There's the asset that we're trying to protect, but more importantly, the people inside.

We're really talking about a minimal equipment set here.

We're talking about Spectrum Analyzer, perhaps the tri-field, maybe.

56

Gamma-ray detection.

Definitely a gamma-ray detector.

Nothing heavy, nothing that broadcasts a signal that would interfere with anything aboard

the aircraft.

How do you feel about that, Brun?

61

The only way that we can really understand what is happening in the airspace is by getting

So in the measures that you're comfortable with and accustomed to using, you know, we're

talking about 7,000 feet above sea level, 8,500 feet above sea level.

But the top altitude being 10,000 feet.

114

Really 10,000 feet above sea level, right?

115

Okay.

So Cameron Fugel has agreed to take us to target altitude incrementally.

117

We'll be flying at different altitudes and at different radii from the center point above

118

the triangle.

On this flight path, we'll be taking measurements and data logging using the gamma ray detector

120

or Geiger counter as well as the RF spectrum analyzer.

What we're hoping to do is to find some support for the idea that there's something going

122

We suddenly detected massive energy spikes on our spectrum analyzer.

135

137

139

all these potentially dangerous energy spikes.

While Thomas and I are on the ground, we are looking at the flight transponder data so

155

we can see exactly where the helicopter is.

156

00:08:33,040 --> 00:08:37,920

And we can match that up with a map that Eric has given us of these rings of height and

157

00:08:37,920 --> 00:08:40,760

distance that he wants to take measurements with.

158

00:08:40,760 --> 00:08:45,400

So Cameron has outfitted us with a transponder that we can communicate directly with the

159

00:08:45,400 --> 00:08:49,880

helicopter while they're in flight so they can be at the exact spots on the map that

160

00:08:49,880 --> 00:08:53,680

Eric's looking to get the data from.

161

00:08:53,680 --> 00:08:56,440

You guys are just approaching the six o'clock location.

162

00:08:56,440 --> 00:08:59,280

Eric, six o'clock position right here.

163

00:08:59,280 --> 00:09:00,280

All right.

164

00:09:00,280 --> 00:09:01,280

All right.

165

00:09:01,280 --> 00:09:02,280

Yeah.

166

00:09:02,280 --> 00:09:05,280

No change really, we're at six.

167

Okay.

168

00:09:06,280 --> 00:09:08,720

What altitude do you show us, that?

169

00:09:08,720 --> 00:09:15,280

I'm showing you right about 7,000, varying between 69,95 and just over 7,000, so you're

170

00:09:15,280 --> 00:09:16,280

in a good spot.

171

00:09:16,280 --> 00:09:18,960

We're at three o'clock position now, Eric.

172

00:09:18,960 --> 00:09:19,960

Okay.

173

00:09:19,960 --> 00:09:23,520

Yeah, for three o'clock positions, what we show now, 7,000.

174

00:09:23,520 --> 00:09:25,520

Three o'clock now.

175

00:09:25,520 --> 00:09:33,720

Okay, so that's all the data points on the outside ring at this altitude.

176

Pretty good.

177

Yeah.

178

So why don't we go now to the next altitude, so we're going to 8,500 feet above sea level.

179

Yeah.

You might then go back out to the outer ring.

181

Approaching six o'clock in three, two, six o'clock.

182

We're at it 2,500 since we're good.

183

00:09:53,080 --> 00:09:55,000

All right.

184

00:09:55,000 --> 00:09:58,200

I've got the six o'clock position at 2,500 foot radius.

185

00:09:58,200 --> 00:10:00,400

So I'm showing the radar altitude meter.

186

00:10:00,400 --> 00:10:01,400

Yeah.

187

00:10:01,400 --> 00:10:03,600

So we're only 40 feet above the ground right now.

188

00:10:04,600 --> 00:10:05,600

That's not good.

189

00:10:05,600 --> 00:10:10,440

Cameron, did I understand you correctly that your altimeter was showing 40 feet above the

190

00:10:10,440 --> 00:10:11,440

ground?

191

00:10:11,440 --> 00:10:13,440

That's what that beeping, I don't know if you heard the beeping.

192

00:10:13,440 --> 00:10:14,440

Yeah, I did.

193

That was, that's a little bit disturbing.

194

So something could be under us.

195

We keep having this indication that something's just below us.

We had a slight spike in the gambas there for a second.

197

Hey, while you're down there, we've got the radar out from an Earth

Here goes again, something showing 50 feet underneath us.

There comes and goes.

216

Nothing beneath you transponding at this time.

218

Thomas is currently looking with binoculars for anything beneath you.

219

They're talking about seeing something tracking them on the radar

below the helicopter.

It's showing right underneath.

It's picking up frequency as we're climbing to and as we're approaching 10,000 feet.

Dragon, I'm not comfortable with having something showing up right underneath the aircraft

What I do have are unsettling indications that we may not have been alone up there.

And we couldn't see it, you know, at the windows in the bottom of the helicopter.

So whatever it was was invisible, at least to the eye, but apparently not to the radar.

Especially if you're flying and it's getting close to dark or if it's cloudy,

371

you've got to have this instrument working.

And I asked Cameron about it and he said he's never had it malfunctioned.

373

Now, this is showing us when it's working.

The fact that Eric has identified these additional UAP that occurred above the ranch when we
