impact. What's this fancy instrument all about? What is that? This is a high resolution metal

down to a depth of four to five feet. So this essentially will give us the road map to tell us

where we need to dig. He has a high resolution metal detector which is great if what we're looking

for is actually made out of metal. Who knows, it's supposed to be a spaceship, right? And then we'll

follow it up with this other instrument. This is the ground penetrating radar. With this instrument

we hope to find disturbed soil layers if they exist. Dave Heidman's equipment looks like a lawnmower

to me. A really expensive lawnmower. Let me tell you, it does look like a lawnmower. Can I try it?

set up a grid and started excavating. You get a hit, we dig a hole. We just found apparent

metals that are interesting and that we're going to dig out and see what's down there.

If we're about to unearth the first piece of an extra-trust real vessel, we want to be very

224

really excited when this happened, and I was really excited too. Your main goal on your first pass

226

is just to pick up the vegetation. There's something here, it's going to be right close to the surface.

Looks for anything that looks man-made or doesn't look natural to this environment.

228

I don't see anything. It looks like rocks to me and grass.

Guys, I'm hitting like a metal piece right here. Just go here, just lift up, top, fold it off.

Trying to uncover it rather than dislodge it.

231

Does that look recognizable to anyone?

232

I want to get some shots of the people we actually picked up. It was a piece of metal about

six, seven inches long. It's curved. Can I pick it up? No, not yet. Let me get a shot in here.

exactly what you might find out here in the ranching country. So it wasn't a piece of a spacing.

Good find. Oh yeah. It's found big-smear'd poop over there too earlier. A UFO might have crashed

out in the house. Debris and gouges are one thing but we all heard the stories that her grandfather

people being told in no uncertain terms if you talk about what you saw will kill you and your family.

Today Rich and I went to the Roswell Army base, the Hangar 84 where we met with a witness that

367

came forward for the first time in public. He was reluctant for a long time to come forward.

He was a first-hand witness to an actual the actual wreckage of the Roswell crash in 1947.

Here we are in a pretty big hangar. In this place here he brings a lot of memories.

370

He doesn't want his his name out there. He's afraid of losing his pension. That's what he said to me

371

privately off the camera. And you know what he's not the first such Roswell witness to say this

372

00:33:24,840 --> 00:33:33,640

type of a thing. I wonder if you can just give us a kind of summary of what you saw when you were

373

00:33:33,640 --> 00:33:40,200

here in July of 1947 working at Roswell Army Airfield. Well it was very unusual because

374

when I first got here I was told that what I was going to see I never saw it. I never

375

was proposed to talk about it. You saw wreckage. Yeah. And it did it look like aircraft wreckage?

Like an ordinary kind of plane that might have gone down? I've seen a lot of aircraft wreckage and

they hit the ground. They burned. You can see a lot of burned pieces of what's left over. On this thing

you didn't have that kind of appearance. Yes I'm skeptical but I have to say that in my heart that

379

00:34:19,640 --> 00:34:24,920

it wasn't a weather balloon. So what happened when you went to the hospital? One door there at the

380

00:34:24,920 --> 00:34:31,960

hospital was partially open on the corridor there. Yes. And there was a terrible water there. It was

381

00:34:32,920 --> 00:34:41,480

a smell you know. And inside they were working in a small creature. Did it look human? No. No.

382

You feel confident that that was not a human being?

383

00:34:48,600 --> 00:34:53,720

No I don't think it was a human being. I asked him a couple of times trying to get a sense of did

384

00:34:53,720 --> 00:34:58,600

you really think this was a non-human? He seemed to think it was a non-human. He seemed to be pretty

385

00:34:58,600 --> 00:35:05,000

sure about that. Could you give me any details about what the face looked like? Did you see eyes,

386

00:35:05,000 --> 00:35:13,080

nose, mouth? The nose was a little much portion. He wasn't a regular nose like that.

387

He was much just protruded something a little. Was he dead or alive? He was still alive. This one was

388

moved a little and he moved slow and then he moved the other way.

389

How close did you get to this creature in the hospital? About roughly about 20 feet.

390

Well thank you so much for talking to us. I really appreciate it. Thank you.

Thank you. He believes in his heart that he saw something that didn't come from this world.

392

I got a real feeling from him that he was telling the truth.

We're left with the testimony of this clearly very sincere,

394

00:35:59,720 --> 00:36:05,080

seeming man. I would have a very hard time trying to say I don't believe you.

395

Has your attitude about Roswell evolved at all? I feel a little different. Now that I'm actually

396

00:36:12,440 --> 00:36:17,560

at the place where the event happened. I've changed my mind over this whole journey. I was

397

really skeptical coming into it. Something happened here. There's no question. There's no doubt in

398

00:36:22,040 --> 00:36:30,920

my mind that something went on. Lisa wanted to visit the UFO Museum in Roswell. I decided to go talk

399

00:36:30,920 --> 00:36:37,400

to Stanley Friedman. There are a lot of people who've looked into the Roswell case but he spent

400

00:36:37,400 --> 00:36:42,520

the most number of years talking to probably the most number of witnesses on Roswell and he's really

401

00:36:42,520 --> 00:36:48,520

the person responsible for bringing Roswell into the public eye at all. You've done extensive

402

00:36:48,520 --> 00:36:53,400

research on the government's role in Roswell incident. Do you think that there was a cover-up?

403

00:36:53,400 --> 00:36:58,520

There's no question that they have been lying through their teeth. Why wouldn't the Air Force

404

00:36:58,520 --> 00:37:04,360

be telling the truth? At least initially it was probably legitimate concerns with national security.

405

00:37:04,360 --> 00:37:08,040

We don't know what these things are. We don't know where they're coming from. How can we go public

406

00:37:08,040 --> 00:37:15,320

and say we can't defend the country? We spoke with a man who said he was afraid all these years

407

00:37:15,320 --> 00:37:18,920

to come forward because he's afraid of losing his pension. He's afraid of other possible

408

00:37:18,920 --> 00:37:23,880

repercussions because of what he knows about Roswell. Do you find that believable? I certainly

409

00:37:23,880 --> 00:37:30,040

find that credible. Yes. And you know we've also heard people being told the no uncertain terms.

410

00:37:30,040 --> 00:37:35,400

If you talk about what you saw, we'll kill you and your family. They put the fear of God in you.

411

00:37:36,040 --> 00:37:42,200

Look, New Mexico is a place that at that time had more classified work going than any place else.

412

00:37:42,200 --> 00:37:47,320

We met with Matt Brasl's granddaughter. She recalled her grandfather talking about

413

00:37:47,960 --> 00:37:52,840

those poor little creatures and she says, look, he was talking exactly about aliens.

414

00:37:52,840 --> 00:37:58,280

It is pretty credible that he would have seen that and have been debriefed very strongly,

415

00:37:58,920 --> 00:38:04,040

not to say anything under any conditions. The Air Force said that there were no

416

00:38:04,120 --> 00:38:09,960

alien bodies at Roswell but that there were crash test dummies. They said that they dropped these

417

00:38:09,960 --> 00:38:16,360

dummies at high altitudes for certain tests. Do you find that credible? Not at all. The dummies

418

00:38:16,360 --> 00:38:22,680

were six feet tall and 175 pounds and they weren't dropped until six years after Roswell and how you

419

00:38:22,680 --> 00:38:29,080

can get those to morph into little guys like this. I just don't understand. The Air Force's main

420

00:38:29,080 --> 00:38:34,120

explanation for Roswell was that it wasn't a flying saucer but rather it was a kind of balloon

421

00:38:34,120 --> 00:38:38,840

that called it the mogul balloon which was used to do testing to see when the Soviets were going

422

00:38:38,840 --> 00:38:42,440

to detonate on the Thomas bomb. What do you think about that? I think they're full of

423

00:38:42,440 --> 00:38:48,440

bologna. There was nothing classified about the technology of mogul balloons. Mogul had standard

424

00:38:48,440 --> 00:38:54,680

conventional weather balloons at this time. The purpose of mogul was classified. But not the technology

425

00:38:55,480 --> 00:39:03,800

They often were led to rot in the desert. I do think Roswell was a cover-up. I think that's

426

00:39:03,800 --> 00:39:08,120

the most plausible scenario that I can concede for everything that happened.

427

Coming up, Rich and Lisa head back to the dig site but will the unforgiving desert finally

428

00:39:16,920 --> 00:39:19,160

reveal its deepest secrets?

429

We didn't find any alien debris but we were still holding out hope that by digging a few trenches

430

00:39:36,840 --> 00:39:42,600

we might find evidence of an old furrow in the ground that is now covered up. In 2002 I found

431

00:39:42,600 --> 00:39:47,560

this V-shaped mark in the side of a trench that I thought might be evidence of a UFO

432

00:39:48,200 --> 00:39:54,040

skidding across the earth some 60 years ago. But I didn't have a chance to dig around this one mark

433

00:39:54,040 --> 00:39:59,960

to see if it continued. If it does, it might validate claims that a UFO did strike the ground here.

434

Hey guys, I want to show you what we got in these backhoe trenches. What you find, Bill?

435

00:40:06,200 --> 00:40:10,680

What's going on? Just a few minutes ago we took a look at the excavated dig site

436

00:40:11,240 --> 00:40:15,160

and Bill Doleman gave an explanation as to what he thinks was going on with that.

437

00:40:15,880 --> 00:40:21,560

Bill, is there evidence of a fissure, of a gash of some sort, any kind of impact, and what you're

438

00:40:21,560 --> 00:40:26,360

seeing? No, these signals are the results of a totally understandable natural process.

439

When we got the signal we said well either there's a furrow there or there's bedrock

440

00:40:31,240 --> 00:40:36,200

near the surface. It turned out to be bedrock near the surface. What's the next step? What do we do now?

441

There's only one other thing for us to do.

442

00:40:43,000 --> 00:40:48,920

And I thought we need to answer this question now and I brought Alleycat and his backhoe in and he

443

00:40:48,920 --> 00:40:55,080

used the front-end loader to carefully just shave across the entire thing and so that we would have

444

00:40:55,080 --> 00:41:03,720

a smooth surface and we could clean it up and then see if that furrow showed up in the plan view

445

00:41:04,360 --> 00:41:09,800

of that area. I'll give you an old burrow or an old furrow.

446

It didn't. We haven't found anything that I wouldn't consider to be evidence of a furrow.

447

There were pretty much two huge highlights today. The first one was when I had to open the

448
