As far as we know, there's no structure underneath here, but we're not sure.

But part of why we're here and doing this is to explore that very question.

They're going to help us explore the area we call the Triangle.

Here's the Triangle.

41

It was here that last week we detected two large, highly magnetic anomalies with a long

42

tunnel-like feature running between them, deep underground.

43

It's also where a researcher named James Kenan shared with us evidence of where he believes

44

could be some kind of underground water course or possibly even an artificial tunnel system.

45

When you look at this, you're cutting right directly through my focal and origin point,

46

which is this location of Skinwalker Ranch.

Look, the history is what it is.

Our attention is naturally drawn to this spot, but then again, we've never tried drilling

We may provoke some response from the ranch.

Who knows what will happen?

We've got magnetometers.

66

We've got GPS.

67

We're going to be looking at the Geiger counter, data logging.

68

On the laptop is where we're looking at our spectrum analyzer.

69

It allows us to see any unusual radio frequency signals that show up while we're conducting

70

OK.

So while you're doing your work, all of this stuff will be running.

73

We're not poking the hornet's nest.

We're kicking it.

We're kicking it down, stomping on it.

86

While Eric and Dragon were working at the triangle, I went with Candace Lindy, Caleb

87

Bench and Thomas Winterton to investigate another area of interest that's right between

88

the triangle and Homestead 2.

89

Wow.

Well, I have some interesting news to share.

91

Last week, Brandon told us that this spot was a particular place of interest for the

92

Sherman's who used to own Skinwalker Ranch.

93

There is an actual location of the area on the ranch where the Sherman said not to dig.

94

I'd like to share with you the coordinates.

95

When we plugged the coordinates in, they pointed right to a big rock sitting all by itself across

96

00:05:22,220 --> 00:05:23,860

the road from the mesa.

97

00:05:23,860 --> 00:05:24,860

Look at that.

98

00:05:24,860 --> 00:05:27,260

So what's the first thing we thought?

99

00:05:27,260 --> 00:05:30,900

Let's go out there and dig and maybe it'll lead to some answers.

100

It's good?

101

00:05:32,900 --> 00:05:33,900

Yeah.

102

00:05:33,900 --> 00:05:34,900

Where's the rock?

103

00:05:34,900 --> 00:05:35,900

It's right over here.

104

Oh, yeah, I see it now.

105

00:05:36,900 --> 00:05:41,900

Yeah, actually, we can go through right here, I think.

106

Just watch.

107

It ditches a little deep right there.

108

Is there water in it?

109

00:05:47,260 --> 00:05:48,420

No.

Was there anything in particular we're looking for here or?

111

Well, the entail that Brandon got was that one of the Sherman said this was the spot

112

not to dig at.

113

00:06:01,900 --> 00:06:06,860

It's an odd coincidence that we took the GPS coordinate that they gave us and it was right

114

00:06:06,860 --> 00:06:08,900

in the middle of that rock.

115

00:06:08,900 --> 00:06:10,220

The rock could be a marker.

116

00:06:10,220 --> 00:06:11,940

Did somebody bury something there?

117

00:06:11,940 --> 00:06:14,260

Is there something there that's dangerous?

118

00:06:14,260 --> 00:06:15,460

We don't know.

119

00:06:15,460 --> 00:06:30,180

And we've got to dig there to see why would somebody say don't dig in this spot.

120

It's stable right there, Thomas.

121

00:06:38,180 --> 00:06:41,060

There's something right there on the rock.

122

00:06:41,060 --> 00:06:42,060

What are you seeing?

123

Well, I'm going to get a bottle of water.

124

00:06:44,820 --> 00:06:45,820

I'll be right back.

125

00:06:45,820 --> 00:06:46,820

I'm going to go to the Jeep and get one.

126

00:06:46,820 --> 00:06:49,020

I'll talk about where I scratched it.

127

No.

128

00:06:50,020 --> 00:06:51,020

Not the white, but...

129

00:06:51,020 --> 00:06:52,020

It's right here.

130

00:06:52,020 --> 00:06:55,020

All right, here, let me get in there, Candice.

131

00:06:55,020 --> 00:06:56,020

Yeah.

132

00:06:56,020 --> 00:07:02,740

That's actually something on it.

133

00:07:02,740 --> 00:07:05,580

Yeah, there's definitely something right there.

134

00:07:05,580 --> 00:07:08,420

You got three clearly defined marks.

135

00:07:08,420 --> 00:07:13,780

Now, I don't want to read too much into anything, but it's definitely curious to me that we

136

found a possible carving on the underside of this boulder where the Sherman family supposedly

137

00:07:19,300 --> 00:07:21,980

said no one should ever dig.

138

00:07:21,980 --> 00:07:25,500

It could be that they made the marking, but we just don't know.

139

It's nowhere else.

140

00:07:27,300 --> 00:07:31,020

And to me, it looks like a bunch of the old Thunderbird symbols that you see in a lot

141

00:07:31,020 --> 00:07:35,820

of Native American tribes and stuff.

142

00:07:35,820 --> 00:07:39,060

One of my pastimes is I love reading mythology and history.

143

00:07:39,180 --> 00:07:44,260

To me, that symbol almost looked like some kind of a Thunderbird that you see in the

144

00:07:44,260 --> 00:07:48,380

Navajo and other Native artwork.

145

00:07:48,380 --> 00:07:52,660

The Thunderbird is a mythical creature of huge importance in Navajo and other Native American

146

00:07:52,660 --> 00:07:54,620

cultures.

147

00:07:54,620 --> 00:08:00,540

It's a symbol of great power, strength, and protection of humans against evil spirits.

148

00:08:00,540 --> 00:08:05,300

Now, what's interesting here is that the legend of the dangerous, shape-shifting entity known

149

00:08:05,300 --> 00:08:10,780

as the Skinwalker is not only what this property's been named after, but it also arose out of

150

00:08:10,780 --> 00:08:12,740

the Navajo culture.

151

00:08:12,740 --> 00:08:17,500

So if this really is a carving of the Thunderbird, then I wonder who would have carved it?

152

00:08:17,500 --> 00:08:21,020

And is it connected to the Sherman's warning not to dig here?

153

00:08:21,020 --> 00:08:25,940

I'll take a picture of it, but it certainly doesn't say enter here.

154

00:08:25,940 --> 00:08:26,940

No.

155

00:08:26,940 --> 00:08:28,220

Well, let's look under the rock.

156

00:08:28,220 --> 00:08:29,220

I like that.

157

00:08:29,220 --> 00:08:31,220

Well, I'm getting over here out of the way.

158

00:08:35,300 --> 00:08:41,260

Who knows what could be here if this really is a marker?

159

00:08:41,260 --> 00:08:46,140

It's right between Homestead 2 and the Triangle, so even though I'm a little skeptical about

160

00:08:46,140 --> 00:08:50,500

it, what if it's covering some kind of strange object that's connected to all these strange

161

00:08:50,500 --> 00:08:52,140

phenomena here on the ranch?

162

00:08:52,140 --> 00:08:56,980

Heck, what if it's even covering an entrance to what we might be drilling down into over

163

00:08:56,980 --> 00:08:58,900

at the Triangle?

164

00:08:58,900 --> 00:09:05,180

We need to poke that sucker as much as possible.

165

00:09:05,180 --> 00:09:07,300

This is a significant water flow.

166

00:09:07,300 --> 00:09:09,380

Just like what James Keenan told us.

167

00:09:09,380 --> 00:09:12,300

Hey, Thomas, let's do another test.

168

00:09:12,300 --> 00:09:14,620

Oh crap, look at that.

169

00:09:14,620 --> 00:09:16,540

That is really magnetic right there.

170

00:09:16,540 --> 00:09:25,300

Holy crap.

171

00:09:25,300 --> 00:09:30,300

We're digging below a boulder right where the Sherman family reportedly said to never

172

00:09:30,300 --> 00:09:31,300

dig.

173

00:09:31,300 --> 00:09:35,940

There's a longstanding legend that warns against any digging on the Skinwalker Ranch, so

174

00:09:35,940 --> 00:09:42,020

I'm really eager to see if we'll find something buried here or if some strange phenomena might

175

00:09:42,020 --> 00:09:44,020

be triggered by the digging.

176

00:09:44,020 --> 00:09:47,020

Hey, do you see anything down there?

177

00:09:47,020 --> 00:09:50,860

Well, let's have a look.

178

00:09:50,860 --> 00:09:51,860

You going to hop down in there, Canis?

179

00:09:51,860 --> 00:09:54,060

Yeah, just real quick.

180

00:09:54,060 --> 00:09:57,140

I just want to look across this hole.

181

00:09:57,140 --> 00:09:58,140

That's just some shale.

182

00:09:58,140 --> 00:09:59,140

Is it just shale?

183

00:09:59,140 --> 00:10:00,140

Yeah.

184

00:10:00,140 --> 00:10:02,260

Well, that is a bigger piece of it.

185

00:10:02,260 --> 00:10:04,660

Oh, hey, look at that.

186

00:10:04,660 --> 00:10:05,660

Okay.

187

00:10:05,660 --> 00:10:08,100

I don't know if it's pottery or something.

188

00:10:08,100 --> 00:10:10,300

Oh, Canis need a hand.

189

00:10:10,300 --> 00:10:15,100

Yeah, I'll take one.

190

00:10:15,100 --> 00:10:16,100

Nothing unusual.

191

00:10:16,100 --> 00:10:18,140

It's just crazy cross bedding.

192

00:10:18,140 --> 00:10:21,580

But I can't help but think the rock was simply the landmark.

193

00:10:21,580 --> 00:10:23,940

To be honest, that could be within 100 feet of the rock.

194

00:10:23,940 --> 00:10:26,180

Oh, well, they might go the rock and take 100 paces due north.

195

00:10:26,180 --> 00:10:27,940

You know, five paces to the east.

196

00:10:27,940 --> 00:10:29,980

It's kind of like finding a needle in a haystack.

197

00:10:30,820 --> 00:10:31,820

We go deeper.

198

00:10:31,820 --> 00:10:33,740

What are you thinking after seeing the hole?

199

00:10:33,740 --> 00:10:36,940

It doesn't look like it's been disturbed and that rock's been sitting on it forever.

200

00:10:36,940 --> 00:10:39,060

That rock hasn't been moved.

201

00:10:39,060 --> 00:10:42,980

I really don't think it's worth investigating this spot anymore right now.

202

00:10:42,980 --> 00:10:47,700

The ground doesn't look back filled like someone dug here or hit anything below.

203

00:10:47,700 --> 00:10:51,860

So we need to focus our energy where we are experiencing anomalies, like the triangle

204

00:10:51,860 --> 00:10:57,380

area and another spot we want to investigate next in the east field of the ranch.

205

00:10:57,380 --> 00:10:59,380

And let's just fill this in and call it.

206

00:11:28,380 --> 00:11:30,380

Oh, it's already getting wet.

207

00:11:32,380 --> 00:11:33,380

Can we take a look?

208

00:11:33,380 --> 00:11:36,380

Yeah, give me just a sec and I'll get you some light.

209

00:11:38,380 --> 00:11:40,380

This is a significant water flow.

210

00:11:40,380 --> 00:11:43,380

Just like what James Keenan told us.

211

00:11:43,380 --> 00:11:46,380

But this is the kind of stuff that caves like crazy.

212

Oh, yeah, it's cavey.

213

00:11:49,380 --> 00:11:51,380

It's already caving, huh?

214

Oh, yeah.

215

What do you think, Eric?

216

Do we want to continue digging in this?

217

00:11:56,380 --> 00:11:58,380

So I really want to get this hole to depth.

218

00:11:58,380 --> 00:12:02,380

If we can get that 100 foot depth, I want to get it.

219

00:12:02,380 --> 00:12:05,380

If we've got to put a casing in the ground, we're going to do it anyway.

220

00:12:05,380 --> 00:12:06,380

Yeah.

221

00:12:06,380 --> 00:12:07,380

I say we do it now.

222

00:12:07,380 --> 00:12:08,380

Yep.

223

00:12:08,380 --> 00:12:11,380

I was pretty surprised to see the amount of water that we encountered at such a shallow

224

00:12:11,380 --> 00:12:16,380

depth here, but we really do want to get to the bottom of what is underneath the triangle.

225

00:12:16,380 --> 00:12:17,380

Thank you.

226

00:12:17,380 --> 00:12:18,380

Thank you.

227

00:12:20,380 --> 00:12:25,380

We're going to head over to where the cow died, right underneath where the UFO appeared in

228

00:12:25,380 --> 00:12:26,380

the video.

229

00:12:26,380 --> 00:12:31,380

After we finished investigating the rock, the next place we wanted to explore was in the

230

00:12:31,380 --> 00:12:35,380

east field where we've seen all kinds of strange phenomena.

231

00:12:35,380 --> 00:12:38,380

I'm going to park right here and sort of be out of his way.

232

00:12:38,380 --> 00:12:44,380

One week ago, we conducted a lidar skin with a company called Juniper Unmanned, and we

233

00:12:44,380 --> 00:12:48,380

detected two very large circular features in the ground.

234

00:12:48,380 --> 00:12:53,380

The anomalies he found right here where this flag is, the peak of that parabola.

235

00:12:53,380 --> 00:12:58,380

And this also happens to be an area where the cattle on the ranch have been avoiding.

236

00:12:58,380 --> 00:13:03,380

One cow mysteriously died last year, while at the same time, a UFO appeared above it

237

00:13:03,380 --> 00:13:04,380

in the sky.

238

00:13:04,380 --> 00:13:08,380

So, the cow we found right here, literally right here, right?

239

00:13:08,380 --> 00:13:09,380

Yeah.

240

00:13:09,380 --> 00:13:12,380

Why don't we just dig right through the center of it?

241

00:13:12,380 --> 00:13:13,380

We can put this to bed really quick.

242

00:13:13,380 --> 00:13:15,380

If there's something there, we'll find it.

243

00:13:15,380 --> 00:13:17,380

If there's not, we'll know and we can get to the next spot.

244

00:13:17,380 --> 00:13:18,380

Yeah.

245

00:13:18,380 --> 00:13:22,380

So why don't we go all the way to the fence and maybe do two swipes and just come back

246

00:13:22,380 --> 00:13:26,380

to about 20 or 30 feet away and just do it?

247

00:13:26,380 --> 00:13:27,380

You want a wider trench?

248

00:13:27,380 --> 00:13:28,380

Yeah.

249

00:13:28,380 --> 00:13:30,380

That way we can actually go in.

250

00:13:30,380 --> 00:13:34,380

If we do see something on an anomaly, we can walk in it safely and maybe look at the dirt

251

00:13:34,380 --> 00:13:35,380

and take samples or whatever.

252

00:13:35,380 --> 00:13:36,380

Yeah.

253

00:13:36,380 --> 00:13:37,380

All right.

254

00:13:37,380 --> 00:13:42,380

The cow died of possibly something that messed up its neurological system.

255

00:13:42,380 --> 00:13:47,380

It makes me wonder, you know, if there is something underground here that caused this

256

00:13:47,380 --> 00:13:50,380

reaction leading up to this cow's death.

257

00:13:50,380 --> 00:13:52,380

Hey, guys.

258

00:13:52,380 --> 00:13:54,380

We're going to get out of the way.

259

00:13:54,380 --> 00:13:55,380

Wow.

260

00:13:55,380 --> 00:14:06,380

No wonder he wants us out of the way.

261

00:14:06,380 --> 00:14:07,380

Yeah.

262

00:14:07,380 --> 00:14:08,380

I'm glad to be out of the way.

263

00:14:08,380 --> 00:14:09,380

Yeah, me too.

264

00:14:09,380 --> 00:14:11,380

The drill rig?

265

00:14:11,380 --> 00:14:12,380

Yeah.

266

00:14:12,380 --> 00:14:14,380

It was water really early and it was starting to cave in.

267

00:14:14,380 --> 00:14:19,380

So now we have these big metal casings we're going to put in the ground and hopefully it'll

268

00:14:19,380 --> 00:14:20,380

help stop the water.

269

00:14:20,380 --> 00:14:22,380

Bring it this way.

270

00:14:22,380 --> 00:14:26,380

So he's actually getting into the ground below the level at which they were drilling, right?

271

00:14:26,380 --> 00:14:27,380

Yeah.

272

00:14:27,380 --> 00:14:28,380

Oh, yeah.

273

00:14:28,380 --> 00:14:29,380

That pipe was 40 feet.

274

00:14:29,380 --> 00:14:33,380

Real soft and wet material can be dangerous.

275

00:14:33,380 --> 00:14:39,380

When that material like that is that saturated, it could cave in and it could tip the rig

276

00:14:39,380 --> 00:14:40,380

over.

277

00:14:40,380 --> 00:14:41,380

Now?

278

00:14:41,380 --> 00:14:42,380

Now.

279

00:14:42,380 --> 00:14:47,380

Oh, there she is.

280

00:14:47,380 --> 00:15:04,380

Let's see her mirror.

281

00:15:04,380 --> 00:15:05,380

How deep are we here?

282

00:15:05,380 --> 00:15:06,380

About 25.

283

00:15:06,380 --> 00:15:07,380

25.

284

00:15:07,380 --> 00:15:09,380

See how it's just running in?

285

00:15:09,380 --> 00:15:10,380

Yep.

286

Well, we had a gentleman come out here to the ranch.

Yeah, when James was out.

We talked about the possibility of there being water flow, significant water flow under the

297

property and even talked about this area as being one of the areas of interest.

I have to admit, I thought it was crazy that we went down maybe 24, 25 feet below the ground

299

Now, I've dug holes all my life and I've never seen a hole as magnetic as that.

Travis, would that suggest that there's current running through this ground that's magnetizing it?

381

Yeah.

382

00:19:22,380 --> 00:19:25,380

Anytime you have an electric current, there's a magnetic field associated with it.

383

00:19:25,380 --> 00:19:30,380

We seem to be finding magnetism with everything we find.

384

When I first came to Skinwalker Ranch last year, Eric Bard explained how a lot of the

385

data he had been collecting on the property indicated that something underground was causing

386

00:19:41,380 --> 00:19:43,380

a highly powerful magnetic field.

387

00:19:43,380 --> 00:19:48,380

Now, he also believed it might help explain things like the horrible head injury Thomas

Winerton suffered a couple years ago and all the malfunctions we've had with electronic

389

devices.

390

00:19:55,380 --> 00:19:56,380

What is it doing?

391

It was in my contacts.

392

00:19:57,380 --> 00:19:59,380

It tried calling a couple of people.

393

Dude, that is crazy.

394

Well, I don't know if there's any reason to keep digging this hole.

395

I don't see a parabolic shape like was in the ground penetrating radar.

396

We probably ought to dig another hole just like this or we've heard stories of cattle

397

mutilation or UFO or whatever.

398

Now, wasn't there another one down here by the big tree?

Down here in the corner by the tree, yeah.

That had landed.

Why don't you guys go down there and scout it out and I'll come down and we'll dig that out.

Let's get the metal.

408

A next deputy sheriff from the area named Chris Port had some pretty incredible stories

409

when he came to visit and told us there had been a cattle mutilation here.

410

00:20:49,380 --> 00:20:54,380

All female organs were removed out of both cows.

411

00:20:54,380 --> 00:20:56,380

I can't explain it.

412

00:20:56,380 --> 00:21:04,380

And there was matted grass where something heavy was set in these weeds and made an impression.

413

I presume that was spaceship.

414

I don't know what to make of Sheriff Port's story.

415

He believes that an actual alien craft landed on this next location.

416

But given the mutilated cows that he officially reported and our own line of our data showing

You see that?

Yeah.

Now, again, this is making me think it's electric, not magnetic.

448

But if it's electric, which would make more sense because that's not a magnet.

And if that's charged and if they're both positive or they're both negative, they'll push each other away.

450

The fact that dirt is statically charged enough that it will push metal to the wall of the dirt is unbelievable.

451

Is there electric current flowing through the ground that's putting electric charge on it?

452

I don't know, but it tells me that there's something weird electromagnetically in the soil once you get to a depth of about five feet or so.

Could this explain why we've seen so much phenomena in this area?

454

It's all connected somehow.

All this is connected somehow.

We just don't know what the culprit is.

We drilled our first hole and we hit water really early and it was starting to cave in, so now we're punching hole number two.

Look at that.

You see what's going on here?

467

This line you see right here?

I've been watching this thing dance around and I've never seen that before.

469

A spectrum analyzer is a device that's sensitive to electromagnetic waves, like radio waves, and it allows us to see which frequencies are present and at what amplitudes.

470

And we're seeing stuff that is neither natural nor easy to produce.

471

00:24:43,380 --> 00:24:47,380

This may be correlated with what we're doing with the rig itself.

472

00:24:47,380 --> 00:24:54,380

I think what I want to do is watch how this changes as they work with the machine.

473

00:24:54,380 --> 00:24:55,380

Okay.

474

00:24:55,380 --> 00:24:56,380

That is strange.

475

00:24:56,380 --> 00:24:58,380

Yeah.

476

00:24:59,380 --> 00:25:02,380

You want to check right here real quick?

477

We might as well get out and walk around to see if we trigger anything.

478

Okay.

Take your phone in case it starts wiggling out.

480

While the drilling continued at the triangle, Caleb and I went back to the east field.

481

I wanted to see if we could measure any potentially dangerous energy spikes or radiation as a possible result of all the digging.

482

So the best thing was right over here, right in the cow, between these two trees.

483

So the gamma ray levels are about three times higher right now, background wise than normal.

484

Okay.

We stopped by the site where the cow died last summer.

486

Suddenly my gamma ray detector started showing an increase in gamma rays.

487

It was jumped up above 20, 24 milli-rempere hour.

488

Gamma rays are higher level x-rays and you can get radiation signals from them.

489

Although the levels weren't immediately dangerous, they were increasing.

490

You know, this is crazy weird.

491

Tell you what, if you hold this for a minute, I want to check another instrument out.

492

We've got a continuous magnetic field that's going on right now.

493

00:26:05,380 --> 00:26:06,380

That should be zero.

494

Hey guys, look at that.

495

This active peak is really interesting here.

496

00:26:14,380 --> 00:26:16,380

This thing's moving around, you see that?

497

Yeah.

Have you ever seen that frequency thing?

499

00:26:18,380 --> 00:26:19,380

I have not seen this before.

500

00:26:19,380 --> 00:26:20,380

Really?

501

If you look over here, you'll see this colored waterfall plot here.

502

00:26:24,380 --> 00:26:28,380

It shows that we've got a peak that's dancing around and I don't know what's driving it.

503

We seem to be receiving some kind of energy.

504

00:26:32,380 --> 00:26:36,380

I think that there may be an energy source nearby.

505

00:26:36,380 --> 00:26:39,380

That could be interpreted as artificial.

506

I wonder if this is somehow connected to the drill.

507

00:26:41,380 --> 00:26:43,380

Look at that.

508

00:26:43,380 --> 00:26:45,380

That makes no sense.

509

00:26:50,380 --> 00:26:52,380

May I just check my compass and see if it looks weird?

510

00:26:52,380 --> 00:26:54,380

I mean, I have the compass in your Jeep.

511

00:26:54,380 --> 00:26:55,380

I've got a compass right here.

512

00:26:55,380 --> 00:26:57,380

Just hang on, let me find it.

513

00:26:57,380 --> 00:26:59,380

It is right there.

514

00:26:59,380 --> 00:27:01,380

That is odd right there, dude.

515

00:27:01,380 --> 00:27:06,380

So there is an externeous magnetic field right here messing my compass up.

516

Caleb, check this out.

517

Magnetic north has been shifted by about five degrees.

Ooh, hey.
