Now, imagine your own physician thinking it's a mental problem too. You wonder, am I crazy?

I don't believe that I was hearing sounds.

367

To more than 1,300 people in Taos, New Mexico, the hum, the ridicule, and, the self-doubt, is not imaginary.

368

It sounds like a motor running, like a refrigerator running two rooms away,

369

00:38:17,000 --> 00:38:20,000

or a diesel truck idling off in the distance.

370

All they can ultimately do is leave. It drives in bunkers.

It's like someone scratching their nails on a blackboard.

It's obviously quite controversial in Taos because not everybody hears it.

But of those who hear it, they're obviously suffering from it, and no one could fake a response like that.

It wasn't until sensitive instruments actually recorded the Taos hum that sufferers learned they were not alone.

At this point, we can't rule out anything as a possible source because we don't know what the source is.

Tom Sharp is a reporter for the Albuquerque Journal, who has been searching for the source of the Taos hum since 1987.

And for some reason, we are hearing it, or some people are sensing it hundreds, if not thousands, miles away.

Investigative reporter Chuck DeCaro is an expert on radiofrequency deployment.

He is investigating claims that secret government testing using RF technology is being conducted near Taos.

385

Could engender a cause-and-effect relationship, much in a way that drugs have a cause-and-effect relationship?

386

Secret underground bases in the southwest are not without precedent. Such bases are known to exist in Colorado and Nevada.

387

00:40:18,000 --> 00:40:23,000

If a similar type of installation exists in New Mexico, what is its purpose?

388

00:40:23,000 --> 00:40:37,000

When we hear from here is what they mention is the possibility of military communications with offshore submarines, with other military installations with electromagnetic waves.

389

There have been a lot of studies in the military and other parts of government about effects of radiofrequency energy, even at low frequencies, on human behavior and physiology.

390

But the Defense Department insists that RF studies have no relation to the Taos Hum.

Congress claims to be as puzzled about the Hum as anyone and is cooperating fully with an ongoing investigation by the University of New Mexico.

There are people out there who are sensing something which is extremely disturbing to them. Many of them make them ill enough, they've left the area.

And obviously, something needs to be done about it.

But so far, the University team's findings have been inconclusive.

Despite these claims, the University of New Mexico continues to study the Taos Hum and its possible source.

The University of New Mexico has had to design and build equipment that will test the responses of these people to very low frequencies.
