Yesterday on the ranch, we found that a two-year-old cow

38

that had gotten completely separated from the rest of the herd

39

just suddenly died and for no apparent reason.

Jim, have you seen anything on the Spectre Matalizer?

which allowed pneumonia to set in.

53

Exactly, yeah.

54

All the signs I've seen point toward stress-induced pneumonia.

55

Luckily, one of Eric Bart's surveillance cameras

56

actually captured the moment that the cow died.

It also captured something else,

58

something that appears to be a UFO

59

in the sky directly overhead.

Go back and show them where you first see it, Eric.

61

Okay, so this is our first shot of it.

62

And I'm going to go single-stepping one frame at a time.

It actually popped.

64

It says that 1-1-1 of a second video.

65

It's 1-15. This is 1-15.

1-15.

And so, clearly, it's behind the trees.

68

And, you know, the distance from the camera to the trees is how far?

69

It's about 75 feet between the tree that you see on the far right

70

and the next tree to the left.

So if it's directly over the tree line,

72

it moves 75 feet in a 15th of a second.

It means it moved about 1,000 feet in a second.

That's fast as a high-powered rifle bullet.

So if it's just beyond the tree, it could be moving

84

There's an interesting thing that I noticed

86

when we were looking at it earlier.

87

If you could pull the one words directly over the cow

88

and zoom in on the thing.

89

You want to go in tighter?

90

Yep.

Uh, if you look around the spot,

92

there's an area that looks a little bit different.

93

Hey, Louis. Yeah.

94

And I noticed it when I did an analysis of the Tic Tac video

95

that the Navy has.

96

Oh, my gosh.

97

And the wind's 120 knots in the west.

98

But there's a good thing.

101

AATIP, or ATIP.

104

And this program was actually put in place

105

to look at unknown aerial phenomena, UFOs.

106

Oh, my gosh, dude. Wow.

And there's a gimbal video that was released

108

in a Tic Tac video.

And all these videos show a vehicle

110

that's flying with some type of propulsion

111

that we don't know of.

112

We can't understand what it is by looking at the video.

113

When we looked at it on a flare,

114

that told us that it was cold and the craft was warm.

115

And then you got ambient air around it.

116

During my first meeting with the skin walker team,

117

Brandon showed me a photo of a UFO

118

that was taken above the ranch.

One of the first things that we captured on the property

120

was an interesting object just over the mesa.

121

And it looked to have that same kind of halo around it,

122

something that I believe is caused by a temperature differential.

123

And that's something I've seen in a number of other UFO videos.

124

It could be a highly, highly classified thing,

125

but here's the thing.

If there's a project that's that classified,

127

that level of technology so far advanced

128

from the rest of the technology we have on the planet,

129

that's real hard to swallow.

130

Two things we don't know.

131

Are we dealing with a craft that is moving point to point

132

00:06:24,000 --> 00:06:28,000

and has influence on the brain of that cop?

133

And the fact that the herd is not around.

134

I don't know that I have seen them pushed up

135

00:06:34,000 --> 00:06:36,000

to that side of the ranch since we brought them on.

136

So that behavior by itself was unusual.

137

I saw the cow and it's not a mutilation.

138

00:06:44,000 --> 00:06:47,000

But somehow that animal was sick enough,

139

00:06:47,000 --> 00:06:51,000

or affected enough, or manipulated enough,

140

00:06:51,000 --> 00:06:55,000

it was left behind all the herd.

141

00:06:55,000 --> 00:06:59,000

And it is that that has been reported over and over

142

00:06:59,000 --> 00:07:02,000

in animal mutilation cases.

143

Is it related in some way?

144

I think we're seeing a reaction to something

145

in its environment at the very end,

146

00:07:11,000 --> 00:07:13,000

and it's enough of a reaction that it's making

147

00:07:13,000 --> 00:07:16,000

a deathly ill cow want to move.

148

00:07:16,000 --> 00:07:17,000

Get out of there.

149

00:07:17,000 --> 00:07:19,000

We very well could have prevented

150

00:07:19,000 --> 00:07:22,000

a full-blown cattle mutilation from occurring.

151

00:07:22,000 --> 00:07:23,000

That's a possibility.

152

00:07:23,000 --> 00:07:24,000

Possibility.

153

00:07:24,000 --> 00:07:26,000

It's oddly serendipitous.

154

00:07:26,000 --> 00:07:29,000

You know, it's one of those things we continue to hit home

155

that correlation isn't causation.

156

But we have two really interesting phenomena

157

occurring at exactly the same time,

158

00:07:36,000 --> 00:07:38,000

very near the same spatial location.

159

It really makes you want to look deeper to see,

160

00:07:41,000 --> 00:07:44,000

can we prove the cow moved because of that thing?

161

Man, you just got to wonder if this object appeared

162

00:07:48,000 --> 00:07:53,000

at just the same time this cow is dying its last breath.

163

00:07:53,000 --> 00:07:54,000

And then just after the fact,

164

00:07:54,000 --> 00:07:57,000

we're measuring all these weird electromagnetic signals.

165

Is that a coincidence?

166

00:07:59,000 --> 00:08:01,000

We're out in the middle of nowhere.

167

00:08:01,000 --> 00:08:03,000

So, which begs the question, Linda,

168

have you seen with other cases you have investigated

169

00:08:07,000 --> 00:08:12,000

these type of phenomena attend cattle mutilations

170

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:15,000

and other events?

171

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:19,000

The sudden separation of a herd that goes completely as far

172

00:08:19,000 --> 00:08:20,000

as they can go in a pasture,

173

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:23,000

leaving the animal that is found mutilated,

174

00:08:23,000 --> 00:08:26,000

that's happened many, many times.

175

00:08:26,000 --> 00:08:30,000

What about the electromagnetic type of anomalies?

176

00:08:30,000 --> 00:08:34,000

I feel strongly where there are mutilations,

177

00:08:34,000 --> 00:08:36,000

where there are UFOs,

178

00:08:36,000 --> 00:08:39,000

you're going to find that there are magnetic anomalies.

179

00:08:39,000 --> 00:08:41,000

They go together.

180

00:08:41,000 --> 00:08:45,000

And that includes the running down of batteries.

181

Wow.

182

00:08:47,000 --> 00:08:49,000

That's, we get that all the time.

183

It's really weird that when strange things seem to happen,

184

00:08:53,000 --> 00:08:56,000

we seem to find something in the sky at the same time.

185

I think we are dealing with point to point.

186

I think we're dealing with portals.

187

00:09:01,000 --> 00:09:04,000

I think we are dealing with advanced technology.

188

00:09:04,000 --> 00:09:09,000

You've got the combination of just about every high strangeness

189

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:12,000

going on here at Skinwalker Ranch.

190

But after being here for a day,

191

00:09:15,000 --> 00:09:19,000

I think the chapter has just simply turned.

192

And what I think gives me a new confidence

193

that maybe we're going to get some more data

194

00:09:26,000 --> 00:09:28,000

is because of the work you're doing.

195

So, hooray, you guys keep doing this

196

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:34,000

because this is maybe the only way we're really going to learn

197

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:37,000

some of the truth that has been hidden.

198

Absolutely.

199

00:09:39,000 --> 00:09:42,000

I think we're just starting to pull back the curtain

200

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:45,000

with our investigation here at Skinwalker Ranch.

201

And we'll look forward to further updates in the future.

a local veterinarian.

And what they found out was that it died of pneumonia

303

brought on by stress.

304

What we did record is we did record some anomalous object

305

in the sky above the cow before it died

306

00:13:56,000 --> 00:13:58,000

that it was reacting to.

307

00:13:58,000 --> 00:14:02,000

So you have biosensor in essence that reacted immediately

308

00:14:02,000 --> 00:14:03,000

to the event.

309

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:04,000

Absolutely.

310

00:14:04,000 --> 00:14:05,000

Something that scared it to death.

311

00:14:05,000 --> 00:14:07,000

That's a really good way to put it.

312

00:14:07,000 --> 00:14:09,000

Something that scared it to death.

313

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:12,000

It gets even stranger because after this cow died,

314

00:14:12,000 --> 00:14:14,000

we do what most ranchers do,

315

00:14:14,000 --> 00:14:16,000

and you drag it off to a corner,

316

00:14:16,000 --> 00:14:18,000

and you let the body decompose.

317

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:20,000

And let the scavengers have the body.

318

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:22,000

Yeah, and the typical thing is the coyotes and the scavengers

319

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:24,000

come in and they pick it clean.

320

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:27,000

I was just up there a week ago on a patrol,

321

00:14:27,000 --> 00:14:29,000

and I went over there where that cow's at,

322

00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:31,000

and it has not been touched.

323

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:35,000

To this day, not a single scavenger has touched that cow.

324

00:14:35,000 --> 00:14:37,000

Highly irregular.

325

00:14:37,000 --> 00:14:41,000

One of my graduate students grew up working on a cattle farm

326

00:14:41,000 --> 00:14:45,000

in Alabama, and he told me that if lightning ever struck

327

00:14:45,000 --> 00:14:48,000

one of the cows, that the predators would not eat it.

328

00:14:48,000 --> 00:14:50,000

Maybe something happened to this cow.

329

00:14:50,000 --> 00:14:52,000

We know it wasn't struck by lightning because there was

330

00:14:52,000 --> 00:14:55,000

no storms at the time, but we did measure really high

331

00:14:55,000 --> 00:14:59,000

microwaves, and maybe whatever these signals are is affecting

332

00:14:59,000 --> 00:15:02,000

this cow in such a way that it tainted it.

333

00:15:02,000 --> 00:15:04,000

And it's still sitting there.

334

00:15:04,000 --> 00:15:06,000

No, nothing has touched it.

335

00:15:06,000 --> 00:15:09,000

So there's something to that.

336

00:15:09,000 --> 00:15:12,000

And there was another day where we were launching rockets,

337

00:15:12,000 --> 00:15:16,000

for example, when suddenly we see so many phenomena

338

00:15:16,000 --> 00:15:18,000

across so many different regimes of measurement.

339

00:15:18,000 --> 00:15:21,000

While we were launching these rockets,

340

00:15:21,000 --> 00:15:25,000

the entire herd of about 40 cows come over to the area

341

00:15:25,000 --> 00:15:27,000

where we are.

342

00:15:27,000 --> 00:15:31,000

You might think that they would be frightened of our activity.

343

00:15:31,000 --> 00:15:33,000

You'd think they'd go away from us.

344

00:15:33,000 --> 00:15:36,000

Instead, during that activity, we watched the cattle come

345

00:15:36,000 --> 00:15:38,000

to the east field.

346

00:15:38,000 --> 00:15:39,000

They ran.

347

00:15:39,000 --> 00:15:41,000

Well, that was exactly the point.

348

00:15:41,000 --> 00:15:44,000

And some of them behaved as if they were in a panic.

349

00:15:44,000 --> 00:15:47,000

It was nearly stampeding behavior.

350

00:15:47,000 --> 00:15:49,000

Yeah.

351

00:15:49,000 --> 00:15:51,000

Look at the cows.

352

00:15:51,000 --> 00:15:53,000

That is the strangest thing.

353

00:15:53,000 --> 00:15:55,000

I've never seen that before.

354

00:15:55,000 --> 00:15:57,000

They all grouped together so tight they started fighting.

355

00:15:57,000 --> 00:15:59,000

They started to fight among each other,

356

00:15:59,000 --> 00:16:00,000

headbutting each other.

357

00:16:00,000 --> 00:16:01,000

They were moving.

358

00:16:01,000 --> 00:16:04,000

I thought they were going to take down the east fence.

359

00:16:04,000 --> 00:16:07,000

Something that gave them more concern than the sound

360

00:16:07,000 --> 00:16:08,000

of the rockets.

361

00:16:08,000 --> 00:16:11,000

And it's at the same time that the unidentified aerial

362

00:16:11,000 --> 00:16:14,000

phenomena start appearing in the sky.

363

00:16:14,000 --> 00:16:15,000

Really?

364

00:16:15,000 --> 00:16:16,000

Ignition.

365

00:16:19,000 --> 00:16:20,000

What is that?

366

00:16:20,000 --> 00:16:21,000

We got something.

367

00:16:21,000 --> 00:16:22,000

Hold on.

368

00:16:22,000 --> 00:16:23,000

Wait, wait.

369

00:16:23,000 --> 00:16:24,000

It's a plane, I think.

370

00:16:24,000 --> 00:16:26,000

No, that wasn't a plane.

371

00:16:26,000 --> 00:16:27,000

Oh, there it is again.

372

00:16:27,000 --> 00:16:28,000

There it is again.

373

00:16:30,000 --> 00:16:32,000

It's gone.

374

00:16:32,000 --> 00:16:35,000

It's one thing to have a light in the night

375

00:16:35,000 --> 00:16:37,000

or some random sighting,

376

00:16:37,000 --> 00:16:40,000

but when livestock start to literally fall over,

377

00:16:40,000 --> 00:16:43,000

not unheard of to have them die from time to time,

378

00:16:43,000 --> 00:16:45,000

but not under these kinds of circumstances,

379

00:16:45,000 --> 00:16:47,000

not with this many questions,

380

00:16:47,000 --> 00:16:51,000

or are bigger concern beyond livestock

381

00:16:51,000 --> 00:16:54,000

when this starts to potentially impact human beings.

382

00:16:54,000 --> 00:16:55,000

Yes.

383

00:16:55,000 --> 00:16:58,000

You found out firsthand, surprisingly,

384

00:16:58,000 --> 00:17:02,000

how dangerous this ranch can be.

385

00:17:02,000 --> 00:17:03,000

Absolutely.

386

00:17:03,000 --> 00:17:07,000

While we were out there, we were in a cave,

387

00:17:07,000 --> 00:17:10,000

and I was exposed to something that made me

388

00:17:10,000 --> 00:17:12,000

nearly pass out.

389

00:17:14,000 --> 00:17:16,000

Let me ask you a question, guys.

390

00:17:16,000 --> 00:17:18,000

Do any of y'all feel it swimming headed at all?

391

00:17:18,000 --> 00:17:19,000

You feeling it?

392

00:17:19,000 --> 00:17:20,000

I don't know.

393

00:17:20,000 --> 00:17:22,000

Slightly, I felt like I was not holding my balance well

394

00:17:22,000 --> 00:17:23,000

for a second there,

395

00:17:23,000 --> 00:17:25,000

so I put my hand over on the rock,

396

00:17:25,000 --> 00:17:27,000

and I'm feeling it now, too.

397

00:17:27,000 --> 00:17:29,000

And then a few days later,

398

00:17:29,000 --> 00:17:33,000

I was exposed to a fairly high dose of gamma ray radiation.

399

00:17:34,000 --> 00:17:36,000

That could be a ton of entrance for all we know.

400

00:17:36,000 --> 00:17:38,000

I'd like to know what's in this thing.

401

00:17:38,000 --> 00:17:40,000

Don't lift it up.

402

00:17:40,000 --> 00:17:43,000

I feel like I've got a little bit of a headache

403

00:17:43,000 --> 00:17:44,000

or something happening.

404

00:17:44,000 --> 00:17:45,000

Holy crap, mine's beeping.

405

00:17:45,000 --> 00:17:47,000

Your total dose is way up there.

406

00:17:47,000 --> 00:17:50,000

We were just exposed to ionizing radiation.

407

00:17:50,000 --> 00:17:52,000

So did you end up going to the hospital

408

00:17:52,000 --> 00:17:53,000

as a result of this?

409

00:17:53,000 --> 00:17:54,000

Yes, injuries.

410

00:17:54,000 --> 00:17:56,000

I had surgery as a result of those injuries.

411

00:18:00,000 --> 00:18:03,000

Maybe a week, maybe two weeks at most,

412

00:18:03,000 --> 00:18:05,000

after I got exposed to the radiation,

413

00:18:05,000 --> 00:18:07,000

I started getting a knot forming here,

414

00:18:07,000 --> 00:18:09,000

a bump coming out of my knuckle there.

415

00:18:09,000 --> 00:18:11,000

And then another bump started forming,

416

00:18:11,000 --> 00:18:13,000

and on into the summer,

417

00:18:13,000 --> 00:18:15,000

it kept getting bigger and bigger and started hurting.

418

00:18:15,000 --> 00:18:16,000

Yeah?

419

00:18:16,000 --> 00:18:17,000

That's nasty, man.

420

00:18:17,000 --> 00:18:19,000

So then I went ahead and had it x-rayed,

421

00:18:19,000 --> 00:18:21,000

and my doctor looked at it, and he says,

422

00:18:21,000 --> 00:18:24,000

well, you've got two bone spurs in there.

423

00:18:24,000 --> 00:18:26,000

They said, well, you're going to get a bone spurs.

424

00:18:26,000 --> 00:18:28,000

Because it's going to keep getting bigger and worse.

425

00:18:28,000 --> 00:18:30,000

And so they went in, and they took out a cyst

426

00:18:30,000 --> 00:18:32,000

that was almost as big as an M&M.

427

00:18:32,000 --> 00:18:34,000

There were like 18 stitches in there.

428

00:18:34,000 --> 00:18:36,000

Mm, that's a real...

429

00:18:36,000 --> 00:18:39,000

And it still feels like it's a broken finger.

430

00:18:39,000 --> 00:18:40,000

It's still a little bit painful,

431

00:18:40,000 --> 00:18:42,000

but it's healing fine.

432

00:18:42,000 --> 00:18:44,000

Wow.

433

00:18:44,000 --> 00:18:46,000

I believe that whatever this phenomena is

434

00:18:46,000 --> 00:18:48,000

that we've measured, every time we've measured it,

435

00:18:48,000 --> 00:18:50,000

we do get high energy levels and microwaves,

436

00:18:50,000 --> 00:18:52,000

and we do get high energy levels and microwaves.

437

00:18:52,000 --> 00:18:54,000

And we do get high energy levels and microwaves.

438

00:18:54,000 --> 00:18:56,000

And we've measured gamma rays.

439

00:18:56,000 --> 00:18:59,000

And so it's possible that whatever this is that's occurring

440

00:18:59,000 --> 00:19:02,000

is what's causing the injuries.

441

00:19:02,000 --> 00:19:04,000

But you're not the only one, right?

442

00:19:04,000 --> 00:19:06,000

No, there's...

443

00:19:06,000 --> 00:19:07,000

Winnerton had a...

444

00:19:07,000 --> 00:19:08,000

A serious one, yeah.

445

00:19:08,000 --> 00:19:10,000

I know, at least for my injury,

446

00:19:10,000 --> 00:19:12,000

and if I'm under the correct understanding

447

00:19:12,000 --> 00:19:14,000

of some of the other injuries,

448

00:19:14,000 --> 00:19:15,000

they couldn't explain it away.

449

00:19:15,000 --> 00:19:16,000

That's what...

450

00:19:16,000 --> 00:19:18,000

That's what the particular one you could...

451

00:19:18,000 --> 00:19:20,000

They never came to conclusion of what caused it,

452

00:19:20,000 --> 00:19:22,000

and they couldn't find what it was.

453

00:19:22,000 --> 00:19:23,000

Right?

454

00:19:23,000 --> 00:19:24,000

Yeah.

455

00:19:24,000 --> 00:19:26,000

Well, to your point, Thomas, too,

456

00:19:26,000 --> 00:19:28,000

when you talk about ranching injuries,

457

00:19:28,000 --> 00:19:30,000

we're not talking about broken bones and smashed hands.

458

00:19:30,000 --> 00:19:32,000

We're talking about radiation exposure.

459

00:19:34,000 --> 00:19:37,000

The injuries that Tom Winnerton experienced

460

00:19:37,000 --> 00:19:39,000

back two years ago were of the nature

461

00:19:39,000 --> 00:19:42,000

that he had a neurological episode

462

00:19:42,000 --> 00:19:45,000

and he had a big swelling in the back of his head.

463

00:19:46,000 --> 00:19:49,000

And his injuries was consistent with a radiation beam

464

00:19:49,000 --> 00:19:51,000

that entered his body from a specific angle

465

00:19:51,000 --> 00:19:53,000

back behind his head.

466

00:19:53,000 --> 00:19:55,000

So Thomas' injury really reinforces

467

00:19:55,000 --> 00:19:57,000

that this ranch could be very dangerous.

468

00:19:58,000 --> 00:20:00,000

And somehow, all of this is coupled.

469

00:20:00,000 --> 00:20:01,000

We just don't know how.

470

00:20:03,000 --> 00:20:04,000

Yeah.

471

00:20:04,000 --> 00:20:06,000

Obviously, we're experiencing things

472

00:20:06,000 --> 00:20:08,000

of a subjective nature.

473

00:20:08,000 --> 00:20:10,000

Something in our physiology is responding

474

00:20:10,000 --> 00:20:12,000

to something on the property,

475

00:20:12,000 --> 00:20:15,000

but we also see devices of many different kinds

476

00:20:15,000 --> 00:20:17,000

malfunctioning on the ranch.

477

00:20:17,000 --> 00:20:19,000

We're talking about the disruption

478

00:20:19,000 --> 00:20:22,000

of a handheld or a mobile device.

479

00:20:22,000 --> 00:20:24,000

Like the phones, right?

480

00:20:25,000 --> 00:20:26,000

My phone's freaking out.

481

00:20:26,000 --> 00:20:28,000

It's just been doing this for the last, you know,

482

00:20:28,000 --> 00:20:31,000

couple minutes and it just ran up here so you could see it.

483

00:20:31,000 --> 00:20:32,000

It was in my contacts.

484

00:20:32,000 --> 00:20:34,000

It tried calling a couple people

485

00:20:34,000 --> 00:20:36,000

and then it's been messing around in my camera.

486

00:20:36,000 --> 00:20:38,000

Dude, that is crazy.

487

00:20:40,000 --> 00:20:44,000

We are continuously dealing with some kind of interference

488

00:20:44,000 --> 00:20:46,000

that takes our systems down.

489

00:20:46,000 --> 00:20:48,000

And it's not one type of device.

490

00:20:48,000 --> 00:20:50,000

It's many kinds of devices.

491

00:20:50,000 --> 00:20:51,000

Right.

492

00:20:51,000 --> 00:20:54,000

You know, very often batteries are discharged.

493

00:20:54,000 --> 00:20:55,000

Yeah.

494

00:20:55,000 --> 00:20:56,000

Or things don't work correctly.

495

00:20:56,000 --> 00:20:57,000

Yeah.

496

00:20:58,000 --> 00:20:59,000

Oh, my gosh.

497

00:20:59,000 --> 00:21:03,000

I completely charged these four batteries last evening

498

00:21:03,000 --> 00:21:06,000

and now they're into the yellow section.

499

00:21:06,000 --> 00:21:07,000

When have you seen that before?

500

00:21:07,000 --> 00:21:10,000

I quite frankly have not seen that before.

501

00:21:14,000 --> 00:21:17,000

You name it, if it had electronics in it,

502

00:21:17,000 --> 00:21:19,000

it would have somehow or other it malfunctioned

503

00:21:19,000 --> 00:21:21,000

while we were out there this summer.

504

00:21:21,000 --> 00:21:23,000

It either turned itself off.

505

00:21:23,000 --> 00:21:25,000

It just wouldn't function.

506

00:21:25,000 --> 00:21:28,000

It's electronic control software didn't work.

507

00:21:28,000 --> 00:21:31,000

We had drones that worked fine one second

508

00:21:31,000 --> 00:21:35,000

and then move it 10 feet over and it wouldn't work at all.

509

00:21:36,000 --> 00:21:38,000

All right, let's do this.

510

00:21:38,000 --> 00:21:40,000

No connection.

511

00:21:40,000 --> 00:21:41,000

Huh.

512

00:21:41,000 --> 00:21:42,000

That's weird.

513

00:21:42,000 --> 00:21:44,000

I'm not connecting to the remote.

514

00:21:44,000 --> 00:21:46,000

I don't know what's happening with it.

515

00:21:46,000 --> 00:21:47,000

I don't know.

516

00:21:47,000 --> 00:21:49,000

I don't think this is a coincidence.

517

00:21:49,000 --> 00:21:52,000

I think what happened is that because we were all there,

518

00:21:52,000 --> 00:21:54,000

we were concentrated, we were doing experiments

519

00:21:54,000 --> 00:21:55,000

on a daily basis.

520

00:21:55,000 --> 00:21:57,000

Because it's going nuts.

521

00:21:57,000 --> 00:21:59,000

It's coming from up there.

522

00:21:59,000 --> 00:22:01,000

And we were doing lots of experiments

523

00:22:01,000 --> 00:22:03,000

that no one has ever really done on the ranch.

524

00:22:03,000 --> 00:22:04,000

Oh, you see that?

525

00:22:04,000 --> 00:22:05,000

Look, look, look.

526

00:22:05,000 --> 00:22:07,000

That caused the entity, the phenomena,

527

00:22:07,000 --> 00:22:08,000

whatever you want to call it,

528

00:22:08,000 --> 00:22:11,000

to actually show itself on a more frequent basis.

529

00:22:11,000 --> 00:22:13,000

That's a definite beam.

530

00:22:13,000 --> 00:22:16,000

It is clearly a beam going across there.

531

00:22:16,000 --> 00:22:18,000

What we're seeing might not just be the reactions

532

00:22:18,000 --> 00:22:20,000

of the phenomena.

533

00:22:20,000 --> 00:22:22,000

The phenomena might actually be trying to tell us something

534

00:22:22,000 --> 00:22:25,000

or show us something or lead us to something.

535

00:22:26,000 --> 00:22:31,000

As you've seen unidentified aerial phenomena appear simultaneous

536

00:22:31,000 --> 00:22:36,000

with other events, does that constitute contact?

537

00:22:36,000 --> 00:22:40,000

So we didn't, as far as I can tell,

538

00:22:40,000 --> 00:22:42,000

try and talk back to them,

539

00:22:42,000 --> 00:22:44,000

but we don't know that we didn't.

540

00:22:44,000 --> 00:22:46,000

We were launching rockets, for example,

541

00:22:46,000 --> 00:22:49,000

when a lot of them appeared over us.

542

00:22:49,000 --> 00:22:50,000

Right.

543

00:22:50,000 --> 00:22:51,000

Yeah.

544

00:22:51,000 --> 00:22:55,000

After having a month to reflect on all the things we did,

545

00:22:55,000 --> 00:22:59,000

the one thing that I just can't seem to quit thinking about really

546

00:22:59,000 --> 00:23:01,000

is while we were launching those rockets,

547

00:23:01,000 --> 00:23:03,000

we had all these experiences.

548

00:23:03,000 --> 00:23:06,000

We saw all these UFOs appearing in the sky.

549

00:23:06,000 --> 00:23:07,000

Look, look, look.

550

00:23:07,000 --> 00:23:08,000

What is that?

551

00:23:08,000 --> 00:23:09,000

And we measured with all these instruments.

552

00:23:09,000 --> 00:23:12,000

I wonder, were we communicating with whatever this phenomena is

553

00:23:12,000 --> 00:23:14,000

by launching these rockets and it said,

554

00:23:14,000 --> 00:23:16,000

hey, we're here and they said, hey, back.

555

00:23:16,000 --> 00:23:17,000

Oh, there it is.

556

00:23:17,000 --> 00:23:18,000

There it is again.

557

00:23:18,000 --> 00:23:20,000

It's still in the same spot.

558

00:23:20,000 --> 00:23:23,000

There's some communication possibly taking place

559

00:23:23,000 --> 00:23:27,000

in response to the experiments that you launched.

560

00:23:27,000 --> 00:23:28,000

Right.

561

00:23:28,000 --> 00:23:32,000

And also, if there are connections, what are they?

562

00:23:32,000 --> 00:23:33,000

Are we intelligent enough?

563

00:23:33,000 --> 00:23:35,000

Are we intuitive enough, perhaps,

564

00:23:35,000 --> 00:23:39,000

to understand if, in fact, we're being communicated with?

565

00:23:39,000 --> 00:23:40,000

Yep.

566

00:23:40,000 --> 00:23:45,000

Do any of the things that we've observed constitute communication?

567

00:23:45,000 --> 00:23:51,000

Well, there's absolutely no disputing the fact that we launched rockets.

568

00:23:51,000 --> 00:23:53,000

Phenomena occurred.

569

00:23:53,000 --> 00:23:57,000

I mean, within seconds and minutes of each other.

570

00:23:57,000 --> 00:24:01,000

It would be interesting to say it's just serendipitous,

571

00:24:01,000 --> 00:24:07,000

but never before on the ranch have you guys reported this much activity at one time.

572

00:24:07,000 --> 00:24:08,000

None to this level.

573

00:24:08,000 --> 00:24:09,000

It's unexplainable.

574

00:24:09,000 --> 00:24:10,000

Yep.

575

00:24:12,000 --> 00:24:16,000

We've never had physical evidence that we actually saw with our own eyes.

576

00:24:16,000 --> 00:24:21,000

We've never had recorded, electronically recorded data that we took with instruments.

577

00:24:21,000 --> 00:24:23,000

I mean, this is amazing.

578

00:24:23,000 --> 00:24:24,000

Yeah.

579

00:24:24,000 --> 00:24:27,000

And for those of us who look at a lot of evidence, that's the most credible type of evidence.

580

00:24:27,000 --> 00:24:30,000

The stuff that's happening right in front of your eyes, right?

581

00:24:30,000 --> 00:24:35,000

No chance for someone's memory to fade or to distort.

582

00:24:35,000 --> 00:24:37,000

So that's impressive.

583

00:24:37,000 --> 00:24:42,000

So what it tells us is, beyond a shadow of a doubt, there is some phenomena occurring,

584

00:24:42,000 --> 00:24:44,000

and we have measured the phenomena.

585

00:24:44,000 --> 00:24:46,000

The phenomena is real.

586

00:24:46,000 --> 00:24:49,000

Now the question is, what is this phenomenon?

587

00:24:49,000 --> 00:24:50,000

Fascinating.

588

00:24:50,000 --> 00:24:56,000

So, technologically, now we've advanced this whole thing, very, very high to high level,

589

00:24:56,000 --> 00:24:58,000

which means that we can take the next level.

590

00:24:58,000 --> 00:24:59,000

Right.

591

00:24:59,000 --> 00:25:00,000

Why can't we communicate with them?

592

00:25:00,000 --> 00:25:04,000

So now that brings up all these moral issues that falls on your shoulders.

593

00:25:04,000 --> 00:25:09,000

Whatever these are, are saying, hey, do we have permission to say hi back?

594

00:25:09,000 --> 00:25:10,000

Yeah.

595

00:25:10,000 --> 00:25:13,000

There are government agencies and divisions for interactions.

596

00:25:13,000 --> 00:25:15,000

We had them when we flew to the moon.

597

00:25:15,000 --> 00:25:21,000

We had to prepare, just in case, even in a one in a million chance that we made first contact,

598

00:25:21,000 --> 00:25:23,000

how do we interact?

599

00:25:23,000 --> 00:25:25,000

Who's going to interact?

600

00:25:25,000 --> 00:25:26,000

What's the message?

601

00:25:26,000 --> 00:25:27,000

Yeah.

602

00:25:27,000 --> 00:25:28,000

What are the protocols?

603

00:25:28,000 --> 00:25:29,000

Yeah, that's right.

604

00:25:29,000 --> 00:25:30,000

That's it, exactly.

605

00:25:30,000 --> 00:25:31,000

Right.

606

00:25:31,000 --> 00:25:35,000

Maybe that's what we do is just follow what's in that particular guidance.

607

00:25:35,000 --> 00:25:36,000

Yeah.

608

00:25:36,000 --> 00:25:37,000

Right.

609

00:25:37,000 --> 00:25:46,000

You know, as I've been listening, my head is swimming with ideas about what it all means.

Recently, I've been preparing, I guess we'll call it a model, prompted by measurements of

RF, in particular, microwave frequencies.

We've observed this summer.

615

For example, if there were a source projecting energy downwards towards the ground, then what

616

00:26:22,500 --> 00:26:27,000

we see in the model represents how it would be reflected by the terrain into the space

617

00:26:27,000 --> 00:26:28,000

above.

618

00:26:28,000 --> 00:26:33,000

One of our theories is that the Uinta basin looks like a very large radio antenna.

619

00:26:33,000 --> 00:26:37,000

It's a dish, because it's shaped parabolically.

620

00:26:37,000 --> 00:26:38,000

Right.

621

00:26:38,000 --> 00:26:42,120

And so if that's the case, whatever these weird signals we're seeing, they're bouncing off

622

00:26:42,120 --> 00:26:45,720

of it and being focused to somewhere, just like a dish focuses the energy.

623

00:26:45,720 --> 00:26:50,720

So, Attorney General Riz, what we're doing is we're fleshing out a hypothesis.

624

00:26:50,720 --> 00:26:52,200

We have some measurements.

625

00:26:52,200 --> 00:26:58,480

We have some data that are very suggestive that maybe what Travis just described is relevant

626

00:26:58,480 --> 00:27:00,800

somehow to what's going on.

627

00:27:00,800 --> 00:27:05,480

And so to visualize that problem, I decided to build this model.

628

00:27:05,480 --> 00:27:10,560

So what I'd like to do is to share some of the results of the modeling.

629

00:27:10,560 --> 00:27:17,280

So the data that we use to build this model comes from the United States Geologic Survey.

630

00:27:17,280 --> 00:27:20,840

This is terrain data that tells us what the lay of the land is.

631

00:27:20,840 --> 00:27:24,980

We plug that into the model and then turn it into a reflector.

632

00:27:24,980 --> 00:27:28,480

So we should all recognize this geography.

633

00:27:28,480 --> 00:27:29,480

Wow.

634

00:27:29,480 --> 00:27:37,480

So we're going to focus on the things that may happen that intersect with the ranch property.

635

00:27:37,480 --> 00:27:40,800

We are located where you see that graphic.

636

00:27:40,800 --> 00:27:43,440

Right, almost dead center.

637

00:27:43,440 --> 00:27:44,440

Yes.

638

00:27:44,440 --> 00:27:53,480

So what I did was construct a 60,000 square kilometer mirror and then producing a line

639

00:27:53,480 --> 00:27:59,040

of what you just described as radiation coming down from above.

640

00:27:59,040 --> 00:28:06,240

So we're going to look at how those rays interact with and reflect from this surface, which

641

00:28:06,240 --> 00:28:08,600

is what this next visual shows us.

642

00:28:08,600 --> 00:28:09,600

Wow.

643

00:28:09,600 --> 00:28:12,240

These little waves.

644

00:28:12,240 --> 00:28:17,520

This represents measurements of microwave frequencies that we had in the summer.

645

00:28:17,520 --> 00:28:23,360

We are looking at parallel rays of energy coming down from above, primarily for long

646

00:28:23,360 --> 00:28:27,320

wavelengths, not necessarily visible light.

647

00:28:27,320 --> 00:28:28,320

Incredible.

648

00:28:28,320 --> 00:28:29,320

Yeah, it's really cool.

649

00:28:29,320 --> 00:28:34,280

If you look at the ones right in the center, they're being focused.

650

00:28:34,280 --> 00:28:39,040

And the ones at the edge, you can see there is a significant focus where these things

651

00:28:39,040 --> 00:28:44,520

are being brought to a point and there's a big concentration of energy up here somewhere.

652

00:28:44,520 --> 00:28:47,360

If you think about it, that is amazing.

653

00:28:47,360 --> 00:28:49,040

Eric, this is so cool.

654

00:28:49,040 --> 00:28:50,040

Impressive.

655

00:28:50,040 --> 00:28:52,800

Based on Eric's visualization, I believe that the U.N.

656

00:28:52,800 --> 00:28:58,400

Tobacin could be acting almost like a satellite dish, one that both collects and directs energy

657

00:28:58,400 --> 00:29:01,160

from somewhere out in space.

658

00:29:01,160 --> 00:29:03,040

Big question.

659

00:29:03,040 --> 00:29:06,400

What could be causing this energy?

660

00:29:06,400 --> 00:29:07,400

That's the big question.

661

00:29:07,400 --> 00:29:09,040

That is the question of the day.

662

00:29:09,040 --> 00:29:11,160

So there's two possibilities.

663

00:29:11,160 --> 00:29:15,240

Right now we're thinking, okay, it's a reflective dish.

664

00:29:15,240 --> 00:29:19,800

And so maybe the energy's coming from space and it hits and it's being focused up.

665

00:29:19,800 --> 00:29:25,280

Or the other possibility is this could be acting like a lens and not just a dish.

666

00:29:25,280 --> 00:29:30,400

The source could be down here inside the earth and coming up through it and focusing.

667

00:29:30,400 --> 00:29:34,720

But to what end we don't know and we've got to come up with other measurements to figure

668

00:29:34,720 --> 00:29:38,400

out where the energy's coming from.

669

00:29:38,400 --> 00:29:42,240

So we've had the debate of whether it's below the earth or coming from above.

670

00:29:42,240 --> 00:29:44,480

I mean, it could be a combination of the two.

671

Absolutely.

672

00:29:45,480 --> 00:29:46,480

I agree.

673

00:29:46,480 --> 00:29:47,480

I agree 100%.

674

00:29:47,480 --> 00:29:48,480

There's a source and a destination.

675

00:29:48,480 --> 00:29:49,480

Were there, you know...

676

00:29:49,480 --> 00:29:53,360

Yeah, one of them is there's a source and to what end we've got to find out where they're

677

00:29:53,360 --> 00:29:54,360

coming from.

678

00:29:54,360 --> 00:29:55,360

Yeah.

679

00:29:55,960 --> 00:30:01,240

Now this also reminds me of something that what I found kind of troubling during the

680

00:30:01,240 --> 00:30:03,080

summer.

681

00:30:03,080 --> 00:30:11,400

You recall you did an exercise where you seemingly located a source, a concentration of signals

682

00:30:11,400 --> 00:30:13,200

fairly low.

683

00:30:13,200 --> 00:30:14,200

At about 5,000 feet.

684

00:30:14,200 --> 00:30:15,720

And I was just thinking about that.

685

00:30:15,720 --> 00:30:16,720

Right.

686

00:30:16,720 --> 00:30:19,880

And could you point in the vicinity of where you think that was?

687

00:30:19,880 --> 00:30:20,880

Yeah.

688

00:30:21,120 --> 00:30:25,720

So right in here you can see there is some convergence right there.

689

00:30:25,720 --> 00:30:30,640

There was a local focus and we launched a weather balloon with radio frequency and microwave

690

00:30:30,640 --> 00:30:31,840

instruments on it.

691

00:30:31,840 --> 00:30:35,280

And when it got to about that height, the instrument started failing.

692

00:30:35,280 --> 00:30:37,280

You guys ready?

693

00:30:37,280 --> 00:30:38,280

Yep.

694

00:30:38,280 --> 00:30:39,280

Good to go.

695

00:30:39,280 --> 00:30:40,280

All right, here we go.

696

00:30:40,280 --> 00:30:41,280

All right, slowly let it up.

697

00:30:41,280 --> 00:30:42,280

All right, keep going.

698

00:30:42,280 --> 00:30:43,280

You're good.

699

00:30:43,280 --> 00:30:45,080

Okay, we're clear.

700

00:30:45,080 --> 00:30:46,080

All right.

701

Man, that's a big balloon.

702

Yeah, ain't that cool?

Heck yeah.

But it failed right there, which suggests maybe the power was so high that it burned

706

out the instruments.

707

Wow.

708

And whether it's just bad luck or not, we never recovered the balloon either.

709

Interesting.

710

You never recovered the balloon?

711

00:31:08,360 --> 00:31:09,360

No.

712

00:31:09,360 --> 00:31:10,360

And we had GPS trackers on it.

713

So you lost it when it hit that point.

714

All of the instruments failed.

715

00:31:15,240 --> 00:31:17,240

All the other instruments failed.

716

What?

717

Wow.

718

You know, it's really intriguing and actually kind of startling a little bit is I've been

719

00:31:29,440 --> 00:31:35,120

contacted by some folks in the intelligence community that are really interested in what

720

we've found.

721

So is it they approached you?

722

How have they heard about?

They approached us.

Wow.

725

So we're being monitored.

726

Yep.

727

So we're being monitored.

728

00:31:58,440 --> 00:31:59,920

There are people interested in what we're doing.

729

00:31:59,920 --> 00:32:02,400

I find that really intriguing.

730

00:32:02,400 --> 00:32:03,400

They're going to tell us something.

731

00:32:03,400 --> 00:32:08,080

I don't know what, but my suspicion is they've measured a similar phenomenon, don't know

732

00:32:08,080 --> 00:32:10,600

what it is, and they want to compare notes.

733

And I find that really intriguing.

734

It's a very strange.

735

So what this tells us though is there are real government organizations who are interested

736

After being contacted by representatives of the government, including some folks in the

739

intelligence community, it was clear to me that someone had been following our progress

740

on the range.

741

00:32:37,600 --> 00:32:38,600

Look at that.

742

00:32:38,600 --> 00:32:39,600

What is that?

743

00:32:39,600 --> 00:32:41,600

There's a helicopter right up there.

744

00:32:41,600 --> 00:32:42,600

Yeah, sure is.

745

00:32:42,600 --> 00:32:43,600

You can hear it.

746

00:32:44,560 --> 00:32:46,440

I think it's hovering right there.

747

00:32:46,440 --> 00:32:48,640

I think somebody's watching us right now.

748

00:32:48,640 --> 00:32:49,960

That's exactly what it looks like.

749

00:32:49,960 --> 00:32:51,760

I think they're watching us, guys.

750

00:32:51,760 --> 00:32:55,680

So guys, I'm going to try to go in and look at the transponder data, see if I can figure

751

00:32:55,680 --> 00:32:56,680

out who it is.

752

00:32:56,680 --> 00:33:00,280

Yeah, that's a good idea, Eric.

753

00:33:00,280 --> 00:33:01,280

They should by law.

754

00:33:01,280 --> 00:33:02,280

Right?

755

00:33:02,280 --> 00:33:03,280

Be transponding.

756

00:33:03,280 --> 00:33:04,280

What we got, Eric?

757

00:33:04,280 --> 00:33:08,240

They didn't show up at all.

758

00:33:08,240 --> 00:33:12,200

So do you have a fear that there's a possibility of them shutting us down or?

759

00:33:12,200 --> 00:33:13,200

No.

760

00:33:13,200 --> 00:33:14,200

I think so.

761

00:33:14,200 --> 00:33:17,080

I think it's more they're going to encourage us to go in a direction.

762

00:33:17,080 --> 00:33:20,160

But do they want the world to know what's happening?

763

00:33:20,160 --> 00:33:22,280

They won't tell anybody.

764

00:33:22,280 --> 00:33:25,680

They may not, but I doubt they will acknowledge it.

765

00:33:25,680 --> 00:33:30,680

They ever had the meeting with us, but they will know what we know at that point.

766

00:33:30,680 --> 00:33:36,480

The fact that we're being monitored, that our efforts have received a higher level of

767

00:33:36,480 --> 00:33:42,720

attention and awareness within those channels, I think speaks to the reality of this ranch.

768

00:33:42,720 --> 00:33:43,720

I agree.

769

00:33:43,720 --> 00:33:45,560

I agree 100%.

770

00:33:45,560 --> 00:33:51,840

As we have obtained all of this data and evidence, I think now it is our responsibility to take

771

00:33:51,840 --> 00:33:52,840

this forward.

772

00:33:52,840 --> 00:33:58,720

But I'd like to hear from the team, what do we need to implement that will help us advance

773

00:33:58,720 --> 00:34:01,360

this research to the next level?

774

00:34:01,360 --> 00:34:07,360

So naturally, I'm interested in increasing our instrumentation bandwidth, our virtual

775

00:34:07,360 --> 00:34:09,360

presence on the property.

776

00:34:09,360 --> 00:34:14,200

We can't always be present at the same time I have a feeling, more than a feeling.

777

00:34:14,200 --> 00:34:18,880

I have the data that suggests that there are things taking place all the time that are

778

00:34:18,880 --> 00:34:22,240

part of this puzzle, and we want to collect as much of that as possible.

779

00:34:22,240 --> 00:34:24,040

That's a great idea.

780

00:34:24,040 --> 00:34:31,200

So another experiment that we really should do also is that we should design and construct

781

00:34:31,200 --> 00:34:39,360

a very good small satellite platform that we could get launched as a secondary payload

782

00:34:39,360 --> 00:34:40,360

pretty much for free.

783

00:34:40,360 --> 00:34:43,520

NASA has projects, especially we involve a university that will launch it for you for

784

00:34:43,520 --> 00:34:44,520

free.

785

00:34:44,520 --> 00:34:45,520

You don't have to pay to get it launched.

786

00:34:45,520 --> 00:34:49,080

And we would put it in an orbit that goes over the ranch.

787

00:34:49,080 --> 00:34:50,920

Wow.

788

00:34:50,920 --> 00:34:55,400

And so that we would continually get data from it.

789

00:34:55,400 --> 00:35:02,800

I want to try and reproduce stimulating the phenomena, like the rocket test day where

790

00:35:02,800 --> 00:35:08,960

we're doing measurements with the rockets and then suddenly we see so many phenomena.

791

00:35:08,960 --> 00:35:11,280

I want to see if we can reproduce that.

792

00:35:11,280 --> 00:35:16,280

Thomas has said before, maybe the ranch gets immune to it and we have to bring it up a

793

00:35:16,280 --> 00:35:17,280

notch each time.

794

00:35:17,280 --> 00:35:23,200

You know, do we do twice as many rockets the next time or do we do one bigger rocket?

795

00:35:23,200 --> 00:35:24,880

That is something we should really look at.

796

Right.

797

00:35:26,080 --> 00:35:30,720

So what I would propose, I think that it's important that we have a medical program

798

00:35:30,720 --> 00:35:35,760

with protocols in place before anybody steps back on that ranch in a significant way.

799

Yeah, health and safety is going to be important, especially given the fact that Tom and Travis

800

00:35:41,320 --> 00:35:47,640

both went to the hospital as a result of the activities of the last few months.

801

It would have been great to have had my vitals and all that being recorded when the dosimeter

802

00:35:53,240 --> 00:35:55,800

went off and said I was exposed to radiation.

803

00:35:55,800 --> 00:35:59,720

There is something going on that seems to emanate from the ground.

804

00:35:59,720 --> 00:36:01,840

How can we learn more about it?

805

00:36:01,840 --> 00:36:06,000

So I want to know how could we get a really deep core sample?

806

00:36:06,000 --> 00:36:09,360

Like, can we dig really, really, really deep?

807

00:36:09,360 --> 00:36:13,400

How do you feel about doing that digging or would you want to hire somebody?

808

00:36:13,400 --> 00:36:18,440

Because even when we did the core drilling, you know, you chose to position yourself away

809

00:36:18,440 --> 00:36:21,360

and you're the one that has suffered the ramifications of the digging.

810

And this goes way back to what we talked about when we first began this exercise.

811

I don't want to put you in harm's way.

812

Well, the points that we identified are not that deep.

They're not that far down.

817

15, 20 feet is not a big deal.

818

00:36:51,560 --> 00:36:53,600

I'm just going to wear my tin foil hard hat.

819

00:36:57,120 --> 00:37:03,520

I do have a lot of people around me that think without a doubt my injury was tied to the digging.

820

00:37:03,520 --> 00:37:05,960

Well, it's not conclusive that it was the digging.

821

00:37:05,960 --> 00:37:08,960

So that's why there's part of me that said, yeah, I would.

822

00:37:08,960 --> 00:37:11,880

I'd just be very cautious.

823

I have a question for you guys, though.

824

For the first time since you've owned the ranch,

825

you guys talk as if this ranch has a personality because we talked about how

828

00:37:29,360 --> 00:37:32,360

when you introduce somebody new, the ranch responds.

829

00:37:32,360 --> 00:37:33,480

Yeah, it's not a person.

830

00:37:33,480 --> 00:37:37,480

It's not an entity, but it responded.

831

00:37:37,480 --> 00:37:38,760

Yeah.

832

00:37:38,760 --> 00:37:43,800

I have to tell you guys, when Brandon first invited me in the first day I came in here,

833

00:37:43,840 --> 00:37:50,240

I honestly didn't know what to expect, but I didn't think you guys were really onto what you were onto.

834

00:37:50,240 --> 00:37:55,920

Because I don't believe 99% of the things that people claim they've seen.

835

00:37:55,920 --> 00:37:56,720

Right?

836

00:37:56,720 --> 00:38:02,120

I think this is in that 1% of the unexplainable weirdness, the what is it?

837

00:38:02,120 --> 00:38:12,160

And now we've got indisputable evidence that there is a real phenomena that's happening that is unexplainable.

838

Whatever you want to call it, high strangeness, it's real and it's there.

839

And I think the ramifications of it is world changing.

840

Agreed.

And I'll tell you what I told you when we started on this adventure.

842

I truly believe now more than ever, if this ranch can help us better understand the nature of the universe

and perhaps confirm that we're not alone, this will indeed be the greatest science project

844

00:38:38,760 --> 00:38:41,480

and endeavor of all time.

845

And as we move forward and take next steps, we appreciate you coming in and spending the time.

846

You have my personal interest, Brandon, and I just want to make sure you all understand.

847
