We've recently had an increased number of reports here in the area

All of a sudden, a blinding white light came from directly above me.

incredibly bright light straight above me.

Airborne reporter and pilot Peter Peelegraine

149

was Denver's eye in the sky.

150

But on February 12, 1992,

151

Peter's career came to a crash.

152

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:19,000

His engine failed, and he didn't have anywhere to go,

153

but the reservoir.

154

So it took him 45 minutes to actually affect a rescue,

155

which they finally did with a rescue boat.

156

And Peter had lost consciousness

157

and was floating on top of the water.

158

They airlifted him to the hospital.

He didn't have a heartbeat for the first 45 minutes.

When he got to the hospital, he went to the hospital

161

and he went into surgery.

162

The doctors came out and told me that he had been clinically dead.

163

He made it through the surgery and was in a deep coma.

164

Peter was a boisterous transplant from Australia,

165

a family man, a fun-loving, joyous father of five.

It was hard to imagine that a man so full of life

167

00:09:04,000 --> 00:09:06,000

could now be on the brink of death.

168

But he was.

169

The doctors told me that with the results of the EEG

170

that the prognosis was getting worse

171

and that I needed to start thinking about making a decision

172

to either end his life or not.

173

Her decision was to put her husband's life in the hands of a man

174

she had never met, Roger LeBord.

175

I can't explain to you just exactly what I do

176

because in the four separate cases that I've worked with,

177

they've all been different.

Roger LeBord claims that he has used a unique psychic gift

179

to successfully communicate with four separate coma patients.

All four instances, they were going to pull life support

181

and let them die and it was the neurologist's opinion

that there was no hope.

183

Roger arrived about 10.30 and I said,

184

well, why don't you get some rest and we'll go over in a few hours

185

and be with him and he said, no, it's really better if I start now.

186

Then Roger put his hands on Peter and Peter's arm

187

and I laid my hand on his other arm

188

and all of a sudden I got this really strange sensation

189

of sort of electricity in my stomach

190

and I just thought I can't deal with this right now.

191

I can't.

192

And so I said, well, I'm going to leave you alone

193

and I'm going to go back and try and get some sleep.

194

I sat in the room for four hours doing my best to blank my mind.

195

What came to me was to go over and start talking to Peter

about walking through a field of flowers

and I described to him what the flowers looked like, the smells.

I described the surroundings and then I said to him,

199

I said, you know, Peter, when you're walking through a field of flowers

200

you have to move your feet

201

and that's when he began to move his feet under the sheet.

202

I knew then that Peter was making an effort to recover and make contact.

203

The doctor came in that night and asked me if I'd made a decision

204

and I said, well, Peter's made a decision and I think he's coming back.

205

For the next four weeks, LeBord continued to communicate with Peter

206

through directed visualization.

Peter seemed to be responding.

208

When you have someone who is not able to move

209

00:11:14,000 --> 00:11:17,000

and someone who's not able to speak

210

00:11:17,000 --> 00:11:20,000

and their focus of attention is elsewhere,

211

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:22,000

to communicate with him you have to be creative,

212

00:11:22,000 --> 00:11:24,000

you have to figure out some other way to communicate with him.

213

My discovery was that there's a way of doing that energetically.

214

What I was saying to him, which I did verbalize to him later,

215

that I was there to help him to stay or go,

216

but I needed to know what he was going to do.

But the four successful cases LeBord has worked on

218

do not convince the medical community that his technique works.

If someone's deeply unresponsive by nature of the definition,

they don't respond to my questioning,

221

nor to the nurses, you know, or other people.

Dr. Philip Yarnel is one of Denver's leading neurologists.

223

He believes that coma patients are neither physically nor mentally capable

224

00:12:01,000 --> 00:12:04,000

of responding to communication of any kind.

225

00:12:04,000 --> 00:12:09,000

We think that they have hearing in that the transmission of sounds

226

00:12:09,000 --> 00:12:14,000

from clicks in the ears to recordings on the brain are often intact.

227

00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:19,000

Now whether they hear as we hear so that we interpret sounds as voices

228

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:25,000

or as the messages of loved ones, that we can't tell.

229

But some recovered coma patients claim that their personal experience

230

has been just the opposite.

231

I had the experience that's classically described as the near-death experience

232

where you see the blinding light lights and feel the overwhelming sense of

compassion and forgiveness and peacefulness.

In 1991, Mary Kay Blakely fell into a diabetes-induced coma.

235

For nine days she lay in a New York City hospital

236

while friends and family kept around the clock vigil.

237

00:12:54,000 --> 00:12:58,000

Unlike most coma patients, Mary Kay claims that she can recall the thoughts

238

and feelings she experienced while she was comatose.

239

00:13:01,000 --> 00:13:05,000

She's chronicled her ordeal in this book, *Wake Me When It's Over*.

240

I imagined that I was in prison and couldn't, I spent the whole nine days

241

00:13:09,000 --> 00:13:12,000

trying to figure out what I had done to land there.

242

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:14,000

You lose all measurements of time.

243

00:13:14,000 --> 00:13:16,000

There's no day, there's no night.

244

00:13:16,000 --> 00:13:22,000

Felt no pain, I felt no air, I felt no breath, I felt no heartbeat.

245

It was very relaxing.

246

00:13:24,000 --> 00:13:27,000

You wanted to stay in that state forever.

247

Mary Kay gives a lot of the credit for her recovery to her sister,

248

who maintained a continuous one-way dialogue at Mary Kay's bedside.

249

She thought it was her personal mission to give me some reason to come back,

250

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:43,000

so maybe it made a difference.

251

Dr. Arnold Mindell is a clinical psychologist who has spent 20 years studying the coma state.

252

00:13:48,000 --> 00:13:53,000

He challenges the mainstream belief that deep coma is synonymous with brain death.

253

00:13:53,000 --> 00:13:56,000

He believes it is simply an altered state of consciousness.

254

00:13:56,000 --> 00:14:01,000

Years from today, people are going to look back on this period of medicine

255

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:03,000

and dealing with comatose states and they are going to say,

256

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:09,000

my God, wow, we were making decisions to pull the tubes on this character

257

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:14,000

without asking her or him or any trying to communicate with them.

258

00:14:14,000 --> 00:14:20,000

The goal is not to get the person to awake and the goal is not to get the person to die.

259

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:23,000

The goal is to follow nature.

260

00:14:23,000 --> 00:14:27,000

I don't think that Roger is a prophet or a saint.

261

00:14:27,000 --> 00:14:34,000

I think that he has found a calm and a knowledge and a wisdom of the heart.

262

He helped us. There's no question of that.

263

00:14:37,000 --> 00:14:39,000

Never give up.

264

Only until the individual in the coma states that they want to go,

265

00:14:43,000 --> 00:14:49,000

then I would say be responsible and follow their wishes and pull life support.

266

But don't give up hope.

267

Every day he gets a little bit better, but the improvements are in millimeters.

268

You know, they're not in feet or yards. They're tiny.

269

And everyone is a hard fought victory.

270

And he amazes me how hard he works for things.

271

But a sense of humor is intact.

272

He still comes up with some great one-liners.

273

marshaled every resource they could to find Danny.

We had search and rescue from, as far as the Oregon border, Nevada,

372

00:23:41,000 --> 00:23:48,000

and down below the Bay Area, throughout California, come national guards assisted.

373

00:23:48,000 --> 00:23:55,000

We had dogs, we had highway patrol, FBI, everybody assisted in this whole.

374

Investigator Vern Kelch headed up the search,

375

concentrating his forces in the canyon bordering Danny's house.

And if so, is there a way to make contact with this energy and summon it at will?

Because the landing gear appeared to be down and locked, the captain was given clearance for an immediate emergency landing.

Immediately, maintenance checked the airplane and found that the shock absorber was torn off.

It was clear that there had been a collision. But with what?

The pilot is coming, he wants to talk to you.

Journalist Jaime Musad has heard many first-hand accounts from pilots who have had unexplained encounters with UFOs.

But Captain Ruelano is the first commercial pilot in Mexico willing to risk his professional reputation and publicly state what he experienced at the helm of the DC-9.

In the next 10 days, we have six sightings of pilots going almost landing in Mexico City. They have these sightings.

Air traffic controllers have also made sightings in the air and on radar.

Sightings interviewed two controllers at Mexico City Airport while they refused to speak on camera.

I have commercial cases from almost every country in the world, by the way. Military sightings, test pilot sightings like the X-15, for instance, and NASA kind of test aircraft, and also private pilots.

Although the Mexican government is aware of the UFO flap active here, their action has been limited.

590

What we are doing now, the pilots, is to be more attentive in coordination with radar control.

Because government cooperation is lukewarm, tower controllers and the Mexican Association of Pilots

are seeking their own safe solution.
