A few years ago, ufologists added CE-4 to describe reported alien abductions of humans.

And now, there's a new category, close encounters of the fifth kind, CE-5,

which humans and aliens actively communicate with each other through light and sound.

The Center for the Study of Extraterrestrial Life, or CE-7, is pioneering the study of CE-5s.

Dr. Stephen Greer is CE-7's director.

A close encounter of the fifth kind is a term that we have coined to describe humans deliberately attempting

130

to vector a spacecraft into an area with the intention of interacting with it.

Most encounters in all the other categories are passive.

132

In a CE-5, we take the initiative to communicate in some fashion,

whether it be with sound or light or thought, to try and get a response,

rather than just being passive observers. We want to interact.

And some of these are sometimes quite serendipitous.

The purpose of our work is for peaceful communication, mutual respect.

We absolutely assume non-hostility on the part of any visitors until it's proven to us beyond a shadow of a doubt.

In their field research, CCETI has developed a specific set of protocols for initiating contact with aliens' spacecraft.

Their goal is a successful CE-5.

The different methods of initiating a CE-5 include using sound,

145

which are at this point we're using anomalous sounds that were recorded inside of crop circles in England.

We use light. When we go out into the field, we go with half million candle power halogen lights that are portable.

147

The lights are used signaling to the UFO, either in a series of flashes,

So we're using these, what we call the contact trilogy, in a protocol fashion with the express intention of a boarding party,

In the spring of 1992, Dr. Greer took a CCETI group to one UFO hotspot, Gulf Breeze, Florida.

This computer simulation is based on CCETI's own footage, supposedly showing communication with a UFO.

We began signaling to them with these lights and they would signal back so that we would flash to them two flashes and off,

157

and they would flash back two times and off.

158

They disappeared briefly and during that time period, we were making a equilateral triangle in the sky with these high powered lights.

159

At that point, shortly after we did that, they reappeared in a perfect equilateral triangle.

160

Over 40 people witnessed a definite close encounter of the fifth kind between the CCETI group and these UFOs.

With their apparent success at Gulf Breeze, CCETI expanded their field research to include an investigation in Great Britain.

They combined forces with British researchers who were interested in investigating if alien spacecraft could be responsible for England's famous crop circles.

We wanted to try and prove once and for all if a link really did exist between the UFO phenomenon and the crop circle phenomenon.

We picked the Wiltshire area because the majority of the crop circle formations in England are forming in that particular county.

The site there is very close to Stonehenge. It's a very prolific area for aerial phenomena and for the ground patterns.

During our protocol that evening of July 23rd, we focused on our thought process for this particular formation for 20 minutes.

We all held in our minds the thought of a triangle with a circle at each point of the triangle.
