Two U.S. military Chinook helicopters flew very low over the ranch,

41

circling above the Mesa and the triangle area for several minutes.

42

And, of course, they don't identify themselves.

43

I am getting nothing from above the ranch on the ADSB receiver here.

44

It's strange not only because the closest military airfield

is over 150 miles away,

but also because it's the second time this year

47

We may be looking at the anomaly for the first time, guys.

Obviously there's ADSB data that shows military aircraft.

130

And there were no visible markings on them either.

134

The continued covert military surveillance of the property has been deeply concerning.

The footage that we have been able to obtain through our research constitutes some of the best evidence on record

We need to launch pad right here.

224

The first will be on top of the Mesa,

225

where Thomas Winerton and I will launch rockets horizontally

226

about 100 feet high through the anomalous zone above the triangle.

227

You can get it right there. There you go.

228

The second station will be in the middle of the triangle,

229

where Dragon and Joe Loeb will be launching rockets at the same time,

230

straight up through that zone as well.

We're ready to go right now.

232

If you can get in a safe spot, we're good to launch.

233

That was good. We're moving.

234

Meanwhile, Cameron Fugol will fly Brandon, Eric and Caleb in the helicopter

235

above and safely off to the side of the triangle.

236

00:12:43,000 --> 00:12:45,000

We should be over right now.

237

00:12:45,000 --> 00:12:50,000

So that Eric can use his spectrum analyzer to scan for any strange energy spikes,

238

RF radiation signals, or any other electromagnetic anomalies

239

00:12:54,000 --> 00:12:57,000

like we've recently detected in that area.

240

00:12:57,000 --> 00:13:00,000

And later tonight, once the sun has completely gone down,

241

Cameron will be using military-grade night vision technology

242

in order to look for anything out of the ordinary that we might not be able to see.

This experiment has a lot of moving parts,

244

but hopefully it will finally reveal some definitive answers about the triangle.

Cameron, you're safe over there where you are.

252

If you want to stay in that kind of orbit over there somewhere, that'd be fine.

Sounded again.

254

I'm going to just fly forward for a minute because the hover is a little more challenging.

255

Copy that.

All right, Thomas. We are ready when you are.

258

All right. We're ready to go on the simultaneous launch on my countdown.

All right. Going hot.

Five, four, three, two, one.

261

Beautiful.

Now we got that one. We're able to see that.

Hey, Travis, we are hot and ready to launch when you are.

Oh, that was cool.

273

I have good eyes on the rocket here. It's coming down.

274

Eyes on the rocket.

275

That's beautiful. That was going to land right in the triangle.

That was a perfect, perfect simultaneous launch.

Up here, can you see anything?

I don't see anything.

Our first two simultaneous rocket launches through the anomalous zone above the triangle were executed perfectly.

385

right at the 31-foot level in the blob zone above the Triangle.

386

Wow, what the crap is that?

387

It's moving.

388

We were stunned when a UAP suddenly appeared,

437

Cameron is outfitted with advanced military-grade night vision goggles,

440

so he'll be able to safely fly the helicopter in the darkness

441

and detect objects that aren't visible to the naked eye.

442

So it's going to take a minute to get up to altitude.

443

If the blob or any other kind of phenomena were stimulated,

445

Hey, Cameron, how's it going?

472

We've got it.

473

There's always all across all spectrum, according to Eric.

474

Is he seeing something?

475

Yeah, he said there's something on the spectrum.

476

Oh, what the hell?

477

What do you got?

478

It's just something went by. It looked like it's falling away.

479

but objects flying by, and they're up here in 10,000 feet,

489

which is not usual.

490

At the same time we're seeing these elevated levels of RF noise,

491

Cameron is seeing objects passing the helicopter.

492

He's only seeing them in this night vision technology

493

that he has.

494

I can't help but wonder whether these are members of the same

495

class of thing that we've been seeing throughout the entire summer.

496

How close to the helicopter are they?

497

Very close. Here's one right underneath it.

498

That's amazing.

499

I don't know whether to be terrified or excited.

500

This is crazy.

Cameron is a skilled pilot for him to see what can only be

described as UFO activity surrounding the helicopter.

It's sobering.

512

I don't see it.

513

00:26:41,000 --> 00:26:42,000

Thomas, look up in the sky with a psionic.

514

Can you see it?

Yeah, I'm looking right now.

516

I've got them in the camera, but, you know,

517

00:26:50,000 --> 00:26:52,000

them up there at 4,500 feet.

518

I don't see that high.

519

Eric, are you seeing anything unusual?

520

00:26:57,000 --> 00:26:58,000

No change.

521

No change, but you're still seeing the same high levels

522

00:27:03,000 --> 00:27:06,000

of disturbance across the entire spectrum.

523

Yeah, frankly, Brandon, it's all unusual.

524

I want you to turn around and take a look at this.
