Photogrammetry is a process where thousands of high-definition photographs

41

are taken of an area of interest and combined to create a detailed three-dimensional map,

42

potentially revealing features that aren't visible to the naked eye.

43

All right, here's good. All right.

Before we have to put our investigation on hold until next year,

45

we want to get a 3D model of every part of the ranch to see if any anomalies appear.

We're interested to find out whether the results will bear out anything anomalous.

Travis, good to see you.

I wanted to catch up with you.

Now, Seth is a senior astronomer for the Institute known as SETI, which stands for the Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence.

I wanted to talk to him about the mysterious 1.6 gigahertz signal that we've been detecting on the ranch, which I believe could be some kind of communication signal.

As you know, I'm out here as part of this investigation of Skinwalker Ranch and we're actually finding some really weird stuff.

86

We're finding optical phenomena and all sorts of different regimes of energy and even a strange RF signal at 1.6 gigahertz.

And what I wanted to ask you is if I found a signal that I thought was an intelligent communication, what protocols SETI would use in a situation like that to start, you know, verifying, validating and reporting?

Well, there is a protocol.

In fact, I was the chair of the committee that revised those protocols about five years ago.

The first thing is if you pick up a signal that you think might be E.T., you want to make sure it isn't a telecommunication satellite.

It isn't a radar down at a local airport or anything like that.

The second thing you do is you tell everybody.

So let me ask you a question.

96

Say we have confirmed an optical signal and it's repeatable.

If you go through the process and you rule out all of the potential logical culprits, the microwave oven, an airplane, a satellite, you know, those types of things, what would be your next step in verifying?

Well, as I say, you're really critically dependent on being able to verify the signal at some other facility.

So you would insist on trying to get somewhere else.

All right, Eric, she's about to broadcast it.

SETS' suggestion that we would want confirmation of the 1.6 gigahertz communication signal at another location struck me because that's exactly what happened a month ago at the Jack FM radio station about 11 miles north of Skinwalker Ranch.

After the station manager and DJ, Jen Rook, told me and Eric that the same kind of signal had infiltrated their airwaves, we decided to see what would happen if she broadcast it back out.

Wow, it really changed her waveform big time.

Last night, about 8 p.m.

So imagine, you know, advanced civilization wanted to communicate in real time what type of phenomenology or telltale signs might SETI look for.

If it's really coming from another society, it would be in one direction.

118

And that's kind of the clue that you would see it coming from that direction on the sky.

I think that's exactly what I wanted to hear, Seth.

120

It was interesting how Seth, a highly accredited scientist who researches the potential for ET life, believed the type of communication signal we detected would come from a specific direction because that's exactly what happened on the ranch.

Go back the other way.

Five weeks ago, when we detected the 1.6 gigahertz signal, it came from a specific spot.

Right there.

Where we had just launched a rocket near Homestead 2.

And then later that night, Eric recorded an incredible UAP moving around the Homestead.

132

We can't be sure if that communication signal we detected was what led to the UAP appearing or if it represents more evidence that portals could really exist on Skinwalker Ranch.

The day after Pete Kelsey conducted his photogrammetry scan of the ranch, he sent Eric all of his compiled data files for us to review.

150

Well, I've got only about a billion data points.

151

Of course, this comes out of Pete Kelsey's recent survey work.

152

This is a three-dimensional model.

153

It's point cloud data.

154

00:10:03,000 --> 00:10:10,000

What it is is individual points that have been located through a complex algorithm coming out of all these thousands of pictures that he's taken.

155

So you take all those images, you stitch them together, and you get a three-dimensional model.

156

That's incredible.

157

00:10:15,000 --> 00:10:16,000

Oh, yeah.

158

Yeah, so I've been diving into this, and it turns out there are some very interesting artifacts showing up.

159

Whoa.

You might...

I just saw one.

That looks like that's a whole bunch of points right there.

This phantom structure that's sticking up in the sky.

Wow, I think it was really prominent from here.

179

It's like it's a...

180

Yeah.

Some sort of big feature.

182

It looks more than 100 feet in here.

183

That's nuts.

184

One way of interpreting this is to say that the drone did not

185

properly register its correct GPS position when it took the pictures.

186

Were you thinking that?

187

I was about to suggest that we've had such trouble with those drones and their GPS coordinates being spoofed,

188

hacked, or jammed.

189

Yes.

190

What if it thought it was somewhere else when it took those pictures?

191

But you got tens of...

192

Correct.

193

...positions that should cancel itself out.

194

Well, you'd have to have a lingering condition in that space that causes some sort of displacement,

195

some phantom displacement of the reckoned position,

196

00:11:40,000 --> 00:11:42,000

the measured position of the drone in the sky.

197

What's so strange here is, if the GPS was being spoofed for the whole survey,

198

the final photogrammetry image would be a big blur.

199

That's not what's happening at all.

200

This one specific spot over the ranch is confusing the photogrammetry data

201

and confusing it from a number of different angles,

202

which makes me think there's something really strange about this particular area.

203

Another interpretation might be if you did have some kind of translucent effect or object in the sky,

204

then I suppose it might also cause the algorithm to perceive those pixels

205

whose color comes from the ground as being somewhere else up in the air.

206

Has Pete seen this before?

207

Did you ask him?

208

00:12:25,000 --> 00:12:26,000

That's the other important point.

209

I've connected with Pete and I've also spoken with the vendor of this software

210

asking, is this common?

211

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:36,000

And the answer that I've gotten is no.

212

Really?

213

00:12:38,000 --> 00:12:43,000

This is not a common thing in terrestrial surveys like this.

214

Are there any other areas in his survey that had this sort of artifact to them?

215

Yes.

I want to show you something at another location that we've visited that is part of this survey.

217

Okay.

This is right above the petroglyph area, right?

220

Yes, it is.

Just on the edge of our property.

222

Right.

And you'll recognize the stone circle here.

224

Yep.

And the feature that I want to show you is actually very close to this stone circle.

226

Oh, there you go.

There you go.

So let me spin us around.

230

I noticed a couple of things here.

231

Wow, now look at this.

232

And you may observe the same thing I have.

233

So line those two up and where are they pointing?

234

This feature, this artifact, the largest stone that was part of the stone circle

235

and that prominent thing that's jetting up, you know, further to the south.

236

See, you have three points in a line.

237

Wow.

238

Interestingly and somewhat mysteriously, the anomalies to the south and to the north of the stone circle

239

align perfectly with that large center stone in the stone circle itself.

240

Could be a coincidence, but it sure is suggestive.

241

What are the odds of that?

242

Right.

243

We've learned not to ignore any anomalous features in our data, even if we have no idea what to make of them.

244

So that to me seems like you've almost drawn a ray from the other anomaly through this stone to this anomaly.

245

We've got a line being drawn here.

246

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:24,000

Then what is that line pointing to?

247

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:26,000

What is the line there for?

248

00:14:26,000 --> 00:14:33,000

We need to mark these spots because, you know, what if this is somehow mapping an anomaly that we need to investigate?

249

You remember last year when we had that expert out?

250

He said that the petroglyph was depicting a portal.

251

So, I mean, we're getting way out there.

252

That pillar's alignment with it kind of looks like in the data points, a spiraling thing, a portal type feature.

253

That's interesting.

Last year, we had Dr. Alan Garfinkel come out to examine some petroglyphs we had discovered on the east side of the property,

255

right by the location of this strange aerial anomaly that we're seeing.

256

What I'm looking at is these curves.

257

It's a metaphor for a serpent or a snake.

258

Snakes represents two different worlds.

259

So it's a guardian to the portals.

260

The portal is a window into the supernatural.

261

Dragon is right about the petroglyphs near this area.

262

But this strange structure in Pete's photogrammetry data is right above a mysterious spiral of boulders on the mason.

263

I'm thinking there's definitely something here.

264

And earlier this year, Navajo expert and historian John Dover told us this feature may have been constructed by ancient indigenous people to represent a very specific phenomenon.

265

Looking at this place in its entirety, it struck me as a holy place.

266

We have basically a spiral right here that's been put into this ground here.

267

That spiral is indicative of a portal, a dimensional rip, an opening.

We've seen a lot of unidentified aerial phenomena, some that I would say even qualify as unidentified flying objects.

That's when his drill bit encountered something hard and seemingly impenetrable.

412

We're coming up about 11 inches every 10 feet.

413

So it sounds like you're describing kind of a V.

Not only was this hard object dome shaped.

It also appeared to be 400 feet wide and made out of metal.

But the biggest surprise came when we had a piece of the metal analyzed.

So I'm going to pass around a few of the samples of which we have many into the hundreds

428

that have been taken out of that, what, 5 or 6 inch diameter hole.

429

We're talking about a 6 inch hole into the mesa.

430

We made it back about 420 feet.

431

These started coming out as we were well into the hundreds of feet into the mesa.

432

But who knows how much of it never came back out of the mountain.

Eric reached out to the local university here and had them do an analysis with a scanning electron microscope

434

and do precise elemental analysis make up of this material.

435

The interesting thing about the analysis that we got,

436

tellurium is only on one side and europium which is on the other side.

437

Now tellurium and europium are two of the most rare materials on the planet and it was fused.

438

Can that happen naturally?

439

If it were going to be made on earth, it would have to be done deep under the crust,

440

00:28:29,000 --> 00:28:32,000

miles deep in a geological process.

441

There's no volcanic processes happening there on the ranch or in the U.N.T. basin that we know of.

442

The only other natural way to create this would be an asteroid impact.

443

But what we're missing from this asteroid is we're missing nickel, we're missing iridium,

444

we're missing some other things that would be there if it were an asteroid.

445

This bears a lot of resemblance to things that were made in a furnace as if this is perhaps an engineered material.

446

You remember the space shuttle tiles that protected it from heat on reentry?

447

This material make up is very similar to that ceramic.

448

So Governor Herbert, let me tell you, we did another, probably the biggest, most complicated, most expensive experiment

449

that has ever been done at the ranch.

450

We had three laser systems and we placed them in a triangular position, pointed up at the anomaly in the sky over the ranch.

451

And then we also had a very large rocket system so that we could put a payload into the anomaly and have it linger

452

as the recovery system brought it back down with multiple instruments.

Now, we get ready to do the launch and Brandon tell me what happened when we counted down and you pushed the button.

454
