An Iranian Air Force F-4 Phantom jet fighter was ordered to engage the UFO and determine what it was.

The F-4 approached Mach 1 in its pursuit of the UFO.

At an altitude of 23,000 feet, the lead pilot reported in that he clearly saw a brilliant object 75 miles ahead of him.

His actual radio transmissions are heard here publicly for the first time outside Iran.

The F-4 was closing fast, but when the pilot got within 10 miles of the UFO, all onboard instruments failed.

And now it is a communication between the mother ship and that small flying object.

Hussein Parousi, an air traffic controller at Maravad Air Force Base, was also present at that meeting.

they concluded that no country is able to have such a technology,

119

I don't know why the appropriate authority prohibited me to interview with the press or news reporter.

129

I don't know why this information is prohibited from the public.

130

00:12:35,400 --> 00:12:43,400

Somehow the government doesn't want to open up to the public. I don't know why, but...

131

Despite media dismissals of the event as a joke,

132

00:12:47,400 --> 00:12:52,400

our sources report that a full-scale military investigation continued to search for answers.

133

I asked from the pilot of the F-4 to go and to look after that flying object.

134

00:13:00,400 --> 00:13:09,400

He knew where it landed, and when they flew and the Army personnel they were in the area, they couldn't see anything.

135

The general who headed that search still lives in Tehran and denied repeated requests for an interview.

136

But others who were present told sightings that no physical evidence of a UFO was found on the mountaintop

137

where so many had reported seen a small craft landing.

138

However, for the first three days after the incident there were serious electronic anomalies in the area.

139

The beeping sound that was picked up could be one of a number of things.

It might be technology.

141

In fact, depending on the frequency stability and interfrequency pulse and other factors like that,

it very likely is a technology of some sort, as opposed to a natural phenomenon.

And then there is this.

An American defense systems program satellite operated by the U.S. Defense Department

Experts from DSP are revealing this information for the first time.

147

We saw something.

148

00:14:12,400 --> 00:14:19,400

The DSP satellite is, in fact, a spy satellite that monitors airspace in military hotspots.

149

00:14:19,400 --> 00:14:26,400

On the night of September 19th, 1976, the satellite was scanning the skies over Tehran.

150

00:14:26,400 --> 00:14:32,400

That's an independent confirmation that an event of some type occurred at that time and place.

151

00:14:32,400 --> 00:14:34,400

What it was, we don't know.

152

00:14:34,400 --> 00:14:41,400

Sightings asked the experts to explain the meaning of 238 scans possible SR,

153

00:14:41,400 --> 00:14:44,400

but they told us that information was top secret.

154

00:14:44,400 --> 00:14:47,400

Right now all we can do is say, yes, there was something there.

155

00:14:47,400 --> 00:14:55,400

Certain agencies, including the CIA, have gone on record as having information on this particular case.

156

00:14:55,400 --> 00:15:00,400

In fact, sightings has obtained these documents from the United States Air Force Security Service

157

00:15:00,400 --> 00:15:04,400

that confirm our government's involvement in the UFO investigation.

158

And, according to this Washington Post article, the investigation was still in full force as late as 1979.

159

Now what does that say?

160

It says that somebody thought this case was very, very important when it happened.

Why, after this many years, that's still important?

I think it's a fundamental question and the American people deserve to know what happened.

Dr. Richard Haynes continues to investigate pilot UFO confrontations as part of his own project, Delta.

164

For the past 30 years, Dr. Haynes has interviewed more than 100 civilian and military pilots who claim to have encountered UFOs.

165

Next, there's a serial killer in the Nevada desert.

166

He does pose as either a security guard or a policeman.

167

00:15:49,400 --> 00:15:53,400

She's seen the crime in her mind's eye and the police are listening.

168

00:15:56,400 --> 00:15:59,400

There's a serial killer on the loose somewhere in the west.

169

00:15:59,400 --> 00:16:02,400

There have been six, maybe even seven victims already.

170

00:16:02,400 --> 00:16:08,400

No one knows where or when the killer will strike again, but sheriffs in Utah, Nevada and Wyoming

171

don't want to wait until another young woman dies before they find out.

172

00:16:11,400 --> 00:16:17,400

They have agreed to our request to let psychic detective Dorothy Allison in on the case.

173

In Desolate, Elko County, Nevada, two rock collectors found her body.

174

00:16:26,400 --> 00:16:31,400

At the time, no one knew that she was just one of many or that it would take a psychic to name her killer.

175

I was notified on November 16, 1993 that we had a body in the desert off of Interstate 80,

176

about 23 miles west of the Utah state line.

177

When we got out there, we found a white female unidentified, completely stripped of all her clothing, jewelry,

178

00:16:50,400 --> 00:16:53,400

and had been killed by a gunshot.

179

00:16:53,400 --> 00:16:59,400

An enhanced sketch of the victim was released in the hope that a loved one would come forward to claim her.

180

00:16:59,400 --> 00:17:01,400

No one did.

181

00:17:02,400 --> 00:17:04,400

It's very sad.

182

00:17:04,400 --> 00:17:09,400

I have a teenage daughter right now and I would hate for her something like this to happen to her

183

00:17:09,400 --> 00:17:14,400

and she'd be just sitting somewhere and nobody knowing who she is or how she got there.

184

00:17:14,400 --> 00:17:19,400

The town of Elko adopted the unknown victim as one of their own.

185

00:17:19,400 --> 00:17:23,400

A local mortuary sponsored a funeral for the young woman nobody knew.

186

00:17:23,400 --> 00:17:28,400

This young lady had to be somebody's daughter, maybe somebody's wife, somebody's mother.

187

00:17:28,400 --> 00:17:31,400

She was due some dignity and respect.

188

00:17:31,400 --> 00:17:38,400

The way she died was not very pleasant and we just couldn't, in good conscience, just take her out and bury her.

189

00:17:38,400 --> 00:17:42,400

Without having some type of a funeral service.

190

00:17:42,400 --> 00:17:45,400

Elko could only mourn and wonder why.

191

00:17:45,400 --> 00:17:50,400

The victim was buried just as she had been discovered, alone and anonymous.

192

00:17:50,400 --> 00:17:58,400

With few clues to go on, detective Schultz sent out a teletype describing the Elko murder case to law enforcement agencies across the country.

193

00:17:58,400 --> 00:18:04,400

Almost immediately, sheriff's detectives in Millard and Juab counties in Utah called in.

194

00:18:04,400 --> 00:18:08,400

They both had unsolved murders strikingly similar to the one in Elko.

195

I'll show you where our girl was found.

196

00:18:10,400 --> 00:18:13,400

They faced the chilling reality that a killer was on the loose.

197

00:18:13,400 --> 00:18:19,400

When all of the investigating detectives met to go over their individual cases, a pattern developed.

198

00:18:19,400 --> 00:18:24,400

Instantly linking all of the murders, all of the victims were young women,

199

00:18:24,400 --> 00:18:27,400

shot with a small caliber weapon and stripped naked.

200

00:18:27,400 --> 00:18:31,400

Strangely, their corpses weren't haphazardly dumped, they were placed.

201

00:18:31,400 --> 00:18:37,400

The scenes are almost identical. The way their hair was pulled up underneath them, the way their heads were turned,

202

00:18:37,400 --> 00:18:43,400

the way their hands were laid out in a particular fashion, the way their feet were laid out in a particular fashion.

203

We feel very strongly that the bodies were in fact posed, that there are some things that are not natural, but the way the bodies were positioned.

In all, seven victims in Nevada, Utah and Wyoming have now been identified as murders that could fit the pattern.

We have a serial killer, we believe, out there that is going to strike again.

206

A killer who has an uncanny knack for finding victims nobody knows and nobody misses.

207

It's very frustrating. You start wondering, you know, what else can you do? What can you do?

208

00:19:16,400 --> 00:19:21,400

With anonymous victims and few leads, the detectives accepted Sighting's offer of help.

209

00:19:21,400 --> 00:19:23,400

We brought in Dorothy Allison.

210

00:19:23,400 --> 00:19:33,400

This 69-year-old New Jersey housewife is also a psychic detective who has worked with the FBI and local law enforcement agencies on over 4,000 murder cases.

211

For Dorothy, the first order of business was to go to the site where the body of Elko's Jane Doe was discovered.

212

00:19:39,400 --> 00:19:49,400

The minute that I get near the scene, it seems like the blood is rushing through my body and saying to me, this is what happened to this girl.

213

00:19:49,400 --> 00:19:54,400

This is what he looks like. Things that cannot be put out by the police.

214

00:19:54,400 --> 00:20:02,400

Her first impressions at the site were about the killer himself. She envisioned the victim's last terrified moments alone with him.

215

00:20:02,400 --> 00:20:09,400

He does pose as either a security guard or a policeman. He does not pose as a trucker that he may be.

216

00:20:09,400 --> 00:20:17,400

That's what is so shocking to the girls because they think they were the police officer and they don't expect this to happen.

217

00:20:17,400 --> 00:20:21,400

They are more or less in the state of shock when he starts attacking them.

218

00:20:21,400 --> 00:20:25,400

At first, the detectives were skeptical and merely listened politely.

219

00:20:25,400 --> 00:20:33,400

But Dorothy quickly gained their undivided attention when she made a series of remarkably accurate statements no one outside of the investigation could know.

220

00:20:33,400 --> 00:20:41,400

I was told this girl was shot and that was all I was told. But I got a feeling about the throat. There's something wrong with the throat.

221

00:20:41,400 --> 00:20:48,400

I don't know. Maybe the police can sort of let me know what I feel about that throat.

222

00:20:48,400 --> 00:20:58,400

The only problem I have with that is that it's never been released. That's a lead for us. Something was done on the throat.

223

Her accuracy made the detectives uneasy, but it also heightened their interest in Dorothy's psychic vision of the killer.

At the Tyler Rehabilitation Center in Texas, more than 80 dogs and their owners are involved in the Animal-Assisted Therapy program.

It's like this is not happening, you know, because there was no smiles, no reaction.

There was like nothing. He might like look at you, but it was like space, you know. There was nothing there.

Head injury patients, we might work on tracking or focusing as they're coming out of a coma.

Spinal cord patients might work on a variety of different balance activities like throwing the ball.

The dogs give me a sense of happiness and I know that they're working with me as well as me working with them and it just makes me feel good.

We thought she'd die. We truly thought she would die. We thought she was too sick to get better.

She had so many things stacked against her.

364

But Kirsten Sender didn't die, despite the fact that she was crushed inside this van, submerged in a muddy creek.

365

She inhaled all that water. She had pneumonia. She had a concussion. She had multiple broken bones.

The woman who strokes this greyhound today entered the center completely paralyzed.

367

The muscles that now throw a ball for a game of fetch were once badly atrophied.

I don't know what's happening there. I don't think anyone knows specifically what's going on among the neurons in the brain that allow that break to.

Well, I have never really been an emotional man, but I have become one in the last four weeks, five weeks.

I mean, watching my daughter today flex her fingers was very, very emotional.

The minute she gets onto the table, you can almost see her little brain click. It's very, very serious business to her.

While science tries to figure out why, the animals continue to restore lives and families.

They're prognoses with them, and they didn't know that with her injuries, if that she would ever be able to respond to the messages that were coming from her brain.

In 1993, Stacey Paul was a high school track star, member of the drill team, a loving daughter and sister. Then there was a car crash.
