and also a number of other shapes.

Wow.

It turns out that in the 19th century,

93

members of the indigenous youth and Navajo nations in the region

had a bitter feud, and the Navajo cursed the land

95

known as skinwalkers.

But that was only the beginning of what people have claimed

98

to experience on and near the ranch.

As early as 1911,

100

newspaper reports profiled strange noises in the basin.

101

and he has a wide variety of scientific knowledge.

127

We want your perspective.

128

We've noticed that when we bring new people onto the ranch,

129

the ranch behaves differently than it normally does.

130

It's just a place, right?

131

I mean...

132

And then there's the ranch superintendent, Thomas Winnerton.

133

Back in 2016, he found out firsthand

134

that a legend warning never to disturb the ground

135

on Skinwalker Ranch might have some merit.

I had been warned not to dig on this ranch

137

Look at the cows.

179

That's crazy.

180

00:08:18,500 --> 00:08:20,500

Never seen that before.

181

00:08:21,500 --> 00:08:22,500

Look, look, look, look.

182

00:08:22,500 --> 00:08:23,500

What is that?

183

00:08:23,500 --> 00:08:25,500

We got something. Hold on.

184

00:08:25,500 --> 00:08:26,500

It was stunning.

185

00:08:26,500 --> 00:08:29,500

A UAP not only appeared in the sky,

186

but the cattle on the ranch seemed to sense it before we did.

Fill my phone.

198

00:09:02,500 --> 00:09:04,500

It's going vibrate to mute, vibrate to mute like crazy.

199

Holy crap.

200

When we went to investigate, both Thomas' and Caleb Bench's phones went haywire.

201

My phone starts freaking out whenever your tri-field goes off.

202

I don't have any control over my phone right now.

203

Dude, look at that.

Is it still doing it?

205

00:09:20,500 --> 00:09:21,500

Is it five?

206

00:09:21,500 --> 00:09:22,500

It's 18?

207

00:09:22,500 --> 00:09:24,500

It just jumped to 18 just then.

208

And another dangerous spike of radiation registered on our meters.

209

Oh, wow.

But we need to get out of here, guys.

211

Let's get out of here.

212

We had no explanation for what happened to the cow or what caused the radiation.

213

But then we met with Linda Moulton-Howe to review surveillance footage that captured the cow's death.

214

We were shocked by what we saw.

228

What was this craft doing out there?

230

And why, at the very time this cow was dying, was this craft seen in the sky?

231

We very well could have prevented a full-blown cattle mutilation from occurring.

232

That's a possibility.

233

That's a possibility.

234

I feel strongly where there are mutilations, where there are UFOs, you're going to find

Over the past three years, one of the places on Skinwalker Ranch where we've seen and felt

247

It was built in 1905 by John and Emma Myers, who lived there and raised cattle, but it's

248

been abandoned since the 1930s.

249

And I've come to understand why.

250

I was looking around the Homestead with a fellow scientist, Dr. Jim Sagala, and became

very curious about an old, covered cistern.

What the crap is that?

It's filled with something.

254

I don't know.

256

I've got a little bit of a headache or something happening.

257

00:12:05,500 --> 00:12:10,500

I don't know where it came from, but as soon as I lifted that lid, I was overcome with

258

00:12:10,500 --> 00:12:12,500

dizziness and a headache.

259

00:12:12,500 --> 00:12:15,500

Well, maybe we should check our dose meters or whatever.

260

00:12:15,500 --> 00:12:16,500

Yeah.

261

00:12:16,500 --> 00:12:19,500

Holy, mine's beeping.

262

00:12:19,500 --> 00:12:20,500

Your max dose rate is about 120?

263

00:12:20,500 --> 00:12:21,500

Yes, 120 something.

264

00:12:21,500 --> 00:12:23,500

That's pretty high.

265

00:12:23,500 --> 00:12:29,500

Turns out, I got hit with radiation that was equivalent to about 20,000 airport security

266

00:12:29,500 --> 00:12:35,500

X-rays all at once that left burns on my hand and my face.

267

00:12:35,500 --> 00:12:39,500

So how does it feel right now to be back?

268

00:12:39,500 --> 00:12:41,500

It's a little, I'm a little nervous.

269

00:12:41,500 --> 00:12:44,500

I'm not, you know, to be honest.

270

00:12:44,500 --> 00:12:50,500

Another disturbing incident happened in 2020 when a local resident named Roland McCook told Jim

271

Morse and ranch caretakers Tom Lewis and Candace Lindy about an experience he had many years

272

00:12:55,500 --> 00:12:59,500

ago at Homestead 2 while hunting on the property.

273

00:12:59,500 --> 00:13:01,500

We were looking for tracks.

274

00:13:01,500 --> 00:13:04,500

We noticed there were human footprints.

275

00:13:04,500 --> 00:13:10,500

And I followed the tracks and then I'll turn from human footprints to a big dog.

276

00:13:10,500 --> 00:13:11,500

Tracks.

277

00:13:11,500 --> 00:13:13,500

Like a wolf.

278

00:13:13,500 --> 00:13:18,500

And it came out red ice, probably like eight feet tall.

279

Whatever it is, it doesn't belong here.

280

Roland's story sounded incredible, but he was so sincere about it.

281

Did he really encounter a skin walker?

282

We don't know, but what happened moments later was definitely real.

Hold on.

Just like what happened to me and others, Roland was clearly affected by a strange energy spike

288

Around that same time, retired Army Colonel John Alexander, one of the principal investigators who worked for Robert Bigelow,

290

not only shared a crazy story of his own, but also offered a theory of what is causing the phenomena at Homestead 2.

After the UAPX experiment, we invited a team of astronomers out to focus high-powered telescopes up through the Mile High Zone at the triangle.

We still have a lot of questions about what is truly behind all the phenomena we and many others

723
