What do you think you'll be able to get the drill

41

actually up in here in an area right there where he's been cleared out?

Yep, we can get her up in here.

He's done a good job.

44

Boy, that thing sounds like it's hitting something hard.

45

It's right in this spot where last year,

46

we drilled up against a massive 400-foot-long dome-shaped object.

47

We're coming up about 11 inches every 10 feet.

So, it sounds like you're describing kind of a V.

49

Yeah, it could even be. Maybe a dome.

What is that?

The drill didn't penetrate it,

52

but we did obtain metallic fragments that could be from its surface.

53

There's no telling how much of this metallic crap

54

there is still in that hillside.

55

Scientific analysis revealed to us that those fragments

56

were made up of materials that are similar to what we're seeing

57

on the exterior of the space show for protection from extreme heat

behind the dome-shaped object that's almost as tall as the Mesa.

I can't tell you what that is, but it is highly anomalous.

72

73

Start in up above it this time, huh?

Maybe we'll have a better chance of pushing through whatever that is.

Since we couldn't penetrate the underside of the dome-shaped object when we drilled last year,

85

this time, we want to drill into it from above.

Hopefully, we can not only get better evidence of what that is,

87

00:04:27,000 --> 00:04:32,000

but also figure out whatever the vertical anomaly behind it is, too.

We're talking about a 300 feet in and about 2 1/2 degrees off of north.

89

Now, I don't know how precisely you can direct that thing.

Right there is perfect. You can get to stay up.

I've got a Spectran device connected to the antennas,

the Yaggies that are out in the field with us,

and we'll be looking, especially, of course,

110

in that 1.6 gigahertz frequency range

111

to see if there is an increase in activity here.

and this area, the skinwalker ranch,

152

has always been cursed, evil,

153

whatever you want to call it.

154

Was it someplace that you were scared to go?

155

Yeah, most definitely.

161

by the other tribes or other tribal members.

The Yute people have been handing down accounts

164

of strange phenomena and mysterious,

165

00:07:43,280 --> 00:07:45,280

shape-shifting creatures in the area

166

00:07:45,280 --> 00:07:49,780

that are known as skinwalkers dating back centuries.

167

00:07:49,780 --> 00:07:51,480

Usually, they won't talk about it

168

00:07:51,480 --> 00:07:53,480

with anyone outside their tribe,

169

00:07:53,480 --> 00:07:56,080

so whenever members are willing to open up to us,

170

00:07:56,080 --> 00:07:58,020

our team takes it very seriously

171

00:07:58,020 --> 00:08:00,420

and listens with the Yute most respect.

172

00:08:01,420 --> 00:08:02,920

Do you think it's changing now?

173

00:08:02,920 --> 00:08:07,020

Like, the generations are more open to talk about it?

174

00:08:07,020 --> 00:08:09,520

In my opinion, I think this investigation

175

00:08:09,520 --> 00:08:11,460

is opening a lot of doors.

176

00:08:11,460 --> 00:08:15,760

Those who keep quiet are slowly coming forward.

177

00:08:15,760 --> 00:08:18,500

I think throughout the Yuenna Basin,

178

00:08:18,500 --> 00:08:21,100

the majority of people out here

179

00:08:21,100 --> 00:08:22,840

have experienced something strange.

180

00:08:22,840 --> 00:08:23,840

Yeah.

181

00:08:23,840 --> 00:08:26,340

They cannot define.

182

00:08:26,760 --> 00:08:30,100

And it's extremely important

183

00:08:30,100 --> 00:08:33,900

for brave people like yourselves to come out

184

00:08:33,900 --> 00:08:36,080

and just talk about it.

185

00:08:36,080 --> 00:08:39,080

Have you ever seen anything you couldn't describe or...

186

00:08:39,080 --> 00:08:43,280

Well, have you guys heard of the path of the skinwalker

187

00:08:43,280 --> 00:08:44,180

by any chance?

188

00:08:44,180 --> 00:08:45,020

Oh, yes.

189

00:08:46,580 --> 00:08:49,520

The ridge or the mesa that runs the expanse of this property

190

00:08:49,520 --> 00:08:53,220

has always historically been known as skinwalker ridge.

191

00:08:53,220 --> 00:08:55,060

And the Yutes and the Navajo

192

00:08:55,080 --> 00:08:56,860

had always, for generations,

193

00:08:56,860 --> 00:08:59,020

referred to this property as being in the path

194

00:08:59,020 --> 00:09:00,820

of the skinwalker.

195

00:09:00,820 --> 00:09:04,660

The shape-shifting demonic figure from a curse

196

00:09:04,660 --> 00:09:06,160

that was placed on the property.

197

00:09:07,500 --> 00:09:11,500

My grandmother used to say that skinwalkers

198

00:09:11,500 --> 00:09:16,300

use these old pathways to get from one area to another.

199

00:09:16,300 --> 00:09:17,140

Okay.

200

00:09:17,140 --> 00:09:18,800

And many paths would converge back

201

00:09:18,800 --> 00:09:20,980

into the skinwalker ranch area.

202

00:09:21,980 --> 00:09:23,700

One night we were driving south

203

00:09:23,700 --> 00:09:25,740

and we came up to the south end,

204

00:09:25,740 --> 00:09:27,140

way down there on the road,

205

00:09:27,140 --> 00:09:32,140

and we seen the skinwalker literally maybe from...

206

00:09:32,640 --> 00:09:36,180

From me to the gate right here, the fence line.

207

What was odd about it was it was like almost...

208

00:09:41,920 --> 00:09:44,320

It looked human, but almost feline.

209

It literally crawled on all fours

210

00:09:50,300 --> 00:09:53,060

from one end of the road to the other,

211

00:09:53,060 --> 00:09:54,580

looked up once at us,

212

00:09:54,580 --> 00:09:56,340

and it was as if it was startled

213

00:09:56,340 --> 00:09:58,900

and crawled even faster away from us.

214

00:09:59,860 --> 00:10:00,700

Really?

215

00:10:00,700 --> 00:10:02,020

Yeah.

216

00:10:02,020 --> 00:10:04,540

Yeah, that would be one example.

217

00:10:04,540 --> 00:10:07,540

Other experiences include one night,

218

00:10:07,540 --> 00:10:11,860

around the year 2013.

219

00:10:11,860 --> 00:10:15,140

It was about July, if I remember correctly.

220

00:10:15,140 --> 00:10:18,900

We saw these fluorescent lights coming up

221

00:10:19,140 --> 00:10:20,060

in the highway.

222

00:10:21,020 --> 00:10:25,580

I was stupid enough to park the car and watch these lights

223

00:10:25,580 --> 00:10:28,820

about a dozen of them in that south field over there.

224

00:10:28,820 --> 00:10:32,500

They were like blue, green, and maybe purple,

225

00:10:32,500 --> 00:10:35,860

until one of them like kind of started going towards us.

226

00:10:35,860 --> 00:10:36,780

Came toward you?

227

00:10:36,780 --> 00:10:37,620

Yeah.

228

00:10:37,620 --> 00:10:38,460

Yeah.

229

00:10:38,460 --> 00:10:40,020

It did feel like they were threatening us.

230

Wow.

231

00:10:46,860 --> 00:10:48,740

We got so scared.

232

00:10:49,460 --> 00:10:51,580

Right after that, we took off,

233

00:10:51,580 --> 00:10:54,180

but we all got sick that night.

234

Sick how?

235

00:10:55,020 --> 00:10:57,300

Like nausea, feeling, headache.

236

00:10:58,180 --> 00:11:00,260

How long did that sickness last?

237

00:11:00,260 --> 00:11:03,300

I'd say just a few hours.

238

00:11:03,300 --> 00:11:04,260

So once you were gone?

239

00:11:04,260 --> 00:11:07,380

Yeah, once we got home up in Neola,

240

00:11:07,380 --> 00:11:10,780

we all got better.

241

00:11:11,700 --> 00:11:14,180

That's something that I've experienced

242

00:11:14,180 --> 00:11:16,500

and others on the ranch have experienced.

243

00:11:17,460 --> 00:11:20,260

In recent years, members of our team,

244

00:11:20,260 --> 00:11:22,660

as well as people who we've invited to the ranch

245

00:11:22,660 --> 00:11:24,820

to help in our investigations,

246

00:11:24,820 --> 00:11:26,260

have suddenly had really strange

247

00:11:26,260 --> 00:11:28,420

and disturbing health episodes.

248

00:11:29,620 --> 00:11:30,980

My head is killing me.

249

00:11:30,980 --> 00:11:32,340

That's not all right.

250

00:11:32,340 --> 00:11:33,140

It's just robbing.

251

00:11:33,940 --> 00:11:35,060

Hold on.

252

00:11:35,060 --> 00:11:35,380

Hey.

253

00:11:38,580 --> 00:11:39,620

Are you okay?

254

00:11:39,620 --> 00:11:39,860

No.

255

00:11:39,860 --> 00:11:41,540

I'm in the changing stuff.

256

00:11:41,540 --> 00:11:42,500

We've worked out.

257

00:11:42,500 --> 00:11:43,300

Are you serious?

258

00:11:43,780 --> 00:11:45,700

So it was even more intriguing

259

00:11:45,700 --> 00:11:48,020

that Mikey had similar experiences.

260

00:11:48,020 --> 00:11:49,540

And it was really incredible

261

00:11:49,540 --> 00:11:53,220

that he believed he saw numerous orbs or UAPs

262

00:11:53,220 --> 00:11:54,820

in the South Field,

263

00:11:54,820 --> 00:11:57,860

and that one of those orbs had even stalked him.

264

It's very interesting because that's

265

a common phenomenon that happens here.

266

267

you know, that's when they're going to die.

269

You know, that's when they start to feel better.

270

00:12:14,820 --> 00:12:15,540

So...

271

Is that because of the...

272

Is it almost like an electric field around here?

273

00:12:22,900 --> 00:12:23,940

That's a great question,

274

00:12:23,940 --> 00:12:26,900

and that's something the physicists

275

00:12:26,900 --> 00:12:27,860

are trying to figure out.

276

You know, the strangeness is just the variability of it.

277

We don't know when it's going to happen,

278

I've gone through many reservations

283

and talked to many natives,

284

00:12:44,420 --> 00:12:45,540

and they all...

285

We all have the same thing.

286

00:12:47,300 --> 00:12:48,980

When you see something like that,

287

00:12:48,980 --> 00:12:51,220

you stay away because usually things

288

00:12:51,220 --> 00:12:54,020

attach to our spirits or our bodies,

289

00:12:54,020 --> 00:12:56,260

and you never know.

290

00:12:56,260 --> 00:12:57,540

You just never know.

291

00:12:57,540 --> 00:12:59,220

Well, thank you for your courage,

292

00:12:59,220 --> 00:13:02,420

and thank you so much for coming to the ranch.

293

00:13:02,420 --> 00:13:03,700

Well, thank you for having us.

294

00:13:03,700 --> 00:13:04,420

Making time for us.

295

00:13:04,420 --> 00:13:05,140

Any time.

296

00:13:05,140 --> 00:13:07,300

Anything you need, just ask.

297

00:13:07,300 --> 00:13:07,940

Sound perfect.

298

00:13:09,860 --> 00:13:14,900

How far in are you, Aaron?

299

60 feet.

300

00:13:16,980 --> 00:13:17,460

60?

301

00:13:18,820 --> 00:13:20,980

He's 60 feet into the mesa so far.

302

Well, let us know if you see anything.

303

Copy that.

Later that afternoon,

305

00:13:26,020 --> 00:13:28,420

the drilling process was well underway,

306

00:13:28,420 --> 00:13:30,660

but since we were still more than a couple hundred feet

and got footage of some kind of metallic object.

It definitely looks like it's reflecting something off of there.

What is that?

Yes.

397

Two weeks ago...

398

There's something in the sky above the rocket right here.

399

00:17:24,820 --> 00:17:30,100

We used a high-speed camera to capture an image about 31 feet high above the triangle

400

00:17:30,100 --> 00:17:35,220

of some kind of blob-like phenomena that caused a rocket to explode right after launch.

401

00:17:35,220 --> 00:17:37,940

We're maybe looking at the anomaly for the first time, guys.

402

00:17:39,220 --> 00:17:44,420

So if that blob is the cause of all the phenomena we've encountered at the triangle over the past

403

three years, I believe David Mason and his equipment can help us make it reappear

404

and possibly figure out what it could be.

I hope you brought some good stuff for us to use.

I brought a triple-spectrum lightwave transmitter.

408

We can send data on it and transmit it into the atmosphere to see if we can provoke a response.

It'd be really interesting to see what happens if we pump that 1.6 gigahertz signal through it.

411

Yeah, I'm looking forward to it.

Well, let's get the stuff out and start setting up because it's going to be dark before long.

413

David Mason has actually invented a device he calls a triple-spectrum lightwave transmitter.

414

It's designed to project infrared and ultraviolet lasers, which the naked eye can't see.

415

All right, that'll work.

416

00:18:34,900 --> 00:18:37,700

But it also projects a fully visible laser, too.

417

What we plan to do tonight is use it to broadcast the mysterious 1.6 gigahertz communication signal

418

that we've previously recorded on the ranch through all three lasers aimed straight up at the triangle

419

to see if that will stimulate the blob-like anomaly to reappear.

420

We're going to do some rocket surgery.

421

00:18:58,020 --> 00:19:01,940

At the same time, Caleb and I are going to launch rockets and mortars,

422

which are high-powered fireworks, right up through the triangle to see if that will also

423

00:19:07,540 --> 00:19:09,140

help trigger the phenomena.

424

We need to know what this thing is, so hopefully tonight we'll get an answer.

425

You want Caleb to take the omni and take it all the way off the helipad?

426

This is the first time that David Mason has been on the property, and as far as I know,

this is the first time that any equipment of the kind that he has brought out has ever been used

And I'm really anxious to see what's going to happen.

And so you got three different optical bands.

441

You got, what, ultraviolet?

And then this is the visible light, right?

444

And then this is infrared, right?

Okay, well, that's pretty cool.

447

We're on this lightwave transmitter.

448

We are going to be transmitting data in the form of what we have as recording.

1.6 gigahertz?

450

Yeah.

451

Eric has provided me his 1.6 gigahertz signal.

452

And then I will be transmitting that on the lightwave transmitter.

453

And this lightwave transmitter covers between infrared, visible spectrum, and ultraviolet.

454

So we can take our own data or information and transmit it on this transmitter,

455

hopefully to provoke a response.

456

We've got a lot of equipment here.

457

We've got a lot of moving parts.

458

Now, I know the earlier you and Eric were planning a lot of things that are going to be

459

taking place out at the triangle.

We've never done something like a mortar shell before,

461

where it's got a big percussion, right?

For tonight's activity, we are firing rockets and mortars.

468

I'm going to be directing our cameras from a distance on the triangle area.

469

I hope this experiment will shed a lot of light on the

470

00:21:16,740 --> 00:21:20,100

strangeness that happens in the airspace just above the triangle.

471

00:21:20,100 --> 00:21:24,260

We're going to take off to the south side and just watch, just see what we can.

472

00:21:24,260 --> 00:21:26,100

That's a great idea, Tom.

473

00:21:26,100 --> 00:21:29,060

So if you're going to do that, you guys, he's got some night vision goggles.

474

Oh, that'd be excellent.

475

And so you guys get one each so you can, you know, both be looking and keep it walkie

476

While everyone got to their positions around the ranch to begin the experiment,

487

and look for any strange signals or frequencies that might arise.

489

Just making sure that we're getting a signal.

491

So everything looks quiet right now.

One minute till mortar.

504

We are ready to go.

So David is currently broadcasting that 1.6 signal that we recorded last year

518

Stand by.

The mortar went off just as planned.

521

But for some strange reason, the rocket failed to launch.

522

With us broadcasting that 1.6 gigahertz signal and the ranch being the ranch,

523

it's hard to tell if you simply have an equipment malfunction

524

That's the same place where we recently heard stories about orb-like UAPs from local Ute tribal

Be advised we're about to launch another mortar.

575

Give us just a second to get in position, Travis.

576

It made us really eager to get another rocket launched and mortar fired to see if we could

So I think if you've got a camera pointing South, Eric.
