Greenwood has collected photographs of UFOs taken in 1952 from the deck of the flagship for Operation Main Brace.

They were taken aboard the USS Franklin D. Roosevelt.

On September 20, the newspaper reporter was on the flight deck of the carrier,

He said he turned down the flight deck and noticed a group of guys looking up into the sky.

Two ships appeared to be ships, one above the other, maybe about two or three hundred feet separated by the two of them, and counter-rotating lights.

Several officers, and these are representatives of divisional departments.

They couldn't believe what they were looking at. Everybody signed a release statement that nobody outside of CIC would say anything about this for at least 15 to 20 years.

The CIC, the Combat Information Center, is master control for any Navy aircraft carrier.

Here is where radar, mapping, target searches, and operations are conducted.

A commander down in Virginia, when I was discussing this with him, he was on the ship. He told me that I wasn't even supposed to mention this.

It's one of my desires in life as I find these other witnesses that were up on that flight deck with me witnessing this object as it came on top of the ship.
