So as a result we didn't do much research into looking what's underneath the property.

There have been stories and legends of what might be underneath the ground here like ancient

You can't tell how deep it is or how far down it goes.

And so you know one of the days I was irrigating I thought you know just out of curiosity I'm

going to divert some of the water down into that hole and see how long it takes to fill

It took about three and a half hours to fill this thing up to the top.

Now the interesting thing was is that after taking three hours to fill it up the water

132

disappeared out of sight within 15 minutes.

Oh wow.

That's unbelievable.

135

I thought that water would be sitting there for weeks and so you know I think it would

136

That's a good idea.

You know the ground penetrating radar did show some strange anomalies at depth there.

Last year we did ground penetrating radar and we found some weird anomalies right in

We found some dome features anywhere from 8 to 25 feet.

We can follow that with some dye and perhaps trace the flow of that water and see if it

That's exciting.

We can address this right now then.

I mean these are great ideas and you know if it comes to the point where you are curious

158

about you know seeing what's deeper if we can't get satisfactory answers by the non-invasive

stuff then you know we'll have to open up that area of discussion when it comes to digging

160

We divert water into this hole and fill it up with this green dye that we can track.

You guys need to get out there and start looking for this stuff.

Is this the hole you were talking about?

182

Yeah.

183

How deep do you think it is?

184

You know I'm not sure.

185

They don't have much of that stuff piled up on there is it?

186

There's this hole over at Homestead 2.

187

It's filled with brush and trees and debris and I've observed water disappearing in very

188

00:12:26,560 --> 00:12:31,480

rapidly and the water's got to be going somewhere especially when I look around and all I see

189

00:12:31,480 --> 00:12:33,240

is clay everywhere.

190

Clay just doesn't allow water to seep in.

191

I can't help but wonder if it's not an opening or some kind of tunnel that this water is

192

escaping into.

You know I tried to poke down in there.

194

It feels like it could go down further but I just don't know.

195

I know it took a long time to fill up.

196

How about that?

197

But then it only took about 20 minutes to drain right?

198

Yeah about 15 minutes.

Now that tells you there's something, there's a hole or something under it right?

200

Yeah.

If all that water that Thomas dumped in this pit is not reappearing somewhere else on the

202

ranch then there has to be a massive void of some kind below it.

Nothing else would really explain it.

The question is whether or not it's a natural void and that's what we're going to find

205

out.

What's the what I need to do to help?

207

Well we're just getting this ditch opened up right here.

208

00:13:20,480 --> 00:13:22,960

This is a divert in the stream.

209

00:13:22,960 --> 00:13:28,000

So a couple feet away from this pit is a little irrigation ditch that takes the water out

210

00:13:28,000 --> 00:13:29,000

to the field.

211

00:13:29,000 --> 00:13:33,520

So we're going to dig a channel from this ditch and divert the water from going to the

212

00:13:33,520 --> 00:13:36,120

field and instead running into this sinkhole.

213

Come on, drag it.

214

00:13:40,120 --> 00:13:41,120

Sorry.

215

00:13:42,480 --> 00:13:44,480

That's easy.

216

00:13:44,480 --> 00:13:45,720

10 gallons a minute.

217

00:13:45,720 --> 00:13:49,800

Well that's about triple the rate that I had the first time.

218

00:13:49,800 --> 00:13:50,800

Easy 10 gallons a minute.

219

00:13:50,800 --> 00:13:53,280

Man I wish I had a 5 gallon bucket and a clock.

220

00:13:53,280 --> 00:13:56,240

I actually think I may have a 5 gallon bucket over there.

221

00:13:56,480 --> 00:13:58,760

Let me go see if I can find one.

222

00:13:58,760 --> 00:14:02,200

I want to measure just how much water we're dumping in this pit.

223

00:14:02,200 --> 00:14:04,600

So with a 5 gallon bucket and a stopwatch.

224

Oh hey here we go.

225

00:14:05,680 --> 00:14:08,440

I'll calculate how long it takes to fill it up.

226

00:14:08,440 --> 00:14:10,720

Alright I'm ready when you are.

227

00:14:10,720 --> 00:14:12,840

Three, two, one, go.

228

00:14:15,720 --> 00:14:17,880

So that's about 4 gallons and 2 seconds.

229

120 gallons a minute.

230

00:14:20,200 --> 00:14:24,480

Even as fast as that's going in I'm still shocked it's not coming up faster.

231

Right.

232

00:14:25,920 --> 00:14:30,040

If this rate is going to be filled up before I get down there and back so I'm going to

233

00:14:30,040 --> 00:14:33,240

go get Eric and the rest of the people and die.

234

Okay.

235

00:14:34,240 --> 00:14:35,240

Alright I'll be right back.

236

00:14:35,240 --> 00:14:36,240

That sounds good.

237

00:14:36,240 --> 00:14:38,360

Man y'all don't go swimming in that.

238

00:14:38,360 --> 00:14:40,880

Ain't no telling what's at the bottom of it.

239

00:14:40,880 --> 00:14:42,880

We're not from Alabama.

240

00:14:42,880 --> 00:14:43,880

Ha!

241

00:14:43,880 --> 00:14:49,560

We're bringing the whole team out to the sinkhole so we'll have more eyes to look around in case

242

00:14:49,560 --> 00:14:51,200

something happens.

243

00:14:51,200 --> 00:14:56,520

Our plan is to use a green dye that's a tracker dye.

244

00:14:56,520 --> 00:15:00,360

Perfectly safe, environmentally friendly so it's not going to hurt anything.

245

00:15:00,360 --> 00:15:04,080

And you pour it in the water and you watch for it to come out somewhere and you'll know

246

00:15:04,080 --> 00:15:06,920

that that's the pathway that the water is taking.

247

00:15:06,920 --> 00:15:09,920

Look what the cat dragged in guys.

248

00:15:09,920 --> 00:15:10,920

What's up Casey?

249

00:15:10,920 --> 00:15:13,320

Welcome back man.

250

00:15:13,320 --> 00:15:14,320

I'm Casey Smith.

251

00:15:14,320 --> 00:15:16,480

I work for Qualtech Associates.

252

00:15:16,480 --> 00:15:20,840

I have a degree in geology particularly hydrology so it's groundwater.

253

00:15:20,880 --> 00:15:23,040

So they want to bring me in to help with the tracer test.

254

00:15:23,040 --> 00:15:24,040

You guys ready to put this in?

255

00:15:24,040 --> 00:15:26,040

Yeah I tell you we need to pour it in.

256

00:15:26,040 --> 00:15:27,040

Alright.

257

00:15:27,040 --> 00:15:28,440

I'll watch your stuff.

258

00:15:28,440 --> 00:15:30,640

It's cool when you...look at that.

259

00:15:30,640 --> 00:15:31,640

Is that not awesome?

260

00:15:31,640 --> 00:15:32,640

No what I expected.

261

00:15:32,640 --> 00:15:33,640

It's like the ninja turtles.

262

00:15:33,640 --> 00:15:34,640

Oh yeah.

263

00:15:34,640 --> 00:15:37,720

You're the secret of the ooze here.

264

As this mixes it may take a little while for it to go.

265

Here's what I think what we should do is stop it as close to completely as we can.

266

The next thing we need to do is dam up our flow of water into the pit so the dye can

267

00:15:53,360 --> 00:15:55,120

drain out.

268

00:15:55,120 --> 00:15:58,520

Then we can all go check to see if it emerges anywhere else on the ranch.

269

If not then there's only one place to look.

Eric what do you want to do?

Well I think we should head to the south down to the creek.

277

00:16:19,080 --> 00:16:22,840

I'll take Tom and Candice and we'll go hit this middle section right here.

278

Okay sure.

279

00:16:23,840 --> 00:16:28,720

Hey guys it's already dropped a foot since we just stopped.

280

00:16:28,720 --> 00:16:32,040

I mean I set these bottles right at the edge of the water.

281

00:16:32,040 --> 00:16:35,240

So it's draining quickly you guys need to get out there and start looking for this stuff

282

00:16:35,240 --> 00:16:36,240

right.

283

00:16:36,240 --> 00:16:37,240

Sounds good we'll get out of here.

284

00:16:45,160 --> 00:16:47,240

Nice.

285

00:16:47,240 --> 00:16:51,440

I was really fortunate that my friend Ziko was able to join Eric and I.

286

00:16:51,440 --> 00:16:56,800

He's a drone operator so that we could cover way more ground and be able to you know hopefully

287

00:16:56,800 --> 00:16:59,840

see if there was any dye coming out.

288

00:16:59,840 --> 00:17:05,040

We went to one part where we thought it may come out into the river.

289

00:17:05,040 --> 00:17:08,960

If we find the dye coming out in the river or in the field somewhere you know what that's

290

00:17:08,960 --> 00:17:13,280

an answer so we have an answer to the question.

291

00:17:13,280 --> 00:17:14,280

This the spot?

292

00:17:14,280 --> 00:17:15,680

Yeah this is it.

293

00:17:15,680 --> 00:17:21,040

Now if we don't find it then you know it's going to warrant further investigation.

294

00:17:21,040 --> 00:17:26,920

So I think if we land right in about this area you could probably get drone footage.

295

00:17:26,920 --> 00:17:28,120

Oh cool.

296

00:17:28,120 --> 00:17:31,640

Up and around plus we can see with our physical eyes the water coming down here.

297

00:17:31,640 --> 00:17:33,040

Alright should we throw it up?

298

00:17:33,040 --> 00:17:34,040

Yeah put it up.

299

00:17:34,040 --> 00:17:35,760

I'm anxious to see you fly this thing.

300

00:17:35,760 --> 00:17:36,760

Let's see what happens.

301

00:17:36,760 --> 00:17:47,160

Can you just tell me which way you want me to go?

302

00:17:47,160 --> 00:17:49,880

Yeah the homesteads are off in that direction.

303

00:17:49,880 --> 00:17:50,880

Okay.

304

00:17:50,880 --> 00:17:54,480

So I mean you can follow the river back up.

305

00:17:54,480 --> 00:18:02,560

If you see any discoloration just shut it out.

306

00:18:02,560 --> 00:18:05,040

So let's just follow this water channel.

307

00:18:05,040 --> 00:18:08,200

There's a good trail through here and we'll just go all the way down and see if we can

308

00:18:08,200 --> 00:18:11,120

find that dye.

309

00:18:11,120 --> 00:18:15,120

I personally thought that the water if it might come up anywhere would be one of the

310

00:18:15,120 --> 00:18:20,240

areas that I've been able to go through doing a lot of my patrols.

311

00:18:20,240 --> 00:18:22,160

There's areas of the ground that are very wet.

312

00:18:22,160 --> 00:18:26,480

I've gone through there where there's been about a foot of water in some areas and it's

313

00:18:26,480 --> 00:18:31,000

just random on where that water is coming up.

314

00:18:31,000 --> 00:18:32,000

Travis you got me?

315

00:18:32,000 --> 00:18:33,000

It's Caleb.

316

00:18:33,640 --> 00:18:35,920

Yeah, what's going on?

317

00:18:35,920 --> 00:18:37,720

We're just down in the southwest corner.

318

00:18:37,720 --> 00:18:41,240

It's pretty marshy through here so maybe it's coming up here somewhere.

319

00:18:41,240 --> 00:18:45,880

Well most of the water is drained out of the hole so we'll wind somewhere.

320

00:18:45,880 --> 00:18:46,880

Just keep looking.

321

00:18:46,880 --> 00:18:48,440

We'll do out.

322

00:18:48,440 --> 00:18:52,280

That's a lot of water that went away.

323

00:18:52,280 --> 00:18:53,480

Yeah.

324

00:18:53,480 --> 00:19:00,600

We put 45,000 gallons of water into this hole and at least 80% of it was gone within an

325

00:19:00,600 --> 00:19:01,600

hour.

326

00:19:01,720 --> 00:19:03,920

You know there's no telling where this is going to run out.

327

00:19:03,920 --> 00:19:05,920

To me that looks downhill.

328

00:19:05,920 --> 00:19:12,200

You know appearance yes we think that's downhill but what we don't see is you know what's

329

00:19:12,200 --> 00:19:13,200

underneath us right.

330

00:19:13,200 --> 00:19:17,280

We could have a bed layer that's you know sloping back towards the mesa.

331

00:19:17,280 --> 00:19:20,160

So that actually could be downhill for this water.

332

00:19:20,160 --> 00:19:21,160

Yeah.

333

00:19:21,160 --> 00:19:24,840

You know where we drilled is just right like what 20 feet right there?

334

00:19:24,840 --> 00:19:25,840

Yeah.

335

00:19:25,840 --> 00:19:26,840

Last summer.

336

00:19:26,840 --> 00:19:29,240

Let's take a look at the data here.

337

00:19:29,240 --> 00:19:33,200

Here we used the ground penetrating radar in front of Homestead 2 and detected those

338

00:19:33,200 --> 00:19:35,480

strange tunnel like anomalies.

339

00:19:35,480 --> 00:19:39,240

We all agreed to drill a hole to see what the heck those anomalies were.

340

00:19:39,240 --> 00:19:42,240

That whole thing is shaking.

341

00:19:42,240 --> 00:19:45,240

What is our depth?

342

00:19:45,240 --> 00:19:48,040

We're right now at about 17.

343

00:19:48,040 --> 00:19:50,760

I think that's right in the range where we were getting that pain.

344

00:19:50,760 --> 00:19:54,040

Yeah I think you're right.

345

00:19:54,040 --> 00:19:55,040

Are you getting something?

346

00:19:55,040 --> 00:19:56,040

No.

347

00:19:56,040 --> 00:19:57,520

Just normal background?

348

00:19:57,520 --> 00:19:58,520

Yeah.

349

00:19:58,520 --> 00:20:03,400

We couldn't find anything by drilling but now it's strange that all this water is draining

350

00:20:03,400 --> 00:20:08,280

down somewhere right next to where we found those anomalies.

351

00:20:08,280 --> 00:20:10,040

I say the first place to look is in that hole.

352

00:20:10,040 --> 00:20:13,400

We gotta run something down in there and see if any of this green stuff is getting into

353

00:20:13,400 --> 00:20:14,400

it.

354

00:20:14,400 --> 00:20:15,400

I think we should.

355

00:20:15,400 --> 00:20:18,080

All right let's try that.

356

00:20:18,080 --> 00:20:19,080

Here's the hole.

357

00:20:19,080 --> 00:20:22,080

I think we could probably see down in there.

358

00:20:22,080 --> 00:20:24,240

Oh look you can see the water down there.

359

00:20:24,240 --> 00:20:25,240

See any green?

360

00:20:25,240 --> 00:20:26,240

I can't tell.

361

00:20:26,240 --> 00:20:27,760

Let's see how deep it is.

362

00:20:27,760 --> 00:20:30,200

See if we can get the pipes down in there.

363

00:20:30,200 --> 00:20:32,080

See if you can get some green water on it.

364

00:20:32,080 --> 00:20:35,080

I think we should.

365

00:20:35,080 --> 00:20:37,080

Yep.

366

00:20:37,080 --> 00:20:42,000

Oh I'm in mud.

367

00:20:42,000 --> 00:20:46,120

Okay hold them up at the top of them.

368

00:20:46,120 --> 00:20:48,000

Pull it up quick.

369

00:20:48,000 --> 00:20:52,440

Well I don't see any green water.

370

00:20:52,440 --> 00:20:55,720

No it looks pretty clear.

371

00:20:55,720 --> 00:21:00,200

We should think we'd find the dyed water in the hole closest to where we had diverted

372

00:21:00,200 --> 00:21:02,000

it but it's not there.

373

00:21:02,000 --> 00:21:04,720

We're in the hectic to all that water that we pumped into the hole go.

374

00:21:04,720 --> 00:21:08,480

I don't think there's any green in there.

375

00:21:08,480 --> 00:21:09,480

Yeah.

376

00:21:09,480 --> 00:21:12,560

This is where the radiation event happened.

377

00:21:12,560 --> 00:21:14,880

We saw 45,000 gallons of water disappear.

378

00:21:14,880 --> 00:21:16,920

It must be going somewhere rapidly.

379

00:21:16,920 --> 00:21:19,040

I for one I want to dig it out.

380

00:21:19,040 --> 00:21:22,040

The lore associated with digging there's no way to protect against that.

381

00:21:26,720 --> 00:21:28,720

It broke right out.

382

00:21:28,720 --> 00:21:32,520

Well I don't think there's any green in there.

383

00:21:32,520 --> 00:21:39,480

We pumped about 45,000 gallons of dyed water down into this hole and now it's just gone.

384

00:21:39,480 --> 00:21:45,320

Let's go look in the cistern to see if there might be any green dye leached into it.

385

00:21:45,320 --> 00:21:48,840

So the next logical place that Thomas and Casey and I are going to check is the old

386

00:21:48,840 --> 00:21:52,440

cistern behind Homestead 2.

387

00:21:52,440 --> 00:21:53,440

You got your flashlight right?

388

00:21:53,440 --> 00:21:54,440

Yeah I got it.

389

00:21:55,160 --> 00:22:01,360

Just come right through here.

390

00:22:01,360 --> 00:22:06,480

The thicket that I wanted to go through it's very dense.

391

00:22:06,480 --> 00:22:10,520

You almost need to have some kind of tool to get through there like machete or an axe

392

00:22:10,520 --> 00:22:12,480

to get through some of those branches.

393

00:22:12,480 --> 00:22:14,480

Here's some water down right here.

394

00:22:14,480 --> 00:22:17,480

You see any dye?

395

00:22:17,480 --> 00:22:19,240

Nope, no dye.

396

00:22:19,240 --> 00:22:21,720

It's curious.

397

00:22:21,720 --> 00:22:23,440

We still don't know where this water is going.

398

00:22:23,440 --> 00:22:26,440

Let's head back out.

399

00:22:26,440 --> 00:22:30,400

We're about 450 feet out from where we started.

400

00:22:30,400 --> 00:22:31,400

You can see the bottom.

401

00:22:31,400 --> 00:22:32,400

Right.

402

00:22:32,400 --> 00:22:33,400

Map what's cool.

403

00:22:33,400 --> 00:22:35,400

That's what the terrain we're tracing.

404

00:22:35,400 --> 00:22:40,200

We've spent a lot of time looking for this fluorescent green dye to show up and as of

405

00:22:40,200 --> 00:22:42,240

yet we haven't found any traces of it.

406

00:22:42,240 --> 00:22:47,040

If somebody keeps an eye on the water it looks like normal water so far.

407

00:22:47,040 --> 00:22:52,440

I'd be shocked if we were able to see something at this point as much as it would be diluted.

408

00:22:52,440 --> 00:22:54,440

I'm sure.

409

00:22:54,440 --> 00:23:02,440

This place just has a specific smell to me.

410

00:23:02,440 --> 00:23:05,440

I don't know if it does to y'all or not but I can smell it.

411

00:23:05,440 --> 00:23:10,400

Homestead 2 is not only one of the creepiest looking places on the ranch but it's also

412

00:23:10,400 --> 00:23:15,280

where a lot of strange phenomena and events have occurred.

413

00:23:15,280 --> 00:23:17,640

People have heard creepy voices.

414

00:23:17,640 --> 00:23:20,160

They've had lost time events.

415

00:23:20,160 --> 00:23:25,380

And Robert Bigelow's team actually claimed that they saw a portal open up by Homestead

416

00:23:25,380 --> 00:23:27,840

2 and a creature crawl out of it.

417

00:23:27,840 --> 00:23:31,000

And I've had my own weird experiences here too.

418

00:23:31,000 --> 00:23:35,320

Right around the corner this is where the radiation event happened.

419

00:23:35,320 --> 00:23:38,960

Last summer I had symptoms of radiation sickness.

420

00:23:38,960 --> 00:23:42,400

It's filled with something.

421

00:23:42,400 --> 00:23:47,280

I feel like I don't know I've got a little bit of a headache or something happening.

422

00:23:47,280 --> 00:23:49,120

My dosimeter went off.

423

00:23:49,120 --> 00:23:51,080

Holy, mine's beeping.

424

00:23:51,080 --> 00:23:55,000

I had radiation sickness, flu-like symptoms for a week.

425

00:23:55,000 --> 00:23:59,520

And I had burns and rashes appear.

426

00:23:59,520 --> 00:24:07,920

I'll move it this time.

427

00:24:07,920 --> 00:24:08,920

The water's really clear.

428

00:24:08,920 --> 00:24:09,920

I can see.

429

00:24:09,920 --> 00:24:10,920

Wow, look at that.

430

00:24:10,920 --> 00:24:13,800

So I guess you don't see any green.

431

00:24:13,800 --> 00:24:16,360

No, I don't.

432

00:24:16,360 --> 00:24:18,720

So those readings in here have actually dropped.

433

00:24:18,720 --> 00:24:21,200

So we're getting some shielding from the concrete probably.

434

00:24:21,200 --> 00:24:23,440

But it's actually lower in here.

435

00:24:23,440 --> 00:24:24,440

OK, all right.

436

00:24:24,440 --> 00:24:27,440

Hey Travis, do you copy?

437

00:24:27,440 --> 00:24:30,440

Yeah, Dragon, what's going on?

438

00:24:30,440 --> 00:24:32,920

Unfortunately, really nothing.

439

00:24:32,920 --> 00:24:34,640

We've run the drone.

440

00:24:34,640 --> 00:24:36,640

We really don't see anything yet.

441

00:24:36,640 --> 00:24:39,640

Well that's interesting.

442

00:24:39,640 --> 00:24:42,920

We haven't found anything yet here around Homestead 2.

443

00:24:42,920 --> 00:24:46,400

I wonder if Caleb has seen anything where they are.

444

00:24:46,400 --> 00:24:49,040

OK, I think we're going to head back to the command center.

445

00:24:49,040 --> 00:24:50,840

So when you guys are ready, you can meet us back there

446

00:24:50,840 --> 00:24:53,200

and we'll pow wow and formulate a plan.

447

00:24:53,200 --> 00:24:54,400

All right, that sounds good.

448

00:24:54,400 --> 00:24:57,480

We'll see you there in a little bit.

449

00:24:57,480 --> 00:24:59,160

Well, there you go.

450

00:24:59,160 --> 00:25:03,920

So from the very first day I stepped on this ranch.

451

00:25:03,920 --> 00:25:06,080

We've had crazy RF readings.

452

00:25:06,080 --> 00:25:07,200

We saw UFOs.

453

00:25:07,200 --> 00:25:09,120

I got dosed by radiation.

454

00:25:09,120 --> 00:25:10,560

We had a cow die.

455

00:25:10,600 --> 00:25:15,240

And then we put 45,000 gallons of water into this hole.

456

00:25:15,240 --> 00:25:17,000

So where did it go?

457

00:25:17,000 --> 00:25:21,080

Is there an underground opening that the water fell into?

458

00:25:21,080 --> 00:25:26,000

It's another just weird thing about skinwalker ranch.

459

00:25:26,000 --> 00:25:28,720

I think we're going to gather our stuff and head back.

460

00:25:28,720 --> 00:25:29,280

Sounds good.

461

00:25:29,280 --> 00:25:29,680

All right.

462

00:25:29,680 --> 00:25:30,180

OK.

463

00:25:34,600 --> 00:25:35,680

Greetings, gentlemen.

464

00:25:35,680 --> 00:25:36,880

How are you?

465

00:25:36,880 --> 00:25:37,720

Hey Brandon.

466

00:25:37,720 --> 00:25:39,000

Hey Brandon, we're fine.

467

00:25:39,000 --> 00:25:41,560

So how did the investigation go today?

468

00:25:41,560 --> 00:25:44,280

And what's the list?

469

00:25:44,280 --> 00:25:46,680

Really, we didn't see anything, to be honest.

470

00:25:46,680 --> 00:25:48,520

But with that, it opens the question

471

00:25:48,520 --> 00:25:50,880

as to where is all of that water going?

472

00:25:50,880 --> 00:25:53,040

And how are we going to figure that out?

473

00:25:53,040 --> 00:25:55,960

That's significant.

474

00:25:55,960 --> 00:25:58,000

Brandon, I'd like your permission

475

00:25:58,000 --> 00:26:02,040

to be able to bring some equipment on and dig that brush out

476

00:26:02,040 --> 00:26:05,040

and maybe even excavate out some around that hole

477

00:26:05,040 --> 00:26:07,480

and towards the road where we drilled out.

478

00:26:09,800 --> 00:26:12,200

We find ourselves in a situation again in which

479

00:26:12,200 --> 00:26:13,680

the subject of digging is coming up.

480

00:26:13,680 --> 00:26:15,440

It's not a subject that we engage lightly,

481

00:26:15,440 --> 00:26:17,640

given all the things that have happened in connection

482

00:26:17,640 --> 00:26:20,280

with digging.

483

00:26:20,280 --> 00:26:22,240

I really appreciate your efforts.

484

00:26:22,240 --> 00:26:26,680

But we know that things have happened on that ranch

485

00:26:26,680 --> 00:26:30,160

and continue to happen when there's construction activity

486

00:26:30,160 --> 00:26:32,160

or any digging.

487

00:26:32,160 --> 00:26:35,360

The bear is mentioning that we saw 45,000 gallons of water

488

00:26:35,360 --> 00:26:36,160

disappear.

489

00:26:36,160 --> 00:26:38,120

It must be going somewhere rapidly.

490

00:26:38,120 --> 00:26:40,240

I don't see anything that says don't do it.

491

00:26:40,240 --> 00:26:44,040

That is motivation enough to start at least some kind of digging

492

00:26:44,040 --> 00:26:44,720

into the problem.

493

00:26:47,280 --> 00:26:50,760

Dragon, do you feel that the digging is warranted?

494

00:26:56,640 --> 00:26:58,720

You guys should take a look at Caleb's phone.

495

00:26:58,720 --> 00:27:00,240

I don't have any control over it.

496

00:27:00,240 --> 00:27:01,960

It just goes right past my passcode.

497

00:27:01,960 --> 00:27:04,040

It's just instantly hacking that.

498

00:27:04,040 --> 00:27:06,280

That's almost technologically impossible to do

499

00:27:06,280 --> 00:27:07,680

and it's doing it instantaneously.

500

00:27:07,720 --> 00:27:09,320

Something here is crying out for help.

501

00:27:15,600 --> 00:27:18,680

Dragon, do you feel that the digging is warranted?

502

00:27:22,320 --> 00:27:25,840

Well, Brandon, I mean, obviously, the lore

503

00:27:25,840 --> 00:27:27,760

associated with digging, there's no way

504

00:27:27,760 --> 00:27:29,560

to protect against that.

505

00:27:29,560 --> 00:27:32,720

But we've put some safety protocols in place now.

506

00:27:32,720 --> 00:27:35,040

We've had Casey with Qualtech back out.

507

00:27:35,040 --> 00:27:36,600

Yeah, I think that it's time that we

508

00:27:36,600 --> 00:27:37,680

need to get below the ground.

509

00:27:40,160 --> 00:27:43,160

Well, based on recommendation, you

510

00:27:43,160 --> 00:27:44,800

have my permission to proceed.

511

00:27:44,800 --> 00:27:47,000

That proceed with great caution.

512

00:27:47,000 --> 00:27:47,960

We'll do it.

513

00:27:47,960 --> 00:27:49,880

OK, we'll keep you posted on what we find out.

514

Thanks again, Brandon.

515

We're going to dig a hole.

516

Yeah.

517

00:27:59,520 --> 00:28:03,160

That could be the key to figuring out what exactly is going on

520

00:28:03,160 --> 00:28:05,760

here or at least give us direction as to where

521

00:28:05,800 --> 00:28:07,160

we need to go next.

522

00:28:07,160 --> 00:28:09,120

In the meantime, we got a lot of stuff to do.

523

That's right.

524

Let's get out of here.

525

All right, man.

526

You guys all loading up in the G-plane?

Over and out.

A couple of days ago, we ran a dye test by the pit over at

534

00:28:36,240 --> 00:28:39,800

Homestead 2 to find out where the water was going.

535

00:28:39,800 --> 00:28:44,840

But after the test, we still don't know why it disappeared

536

00:28:44,840 --> 00:28:45,960

or where it went to.

537

00:28:45,960 --> 00:28:51,040

We all got a little bit of bad vibe, juju, mojo about digging,

538

00:28:51,040 --> 00:28:51,480

right?

539

00:28:51,480 --> 00:28:53,200

And we don't, none of us believe it.

540

00:28:53,200 --> 00:28:56,400

But at the same time, we want to do it cautiously.

541

00:28:56,400 --> 00:28:59,000

I think we can make our own protocol and say every two,

542

00:28:59,000 --> 00:29:00,760

three feet, let's sample.

543

00:29:00,760 --> 00:29:02,520

And we'll be monitoring constantly.

544

00:29:02,520 --> 00:29:05,840

The other thing, too, that I want y'all to be aware of,

545

00:29:05,840 --> 00:29:08,080

I think Dragon's really nervous.

546

00:29:08,080 --> 00:29:10,480

He don't want to show it, but I think he is.

547

00:29:10,480 --> 00:29:11,120

Yeah, I don't blame him.

548

00:29:11,120 --> 00:29:14,560

So let's just make sure that he understands

549

00:29:14,560 --> 00:29:18,600

that we're doing everything that we can possibly think of to do

550

00:29:18,600 --> 00:29:20,280

to keep everybody safe.

551

00:29:20,280 --> 00:29:21,280

Absolutely.

552

00:29:21,280 --> 00:29:30,640

It's a good thing I'm so cautious about this.

553

00:29:30,760 --> 00:29:33,000

I just started digging, getting tired of waiting.

554

00:29:33,000 --> 00:29:33,880

Right.

555

00:29:33,880 --> 00:29:35,520

Brandon gave us permission to dig.

556

00:29:35,520 --> 00:29:38,920

So Thomas got a mini excavator delivered to the ranch.

557

00:29:38,920 --> 00:29:41,560

We've got Casey here with all sorts of test equipment

558

00:29:41,560 --> 00:29:44,320

to make sure we're not being exposed to something dangerous.

559

00:29:44,320 --> 00:29:46,840

And we're going to start digging.

560

00:29:46,840 --> 00:29:48,480

Brandon's given us to go ahead to dig.

561

00:29:48,480 --> 00:29:50,520

But with that, I want to make sure

562

00:29:50,520 --> 00:29:52,560

that we do so cautiously.

563

00:29:52,560 --> 00:29:56,760

So Casey, thank you again for coming all the way out here

564

00:29:56,760 --> 00:29:58,680

and bringing all your equipment.

565

00:29:58,720 --> 00:30:01,520

It's no secret that I have concerns whenever

566

00:30:01,520 --> 00:30:04,920

the topic of digging on the ranch is brought up.

567

00:30:04,920 --> 00:30:07,960

As excited as we are about this, every time

568
