Mainly, I was very good in math, and I was very good in science, and I did extremely well in school.

She earned top honors in medical school, graduated with distinction, and then set up her own practice based on the conservative approach to medicine she'd been taught.

I had a very traditional medical practice, really, on the outside.

I taught with the University of Toronto, and I taught medical students and residents.

So, I really did traditional practice.

She did practice that way, but she doesn't anymore.

Something happened to Dr. Kasen that altered not only her approach to medicine, but also fundamentally changed the way she's perceived the world around her.

Dr. Kasen, a nurse, and the pilot of a small plane were transporting a critically ill patient.

152

A freak blizzard caused the plane to lose power.

153

I thought, I'm going to die.

154

And the plane was going in this really rough turbulence crashing down to the ground.

So, we had to very quickly get out of the plane as the plane was sinking into the water.

The plane sank very fast, taking the life of the patient with it.

157

This was sub-zero freezing weather when this happened.

It was about 20 below.

I was wearing heavy clothes, and there I was.

I looked around, and blizzard happening around me.

What should I do?

162

And a voice in my head spoke, and the voice said, swim to shore.

163

But the shore was 200 yards away across a heavy downstream current.

Swimming didn't seem to be the best option.

165

Now, at this point, the pilot started saying, everybody climb on the ice.

Everyone get on the ice.

And I remember sort of arguing with this voice in my head.

So, I didn't start swimming to shore.

I started trying to crawl up on the ice.

170

And every time that I tried to get up on the ice, I'd sink into the water from the weight of my arms.

171

So, finally, I surrendered to that voice, and I started swimming to shore.

172

But the swim was too difficult, and in her frenzy, Dr. Kaysen had a remarkable experience.

It seemed like my consciousness, or my point of perception, raised up above my body somehow.

Once she surrendered to this non-physical presence,

181

Dr. Kaysen believed she was given the strength to reach the shore.

A rescue team rushed Dr. Kaysen, the nurse, and pilot to the hospital.

183

They were all unconscious.

184

I was in this wonderful, expanded place up here, and suddenly, with a noise,

185

I was sucked into my body, and all of a sudden, I was back.

The experience changed my life in a lot of ways.

I really wanted to figure out what it was.

That was the scientific part of me.

And so, I spoke with my medical friends, the doctors,

No one knew what it was.

193

People would give me theories like,

194

oh, maybe this was due to a low blood sugar,

195

or maybe this was a direct effect of cold on the brain, causing a hallucination.

But none of that was good enough for me.

197

After much study, Dr. Kaysen now believes

198

she had what paranormal researchers call the near-death experience.

I totally had lost my fear of death.

And that persists to this day.

Dr. Kaysen also believes that since the experience,

she has acquired psychic abilities, including clairvoyance.

It seems that having a near-death experience opens your consciousness somehow,

204

and makes you more open to various sorts of other mystical and paranormal experiences,

205

such as the clairvoyant experience.

Kevin, you see that house right there?

207

That's where Auntie Vonne grew up.

208

Colleen Isherwood has been Vonne Kaysen's friend for 30 years.

209

They grew up together in this Toronto neighborhood.

210

Before she had her near-death experience,

211

Vonne was not the type of person who would talk about anything mystical like that,

212

anything unusual.

213

But the more she began talking about her paranormal experiences,

214

the more she heard from others with similar stories.

Many people who'd had various sorts of spiritual or paranormal experiences

or a hallucination or a sign of mental illness.

So I found people over the years started coming to my office

220

so that more and more of my patients ended up being people

221

who'd had spiritual or paranormal experiences.

So my practice started shifting in this direction.

223

When I started seeing Vonne, I said,

224

what I want to do is first find out that I'm not crazy,

number one, what I'm experiencing,

and what I want to become is a more spiritual person.

Today, Dr. Kaysen is the director of the Spiritual Emergence Research and Referral Clinic in Toronto,

228

along with the staff of physicians and other healthcare professionals.

229

Dr. Kaysen has steered her practice towards the care and support of patients like Alexis Radlin.

230

After about 11 years of research,

231

I really felt ready to start talking publicly to doctors and to the public

232

00:16:36,000 --> 00:16:41,000

about what I'd come to understand about mystical and paranormal phenomenon.

And in her book, *A Father's Shore*,

234

Dr. Kaysen chronicles the personal stories of more than 100 of her patients,

235

all of whom have been transformed by a paranormal experience.

I know now to the core of my being that it's a universal human phenomenon.

237

Anyone can have a spiritually-transformative experience.

And if you do have one, it's truly a gift that can enrich your life.

Work has begun on the most comprehensive review of alien abduction accounts ever compiled.

Today's search for extraterrestrial intelligence is high-tech and computerized, but in 1924, one of the greatest mechanical minds in the country was an appliance builder named C. Francis Jenkins.

If there was anyone in the kind of world of invention at that time who had all the tools to do the kind of thing that Todd wanted to have done, I think Jenkins was a logical choice.

439

Jenkins had already developed an early form of television that converted radio signals into images on film.

Dr. Todd had Jenkins aim this device toward Mars on a day of national radio silence in October of 1924.

441

Effectively from what I understand, they used it to aim at Mars and knowing that it was going to be closest to the Earth on whatever that date was, and used it to record signals of some kind coming from Mars.

442

The signals proved to be astonishing. For the first time in human history, a strange message coming

from the direction of Mars was actually recorded on film.

443

They brought the film back and then had markings on the film, which were very hard to decipher.

There was apparently something that looked like a face that was constantly repeated along one edge of the film.

And it was this first so-called face-on-mars that rocked the scientific world in 1924. Many called it Martian Code and demanded that it be deciphered.

Todd and Jenkins submitted their film to the country's leading cryptologist. No one knows what happened next.

They sentenced the cryptologist, and I don't believe it was ever satisfactorily deciphered, to see what they had gotten.

That cryptologist was the late William Friedman, the United States government's master of decoded military secrets and the godfather of the CIA.
