Paul Devereux believes it's not history or superstition that creates a sacred site.

Madren Well is another supernatural site.

They believe that hoaxes and absurd tabloid headlines are planted by the Pentagon to discredit

CITINGS has conducted numerous experiments where we found it relatively simple to create

In 1991, a small community outside of Ottawa, Canada, was thought to be the site of Guardian's

What you have is a little rural community in eastern Ontario close to Ottawa called Manion

333

Corners.

A little tiny place, maybe 50 or 60 families lived there.

335

And in 1991, somebody decided that they would put together this UFO hoax and put out a video.

336

After the videotape was distributed worldwide, official looking documents began to surface.

337

Some were written on Canadian government stationery.

338

00:23:40,440 --> 00:23:45,400

Then still photographs of supposedly extraterrestrial creatures were released.

339

These were an obvious tip-off that a hoax was being perpetrated.

So we enlisted the help of Mufon Canada's assistant director, Tom Theophanus, and photo

analyst, Jeff Seino.

The documents are purported to be Department of National Defense Canadian military documents,

343

but just a quick read of them shows that they're obviously falsified.

You see statements like insatiable sex drive.

Their women prefer human partners.

Blonde types infiltrate the artistic centres of Canada.

It appears they need artists to get the message out.

It's obviously such hokey documents that there's no doubt that these are falsified.

Once we know that, we have to go back and take a look at the video and say, since we

know that Guardian is a hoaxer, is there anything exceptional in this video that could not have

351

been hoaxed by a fairly motivated person?

Well, and here you see two light sources.

One coming in from the area of the flares is producing this reddish glow.

And the source that's off, mainly off the ground, an external source of lighting.

And you also have the shrub light on top, which you can see the actual shape of it.

357

Here we're seeing what appear to be four road flares.

358

You can see the smoke wafting off toward this direction the same way that we see on the

359

00:25:10,040 --> 00:25:11,800

UFO later on.

Over here the UFO is badly overexposed.

361

You really can't make it out of any detail.

362

There's no motion there, nothing but a strobe light on top that's anything out of the ordinary.

What would it take to duplicate these images?

Sightings asked a special effects team to try and recreate the Guardian video.

365

They used a scale model helicopter, an asbestos line truck, and road flares.

And the team placed the helicopter in a position similar to that on the Guardian video.

Next, technicians set up a strobe light and road flares to match those used in Canada.

Special effects smoke was added, and the result is not unlike that in the original Guardian

Depending on how much smoke was added, the silhouette of the helicopter could look like

Is there any evidence that any government is involved in that sort of disinformation?

Could the prayers of his family make a difference?

Near Santa Fe, New Mexico, one place stands as a testament to the power of prayer.

For nearly 200 years, people have come to El Sanjuario de Chimayo to pray, often leaving

behind the crutches and wheelchairs they no longer need.

446

Dr. Larry Dossi studies the accounts of healing by prayer that continue to this day.

447

The question for us in science is, can we go beyond people's stories and make anything

448

00:31:15,120 --> 00:31:18,240

scientific out of the personal account?

449

00:31:18,240 --> 00:31:19,600

That's the great challenge.

450

Dr. Dossi has written the best-selling book that chronicles the positive effects of prayer,

451

00:31:25,360 --> 00:31:31,160

a subject considered entirely anecdotal and unsubstantiated until just a few years ago.

452

00:31:31,160 --> 00:31:35,840

I discovered, however, back in the mid-80s that there were some studies coming out showing

453

00:31:35,840 --> 00:31:40,360

that if you take prayer into the clinic or the hospital or the laboratory and test it

454

00:31:40,360 --> 00:31:45,960

pretty much like you would in new medication, you can actually show that prayer does something.

455

00:31:45,960 --> 00:31:51,920

Religious affiliation and religious belief are not factors in these experiments.

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00:31:51,920 --> 00:31:57,400

In the 1980s, medical researchers in Oregon devised an experiment to test the power of

457

00:31:57,400 --> 00:32:00,840

prayer under controlled laboratory conditions.

458

00:32:00,840 --> 00:32:06,600

In a double-blind study, test tubes were filled with equal amounts of yeast and sealed.

459

00:32:06,600 --> 00:32:11,120

Half of the tubes were prayed over by volunteers, half were not.

460

00:32:11,120 --> 00:32:15,680

Researchers were amazed that there was a significant difference in the tubes that had been prayed

461

00:32:15,680 --> 00:32:16,840

over.

462

00:32:16,840 --> 00:32:23,040

You can do this with extreme accuracy and the differences in the growth rates are quite

463

00:32:23,040 --> 00:32:26,840

profound, favoring those that get prayed for.

464

It frequently is the case in the history of medicine that we have known that something

465

00:32:30,920 --> 00:32:33,320

works before we know how it works.

466

Penicillin was an example.

467

When penicillin was discovered, no one had a clue about actually how it worked, but we

468

honored the data, we did the studies and we could show that it did something.

469

We're at the same point with prayer.

470

00:32:45,440 --> 00:32:51,040

We haven't the foggiest idea scientifically how it could work, but we have taken it into

471

00:32:51,040 --> 00:32:52,040

the laboratory.

472

00:32:52,040 --> 00:32:53,720

We have done the precise studies.

473

00:32:53,720 --> 00:32:56,520

We have shown that it works.

474

00:32:56,520 --> 00:33:01,720

Obholstered by the remarkable results found in the yeast experiment, San Francisco General

475

00:33:01,720 --> 00:33:06,160

Hospital launched its own power of prayer study.

476

Volunteers were asked to pray for patients they did not know.

477

00:33:09,480 --> 00:33:13,200

393 patients were prayed for over a 10-month period.

478

00:33:13,200 --> 00:33:17,280

We had the prayers do so only outside of hospital.

479

00:33:17,280 --> 00:33:21,720

They never came inside of hospital and the patients never saw them.

480

00:33:21,720 --> 00:33:28,480

And we didn't produce any standard prayer or prayer format.

481

After analyzing the data, the results were impressive.

482

The patients who received extra prayer from our groups outside of the hospital required

483

00:33:38,280 --> 00:33:47,860

less diuretic therapy, less antibiotics, and had less cardiac arrest.

484

In Riverside, California, Taylor Hall's family didn't know about the results of the San Francisco

485

00:33:53,220 --> 00:33:54,780

General study.

486

00:33:54,780 --> 00:33:57,220

They prayed because they felt they had to.

487

00:33:57,220 --> 00:34:00,420

Their little boy was dying.

488

00:34:00,420 --> 00:34:03,500

His entire pelvis was crushed under the tires.

489

00:34:03,500 --> 00:34:09,060

I had grave doubts about being able to put his intestinal tract back together.

490

The damage was so extensive in the pelvic area.

491

00:34:11,940 --> 00:34:14,940

We had huge open wounds.

492

Again, very susceptible to infection.

493

There was a very good possibility that the infection that might have gotten in there

494

would be the thing that would end up killing him.

495

The next thing we were told was that if he made it through that, that there would be

00:34:35,100 --> 00:34:38,420

a possibility that one, he might not be able to have children.

497

He might have to have a colostomy the rest of his life.

His ability to walk might be impeded substantially.

499

He thought he was going to die.

500

I think that scared the nurses a little bit because they said when patients think that

they're going to die, then it's pretty serious.

But the family never lost their faith and dedication to prayer, that mysterious force

503

00:35:03,380 --> 00:35:09,300

that now has mainstream medicine rethinking its power to heal.

The fact that prayer can work says that the consciousness, the human psyche, the mind

505
