Then in 1995, a sightings researcher made an important discovery.

This is where we were doing that trolling that night.

120

Broke right over these tree tops right here.

But in the two years following this incident,

153

Haunter became only the first in a series of military base overflights.

Between 1973 and 1975,

155

more than 75 bases reportedly had sightings of UFOs.

156

But we will never have a full accounting of these UFO incidents

157

because of what happened at Hunter Army Airfield.

158

Within the structure of the military and the internet,

159

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:20,000

they're not going to reward you for reporting an incident like that.

160

It just doesn't behoove anybody to be passing out medals for that one.

161

Sightings has also located Alexander Murray,

162

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:33,000

the dispatcher who received the original UFO report.

163

Sightings will bring you his interview on a future program.

164

Investigator Larry Fawcett is still trying to locate the second MP

165

00:12:40,000 --> 00:12:42,000

who witnessed the UFO alongside Bart Burns.

166

The former MP's name is Randy Shade.

167

00:12:45,000 --> 00:12:52,000

And in 1973, Shade was a spec for at Hunter Army Airfield in Savannah, Georgia.

168

Next, a London police detective who knows the spirit of the law.

169

I'm questioning the spirit, and I tend to ask a lot of questions

170

of those that communicate with me.

171

In Great Britain, psychics have to be licensed and registered.

172

Among the roster of registered psychics is Keith Charles,

173

a man who believes that he has a sixth sense about where and how

174

00:13:17,000 --> 00:13:19,000

a crime has been committed.

175

00:13:19,000 --> 00:13:22,000

Charles uses this psychic ability every day in his work.

176

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:26,000

He is the world's only registered psychic police constable.

177

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:39,000

In Metropolitan London, detective constable Keith Charles is working his beat.

178

00:13:39,000 --> 00:13:45,000

With a badge, a notebook, and what he believes is a supernatural gift,

179

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:50,000

Keith Charles solves crimes for his department's criminal investigation division.

180

00:13:50,000 --> 00:13:54,000

After hours, he uses those same powers in a completely different setting.

181

00:13:54,000 --> 00:13:58,000

It is those that are in the spirit world, in heaven,

182

00:13:58,000 --> 00:14:02,000

that hopefully will communicate with me.

183

00:14:02,000 --> 00:14:08,000

And I will pass on those messages that they have to you.

184

00:14:08,000 --> 00:14:11,000

Since he was eight, Charles has had clairvoyant visions,

185

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:15,000

one which he believes led him to save the life of a drowning friend.

186

He uses his psychic skills in seminars like this one,

187

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:22,000

and on the job, where his uncanny powers of perception were evident

188

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:25,000

the moment he started patrolling the streets of London.

189

00:14:25,000 --> 00:14:28,000

People would come up from all over the world and all over the UK,

190

00:14:28,000 --> 00:14:31,000

and I would find myself being able to say,

191

I know you, you've got a sister, you've got this,

192

00:14:35,000 --> 00:14:38,000

or you live near a church, and they were saying, how do you know this?

193

And I really didn't know, but I was getting information from somewhere.

194

Charles points out that hard work and diligence drive his investigations,

195

00:14:45,000 --> 00:14:49,000

but he's not above asking for other worldly help in some cases.

196

There are times when I will be investigating a crime,

197

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:57,000

that I've come to a dead end,

198

00:14:57,000 --> 00:15:02,000

and then I will look towards the spirit world and say to him, come on, give me a clue.

199

00:15:02,000 --> 00:15:08,000

And sometimes the spirits in Charles' world lead him down a completely unexpected path.

200

It was a few years ago, whilst working in this district, that in this road here,

201

00:15:12,000 --> 00:15:15,000

a man was stabbed to death.

202

00:15:15,000 --> 00:15:18,000

We formed a murder squad, and I was one of the officers,

203

00:15:18,000 --> 00:15:22,000

and we were asked to suggest the names of possible suspects.

204

00:15:22,000 --> 00:15:26,000

I linked into spirit and asked them if they could give me the name of the person responsible,

205

00:15:26,000 --> 00:15:28,000

and they did, they gave me the name of Ricky.

206

00:15:28,000 --> 00:15:31,000

However, he wasn't responsible for stabbing this man to death,

207

00:15:31,000 --> 00:15:35,000

but that same day, he killed a young lady,

208

00:15:35,000 --> 00:15:38,000

and later in the week killed another young lady.

209

Respect from fellow officers wasn't automatic.

210

00:15:43,000 --> 00:15:47,000

Charles earned their admiration after a series of startling revelations.

211

Detective Inspector Alan Wilson called Charles a lot of murder case

212

00:15:50,000 --> 00:15:55,000

after 2,000 hours of police work failed to turn up a suspect.

213

00:15:55,000 --> 00:16:01,000

Our victim had left the party, had taken the girl to a taxi,

214

00:16:01,000 --> 00:16:04,000

had gone to the bank and got some money.

215

None of these details were released yet, he knew them, some had.

216

He told us descriptions of people who were in the building.

217

00:16:12,000 --> 00:16:16,000

He actually came up with 20 to 25 points,

218

but he came up with information that we'd never released.

219

Even the most skeptical members of a naturally reticent force had to admit,

220

Keith Charles had a way of knowing, beyond logic and reason.

221

There were a lot of skeptics in the police force,

222

and when I told my other colleagues about it,

223

even they, the hairs did stand up at the back of the neck somewhat, yeah.

And Charles was able to turn around a skeptical British press corps,

225

00:16:47,000 --> 00:16:52,000

including one journalist who ended up co-writing Keith Charles autobiography.

226

I was extremely skeptical, yes.

227

00:16:55,000 --> 00:17:00,000

I was originally chasing what seemed to me like a very good news story.

228

I mean, here you had a policeman who was also a psychic.

229

It just had to be a great story.

230

00:17:07,000 --> 00:17:10,000

So I followed him around for quite a while after this

231

and found him unbelievably impressive, and I don't say that lightly.

I've opened the door here, and I have a gentleman who says he's your husband.

233

I have the name of James in the spirit world.

In his public appearances, Charles tries to bridge the gap

235

00:17:27,000 --> 00:17:32,000

between this world and the next, reassuring the living that they're dead are in good hands.

236

As a psychic detective, I'm questioning the spirit.

237

00:17:36,000 --> 00:17:40,000

And I tend to ask a lot of questions of those that are communicating with me

238

00:17:40,000 --> 00:17:44,000

because I feel if I could give somebody that knowledge and that comfort,

239

00:17:44,000 --> 00:17:50,000

knowing that their mum, their dad, brother or son is around them in the spirit world,

240

00:17:50,000 --> 00:17:52,000

that their life continues, that's fine.

241

00:17:52,000 --> 00:17:57,000

You have had a scar on your knee, please, Rachel.

242

00:17:57,000 --> 00:17:59,000

Yes.

243

00:17:59,000 --> 00:18:02,000

Yes, they are aware of this,

244

00:18:02,000 --> 00:18:07,000

and they are bringing you confirmation that spirit do look after you.

245

I now have a grandmother that links with you.

246

I have a scar on my knee.

247

I was in a car accident, and I've got quite a big scar on my knee,

248

and that's when I realised that it was true and that he was telling the truth.

And then when my grandmother came through,

250

I'd been waiting for my grandmother to come through and speak to me for a long time.

In 1994, Keith Charles' 20-year-old son Matthew was killed suddenly,

252

and Charles says he had a life-changing communication with his son.

253

What I've learned from it is that it makes me more determined as a medium

254

to be as genuine and sincere as you can,

255

because I've lost somebody close to me, and I know what it means.

256

And I find it nice and comforting that Matthew can come and help me.

257

He wanted to work with me in the physical, now he's working with me in the spiritual.

258

And I say thank you to him for that, because it's lovely.

259

His life is a balancing act between faith in other worldly forces

260

and the cold reality of the streets.

It's a challenge every day.

262

I enjoy my work as a medium.

263

I enjoy my work as a policeman,

264

and I'm very thankful that I'm able to do both,

265

and that I've been given the opportunity to do both,

266

and I love both of them.

In the United States, few police officers will work with psychics,

268

let alone entertain the possibility that they may be psychic themselves.

It's a feeling Beth Batesle has had for more than 25 years.

As a family, they have lived in 11 different houses throughout the state of New Jersey.

Recently they decided to try a more rural setting in the woods near Lake Arielle, Pennsylvania.

When we moved here, we thought that it was the best thing we could do for the simple reason that it was out of state.

But even putting 200 miles between themselves and their last home has not kept the unwanted hauntings off their trail.

Something, some paranormal force, has followed them here.

Lisa and Laura Batesle were the first to sense that something was terribly wrong in this house as well.

Lisa came tearing up the stairs, telling us something, she was babbling.

It was my cat hanging by a rope with its eyes gouged out.

I knew nothing had happened to the kitten. I knew that what they had seen was an apparition of the kitten.

483

Over the years, Beth and Bob have consulted numerous paranormal investigators, including psychologist Carl Schlotterbeck.

I think there's a rich combination of things happening.

485

One, I think that there are spirits attached to them as a family.

486

There are great hosts for people in bodies and outside of bodies.

In their newest home, Schlotterbeck has taken hundreds of photographs and believes he has been able to capture evidence of spirit forms on film.

It was highly irregular because they are things that I've never seen in photographs before.

Even the large light that looks like it would be lens flare still doesn't fit the typical pattern of lens flare

490

that wasn't a source of light.

491

The photos are an important document of the Batesle haunting, but for Beth, it feels like too little, too late.

492

The ordeal over these last 20 odd years has very much affected me and my whole family and those who we know.

493

Some people have become very frightened of us and are no longer our friends.

494

Sightings ask psychic Peter James to consult with the Batesle family and try to make contact with the stalking spirits.

495

Hello? Give me a sign that you're here. Identify yourself.

496

Peter agreed with Carl Schlotterbeck's assessment. The Batesle's were being followed by spirits,

497

but Peter also sensed a strong force attached to this house in particular.

498

I get the letter R first, then George, and then the last name that has a Y in it.

499

That's correct. The original owner's name was George Robert Kenyon.

Did he die tragically? Did he die abruptly?

501

Yes, he did. He got killed by a train in 1937.

Is it this extreme black, this pitch black circle on each of these objects that sort of was the whistle for you that sounded the alarm like that there might be some similarity between these two objects?

Yes. That area was puzzling to us in the original analysis because it appeared to be so highly absorbent of light.

Most objects illuminated in this bright of sky, even surfaces that are way down on the bottom out of the sunlight in deep shadow, still reflect light back to the camera.

547

This object stops reflecting right here on this forward edge and it falls off very rapidly to pure black down the center.

Very, very black, what we call super black.

Do you know any aircraft? Are you familiar with any aircraft that would look like that?

550

No.

In the sky?

552

We looked at it in comparison with all known types of military and commercial and private type aircraft, but we were unable to find any wings or anything along the geometry of this.

Each UFO has a black ridge center, an identical profile and a white diffuse shape shadowing the core.

554

00:44:36,000 --> 00:44:44,000

But these are not the characteristics that excite our expert, who's trained to analyze minute detail in satellite photos.

We took some video from a golf ball coming up through the sky and down to the green, produces a similar object to a UFO. It's a small white dot in the sky.

556

We were able to go to those images and with very minimal work, able to bring out the dimples in the golf ball in flight.

557

00:45:04,000 --> 00:45:13,000

When we look at these images, we can't get the definition of the geometry that we would expect for objects as close as this one was to a very good camera.

558

The objects by nature are fuzzy or undefined or unclear.

559

00:45:19,000 --> 00:45:26,000

This one was shot by a very expensive tracking camera on a very stable mount.

560

00:45:26,000 --> 00:45:34,000

This one was shot by a handheld consumer video camera and there's no difference in resolution.

561

00:45:34,000 --> 00:45:45,000

We find that puzzling that no matter how many of these images you get from whatever source, they all have that ball of cotton syndrome or that fuzziness to them.

562

00:45:45,000 --> 00:45:50,000

When they were seen only over Mexico City, it was a phenomenon.

563

00:45:50,000 --> 00:46:03,000

Now that the activity of seemingly identical UFOs has spread into American airspace, it can only be called a trend. The sightings investigation will continue.

564

00:46:03,000 --> 00:46:16,000

The Mexico City mass sightings continue unabated. After more than four years of persistent UFO encounters, there is still no consensus on what or who is responsible for these unexplained aircraft.
