There is a ranch in northern Utah.

16

Animal mutilations, bizarre UFO sightings,

Well, gentlemen, it's good to be with you again.

Senator Lee, thank you for joining us.

It's very nice to meet all of you.

Thanks for having me out here.

One of the things that comes up in Washington

48

when members of the Senate discuss things that are observed

in the sky that they can't explain is we need to know what's there.

If there's something that's moving that can be observed,

51

and we don't know what it is, and if we know that it's not ours,

that could be a national security issue.

Absolutely.

54

Over the last four years, we've seen numerous UAPs.

55

Some have been orbs of light, while others looked and maneuvered

like possible nuts and bolts crap.

57

But one of the strangest things was a blob-like anomaly

58

about 31 feet in the air above the triangle that destroyed a rocket.

And it may also be related to GPS and time shift anomalies

60

that we've detected up to 10,000 feet above the ranch.

So, is there anything you want to tell me about that you've observed?

62

We've measured an electromagnetic anomaly with various instruments

63

above this spot on the ranch that we call the triangle.

And in fact, we've even had something appear over the spot

at 31 feet above ground level.

Very often anomalous things happen with our equipment,

67

our surveillance assets, and all the things we measure with.

68

Well, and that seem to correlate with an identified aerial phenomena.

Oh, yeah.

And we've caught things on our camera before

71

that's been brought to our attention by the locals.

And some of the neighbors here have seen the same things that we have seen.

There are any possibility that some of the UAPs that you've observed on site

could be surveillance operations? Somebody curious?

Well, we know we're being monitored.

That's right.

If it's equipment owned by foreign government, that's a concern.

78

Earlier this year, when we first encountered the anomaly 31 feet above the triangle,

helicopter, helicopter, helicopter coming right over,

80

a Black Hawk military helicopter suddenly circled above the ranch for several minutes.

81

And then just a week ago, two Chinook military helicopters also appeared to be surveilling the ranch.

82

It was not like they're trying to be sneaky in any way, shape, or form.

Now, maybe they were looking for evidence that foreign adversaries are linked to

84

But given that many of the UAPs we've seen have traveled much faster

86

and maneuvered in more advanced ways than known U.S. technology

87

and even vanished in some cases, as a scientist, I have a hard time believing that.

88

So if this is our foreign adversaries, then they have leapfrogged physics by 50 to 100 years

89

and haven't told the rest of the world.

One thing we noticed in the recent months is GPS is completely spoofed out here.

91

What's really interesting is a lot of times when we do have these GPS anomalies,

we are detecting a strange signal at 1.6 gigahertz that has no known source or purpose.

Right. Sometimes you hear about GPS signals being jammed near military installations.

96

So something or someone has the technology, the capability to meddle with our systems.

97

Do you have any working theories of what it could be?

98

We have no data that tells us who could have done this.

99

Hey look, UAP, right there!

100

Things that have been observed here have been observed elsewhere

101

and might involve technology that we're not familiar with.

If there are things moving in U.S. airspace that we can't fully explain,

if there's technology that isn't ours that could have some potential military applications,

these are things we need to know about.

in order to help us with our most ambitious experiment ever at the Triangle.

The weather is about to turn really harsh in the U.N. to Basin,

118

so this is our last opportunity of the year to finally figure out just who, or what,

119

and explain the UAPs, the blob, and all the other strange phenomena we've detected at this spot.

120

Hey, Dragon. So, Thomas and Eric and I have been mapping out this out here

121

based on the LIDAR picture from OmniTek.

122

So this is the shadow part?

123

This is the shadow part. Two weeks ago representatives from a company called OmniTek

124

conducted a LIDAR scan above the Triangle while we fired rockets up through the anomalous zone.

125

We got a good shoot.

126

00:07:26,000 --> 00:07:27,000

Come on, good shoot.

127

Look at that.

128

That's interesting.

129

We were stunned when that detected a perfectly circular phenomenon with a black void right in the center of the Triangle.

130

For years we've heard legends that interdimensional portals, or traversable wormholes, actually exist on Skinwalker Ranch.

131

It's a claim that's been made not only by the indigenous tribal elders,

132

but also former ranch investigators who worked with the federal government.

Oh, me too. So let's get them all out and see what they got and figure out where we're going to put them.

So tonight we're going to try to stimulate phenomena above the Triangle all through the anomalous zone

136

by having the team from Locked Precision launch multiple rounds of rockets with ever-increasing power levels.

137

Hey fellas, how are y'all doing?

138

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:20,000

While deploying a number of other cutting-edge technologies that we've used in the past,

139

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:28,000

the hope is that combining them all into one big experiment will help us determine once and for all if this incredible legend is true.

140

Well, I want to welcome everybody back out.

141

00:08:30,000 --> 00:08:32,000

We're at a familiar site.

142

00:08:32,000 --> 00:08:41,000

As all of you gentlemen know, this has become an epicenter of study as well as of anomalous

readings and results historically.

143

I don't think anyone's been out here in the Triangle where they haven't seen some kind of really pathological,

144

00:08:47,000 --> 00:08:50,000

really strange things happening with their equipment.

145

So I'm so grateful to have all of you guys out here at the same time bringing your tech and your personnel.

146

We've got a lot of work to do. We've got a lot of things to set up.

147

So you guys start getting your stuff out and let's figure out where you've got to be and let's get to moving.

148

For tonight's experiment, the teams will be situated all around the Triangle.

149

The guys from New Salt Laser will have three space cannons positioned at each corner of the Triangle,

150

00:09:12,000 --> 00:09:16,000

projecting high-power beams that will encompass the anomalous zone.

151

00:09:16,000 --> 00:09:19,000

And they will reach all the way into outer space.

152

00:09:19,000 --> 00:09:25,000

So if anything strange moves through there, disrupting or bending the lasers, we should be able to see it.

153

00:09:25,000 --> 00:09:33,000

And as a secondary way to detect anything strange, they will be scanning with two rastering lasers all through that zone as well.

154

So if we stimulate phenomena here, hopefully these two laser technologies may be able to detect and confirm the actual shape

155

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:48,000

and exact location of any anomalies. But that's just the beginning of what we're doing tonight.

156

We're also going to scan the nearby Mesa with a projection laser.

157

00:09:52,000 --> 00:09:53,000

You're good.

158

00:09:53,000 --> 00:10:02,000

It will be broadcasting audio that we recorded during a recent sound ritual experiment with an indigenous organization named Blazing Bear.

159

And now look at this.

160

There it is. Go back. Go back.

161

00:10:06,000 --> 00:10:14,000

A sound experiment that captured thermal images of two UAPs flying into the surface of the Mesa.
What is that?

162

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:27,000

Finally, the team from Sky Elements has returned to fly 250 illuminated drones equipped with GPS sensors in pre-programmed formations about 300 feet above the Triangle.

163

Whoa!

164

00:10:29,000 --> 00:10:31,000

Yeah, we got it down trapped right there.

165

00:10:31,000 --> 00:10:36,000

It was at that exact height where earlier this year Brandon's helicopter got pushed around.

166

Holy cow!

167

00:10:38,000 --> 00:10:41,000

Just as we detected something strange with a Lidar scanner.

168

00:10:41,000 --> 00:10:46,000

We've got a clear anomaly right beside us.

169

00:10:46,000 --> 00:10:48,000

Dude, that is awesome.

170

00:10:48,000 --> 00:11:01,000

So tonight, if anything alters the drone swarm's formation or flight patterns, hopefully it will further help us pinpoint and identify what the phenomena we've detected there actually could be.

171

Alright.

172

00:11:02,000 --> 00:11:06,000

The temperature is about to start dropping so I'm going to put on some bigger clothes and a lot of daylight here.

173

So, uh, say we get on it.

174

And all through the night, Eric will be monitoring for strange energy spikes and the 1.6 gigahertz signal with his spectrum analyzer and radiation detectors while recording the entire experiment with a FLIR thermal imaging camera.

175

00:11:22,000 --> 00:11:26,000

We've never had this much technology operating at once on the ranch.

176

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:34,000

So hopefully tonight, we'll cut through the legends about this place and finally reveal the truth of what's really happening out here.

177

Alright, well I gotta get this stuff up and you guys, if you need anything, yell at me.

178

00:11:38,000 --> 00:11:41,000

Alright, let's go and wait for the sun to go down.

179

Travis, I'm set up over here.

180

00:11:50,000 --> 00:11:51,000

So how are you doing over there?

181

00:11:51,000 --> 00:11:52,000

Everything's set up here.

182

00:11:52,000 --> 00:11:54,000

Tim, I say we go ahead and bring the lasers up.

183

00:11:54,000 --> 00:11:56,000

Lasers up.

184

00:11:56,000 --> 00:11:58,000

Lasers are up.

185

00:11:58,000 --> 00:12:03,000

We're conducting the most extensive experiment ever on Skinwalker Ranch.

186

00:12:03,000 --> 00:12:14,000

To try to pinpoint and identify the anomaly at the triangle, lock precision is going to launch the first six rockets simultaneously while sky elements will fly a swarm of 250 drones.

187

00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:19,000

In the past, just a single rocket has gotten strange things to happen at the triangle.

188

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:21,000

So let's see what six might do.

189

00:12:21,000 --> 00:12:24,000

Everyone be advised, clear the launch pad.

190

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:26,000

We're about to launch.

191

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:28,000

Clear the area.

192

00:12:28,000 --> 00:12:30,000

Drones are armed.

193

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:35,000

Oh, hold up.

194

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:37,000

System just crashed.

195

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:39,000

Malfunction, guys, malfunction.

196

00:12:39,000 --> 00:12:43,000

Hey, Tyler, what's our ETA on the first drone swarm?

197

00:12:43,000 --> 00:12:46,000

Hey Travis, we had a really strange thing going on over here.

198

00:12:46,000 --> 00:12:48,000

We're having an interference issue right now.

199

00:12:48,000 --> 00:12:49,000

We're not really sure what's doing it.

200

00:12:49,000 --> 00:12:52,000

We're having trouble getting all the drones to connect.

201

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:53,000

Copy that.

202

00:12:53,000 --> 00:12:54,000

I understand.

203

00:12:54,000 --> 00:12:56,000

That is really odd.

204

00:12:56,000 --> 00:13:00,000

We're going to go ahead and do our first six rocket launches.

205

00:13:00,000 --> 00:13:02,000

Let us know when you're ready.

206

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:03,000

We'll do.

207

00:13:03,000 --> 00:13:04,000

Let's get this up and down.

208

00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:07,000

All right, we are going hot with the rockets.

209

00:13:08,000 --> 00:13:10,000

We got all six hot.

210

00:13:10,000 --> 00:13:16,000

Here we go in five, four, three, two, one.

211

00:13:16,000 --> 00:13:17,000

Come on.

212

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:23,000

Where are the others going?

213

00:13:23,000 --> 00:13:24,000

What's going on?

214

00:13:28,000 --> 00:13:30,000

Well, that was weird.

215

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:33,000

Were they supposed to go off simultaneously?

216

00:13:33,000 --> 00:13:34,000

So what happened with that?

217

00:13:34,000 --> 00:13:35,000

That's a good question.

218

00:13:35,000 --> 00:13:36,000

You tell me.

219

00:13:36,000 --> 00:13:38,000

And the rockets didn't go at the same time,

220

00:13:38,000 --> 00:13:40,000

but they're all hooked to the same wire.

221

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:41,000

Same wire.

222

00:13:41,000 --> 00:13:43,000

That doesn't make any sense.

223

00:13:43,000 --> 00:13:45,000

Did you notice another rockets went straight up?

224

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:46,000

Yeah, they did.

225

00:13:46,000 --> 00:13:49,000

All five of them went different ways.

226

00:13:49,000 --> 00:13:52,000

So have the winds of loft changed?

227

00:13:52,000 --> 00:13:53,000

There's nothing.

228

00:13:53,000 --> 00:13:54,000

There's any wind.

229

00:13:54,000 --> 00:13:56,000

You still got one on the pad.

230

00:13:56,000 --> 00:13:57,000

All right.

231

00:13:57,000 --> 00:13:58,000

Everybody stay clear of the pad.

232

00:13:58,000 --> 00:14:00,000

There's still one hot rocket on the pad.

233

00:14:00,000 --> 00:14:01,000

Everyone clear?

234

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:02,000

I'm going to go check it.

235

00:14:02,000 --> 00:14:03,000

Yep.

236

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:04,000

We got it off?

237

00:14:04,000 --> 00:14:05,000

Yep.

238

00:14:05,000 --> 00:14:06,000

We weren't sure what was going on,

239

00:14:06,000 --> 00:14:07,000

but just before we launched the drones,

240

00:14:07,000 --> 00:14:09,000

they all inexplicably malfunctioned.

241

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:11,000

And then immediately after that,

242

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:13,000

the rockets malfunctioned as well.

243

00:14:13,000 --> 00:14:15,000

Our rockets were on one circuit,

244

00:14:15,000 --> 00:14:17,000

meaning they should have launched together.

245

00:14:17,000 --> 00:14:20,000

But instead, only five took off,

246

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:22,000

and they all launched at random intervals

247

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:24,000

in really odd directions.

248

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:27,000

Hey, Tyler, how's your progress?

249

00:14:27,000 --> 00:14:29,000

Yeah, we're having some network issues.

250

00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:32,000

Drones just seem to be falling off and not connecting,

251

00:14:32,000 --> 00:14:34,000

and the methods we usually use to resolve those issues

252

00:14:34,000 --> 00:14:36,000

don't seem to be working.

253

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:39,000

This is the exact same thing they had happen last time.

254

00:14:39,000 --> 00:14:40,000

Yeah, isn't that something?

255

00:14:40,000 --> 00:14:42,000

They tested all these drones before they brought them out here.

256

00:14:42,000 --> 00:14:44,000

And said that they were like their best ones,

257

00:14:44,000 --> 00:14:47,000

and that they brought out all their best stuff.

258

00:14:47,000 --> 00:14:49,000

I think it's too early for us to declare

259

00:14:49,000 --> 00:14:51,000

that there is an assignable cause here

260

00:14:51,000 --> 00:14:54,000

for the drone malfunctions and this rocket failure.

261

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:56,000

However, when we have events like this,

262

00:14:56,000 --> 00:14:58,000

the attention of our entire team

263

00:14:58,000 --> 00:15:02,000

is more intently focused on what is going on.

264

00:15:02,000 --> 00:15:06,000

Why are we experiencing these equipment and other failures?

265

00:15:08,000 --> 00:15:09,000

What happened?

266

00:15:09,000 --> 00:15:11,000

Six great continuities fine.

267

No. It moved outside of the field of view of the flare camera, Eric.

when we launched the first two rockets.

And then it moved off of the field of view.

as far as we can figure.

So the big rocket was something we concocted

866

to push a few boundaries out here.

867

We're expecting to hit about 10,000 feet and Mach 1.5.
