Hey, look! UAP, right there!

10

So we have a region in altitude

11

that tells us there's some kind of phenomenon

12

00:00:27,000 --> 00:00:29,000

taking place in the area.

13

00:00:29,000 --> 00:00:31,000

There is some kind of phenomenon taking place right here

14

00:00:31,000 --> 00:00:33,000

over the triangle.

15

00:00:33,000 --> 00:00:38,000

There is a ranch in northern Utah.

16

00:00:38,000 --> 00:00:42,000

It is considered the epicenter of the strangest

17

00:00:42,000 --> 00:00:45,000

and most disturbing phenomena on Earth.

18

00:00:45,000 --> 00:00:47,000

Animal mutilations,

19

00:00:47,000 --> 00:00:50,000

bizarre UFO sightings,

20

00:00:50,000 --> 00:00:55,000

and unusual energies that have proven harmful to humans.

21

For 20 years, the federal government

22

tried to find answers and failed.

23

Now, a new team of dedicated scientists,

24

I don't know if it's the things we're doing

28

that's stimulating these things like launching rockets,

but there seems to be something happening

30

that is jamming, hacking, spoofing us.

31

We've recently conducted two new experiments at the triangle

32

and have gotten more confirmation that something strange

33

is happening about a mile above that area.

Three, two, one, wobbly drop.

35

First, we dropped GPS units from Brandon's helicopter

36

down through it.

37

00:01:54,000 --> 00:01:56,000

We pulled a cowl, look at that.

38

So we threw it out right there, and then look, it goes upwind.

39

But something we couldn't see

40

seemed to deflect our instruments away from the spot.

41

Rocket is going hot.

42

Then, we launched rockets up there

43

with a team of former military experts

44

who brought a specialized tracking system for studying UAP.

45

Hey, look, UAP right there.

46

We did stimulate something to appear in the sky,

47

but the tracking system mysteriously shut down over and over.

48

You got to be kidding me.

49

Preventing us from getting any data.

50

54

to keep happening on Skinwalker Ranch.

Well, you know, these rockets are great,

56

and we're seeing this data.

57

The problem with them is they go up so fast, come down so fast,

58

they don't feel like you guys are really getting a lot of data.

A typical flight trajectory is even with a very big ship,

a very big shoot on them is less than 20 or 30 seconds.

So, it would be nice to linger there,

62

like with a fixed-wing aircraft

63

that we could just keep flying, orbiting over the spot or something.

You know, where we just make a push-broom type of pattern

65

at various altitudes.

You could do that with a SESSNUG or something like that,

67

and you could put plenty of instruments in it.

68

They could go about 100 miles an hour or slower

69

and just push-broom back and forth over the ranch.

70

And then you could go up an altitude and do it again and keep doing it.

71

We could get a complete 3D map of GPS, gamma rays, radio,

72

whatever we wanted to do like that.

Well, we've talked about this for a while. I'd say we could do it.

Tom Lewis and Candace Lindy went to nearby Mckonkey Ranch

to meet with a respected Navajo Nations member named John Dover.

86

I think he said he was going to meet us just at the trailhead up here.

87

Hello!

I'm up here.

89

John!

Hello!

Come on up.

Let's head on up.

93

Now, we want any information that can help us with our investigation

94

and the indigenous people in this region have a long history

95

with all kinds of strange phenomena.

96

Are you good?

97

Oh, yeah. Just recently, we met with Corey Sarawak

98

who would share a story with us about his experience in the UNI basin.

One thing he brought up was that we should visit Mckonkey Ranch

100

and check out the petroglyphs there.

This is amazing.

Yeah.

John Dover has a deep understanding of the petroglyphs and pictographs

105

that are up on the walls in Mckonkey Ranch.

106

And so Candace and I are very interested to hear what John has to say.

I spent 27 years as a archaeological resource investigator

117

with the Navajo Nation Rangers.

118

Oh, wow.

119

Yeah. This place is amazing.

120

This is one place, a whole bunch of places that have petroglyphs

121

that were put on these rocks a thousand years ago or even earlier than that.

122

The ancient people that populated this place and some of the other places around here

123

00:05:45,000 --> 00:05:51,000

show that the natives back then were seeing unusual things happening

124

00:05:51,000 --> 00:05:53,000

and were recording them too.

125

There's a lot of information that's put on these rocks

126

and they're put on in successive timescales.

127

Everybody that came through would add something to it.

128

They're a record and unusual things would be documented on them.

129

They could depict clans.

130

They could depict gods.

131

They could even depict maps of the area.

132

Yeah, we have a few small panels at the ranch

133

00:06:21,000 --> 00:06:25,000

and we're really trying to tie anything together that's in this region to the ranch

134

to see if there's connections or anything that we could draw lines to.

135

We'll definitely see some connections here.

136

Excellent.

137

If we go further down here, we're going to take a look at one of them.

138

Great.

Show us the way.

140

Here's the most interesting one that I found so far is this spiral right here.

141

The spiral seems to be universal all through the United States, through the Southwest,

142

00:06:53,000 --> 00:06:55,000

in Europe and Africa.

143

Some archaeologists tell me that this spiral could refer to some kind of a portal.

144

00:07:02,000 --> 00:07:03,000

A portal?

145

00:07:03,000 --> 00:07:05,000

Yeah, a portal.

146

Okay.

147

00:07:06,000 --> 00:07:11,000

And we think that there's something called infrasound,

148

which is different frequencies of sound that you can't detect them with the human hearing.

149

And we believe that it's very possible that these different frequencies can open portals to other places.

150

For two years now, all over Skinwalker Ranch, we've seen this strange signal with an RF frequency of 1.6 gigahertz.

151

We've got lift off.

152

00:07:38,000 --> 00:07:43,000

Oh my god, during launch, the electromagnetic spectrum is going crazy, guys.

153

00:07:43,000 --> 00:07:44,000

I've never seen anything like it.

154

No technology that we know of uses this specific 1.6 gigahertz frequency,

155

00:07:50,000 --> 00:07:57,000

but we often see it when people have physiological episodes on the ranch and also when we've seen UAPs.

156

Now the idea that UAP and strange frequencies are somehow connected to a phenomenon like a portal is very interesting,

157

00:08:05,000 --> 00:08:12,000

especially since many of the indigenous people in this area truly believe that connection exists.

158

You're saying this is a portal or it could be a portal?

159

00:08:16,000 --> 00:08:19,000

This very much could be a portal.

160

The significance of portals or dimensional gates, if you would, is that the Navajos themselves talk about people coming to visit.

161

Different dimensions are not like walls.

162

If you can imagine, they're interlaced together.

163

00:08:40,000 --> 00:08:45,000

So what if every now and then something just leaks through?

164

You could travel.

165

00:08:47,000 --> 00:08:49,000

We just don't know how to do it.

166

Even the Navajo creation story talks about coming through several different worlds until they see a hole in the sky and they climb up into this world.

167

We think that there's something going on with frequency that is creating this effect.

168

Wow. There's a lot more we need to look at up here.

169

So we'll move along here.

170

As we are looking at this spiral petroglyph described as a portal, Candace and I realize there is some sort of connection here with what's happening on the ranch and possibly at the trine.

171

We've heard a lot of very interesting stories about seeing portals that opened right above people's heads and figures coming out of these portals.

172

00:09:38,000 --> 00:09:40,000

It's amazing.

173

00:09:40,000 --> 00:09:41,000

Yeah.

174

Oh yeah, I see him.

175

00:09:43,000 --> 00:09:45,000

Oh, and that's like a humanoid figure.

176

00:09:45,000 --> 00:09:53,000

One thing I've just thought about is, you know, just on this rock wall right here, and it is speculation and inference, right?

177

Right. But we could have a skinwalker, a shapeshifter.

178

We could have aliens through other dimensions.

179

Right.

180

The idea of Navajo skinwalkers, gods coming from the sky.

181

Even UFOs all had one thing in common and that's this idea of dimensions and portals.

182

And it's the one thing that ties everything together.

183

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:26,000

Those spirals back here that you were talking about could be indicative of a portal.

184

00:10:26,000 --> 00:10:30,000

It could be that it was right here or maybe off in the distance.

185

What do you think?

186

It could be a whole range of things.

187

We've actually had stories involving UAPs that have entered into Mesa's and just gone right into the rock.

188

This idea of portals, of dimensions, it all ties together.

189

And that's what we're seeing with a lot of these places and I think that's what you're experiencing in the UN to base in there.

190

A lot of phenomenon that's associated with cross-dimensional things going on.

191

Wow.

192

We'd really love to have you come to the ranch and look at a few things based on what you've told us today and your interpretation of these panels.

193

I think there's a good chance that the same people that were here could have very well been on our ranch at one point.

194

00:11:28,000 --> 00:11:35,000

I think we've both benefited from you coming to the ranch and giving your insight to what we've seen there.

195

We have some very interesting things right on the skinwalker ranch.

196

00:11:38,000 --> 00:11:40,000

It might be things you've never seen before.

197

00:11:40,000 --> 00:11:42,000

I'd love to come over there.

198

Great.

199

00:11:43,000 --> 00:11:44,000

Lead the way.

200

I think we'll just stop right here in effect.

201

00:11:52,000 --> 00:11:58,000

Because of what happened last year with the sensors on Branagh's helicopter detecting an object right below us.

202

And also what happened just two weeks ago when we dropped GPS units into the triangle anomaly which appeared to just bounce off of an invisible object in the sky above the ranch.

203

Hey Kendra.

204

How are you?

205

00:12:10,000 --> 00:12:13,000

We really wanted to go further with attempting to map that anomaly.

206

So to conduct today's experiment above the triangle area, Cameron Fugle put us in touch with a pilot named Kendra Hart who's agreed to take Eric up in her Cessna to help us collect our data.

207

Since you fly out here, have you flown over the property, the ranch itself?

208

00:12:29,000 --> 00:12:30,000

I have not.

209

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:34,000

Most of my students stay further west and so this will be my first time this far out east and especially over the ranch.

210

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:35,000

Really?

211

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:36,000

Yeah, it'll be my first time.

212

00:12:36,000 --> 00:12:37,000

First time?

213

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:38,000

First time.

214

00:12:38,000 --> 00:12:42,000

What we want to do is fly from here over to the ranch.

215

00:12:42,000 --> 00:12:49,000

When you get there, we would like for you to do a grid pattern at five different altitudes.

216

00:12:49,000 --> 00:13:00,000

Eric will show you the points of interest but there's a triangle right in the middle of the property and directly above that between say 2,500 and 5,000 feet, we've seen some weird things.

217

Okay.

218

00:13:01,000 --> 00:13:06,000

And so we're hoping to get some instrumentation in that area and see if we can figure out what those weird things are.

219

Awesome.

220

One thing that not to scare you but occasionally when people are on the ranch and even above the ranch have sort of a physiological response to be in there.

221

You start feeling anything at any point, you know, you're the pilot.

222

00:13:21,000 --> 00:13:25,000

If it's time to abort the mission because you got a weird feeling, then you abort the mission, right?

223

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:26,000

Mm-hmm.

224

00:13:26,000 --> 00:13:31,000

Well, we've got some work to do to get ready to go and you may have some flight prep or something.

225

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:32,000

Absolutely.

226

00:13:32,000 --> 00:13:36,000

So we'll be maybe in and out of the cargo area for the next couple of minutes and then we'll be ready to go.

227

Let's get it done.

228

All right, Eric, let's grab everything.

229

00:13:38,000 --> 00:13:45,000

I'll be going up in the Cessna aircraft today with some GPS trackers and a data logging radiation meter.

230

Our standard equipment set including our spectrum analyzer, Geiger counter and other local equipment.

231

00:13:51,000 --> 00:13:58,000

To observe whether there are any GPS anomalies up near the 5,000 foot point over the triangle.

232

00:13:58,000 --> 00:13:59,000

All right.

233

00:13:59,000 --> 00:14:02,000

And I'm going to close it up and then go put it in the plane.

234

00:14:02,000 --> 00:14:03,000

Sounds good.

235

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:12,000

Today, the plan is to fly the Cessna in a sequential push broom pattern over the ranch, sweeping back and forth over the triangle at various altitudes.

236

00:14:12,000 --> 00:14:25,000

At the same time, using the GPS sensors to collect data that we hope will give us a three-dimensional model of the anomaly that we believe is up there somewhere between 3 and 5,000 feet above the ground.

237

What do you got there?

238

00:14:27,000 --> 00:14:28,000

This is your headset.

239

00:14:28,000 --> 00:14:29,000

Got it.

240

00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:34,000

Okay, and then this is the radio that we're using for the radio source.

241

00:14:34,000 --> 00:14:43,000

For this experiment, we're also making use of a new avionic comm system, making it easier for us to directly communicate from the aircraft to the ground.

242

00:14:43,000 --> 00:14:46,000

I'm going to head back over to the ranch.

243

00:14:46,000 --> 00:14:47,000

You guys, getting the air.

244

00:14:47,000 --> 00:14:48,000

We're burning daylight, right?

245

00:14:48,000 --> 00:14:49,000

See ya.

246

00:14:49,000 --> 00:14:50,000

All right, see you in a bit.

247

00:15:00,000 --> 00:15:02,000

That's about traffic.

248

00:15:02,000 --> 00:15:08,000

Skyhawk 847-7 is taking my 7-4 and direct the eastbound approach.

249

00:15:12,000 --> 00:15:17,000

While I'm in the plane above the ranch, the rest of the team will be monitoring from below.

250

00:15:17,000 --> 00:15:21,000

I'm really excited to see what happens during the course of the experiment.

251

00:15:21,000 --> 00:15:24,000

So we'll go ahead and get closer in and fly over.

252

00:15:24,000 --> 00:15:25,000

I know your land large here.

253

00:15:30,000 --> 00:15:32,000

I've got these antennas running.

254

00:15:32,000 --> 00:15:34,000

This is going out to the two Yaggies.

255

00:15:34,000 --> 00:15:35,000

Okay.

256

00:15:35,000 --> 00:15:40,000

Once she gets over here, we should see her start tracking on there.

257

00:15:40,000 --> 00:15:41,000

Okay.

258

00:15:41,000 --> 00:15:44,000

We're going to monitor this experiment with a couple of different systems.

259

00:15:44,000 --> 00:15:46,000

First, we have an ADS-B.

260

00:15:46,000 --> 00:15:52,000

Now that identifies all the air traffic flying in the vicinity of the ranch and shows them on a map.

261

00:15:52,000 --> 00:15:55,000

We've also mounted two antennas on the deck of the command center.

262

00:15:55,000 --> 00:16:00,000

Those are pointed at the triangle to track the signals being broadcast from Kendra's plane,

263

00:16:00,000 --> 00:16:05,000

as well as scan for any dangerous energy spikes like we've detected there in the past.

264

00:16:05,000 --> 00:16:06,000

All right, great.

265

00:16:06,000 --> 00:16:08,000

Let me get this going.

266

00:16:08,000 --> 00:16:09,000

There it is.

267

00:16:09,000 --> 00:16:10,000

Got it.

268

00:16:10,000 --> 00:16:14,000

All right, both antennas and radios are functioning properly.

269

Hey, Caleb, this is the command center.

270

00:16:17,000 --> 00:16:18,000

Do you copy?

What could cause Kinders Plane not to show up on the ADSB like that?

298

It makes no sense.

299

Why are we picking them up?

300

You can walk her control to N84717.

301

00:17:30,000 --> 00:17:32,000

Do you copy?

302

Hey, Travis.

303

There you go.

Hey, Eric.

This is Travis.

You copy?

We have not had a single experiment out of the triangle, up in the air, that has gone per plan.

So what is it about the triangle and us trying to do experiments at the triangle that seems to trigger irregularities?

It seems like someone or something doesn't want us to collect data from the triangle.

What are you hearing?

I would describe it as a mechanical grinding coming out of the speaker.

We're not broadcasting anything like that.

Alright, so yeah, we're not broadcasting anything like that.

You know, I'm seeing the shadow of some other aircraft on going across the property.

Check the ADSB and see if you've got some traffic here.

388

Negative, Eric, there's nothing within 40, like 50 miles of the ranch.

389

Is it another airplane?

I just caught the shadow moving across the property.

391

Seeing anomalies over in the ranch makes me feel a little bit nervous.

392

We were all totally mystified when both Eric and Kendra, the pilot, suddenly reported that some kind of shadow was tracking along with the Cessna.

393

That's extremely strange.

We checked our ADSB system and there was no other plane in the area.

395

There's something underneath us according to the radar.

That we later identified in camera footage as some kind of shadowy UAP.

Stand by, stand by for one moment please.

414

There's no way that should have been possible.

It was like we were being recorded by someone or something in real time.

416

Maybe it's in here.

417

We're here.

That is telling us that one of us is broadcasting at 1.623800 GHz.

419

Eric and I have been having a conversation late that we think that there could be a needs dropping device here.

421

Maybe we've been detecting it with these spectrum analyzers.

And that might be it.

Really?

424

And so somebody's turning it on and off which is why we're not seeing it all the time?

425

The strange energy spike along with the sound frequency from the radio and our voices being broadcast and echoing back at us could mean that we're being surveilled on the ranch.

427

But what I can't even begin to explain, especially given that Eric and Kendra saw what they believed to be a UAP, is what the source of that surveillance could be.

428

So we can still hear you outside.

441

Oh.

442

Testing, testing, testing. You guys picking me up at all.

443

Testing, testing.

444

00:26:46,000 --> 00:26:55,000

The most troubling thing for me was hearing Travis, Bryant and myself being broadcast over this frequency.

445

What the crap does that mean?

446

I've said before, is there not any safe place on the ranch?

447

00:27:01,000 --> 00:27:05,000

I would say now, is there any private place on the ranch?

448

The signal stopped.

449

00:27:10,000 --> 00:27:12,000

What have we played with?

450

00:27:12,000 --> 00:27:13,000

What just happened?

451

00:27:13,000 --> 00:27:15,000

That was really odd.

452

00:27:16,000 --> 00:27:25,000

So we are descending now, approaching the 3000 HGL mark, and we advise that strange noise has just disappeared.

453

But as we were descending from the 5000 foot level, we were getting this interference on our cocks, and it has disappeared.

454

Eric, I don't like that.

455

00:27:40,000 --> 00:27:44,000

I would advise that you come down from a safety standpoint.

456

Hey Kendra, does Travis do you copy?

457

I do, we're at the 2000 foot level.

458

I think we stopped attempting and...

Head on back to the airport from there.

460

Sounds good, we're going to have to turn eastbound here now.

461

Well they're done, that's it. They're headed back to the airport. Eric's still got the hand held if we want to talk to him on his way, but they'll be at the airport. 5 or 10 minutes.

The main bit of data that we're really looking forward to is the GPS data that Eric and I put in the plane, that's collecting it real time on the computer, so we know it's actually working.

And when he gets on the ground and we crunch that, we're going to be able to create a GPS anomaly map over the entire ranch from a 1000 feet to 6000 feet above ground level.

After meeting with John and Mckonkey, it was obvious that he needed to come to Skinwokker Ranch. His interpretation of the petroglyphs and pictographs that are up on the walls of Mckonkey Ranch could be really interesting to Eric and Travis.

471

There's a lot of similarities in what we saw there, and then there's some things here that I've never seen before, and we hope you can give us some insight on.

472

00:29:18,000 --> 00:29:19,000

Right, I'd love to see them.

473

00:29:19,000 --> 00:29:22,000

Let's jump in the Ranger and head down.

474

00:29:25,000 --> 00:29:33,000

We've found an strange notable location on top of the mesa. We're hoping to get his take on what it is.

475

00:29:33,000 --> 00:29:38,000

So it is just right kind of at the top of this mesa, so it's a little bit of a hike.

476

00:29:39,000 --> 00:29:46,000

It's important that we explore what all these sites could mean in the bigger picture of the ranch.

477

00:29:47,000 --> 00:29:51,000

Yeah, so this spot is some sort of mound.

478

00:29:54,000 --> 00:29:56,000

Absolutely amazing.

479

00:29:56,000 --> 00:30:09,000

The fact that there's all these stones around what seems to be some sort of mound in the very middle, what do you think?

480

00:30:09,000 --> 00:30:15,000

I get the sense that this is something sacred here, that it was purpose built.

481

00:30:16,000 --> 00:30:27,000

I was going to make a suggestion. In a lot of native cultures, you approach things from a clockwise direction.

482

00:30:27,000 --> 00:30:35,000

So what I'd like to do is approach this and go around in a clockwise manner and take a look at things.

483

00:30:35,000 --> 00:30:43,000

It's just a sign of respect on any type of sacred site, and we just want to honor that here.

484

00:30:43,000 --> 00:30:46,000

If you go counterclockwise, it's kind of a negative thing.

485

00:30:46,000 --> 00:30:48,000

Oh, well let's do that.

486

00:30:48,000 --> 00:30:50,000

Yeah, why don't you lead the way?

487

00:30:53,000 --> 00:31:03,000

We got up to the top of the mesa there, and to me it looked almost like a stonehenge type structure with these rocks and a circular pattern around there.

488

00:31:03,000 --> 00:31:09,000

Traditional beliefs with the Navajo are something that is brought up when you're a child.

489

00:31:09,000 --> 00:31:24,000

You grow up in that there's a certain way to act, there's a certain way to do things, and so you would start and go clockwise around it and come back to it to complete the circle before you entered.

490

00:31:25,000 --> 00:31:28,000

That's just traditional with most native tribes.

491

00:31:29,000 --> 00:31:33,000

So I want to stop and show you something on this boulder.

492

00:31:33,000 --> 00:31:44,000

Maybe you want to step over and look at it here yourself for just a minute, but there were a few things that seemed worth noting.

493

What do you think of those?

494

00:31:48,000 --> 00:32:01,000

What I'm seeing here is four distinct lines that are carved into this rock, and typically they could be marking periods of time.

495

We don't know what the time was.

And then around the side there you see right where you're standing.

497

00:32:07,000 --> 00:32:12,000

We understand the erosion here, but that hole.

498

Right.

00:32:14,000 --> 00:32:19,000

Yeah, so that looks like it could be natural.

500

00:32:19,000 --> 00:32:26,000

Well, this one, if you sight through it, it's right on the horizon when you're looking at it.

501

00:32:26,000 --> 00:32:35,000

And during spring and fall, when the sun rises, it comes straight through this hole.

502

00:32:35,000 --> 00:32:36,000

Yeah.

503

00:32:36,000 --> 00:32:40,000

So what do you believe this is, this place?

504

00:32:40,000 --> 00:32:44,000

This is rather interesting.

505

00:32:44,000 --> 00:32:50,000

When I see mounds like this, it could be a holy place.

506

00:32:50,000 --> 00:32:57,000

I'm thinking here's a place where prayers were offered, a sacred place.

507

00:32:57,000 --> 00:33:03,000

I believe that this area is used as a tailspin to keep the evil on that side.

508

00:33:11,000 --> 00:33:13,000

That is incredible.

509

00:33:13,000 --> 00:33:17,000

I'm thinking there's definitely something here.

510

00:33:17,000 --> 00:33:22,000

And I just, I can feel it in my bones, you know.

511

00:33:22,000 --> 00:33:23,000

Yeah.

512

00:33:23,000 --> 00:33:26,000

Well, let's continue around and complete the circle.

513

Okay.

514

00:33:27,000 --> 00:33:32,000

Looking at this place, in its entirety, it struck me as a holy place.

515

00:33:32,000 --> 00:33:45,000

It could have been used as some kind of protection ceremony to keep whatever is historically here in Skinwalker Ranch from traveling over the Mesa.

516

00:33:45,000 --> 00:33:55,000

And we have basically a spiral right here that's been put into this ground here.

517

00:33:55,000 --> 00:34:06,000

And as we've seen today at Mankanke, and maybe here, that spiral is indicative of a portal, a dimensional rift, an opening.

518

00:34:06,000 --> 00:34:12,000

The ancient people that populated this land knew of this place.

519

00:34:12,000 --> 00:34:13,000

There's evil there.

520

00:34:13,000 --> 00:34:20,000

There's something that can kill you, whether it's skinwalkers or some kind of malignant power.

521

00:34:20,000 --> 00:34:29,000

So it doesn't strike me as unusual, this spiritual idea of this warding off of what could come that way.

522

00:34:29,000 --> 00:34:36,000

So John, you've enlightened us so much and given us so much more to work on and added greatly to our investigations.

523

00:34:36,000 --> 00:34:38,000

Well, good, good.

524

00:34:38,000 --> 00:34:39,000

I'm glad.

525

00:34:39,000 --> 00:34:41,000

Thank you for having me out here.

526

00:34:41,000 --> 00:34:44,000

Thank you for coming and spending this much time with us.

527

00:34:44,000 --> 00:34:46,000

Yeah, let's head back down.

528

We're going to take a look at the data that we got out of the experiment with the Cessna.

529

I've got our own data.

530

We also have some data from the pilot.

531

Oh, good.

532

00:35:06,000 --> 00:35:14,000

The day after our Cessna experiment over the Triangle, Eric has all the data sorted out, so we're eager to see what he was able to collect,

533
