like Mayor Rothschild of the Rothschild banking family in Germany said,

Give me control of a nation's monetary system and I care not who writes their laws.

Nathan Rothschild in 1820 might have more right to say that than any of his successors.

122

In their statement, it's more or less absurd. The Federal Reserve does not control the money supply.

123

The Federal Reserve influences the money supply.

124

00:15:58,300 --> 00:16:04,300

To say that the Federal Reserve only influences the money supply is like saying a robber with a gun to your head

125

00:16:04,300 --> 00:16:07,300

is only influencing you to give him his money.

126

00:16:07,300 --> 00:16:14,300

And of course if you give him your money, you may be spared your life, but here again you don't have your money anymore.

127

There has been in the last 30 or 40 years a much greater international flavor for the activities of the Fed

128

00:16:19,300 --> 00:16:22,300

because the banking system has become global.

129

00:16:22,300 --> 00:16:29,300

And you can no longer regulate the U.S. money supply by simply via the domestic Federal Reserve banks.

130

The Federal Reserve controls the very heart of what's happening with money because money answers everything.

131

It's the one thing that everybody wants.

132

00:16:41,300 --> 00:16:49,300

And when you give a private institution, a monopoly on the creation of this money, you vest total control in that institution.

133

If you have the money, you can get any law passed you want.

134

So who do you care whether Bill Clinton is president or who is senator from New Jersey?

135

It doesn't make any difference because you write a check and you get another senator.

136

One of the stickiest questions in this debate is this. Just who owns the Federal Reserve?

137

The City of London set the whole thing up.

138

00:17:11,300 --> 00:17:18,300

The Federal Reserve Bank of New York is principally owned by five merchant banks in London, chartered by the Bank of England.

139

00:17:19,300 --> 00:17:25,300

Perhaps England, which many have considered a political satellite of the United States in recent years,

140

00:17:25,300 --> 00:17:29,300

is really the one pulling the strings of international policy.

141

00:17:29,300 --> 00:17:32,300

It's not a matter of who owns the Fed, it's who controls it.

142

00:17:32,300 --> 00:17:39,300

The government has given the banks a monopoly and then you see the Justice Department doing nothing about the bank mergers.

143

00:17:40,300 --> 00:17:47,300

A monopoly can only exist with government assistance and they've given great assistance to the banking monopoly.

144

00:17:52,300 --> 00:17:56,300

Perhaps the heaviest allegation made against those who run the Federal Reserve

145

00:17:56,300 --> 00:18:01,300

is that they are responsible for three of the biggest tragedies of the 20th century.

146

00:18:01,300 --> 00:18:06,300

World War I, World War II and the Great Depression.

147

00:18:07,300 --> 00:18:14,300

Wars are very profitable. In fact, wars are probably the most profitable thing an international banker can be involved in.

148

00:18:14,300 --> 00:18:21,300

So consequently throughout the last at least 300 years of North American and European history,

149

00:18:21,300 --> 00:18:26,300

you see incidents of international bankers backing both sides of a conflict.

150

They've been trying to have a war in Europe since 1885, but the central banks of Europe had already bankrupted all the nations of Europe.

151

They had no money. The only money was here in the United States.

152

In order to get that money, they had to put a central bank over on the American people.

153

00:18:43,300 --> 00:18:47,300

It was sold as a way to bring stability to the American economy.

Well, what happens just a little over a decade after the passage of the Fed?

155

00:18:52,300 --> 00:18:56,300

We see the biggest depression of this century in any case.

156

00:18:56,300 --> 00:19:03,300

For the 16 months prior to the crash of 29, the Federal Reserve increased the money supplied by 62%.

157

00:19:03,300 --> 00:19:06,300

Now, what was happening back then? Much like it's happening today.

158

00:19:06,300 --> 00:19:10,300

People were buying and selling, pledging and borrowing, thinking the good times would never end.

159

00:19:10,300 --> 00:19:14,300

And then at the time of the crash, they pulled the plug on the money supply,

160

00:19:14,300 --> 00:19:20,300

and the people who had pledged their stocks, their bonds, their homes, their cars, everything.

161

00:19:20,300 --> 00:19:24,300

They pledged their savings accounts. They lost it all.

162

00:19:25,300 --> 00:19:36,300

Selling guns to one adversary while making loans to another is a common way these boys make their profits during war.

163

00:19:36,300 --> 00:19:43,300

And when profits begin sagging, people like Jacob Schiff, Max Warburg and J.P. Morgan knew how to build them up again.

164

00:19:43,300 --> 00:19:53,300

Surprise, surprise, it's a documented fact that these fellows financed Trotsky and Lenin with billions in golden credit to initiate the revolution in Russia.

165

With Russia out of the war and America in, the conflict was extended by at least another two years.

166

00:19:59,300 --> 00:20:07,300

Two more glorious years of gun sales and wartime bank loans, upon which to earn interest for many more years to come.

167

There is no question that war is a profit-making business.

168

00:20:11,300 --> 00:20:17,300

After World War I, Senator Gerald Nye held very famous hearings here in Washington,

169

00:20:17,300 --> 00:20:28,300

where he dragged in some of the biggest bankers and industrialists and put them on the spot and just examined profits that were made by some of these major interests.

170

War is a profit-making business. Anybody who says otherwise is a liar or a fool.

171

00:20:34,300 --> 00:20:46,300

They were able to manipulate us into World War I, and as a matter of fact, the war dredged out for at least another two years beyond what it would have gone.

172

00:20:47,300 --> 00:20:56,300

Just when you think you're ahead of the game, someone changes the rules.

173

00:20:56,300 --> 00:21:07,300

They did this knowing, with malice of forethought, to strengthen their own profits and to build their own institutions, their own banking institutions.

174

00:21:07,300 --> 00:21:21,300

Many people believe that virtually all the wars of this century have been caused for reasons that benefit small financial groups, those that move in the sphere of influence of the Bilderberg and trilateral commission.

175

00:21:21,300 --> 00:21:36,300

For an example, the war in the Balkans right now, who's been providing malice of it with arms and weapons the Soviets have, who has been financing the Soviet Union, their military industrial complex the United States has, European bankers have.

176

So the bankers have been financing both sides of every major conflict. Conflict brings progress, but control conflict brings control progress.

177

Every major war, every major conflict, arms sales, loaning money to governments, you get their people to pay you interest back into the coffers of the bank, money that you created out of nothing.

178

Nobel Prize winning economist Milton Friedman claimed that the Federal Reserve caused the Great Depression by deliberately reducing the amount of money in circulation.

179

Depositors all over the country were frightened about the safety of their funds and rushed to withdraw them. There were runs, there were failures of banks by the droves, and all the time the Federal Reserve system stood idly by when it had the power and the duty and the power.

180

The duty and the responsibility to provide the cash that would have enabled the banks to meet the insistent demands of their depositors without closing their doors.

181

00:22:42,300 --> 00:23:00,300

Congressman Lewis McFetten, chairman of the House Banking Committee during the crash, agreed, saying, the Great Depression was a carefully contrived occurrence by international bankers seeking to bring about a condition of despair so that they might emerge as the rulers of us all.

There was a memo circulated in advance of the stock market collapse. All the big guys, the insiders, let's say, got out of the stock market during that four year period. They all got out, they were cash heavy when the market crashed.

183

They were able to buy up major corporations for pennies on the dollar.

184

00:23:17,300 --> 00:23:28,300

Franklin Roosevelt's own son-in-law called the Depression the deliberate shearing of the public by the world money power, triggered by the planned sudden shortage of call money in the New York markets.

185

Insider Joseph Kennedy's wealth grew from four million in 1929 to over 100 million four years later.

186

Then as now, America's press failed to tell us what was happening. These scenes of unrest in America have never been seen before.

187

Cameraman would shoot them, but newsreels wouldn't play them. Controlling the news started early in America.

188

Of course, the lighter side of the news continued to get lots of black.

Fortunately, populists from President Andrew Jackson to William Jennings Bryan to Father Charles Coughlin were courageous enough to speak the truth.
