What is that?

14

00:00:26,000 --> 00:00:29,400

It looks like this thing's following Thomas.

There is a ranch in northern Utah.

16

It is considered the epicenter of the strangest

17

Animal mutilations, bizarre UFO sightings,

It was really bright.

32

Last night, we were hoping to zero in

33

on the cause of all the energy spikes, GPS anomalies,

34

and UAPs that we keep seeing in the so-called triangle

35

But when he went over there to investigate it,

43

with Tom Lewis and Candace Lindy, it disappeared.

44

Neither one of us has seen anything

45

00:02:14,040 --> 00:02:16,200

in a candle for that purple light.

46

And then, Caleb Benchin, I saw a UAP above him

47

in our night vision scope that seemed

48

00:02:21,920 --> 00:02:26,040

to be tracking his movements like it was stalking him.

49

If you've got the footage of that light,

50

I'd love to see it, because I never

51

did get to actually see it.

52

So I've got the video up here.

53

The guys look there.

54

00:02:34,200 --> 00:02:36,400

We've got our familiar landmarks.

55

00:02:36,400 --> 00:02:38,120

We know what those lights are.

56

00:02:38,120 --> 00:02:41,240

There's security lights at the houses far enough away.

57

00:02:41,240 --> 00:02:43,320

OK, I'll continue playing.

58

00:02:43,320 --> 00:02:44,520

Or purple.

59

00:02:44,520 --> 00:02:45,020

There.

60

00:02:45,020 --> 00:02:47,240

Whoa, whoa, whoa, right there.

61

00:02:47,240 --> 00:02:49,160

That's it, though.

62

00:02:49,160 --> 00:02:52,320

The first takeaway for me looking at this is, OK,

63

00:02:52,320 --> 00:02:55,160

it is at the same level in our shot

64

00:02:55,160 --> 00:02:59,200

as those known terrestrial light sources.

65

00:02:59,200 --> 00:03:00,240

Exactly.

66

00:03:00,240 --> 00:03:01,400

So it's down low.

67

00:03:01,400 --> 00:03:02,720

It was not in the sky.

68

00:03:02,720 --> 00:03:03,200

Right.

69

00:03:03,200 --> 00:03:06,960

Now the question is, what is it?

70

00:03:06,960 --> 00:03:10,080

So when you compare the size and the brightness

71

00:03:10,080 --> 00:03:13,040

and the intensity of the light to the amber yard lights

72

00:03:13,040 --> 00:03:16,160

and the white ones off there, those lights

73

00:03:16,160 --> 00:03:18,520

are big, big lights, bright.

74

00:03:19,480 --> 00:03:21,120

And this is just as big.

75

00:03:21,120 --> 00:03:23,720

And the fact that it's purple, maybe I'm wrong,

76

00:03:23,720 --> 00:03:25,960

but purple lights don't carry as far as.

77

00:03:25,960 --> 00:03:28,800

No, your eye doesn't respond to purple.

78

00:03:28,800 --> 00:03:31,120

In fact, your eye responds best to a greenish yellow color.

79

00:03:31,120 --> 00:03:33,440

For it to be a purple light and you to see it,

80

00:03:33,440 --> 00:03:36,200

it had to have a lot of energy in it.

81

00:03:36,200 --> 00:03:38,160

And so I find that really interesting.

82

00:03:38,160 --> 00:03:41,360

As an optical scientist, I've studied the light spectrum

83

00:03:41,360 --> 00:03:44,600

that the human eye can see for more than 30 years.

84

00:03:44,600 --> 00:03:47,000

Purple is near the edge of that spectrum.

85

00:03:47,080 --> 00:03:49,560

So for it to be as bright as this,

86

00:03:49,560 --> 00:03:52,280

it had to have been created by something emitting

87

00:03:52,280 --> 00:03:53,840

a lot of energy.

88

00:03:53,840 --> 00:03:56,320

I'm not sure what that could have been.

89

00:03:56,320 --> 00:03:59,360

While you're chasing this purple light,

90

00:03:59,360 --> 00:04:02,800

we've got what appears to be something blinking over your

91

00:04:02,800 --> 00:04:05,520

heads, only a couple hundred feet above you.

92

00:04:05,520 --> 00:04:08,040

And following your motion, that is odd.

93

00:04:08,040 --> 00:04:09,080

Can you point it out to me?

94

00:04:09,080 --> 00:04:10,720

Yeah, I'll show you.

95

00:04:10,720 --> 00:04:11,880

OK.

96

00:04:11,880 --> 00:04:13,680

Caleb and I could tell this thing was moving

97

00:04:13,680 --> 00:04:15,160

and it was right over your head.

98

00:04:15,160 --> 00:04:16,320

I see it right there.

99

00:04:16,320 --> 00:04:20,080

Yeah, you see it right here.

100

00:04:20,080 --> 00:04:22,520

It was right over your head and it moved with you.

101

00:04:22,520 --> 00:04:25,600

It was like a couple hundred feet at most above the ground.

102

00:04:25,600 --> 00:04:26,360

OK.

103

00:04:26,360 --> 00:04:27,640

See it right there how bright it was?

104

00:04:27,640 --> 00:04:28,360

I'm seeing it.

105

00:04:31,000 --> 00:04:34,560

You can't miss it.

106

00:04:34,560 --> 00:04:37,600

Why is that happening at the exact same time?

107

00:04:37,600 --> 00:04:40,160

We're doing these stimulation experiments

108

00:04:40,160 --> 00:04:46,120

and there is a strange purple lighter object appearing

109

00:04:46,120 --> 00:04:47,760

on the property.

110

00:04:47,760 --> 00:04:48,880

I don't like that.

111

00:04:48,880 --> 00:04:49,720

I don't like that either.

112

00:04:49,720 --> 00:04:52,440

I don't like the fact that there was something

113

00:04:52,440 --> 00:04:54,360

following me as I was out there.

114

00:04:54,360 --> 00:04:56,720

If it was a human doing it, it's a bad thing.

115

00:04:56,720 --> 00:04:57,920

And if it wasn't a human doing it,

116

00:04:57,920 --> 00:05:00,040

it's I don't know if that's a good thing or not.

117

00:05:00,040 --> 00:05:00,880

Yeah.

118

00:05:00,880 --> 00:05:04,320

Well, guys, thanks for helping me look through this today.

119

Yeah.

120

00:05:04,920 --> 00:05:05,920

I'm going to get back to work.

121

00:05:05,920 --> 00:05:06,720

All right.

122

00:05:10,240 --> 00:05:12,760

We got the hole empty, so we ready to drill again.

123

00:05:12,760 --> 00:05:13,640

Yeah.

124

00:05:13,640 --> 00:05:15,640

After our meeting in the command center,

125

00:05:15,680 --> 00:05:18,040

Eric Thomas and I headed out to the mesa

126

00:05:18,040 --> 00:05:21,160

where Aaron Blunt and his team from Straight Shot Drillers

127

00:05:21,160 --> 00:05:24,160

were about to continue another major investigation

128

00:05:24,160 --> 00:05:25,720

that we recently started.

129

00:05:25,720 --> 00:05:27,960

Well, this drill, would it drill through steel

130

00:05:27,960 --> 00:05:29,240

re-enforced concrete?

131

00:05:29,240 --> 00:05:30,000

Yes.

132

00:05:30,000 --> 00:05:30,680

It would?

133

00:05:30,680 --> 00:05:32,880

Yeah, we do it quite a few times.

134

00:05:32,880 --> 00:05:33,720

OK.

135

00:05:33,720 --> 00:05:37,960

Last year, Aaron drilled at this location

136

00:05:37,960 --> 00:05:41,760

and is bit scraped along the bottom of a 400 foot long dome

137

00:05:41,760 --> 00:05:44,520

shape, possibly metal object.

138

00:05:44,520 --> 00:05:47,320

Yeah, I'm up against something pretty hard right now.

139

00:05:47,320 --> 00:05:49,000

The bit couldn't penetrate it.

140

00:05:49,000 --> 00:05:52,600

But scientific analysis that we had conducted on small fragments

141

00:05:52,600 --> 00:05:54,880

of metal that were in the spoils

142

00:05:54,880 --> 00:05:58,600

showed they were composed of the same type of materials

143

00:05:58,600 --> 00:06:01,000

that NASA uses on the space shuttle.

144

00:06:01,000 --> 00:06:03,600

It turns like these are using special tiling.

145

00:06:03,600 --> 00:06:06,000

That's actually very interesting.

146

00:06:06,000 --> 00:06:08,480

And then three weeks ago, we conducted

147

00:06:08,480 --> 00:06:11,400

new ground penetrating radar scans in this area

148

00:06:11,400 --> 00:06:15,400

and found that there appears to be a second 120 foot tall

149

00:06:15,400 --> 00:06:18,600

vertical anomaly sitting just behind whatever

150

00:06:18,600 --> 00:06:20,480

this dome shaped object is.

151

00:06:20,480 --> 00:06:22,480

Whatever this is, is as tall as the mesa.

152

00:06:22,480 --> 00:06:23,920

Yeah.

153

00:06:23,920 --> 00:06:27,360

So now, we're having Aaron drill from above the dome shaped

154

00:06:27,360 --> 00:06:30,000

anomaly in the hopes that from this angle,

155

00:06:30,000 --> 00:06:33,280

he can penetrate it and reach the vertical object behind it

156

00:06:33,280 --> 00:06:37,280

to help us figure out what in this world they could be.

157

00:06:37,280 --> 00:06:38,440

I have one more question.

158

00:06:38,440 --> 00:06:40,480

The beacon on the end of the drill,

159

00:06:40,520 --> 00:06:42,800

is it always on or do you guys just turn it on when you're

160

00:06:42,800 --> 00:06:44,000

looking to find it?

161

00:06:44,000 --> 00:06:45,680

It's always on why we're drilling.

162

00:06:45,680 --> 00:06:47,200

And you're at 33 megahertz?

163

00:06:47,200 --> 00:06:47,600

Yeah.

164

00:06:47,600 --> 00:06:48,640

OK.

165

00:06:48,640 --> 00:06:53,800

So when we're out drilling, we have a beacon

166

00:06:53,800 --> 00:06:57,040

that you're running with the bit and the locator will be up

167

00:06:57,040 --> 00:06:58,480

on top of the mesa.

168

00:06:58,480 --> 00:07:00,600

So it'll send a signal up to the locator

169

00:07:00,600 --> 00:07:03,120

and it'll tell how deep it is, where it's at,

170

00:07:03,120 --> 00:07:05,680

what direction it's going so we know where that bit is

171

00:07:05,680 --> 00:07:07,280

at all times.

172

00:07:07,280 --> 00:07:08,440

We're going to look for that.

173

00:07:08,440 --> 00:07:09,360

We've got to look for it.

174

00:07:09,360 --> 00:07:10,000

Yep.

175

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:13,960

Aaron's drill beacon transmits at a frequency of 33 megahertz

176

00:07:13,960 --> 00:07:16,800

in order for the rig to track the drill bit's progress

177

00:07:16,800 --> 00:07:17,720

underground.

178

00:07:17,720 --> 00:07:18,840

That's good to know.

179

00:07:18,840 --> 00:07:21,360

We will also monitor that signal with the spectrum

180

00:07:21,360 --> 00:07:22,840

analyzer as they drill.

181

00:07:22,840 --> 00:07:28,000

Thomas, I want you to keep an eye on the gamma ray detector

182

00:07:28,000 --> 00:07:29,440

fairly periodically.

183

00:07:29,440 --> 00:07:29,920

OK.

184

00:07:29,920 --> 00:07:32,040

In the past, when we've drilled here,

185

00:07:32,040 --> 00:07:35,160

we detected strange radiation and energy frequencies,

186

00:07:35,160 --> 00:07:38,600

most notably, one measuring 1.6 gigahertz,

187

00:07:38,600 --> 00:07:41,880

which I think could be some kind of communication signal.

188

00:07:41,880 --> 00:07:44,880

I just don't know who or what could be trying to communicate

189

00:07:44,880 --> 00:07:47,640

or how it might be related to these strange anomalies

190

00:07:47,640 --> 00:07:48,640

in the mesa.

191

00:07:48,640 --> 00:07:49,840

Yeah, so you start drilling.

192

00:07:49,840 --> 00:07:50,340

OK.

193

00:07:50,340 --> 00:07:50,840

OK.

194

00:07:50,840 --> 00:07:51,340

All right.

195

00:07:55,840 --> 00:07:57,320

Did you get that one working?

196

00:07:57,320 --> 00:07:58,400

Yeah, I got them all working now.

197

00:07:58,400 --> 00:08:00,360

During the drilling operation, we

198

00:08:00,360 --> 00:08:02,600

were using our spectrum analyzer to detect

199

00:08:02,600 --> 00:08:04,240

various energy signals.

200

00:08:04,240 --> 00:08:05,400

That's the beacon.

201

00:08:05,400 --> 00:08:08,800

Now, this included the drill beacon's 33 megahertz signal,

202

00:08:08,800 --> 00:08:11,320

which we were monitoring for any changes that

203

00:08:11,320 --> 00:08:16,160

might suggest some kind of phenomena was affecting it.

204

00:08:16,160 --> 00:08:19,680

Just a minor note to let you guys know as we're about 160

205

00:08:19,680 --> 00:08:20,880

feet in.

206

00:08:20,880 --> 00:08:23,480

I'm going to head up the mesa where I can get eyes on Gavin

207

00:08:23,480 --> 00:08:25,720

and find out how deep they are.

208

00:08:25,720 --> 00:08:26,440

Understood.

209

00:08:26,440 --> 00:08:29,280

Copy and thanks.

210

00:08:29,280 --> 00:08:31,600

I'm getting more and more excited with every foot

211

00:08:31,600 --> 00:08:33,720

that we're drilling into the mesa.

212

00:08:33,720 --> 00:08:36,200

Last year during our drilling exercise,

213

00:08:36,200 --> 00:08:40,640

we discovered metal that was forged that's not natural 300

214

00:08:40,640 --> 00:08:41,680

feet into the hill.

215

00:08:41,680 --> 00:08:43,520

Really, I'm most excited about finding out

216

00:08:43,520 --> 00:08:45,560

what that metal is inside the mesa.

217

00:08:45,560 --> 00:08:48,160

Right now, we're just about right here, right below your feet.

218

00:08:48,160 --> 00:08:49,200

The drill bit's right here?

219

00:08:49,200 --> 00:08:50,480

Yep, that's where it's at.

220

00:08:50,480 --> 00:08:53,520

He's trying to work it down, but it'll let him drill forward,

221

00:08:53,520 --> 00:08:55,880

but he's not able to work it down as much as he'd like.

222

00:08:55,880 --> 00:08:56,840

OK.

223

00:08:56,840 --> 00:08:58,840

What causes that?

224

00:08:58,840 --> 00:09:04,320

Just really tight ground or other objects pushing him

225

00:09:04,320 --> 00:09:05,560

in certain directions.

226

00:09:05,560 --> 00:09:06,560

OK.

227

00:09:06,560 --> 00:09:08,000

You guys got a copy?

228

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:08,720

Go ahead, Thomas.

229

00:09:08,720 --> 00:09:09,880

We hear you.

230

00:09:09,880 --> 00:09:12,200

I'm up here on top with Gavin.

231

00:09:12,200 --> 00:09:15,760

The drill bit is approximately 40 feet below where we're standing

232

00:09:15,760 --> 00:09:16,760

right now.

233

00:09:16,760 --> 00:09:19,840

There's something that's been pushing the drill up.

234

00:09:19,840 --> 00:09:23,280

If you remember last year, there was something pushing it down.

235

00:09:23,280 --> 00:09:26,440

So he's been trying to turn that drill and level it out,

236

00:09:26,440 --> 00:09:28,880

but it's just pushing him up higher and higher.

237

00:09:28,880 --> 00:09:30,880

Similar to what we experienced last year,

238

00:09:30,880 --> 00:09:32,840

just other direction.

239

00:09:32,840 --> 00:09:37,120

Maybe we're on top of it instead of the bottom of it this time.

240

00:09:37,120 --> 00:09:38,640

That could be.

241

00:09:38,640 --> 00:09:41,520

I think Eric's going to come up and do some experiments up

242

00:09:41,520 --> 00:09:42,320

there with you.

243

00:09:42,320 --> 00:09:44,720

He'll be there in a few minutes.

244

00:09:44,720 --> 00:09:45,840

Copy that.

245

00:09:45,840 --> 00:09:46,480

Be careful.

246

00:09:51,200 --> 00:09:53,640

When Thomas told us the drill bit was being pushed up

247

00:09:53,640 --> 00:09:56,120

by something inside the mesa, Eric and I

248

00:09:56,120 --> 00:09:58,720

wondered if Aaron was just scraping along the top

249

00:09:58,720 --> 00:10:00,320

of the dome-shaped object.

250

00:10:00,320 --> 00:10:03,840

So Eric took a handheld spectrum analyzer up to Thomas.

251

00:10:03,840 --> 00:10:07,440

We wanted to see if any strange energy signals could be detected

252

00:10:07,440 --> 00:10:12,120

when the drill made contact with the anomaly inside the mesa.

253

00:10:12,120 --> 00:10:13,920

When we try to approach that point,

254

00:10:13,920 --> 00:10:16,680

our bit is getting pushed down or it's getting pushed up.

255

00:10:16,680 --> 00:10:18,640

So he's hitting resistance right now.

256

00:10:18,640 --> 00:10:21,200

You can hear that drill's hitting something hard.

257

00:10:21,200 --> 00:10:22,200

Oh, yeah.

258

00:10:26,600 --> 00:10:28,880

What's going on, Thomas?

259

00:10:28,880 --> 00:10:33,560

After drilling more than 270 or 280 feet of going through sandstone

260

00:10:33,560 --> 00:10:37,640

like butter, the drill is encountered a hard object

261

00:10:37,640 --> 00:10:39,480

that it cannot penetrate.

262

00:10:39,480 --> 00:10:40,520

Wow.

263

00:10:40,520 --> 00:10:44,120

Well, if that's the case, what I want to do

264

00:10:44,120 --> 00:10:45,920

is see if I can pick up that beacon.

265

00:10:45,920 --> 00:10:48,400

Travis, you hear me?

266

00:10:48,400 --> 00:10:49,240

Copy that, Eric.

267

00:10:49,240 --> 00:10:50,080

I got you.

268

00:10:50,080 --> 00:10:54,000

I'm looking for the beacon signal at 33 megahertz right now.

269

00:10:54,000 --> 00:10:55,720

Copy that.

270

00:10:55,720 --> 00:11:00,320

Let me go to that signal and see where it is.

271

00:11:00,320 --> 00:11:02,840

All right, I think that's him.

272

00:11:02,840 --> 00:11:05,920

Let's see all that activity right there.

273

00:11:05,920 --> 00:11:06,960

Oh, what is that?

274

00:11:10,080 --> 00:11:12,360

Something's going nuts there.

275

00:11:12,360 --> 00:11:13,840

See the small peak in the middle?

276

00:11:13,840 --> 00:11:16,960

That's the beacon from the drill bit.

277

00:11:16,960 --> 00:11:19,120

With these other, the three peaks on either side

278

00:11:19,120 --> 00:11:21,280

were not there until the drill bit hit

279

00:11:21,280 --> 00:11:22,480

whatever it can't go through.

280

00:11:25,840 --> 00:11:30,440

Hey, Thomas, tell Eric that when the drill bit hit whatever

281

00:11:30,440 --> 00:11:35,040

you guys hit up at the top, that the 33 megahertz signal coming

282

00:11:35,040 --> 00:11:39,440

from the drill bit amplified and spread out all around it

283

00:11:39,440 --> 00:11:42,080

like something was rebroadcasting it.

284

00:11:42,080 --> 00:11:45,080

I see the peak at 33 megahertz.

285

00:11:45,080 --> 00:11:48,440

As soon as the drill bit hit whatever stopped it,

286

00:11:48,440 --> 00:11:51,080

six other peaks appeared on the spectrum analyzer

287

00:11:51,080 --> 00:11:53,720

around the 33 megahertz peak.

288

00:11:53,720 --> 00:11:55,720

And we've seen this before.

289

00:11:55,720 --> 00:11:57,280

What's going on here?

290

00:11:57,280 --> 00:11:58,880

There's a phenomenon occurring right now

291

00:11:58,880 --> 00:12:00,000

that we don't understand.

292

00:12:12,360 --> 00:12:15,120

This small peak in the middle, that's the beacon

293

00:12:15,120 --> 00:12:17,640

from the drill bit.

294

00:12:17,640 --> 00:12:19,760

With these other, the three peaks on either side

295

00:12:19,760 --> 00:12:21,920

were not there until the drill bit hit

296

00:12:21,920 --> 00:12:24,400

whatever it can't go through.

297

00:12:24,400 --> 00:12:27,160

Right after Aaron Blunt informed us that his drill bit

298

couldn't penetrate what we believe

299

00:12:29,160 --> 00:12:31,520

to be the top side of the massive dome shaped

300

00:12:31,520 --> 00:12:34,720

object inside the Mesa, Eric and I

301

00:12:34,720 --> 00:12:38,240

noticed that the 33 megahertz radio signal from the drills

302

00:12:38,240 --> 00:12:40,880

tracking beacon was being rebroadcast

303

00:12:40,880 --> 00:12:42,680

into our spectrum analyzer.

The question was, what could have been rebroadcasting it?

305

What are you thinking right now?

I'm thinking metal, especially what we just heard from Travis.

He said that when that drill bit contacted whatever this is

308

00:12:58,120 --> 00:13:00,440

that we can't get through, all of a sudden

309

00:13:00,440 --> 00:13:03,440

that beacon signal was coming, blasting out

310

00:13:03,440 --> 00:13:04,240

to his instruments.

311

00:13:04,240 --> 00:13:05,760

Think about what that means.

312

00:13:05,760 --> 00:13:08,480

He said he's hitting something that's rebroadcasting.

313

00:13:08,480 --> 00:13:12,040

Well, something that behaves like a large antenna will do that.

314

00:13:12,040 --> 00:13:14,760

So when it pushes up against something metal,

315

00:13:14,760 --> 00:13:18,560

it would actually act like a big antenna and amplify it out.

316

00:13:18,600 --> 00:13:20,520

Yeah, or reflector, I don't know.

317

00:13:20,520 --> 00:13:23,640

It makes me want to pull the bit back and do it again.

318

00:13:23,640 --> 00:13:25,840

Try it over and over and see if, in fact, that same thing

319

00:13:25,840 --> 00:13:29,480

happens with the instruments down there where we're set up.

320

00:13:29,480 --> 00:13:31,920

Well, it sounds like a quick experiment.

321

00:13:31,920 --> 00:13:33,720

Is that something we could coordinate with you guys?

322

00:13:33,720 --> 00:13:34,360

For sure.

323

00:13:34,360 --> 00:13:36,360

See if we can get Travis on board with that.

324

00:13:36,360 --> 00:13:38,160

Perfect.

325

00:13:38,160 --> 00:13:39,680

Hey, Travis.

326

00:13:39,680 --> 00:13:41,560

Yeah, go ahead, Thomas.

327

00:13:41,560 --> 00:13:44,360

We would like to do an experiment based

328

on what you were seeing with that amplifying.

329

00:13:47,840 --> 00:13:50,240

We want to try something where the driller goes

330

and pushes up against it, let you see it, then backs off,

331

00:13:54,120 --> 00:13:56,280

then pushes up against it, and then backs off,

332

00:13:56,280 --> 00:13:59,320

and let you look at that and see what you see.

333

I like that experiment a lot.

334

00:14:01,040 --> 00:14:02,960

Let's do it.

335

00:14:02,960 --> 00:14:04,760

All right, so what we're going to have you do is just

336

pull back your bit.

337

00:14:06,280 --> 00:14:08,560

Eric's idea was the perfect way for us

338

to test if whatever the drill was hitting inside the Mesa

339

really was altering or rebroadcasting the 33 megahertz

340

00:14:16,000 --> 00:14:17,720

signal.

341

00:14:17,760 --> 00:14:20,080

OK, and then come back into contact with what are hitting.

342

00:14:23,080 --> 00:14:23,680

Here we go.

343

00:14:26,360 --> 00:14:27,480

He's going.

344

00:14:27,480 --> 00:14:29,880

He should be coming back into contact with it here right now.

345

00:14:36,360 --> 00:14:40,400

Boy, it suddenly got strong as crap.

346

00:14:40,400 --> 00:14:42,840

Look how strong that is.

347

00:14:42,840 --> 00:14:44,720

All right, so let's back away.

348

00:14:44,720 --> 00:14:45,960

All righty, Aaron.

349

00:14:46,000 --> 00:14:47,680

Go ahead and back it off completely.

350

I mean, hold there for a second.

Watch for that.

All right, so now look.

There you go.

Look, look, look, look, look.

Holy cow, look at that.

365

the 33 megahertz signal returned to normal frequency

on the spectrum analyzer.

368

But then each time it made contact

369

with whatever is inside there, the signal

370

00:15:30,320 --> 00:15:32,360

would be amplified again.

371

00:15:32,360 --> 00:15:34,120

Look how strong it got.

372

00:15:34,120 --> 00:15:36,640

Man, it just really started broadcasting.

373

00:15:36,640 --> 00:15:39,960

I have no idea what could be in there that would do that.

374

00:15:39,960 --> 00:15:42,880

Could it be a response?

375

00:15:42,880 --> 00:15:46,320

What could cause the RF spectrum to suddenly change

376

00:15:46,320 --> 00:15:49,560

as the drill bit encounters this apparently impenetrable

377

00:15:49,560 --> 00:15:50,800

object?

378

00:15:50,800 --> 00:15:53,880

We want to know, is this aggression?

379

00:15:53,880 --> 00:15:55,800

Is this an attempt to communicate?

380

00:15:55,800 --> 00:15:57,520

At this point, it's speculation,

381

00:15:57,520 --> 00:15:59,280

but it is certainly very suggestive

382

00:15:59,280 --> 00:16:00,800

that we're dealing with something that isn't

383

00:16:00,800 --> 00:16:03,200

native to that Mesa.

384

00:16:03,200 --> 00:16:04,520

There's something in there.

385

00:16:04,520 --> 00:16:07,080

And we hit it, and the drill cannot punch through it.

386

00:16:07,080 --> 00:16:08,400

There is something in there.

387

00:16:08,400 --> 00:16:11,400

Yeah.

388

00:16:11,400 --> 00:16:14,880

Now you hear that high-pitched sound it's making?

389

00:16:14,880 --> 00:16:16,360

Yeah.

390

00:16:16,360 --> 00:16:20,840

Well, we're just hitting something really, really hard.

391

00:16:20,840 --> 00:16:23,840

I don't know if I'm getting through this.

392

00:16:23,840 --> 00:16:29,320

Seeing we had 8,000 pounds of push, hardly any rotation

393

00:16:29,320 --> 00:16:30,320

off of it.

394

00:16:30,320 --> 00:16:33,000

So either my bits broke off, or it's just

395

00:16:33,000 --> 00:16:34,600

spinning on something smooth.

396

00:16:34,600 --> 00:16:39,600

I'm not even going to move it off.

397

00:16:39,600 --> 00:16:42,600

I've just been sitting here, rotating on it.

398

00:16:42,600 --> 00:16:43,600

No movement.

399

00:16:43,600 --> 00:16:44,600

Nope.

400

00:16:44,600 --> 00:16:47,600

And he even put his augers down so he'd have more push.

401

00:16:47,600 --> 00:16:49,600

So he can't push any harder?

402

Not right now.

403

Nope, not without.

404

I got to tell Travis.

He's officially at the point he cannot go any further.

407

Well, that's exciting.

It means there is something different in there,

409

and it does match the GPR data.

410

And we need to figure out how to get to it and see what it is.

411

Precisely.

412

We know we're on track, and what we didn't know from the GPR data

413

was how far south and north it went.

414

I think we just got our answer.

415

Well, I guess we need to look at those balls

416

and see what's in there.

I agree with you.

I'm completely baffled as to what

419

00:17:25,600 --> 00:17:29,600

it was that was so hard we couldn't drill through it.

420

I'm eager to get this drill bit pulled out of the hill

421

00:17:31,600 --> 00:17:34,600

and see what kind of condition the drill bit's in.

422

00:17:34,600 --> 00:17:38,600

I'm not so really eager to look at this spoils pile and see,

423

00:17:38,600 --> 00:17:41,600

do we have any metal shavings in there like we found last year?

424

00:17:44,600 --> 00:17:46,600

I want to hear from this guy right here.

425

00:17:46,600 --> 00:17:49,600

I mean, you do this every day, all day.

426

00:17:49,600 --> 00:17:52,600

It's hitting something really hard and smooth.

427

00:17:52,600 --> 00:17:55,600

8,000 pounds of push, and it wasn't budging.

428

00:17:55,600 --> 00:17:56,600

That's a lot of pressure.

429

00:17:56,600 --> 00:17:59,600

What could be hard enough to be pushing back on that?

430

00:17:59,600 --> 00:18:01,600

I don't know, because we cut through everything

431

00:18:01,600 --> 00:18:04,600

all the way up to the top, just fine.

432

00:18:04,600 --> 00:18:07,600

I didn't move even a little bit through it, so...

433

That's the thing, what in the world is that?

434

Well, I want to see what's in that pit,

435

because you might have got some chips off of it

436

that would be nice to see what it is.

437

I think we should get this sucked out and go look at it.

438

Yeah, and I'd like to see the end of the bit, too,

439

to see if it dulled it or what happened to it.

440

Once we were done drilling,

441

we vacuumed all the spoils out of the pit

442

where the drill bit entered the mesa

443

so they could be screened for possible clues

444

00:18:32,600 --> 00:18:35,600

of what this dome-shaped object could be.

445

00:18:35,600 --> 00:18:38,600

Meanwhile, Aaron began retracting the drill bit

446

00:18:38,600 --> 00:18:41,600

so we could see what kind of damage it incurred

447

00:18:41,600 --> 00:18:43,600

after grinding away on that huge

448

00:18:43,600 --> 00:18:46,600

and penetrable object for so long.

449

00:18:46,600 --> 00:18:48,600

Here she comes.

450

00:18:52,600 --> 00:18:54,600

You gonna kill him, boss?

451

00:18:55,600 --> 00:18:58,600

Getting this cleaned off?

452

00:18:58,600 --> 00:19:02,600

These teeth are all perfectly intact.

453

00:19:02,600 --> 00:19:05,600

It's not missing a single tooth.

454

00:19:05,600 --> 00:19:07,600

Yeah.

455

00:19:07,600 --> 00:19:10,600

I mean, it looks like it's in perfect condition.

456

You'd think if you were grinding that against something

457

00:19:13,600 --> 00:19:16,600

for a half hour that it would dull it at least.

458

00:19:16,600 --> 00:19:20,600

It should have heated up and at least wore it down flat.

459

That's crazy.

460

00:19:22,600 --> 00:19:24,600

Yeah, that is.

461

00:19:28,600 --> 00:19:31,600

After all the grinding that the drill bit did

462

00:19:31,600 --> 00:19:34,600

against the top of the dome-shaped anomaly inside the mesa,

463

00:19:34,600 --> 00:19:37,600

it showed no sign of damage at all.

464

00:19:37,600 --> 00:19:39,600

It was like it had been spinning on an invisible,

465

00:19:39,600 --> 00:19:41,600

frictionless force field.

466

00:19:41,600 --> 00:19:44,600

That's like the stuff of science fiction.

467

00:19:44,600 --> 00:19:46,600

It made no logical sense.

468

00:19:46,600 --> 00:19:48,600

That's good.

469

00:19:49,600 --> 00:19:52,600

Let's hope we have some.

470

00:19:52,600 --> 00:19:54,600

So as the drill team dumped the materials

471

00:19:54,600 --> 00:19:57,600

that were collected inside the spoils tank,

472

00:19:57,600 --> 00:20:00,600

we were hoping that once we sifted them through a screen,

473

00:20:00,600 --> 00:20:02,600

we'd find evidence that might tell us

474

00:20:02,600 --> 00:20:05,600

what the object inside the mesa could be.

475

00:20:05,600 --> 00:20:09,600

It doesn't look anything like what we did last year.

476

00:20:09,600 --> 00:20:12,600

I'm not seeing anything like those large flakes

477

00:20:12,600 --> 00:20:14,600

that we saw last year.

478

00:20:14,600 --> 00:20:16,600

It looks to me like it's something different.

479

00:20:16,600 --> 00:20:19,600

We're going to have to do some further analysis on that material

480

00:20:19,600 --> 00:20:23,600

to compare it or differentiate it from the material

481

00:20:23,600 --> 00:20:26,600

that we pulled out of the base of the mesa last year.

482

00:20:26,600 --> 00:20:28,600

I'll scoop what's left here in the bucket.

483

00:20:28,600 --> 00:20:31,600

If there's any trace of what we ran into that was so hard,

484

00:20:31,600 --> 00:20:33,600

if we got any of it.

485

00:20:33,600 --> 00:20:36,600

The spoils didn't contain any pieces of metal like last year,

486

00:20:36,600 --> 00:20:39,600

but we'll still send samples of the muddy material to a lab

487

00:20:39,600 --> 00:20:43,600

for testing just in case they aren't natural to a rocky mesa.

488

00:20:43,600 --> 00:20:47,600

Hopefully, we can still learn something about what could be inside there,

489

00:20:47,600 --> 00:20:51,600

especially since we detected a possible communication signal

490

00:20:51,600 --> 00:20:53,600

when we were drilling up against it.

491

00:20:53,600 --> 00:20:55,600

This is a hedge-cratcher, right?

492

00:20:55,600 --> 00:20:57,600

There's something in the mesa.

493

00:20:57,600 --> 00:20:59,600

The drill bit won't go through it though.

494

00:20:59,600 --> 00:21:00,600

That's the thing.

495

00:21:00,600 --> 00:21:02,600

So I don't know what in the world could that be,

496

00:21:02,600 --> 00:21:04,600

that you're putting that much pressure on

497

00:21:04,600 --> 00:21:06,600

and you're not chipping pieces of it off.

498

00:21:06,600 --> 00:21:07,600

Yeah.

499

00:21:07,600 --> 00:21:08,600

There's clearly something there.

500

00:21:08,600 --> 00:21:12,600

We've got three tests now that tell us there's something there.

501

00:21:12,600 --> 00:21:15,600

We need to send these samples out to be tested.

502

00:21:15,600 --> 00:21:17,600

Appreciate you guys doing this.

503

This was a lot of hard work.

504

00:21:19,600 --> 00:21:20,600

Thanks a lot, guys.

505

Yeah, we appreciate the call.

506

Let's do it.

507

00:21:22,600 --> 00:21:23,600

I agree.

508

Ready to go?

509

Yeah, I've got the cameras.

510

While I was taking care of getting our drilling samples sent off

511

to the University of Utah for testing,

512

Eric Bard worked with Thomas Winerton and Caleb Bench

513

00:21:39,600 --> 00:21:42,600

to help us try to get more data down in the South Field

514

00:21:42,600 --> 00:21:45,600

where the purple light and the UAP appeared

515

00:21:45,600 --> 00:21:47,600

during our experiment a couple of nights ago.

516

00:21:47,600 --> 00:21:50,600

I know we've got that whole southern portion covered,

517

00:21:50,600 --> 00:21:52,600

but not very well down in the trees, so...

518

00:21:52,600 --> 00:21:53,600

Not in the trees.

519

00:21:53,600 --> 00:21:56,600

Well, this will help supplement what you've already got.

520

00:21:56,600 --> 00:21:57,600

All right, I'll keep eyes on you.

521

00:21:57,600 --> 00:21:59,600

All right, sounds good.

522

00:21:59,600 --> 00:22:00,600

Thanks.

523

After our experience with this mysterious purple light

524

in the Southeast region of the property,

525

00:22:07,600 --> 00:22:12,600

we've decided that we need to increase our surveillance efforts down there.

526

I've instructed our team to install additional cameras.

527

These are motion-triggered cameras

528

00:22:19,600 --> 00:22:24,600

that should detect anything that emerges in the field of view.

529

Should we see any more of these purple lights

530

00:22:27,600 --> 00:22:28,600

or any other light, for that matter,

531

00:22:28,600 --> 00:22:31,600

emerging in the space over the ranch?

532

Let's see what we can do with this tree right here.

533

Let's go.

534

So, when that flash happened, it was hard to tell

535

whether it was coming from up at the tree level,

536

00:22:51,600 --> 00:22:53,600

whether it was on the ground level.

537

And even though we could see capture some of this

538

00:22:55,600 --> 00:22:57,600

with our other cameras,

539

00:22:57,600 --> 00:23:00,600

I think having a perspective right here at the ground,

540

if we see that flash again,

541

00:23:03,600 --> 00:23:05,600

we're going to know whether it's coming from the trees

542

00:23:05,600 --> 00:23:08,600

or if it really is happening down on the ground.

543

The purple light is something I just keep reflecting back on over and over.

544

What was it doing there on the south end of the property?

545

And why was that UAP we saw observing us?

If I remember right, you were the only one that really saw the flash.

547

Is that why that UAP was following me?

So we're thinking about setting one up here facing the west.

Mysterious animal deaths and mutilations

588

have been documented on Skinwalker Ranch for decades.

589

What in the world?

590

Four years ago, a healthy young cow

591

00:26:12,600 --> 00:26:15,600

died under very mysterious circumstances

592

00:26:15,600 --> 00:26:17,600

not far from the South Field.

593

00:26:17,600 --> 00:26:19,600

Is that black object, the cow?

594

00:26:19,600 --> 00:26:21,600

Yep.

595

00:26:21,600 --> 00:26:23,600

And later, when we reviewed surveillance footage,

596

00:26:23,600 --> 00:26:25,600

Eric noticed a UAP in the sky

597

00:26:25,600 --> 00:26:28,600

directly above the dying cow.

598

00:26:28,600 --> 00:26:30,600

Yo, what is that?

599

00:26:32,600 --> 00:26:34,600

I don't know. This is strange.

600

00:26:35,600 --> 00:26:37,600

Hey, Eric, do you have a copy?

601

00:26:38,600 --> 00:26:40,600

Yeah, go ahead, Thomas.

Huh, look at this.

Got a burn mark.

That's interesting.

There's nothing burned around here.

616

What the heck would have burned this post?

617

This plant's untouched.

618

I mean, there's not a burned branch on the shrub.

619

Pretty fresh looking.

620

And it's in the weirdest spot, too.

621

This has me baffled.

622

We find a burnt post that's raising some questions.

623

Just this one spot right here.

624

And there just so happens that it'll also be a deceased deer

625

in this exact same area.

626

That's definitely interesting.

627

Is a dead deer on the ranch really out of place?

628

00:27:48,600 --> 00:27:50,600

Not necessarily.

629

00:27:50,600 --> 00:27:52,600

But it's hard to say how this deer died.

630

So are they connected?

631

00:27:54,600 --> 00:27:57,600

There are some circumstances here that do raise more questions.

632

All right, so this is installed.

633

So we're good.

We found a dead deer carcass in one fence post

638

along this fence line.

It's got a pretty severe burn scar on it

640

about three feet off the ground.

641

00:28:17,600 --> 00:28:21,600

But the plant around it doesn't show any signs of burn.

642

There's no signs of fire out here.

643

You probably ought to come our way.

644

Copy that, Thomas. We'll see you in a minute.

645

The fact that we're seeing this dead deer,

646

along with this burn mark down on the south side,

647

shows we really do need to get more eyes down on the south side.

648

You see, there's pieces of it strewn all over the place.

649

Yeah.

650

After the cow died four years ago,

651

we detected elevated levels of gamma rays around it.

652

So I immediately wanted to scan the area for any signs of that.

653

So you picking up anything?

654

No higher levels of gamma rays than usual.

655

That's good.

Now, obviously, this deer was killed a while ago.

657

But given the strange UAPs we'd recently seen,

Nothing out of the ordinary from radiation,

669

And there's no other signs of fire around here or nothing, right?

671

None of the trees have been burned.

672

And none of the rest of it's touched, right?

677

So just that one point.

678

You know what it looks like?

It's something just flew, it went right through it.

That looks like whatever it was, it's so hot,

682

it just went just right through it.

683

That is just weird.

684

When I saw how burned that one section of the post was,

685

all I could think about was how the purple light Thomas saw

686

over here the other night must have been emitting a lot of energy.

687

So could it have burned this post?

688

And could it be connected to whatever killed the deer?

689

What's interesting though is we saw this strange light,

or the remains of a deer.

So given the fact we found this mysterious burn,

723

next to this dead deer, we decided to bring Hailey Lundgren out.

She's a veterinarian that is an expert in looking at animal remains.

728

Let's head out.

And it just so happens, it's in the same area where we had this purple light.

730

And so we want to know, are they related somehow?

731

It's really strange.

So we'd like an expert's opinion.

The puncture marks looked like they had been done after this animal had died.

753

What killed this animal?

754

The question remains, is it something we need to worry about?

756

I have the pelvis here.

757

The spine's actually really intact, all things considered.

758

If a predator had gone this when it was alive,

759

I would have expected more damage to the spine as a whole.

If you had to give me your forensic expert opinion as to what happened,

what would you say took place here?

We have a young six-month-old under a fawn that died of something that we're not sure of.

And...

OK.

767

Died of something other than a predator and then was scavenged on at least by coyotes

768

00:34:16,600 --> 00:34:19,600

that we can confirm and possibly some other animals.

769

00:34:19,600 --> 00:34:20,600

OK.

770

00:34:20,600 --> 00:34:24,600

We're going to have to really keep a watchful eye on everything in this area

771

00:34:24,600 --> 00:34:30,600

and try some different experiments to maybe see if we can really find out what's happening in this place.

772

We're really grateful that you'd come out here, lend your expert opinion,

773

So that's the pink rock inside the mesa.

779

Yep.

And I am still puzzled by... I mean, what are we looking at here?

781

A few days after we had to halt our drilling operation inside the mesa,

782

we got lab results back for two items that we sent off to the geology department at the University of Utah for analysis.

783

First was a photo of the pink rock that Dragon and Caleb captured with a snake camera one week ago

784

in a crevice between boulders near where the dome-shaped and vertical anomalies are buried.

And the second was a sample of the spoils we obtained while drilling up against the top of the dome-shaped dodging.

786

The geology geophysics guys are giving us their best guess based upon these images.

787

They have a couple of opinions on this.

788

So, one of the interesting comments was that the pink coloring seems to be like a deposit on the sandstone.

789

Really?

Meaning it's not a mineral that's through and through like a chunk of it.

791

00:35:48,600 --> 00:35:49,600

I think it's a coating.

792

Right?

793

00:35:50,600 --> 00:35:52,600

Now this is interesting.

794

00:35:52,600 --> 00:35:55,600

Possibly from vapor, right?

795

00:35:55,600 --> 00:35:56,600

Okay.

796

00:35:56,600 --> 00:36:03,600

Okay, so the rest of the comment was that the color reminds this individual of elemental selenium deposits.

797

Yes, it does.

798

Selenium is a semiconductor material.

799

You find it in almost every microprocessor chip, every computer.

800

You find it in solar panels.

801

Really?

802

00:36:14,600 --> 00:36:23,600

And in fact, if you mix selenium with zinc and you get zinc selenide, it's an optical material that is being used in military experiments

803

to bend light around objects and create metamaterials like a cloaking material on a plane.

804

00:36:29,600 --> 00:36:31,600

Make them look invisible.

805

00:36:32,600 --> 00:36:33,600

Oh, wow.

806

What would produce a vapor that could leave a selenium deposit?

807

I'm trying to...

808

00:36:44,600 --> 00:36:49,600

Selenium is a solid material at room temperature and pressure.

809

00:36:49,600 --> 00:36:55,600

So, you'd have to get it to whatever its boiling point is to create a vapor to do that.

810

That would have to be hot.

811

00:36:56,600 --> 00:36:59,600

So, what would cause that?

812

I don't know.

813

00:37:00,600 --> 00:37:05,600

And just saying maybe the anomaly in the mesa may have been what caused that.

814

Really?

Zinc selenide is a compound that scientists and researchers at DARPA, the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency,

are currently experimenting with for possible optical stealth, in other words, cloaking applications.

818

On a number of assets including soldiers, gear and uniforms, tanks and even fighter jets.

But it's a pretty futuristic technology at this point.

So, what the heck would similar kinds of materials be doing inside the mesa?

Like when we got drilling from last year at the mesa where we pulled out metal flakes.

You've got sodium, magnesium and aluminum very abundant in the drill tip mud.

842

This is like a very metallic, conductive kind of mixture.

It suggests to me again that the things that we got out of the bottom were part of a manufactured something.

844

This mud is leached material over time right at the spot where the GPR says there's something there and right where the drill bit couldn't go any further.

So it suggests that whatever is there and whatever that GPR anomaly is, is something highly metallic.

Yeah.

So all this suggests there's a big metal object in the mesa.

850

How do we feel about simply drilling with some portable apparatus from the top of the mesa down into that 40 foot or so level?

852

872
