The 2,000-mile-long Oregon Trail exacted a terrible human toll.

There were many accidents, gunshot wounds, children falling out of wagons and being run over by wheels.

226

The wagons were filled to capacity with supplies.

227

The pioneers had to walk.

228

It was a five-month trek if you were one of the lucky ones.

There would be over 300,000 people who headed west, so there would be over 30,000 graves along the trail.

We had a plant sitting over there by the table in the living room and we'd come home and the plant would be in the middle of the floor.

Julie and Gary believe that these photographs capture physical manifestations of apparitions the

entire family has felt, including the family dog.

Our dog barked at it. He sits there and he looks the air. He barks at somebody's petting him.

Most of the activity takes place in what used to be Sarah's bedroom.

I don't like the idea of terminal. I think that we're making a lot of assumptions when we say someone has a terminal illness

because there's not a single illness that there is not at least one person who has recovered from it.

And I say, if there's one chance in a hundred, one chance in a thousand, why not go for it?

I was reading the Lost and Found column and I almost shuddered to see 27 missing cats when I was used to seeing three or four.

What do the cats know that I didn't?

They're reacting to the electromagnetic field and the magnetic fields that change prior to quakes.

372

This is documented. We know that these changes occur and I'm convinced that animals can detect these changes.

373

Before Berkland began linking animals and earthquakes, he was well known for his seismic windows theory

374

that the changing gravitational pull between the moon, sun and earth has a reciprocal effect on earthquakes.

Combining that theory with information about missing pets in Northern California,

376

Berkland accurately predicted the 7.1 quake that hit San Francisco in 1989.

377

This newspaper account of Berkland's prediction appeared four days before the actual quake occurred.

378

I have never seen anybody predict earthquakes as accurate as he does.

379

Nick Corini raises championship homing pigeons.

380

00:39:09,000 --> 00:39:14,000

He depends on Jim Berkland's predictions before racing his birds competitively.

381

00:39:14,000 --> 00:39:21,000

Just before we have earthquakes, they become very, very energetic, very active.

382

00:39:21,000 --> 00:39:26,000

They're very uncomfortable and it affects them tremendously in a very negative way.

383

00:39:26,000 --> 00:39:32,000

The negative effect on his pigeons that Corini describes has been documented scientifically.

384

00:39:32,000 --> 00:39:38,000

The pigeons are trying to come home. They know where north is, they use the magnetic field to come home

385

00:39:38,000 --> 00:39:44,000

and if the magnetic field gets distorted, the pigeon races can be endangered and they don't like to fly

386

00:39:44,000 --> 00:39:51,000

and that's usually just before an earthquake as the pigeons fly over a quake area that's about to kick off.

387

We know that animals have senses that are much more developed than ours.

388

Dr. Bernadine Cruz believes that animals do have special sensitivities that humans do not possess.

389

Animals have some abilities that we will never have.

390

00:40:04,000 --> 00:40:10,000

A dolphin's ability to echo, locate, a bat's ability to send off these sonar waves

391

00:40:10,000 --> 00:40:14,000

and to pick it up and to be able to get around basically blind.

392

00:40:14,000 --> 00:40:19,000

I don't know if I can honestly say that an animal can tell when an earthquake is about to happen.

393

00:40:19,000 --> 00:40:24,000

I think they can sense that there are changes that are going on in their environment.

394

00:40:24,000 --> 00:40:30,000

The problem with animal prediction of earthquakes is it's so difficult to interpret what the animals are doing.

395

But seismologist Dr. Kate Hutton does concede that there are subtle warnings before a quake that animals may be picking up.

396

We know there are electrostatic changes in a few hours or minutes before an earthquake

397

00:40:45,000 --> 00:40:50,000

because of the strain being released in the crust and they might be sensing that.

398

Following the 1994 Northridge earthquake, many people reported that their pets had sensed the quake before it happened, including Sighting's own writer.

399

She jumped on the bed and she jumped right on my chest and she started meowing very insistently.

400

She runs down the hall, she leads me into the baby's room, into the closet and she's cowering in the closet.

It happened over and over and I kept saying, what's wrong, what's wrong?

402

Unfortunately, I didn't know what it was that she was trying to tell me.

So I went back to bed and I said to my husband, that's it, we're taking her to the vet in the morning.

Cats handle stress in a lot of different ways.

Cats oftentimes, when they get stressed, will become very reclusive.

They'll just go ahead and hide.

But can pets really succeed with quake sense where the most delicate scientific instruments have failed?

410

Being the writer for Sighting's, I have to be skeptical because we hear all kinds of stories from all kinds of people.

411

Some of them are hoaxes, some of them are genuine.

So when I started telling people in sightings that my cat had predicted the earthquake,

413
