All electronic devices operate on some RF frequency, radios,

180

GPS, satellites, TV, even microwaves.

181

But the one we consistently see here

182

appears at 1.6 gigahertz.

183

And no technology that we know of

184

uses that specific frequency.

It's an anomaly that's also been recorded

186

The legend of the malevolent shapeshifting entity known

743

put on the Yut people during a bitter conflict back

in the 19th century.
